ISSO OLYMPIAD 2022-23

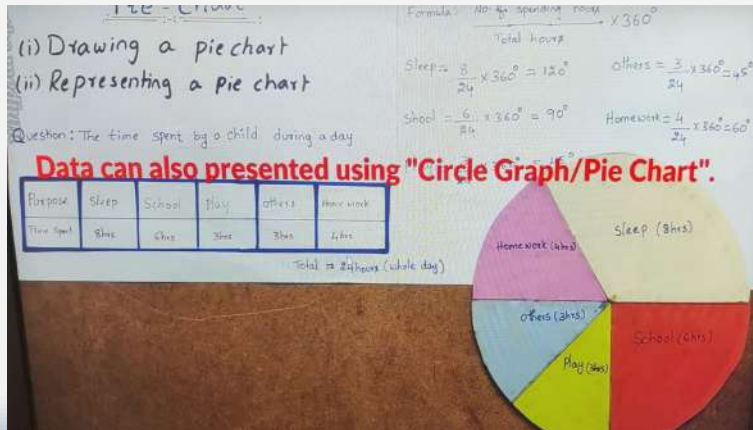
The students were given the medals for their achievements in the ISSO Olympiad for the session 2022-23. We congratulate all the achievers.

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD: CHESS TIME

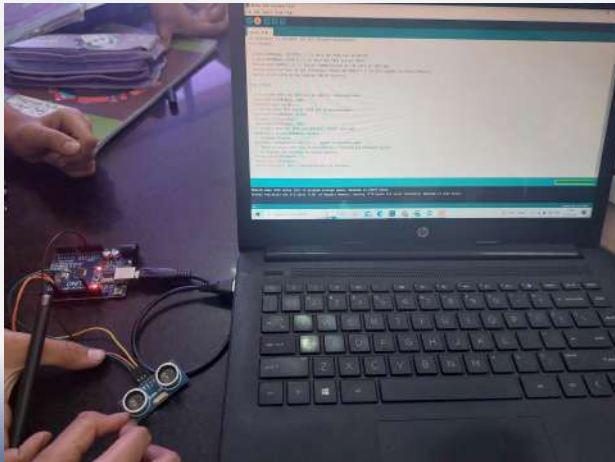
“You may learn much more from a game you lose than from a game you win. You will have to lose hundreds of games before becoming a good player.” – Jose Raul Capablanca

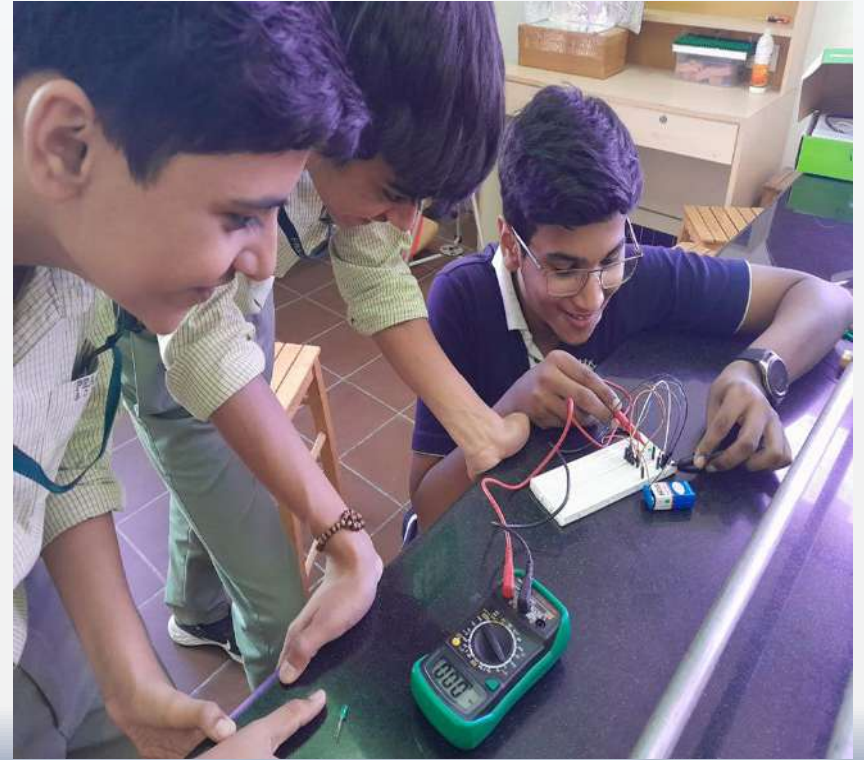
ATL SESSION IX-X

- Vocabulary: (colors, prepositions, labeling)

Practice self-regulation:

- Holding directions in your head
- Following multi-step directions
- Turn taking
- Switching between different tasks

Build math skills:

- Proportions (bigger, smaller, more than)
- Counting
- Sorting and matching items
- Measuring
- Shapes

Develop motor skills:

- Carrying and balancing
- Pinching and grasping, dexterity
- Coordinating movements and working with others
