ENGLISH

Letter O was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards and they were also encouraged to think and tell more things with letter O. They did colouring of O related pictures in their Letter Book and tracing of the letter O in their workbook.

MATHS

Number 11 was introduced to the students. They did counting of number 11 using different objects and practiced writing number 11 in their workbook. Children also practiced sequence writing of number 0-5 in their notebooks.

ENGLISH



This week letter r was introduced using picture flash cards and letter related stories. Children did written work in their workbooks and notebooks. Three letter words of ag family was done in class. Along with family words, the story The Red Hen was narrated in the class.

MATHS

Sequence writing from 100-140 was done in the class. Children also solved the sums in their workbooks related to the concept what comes before and after.

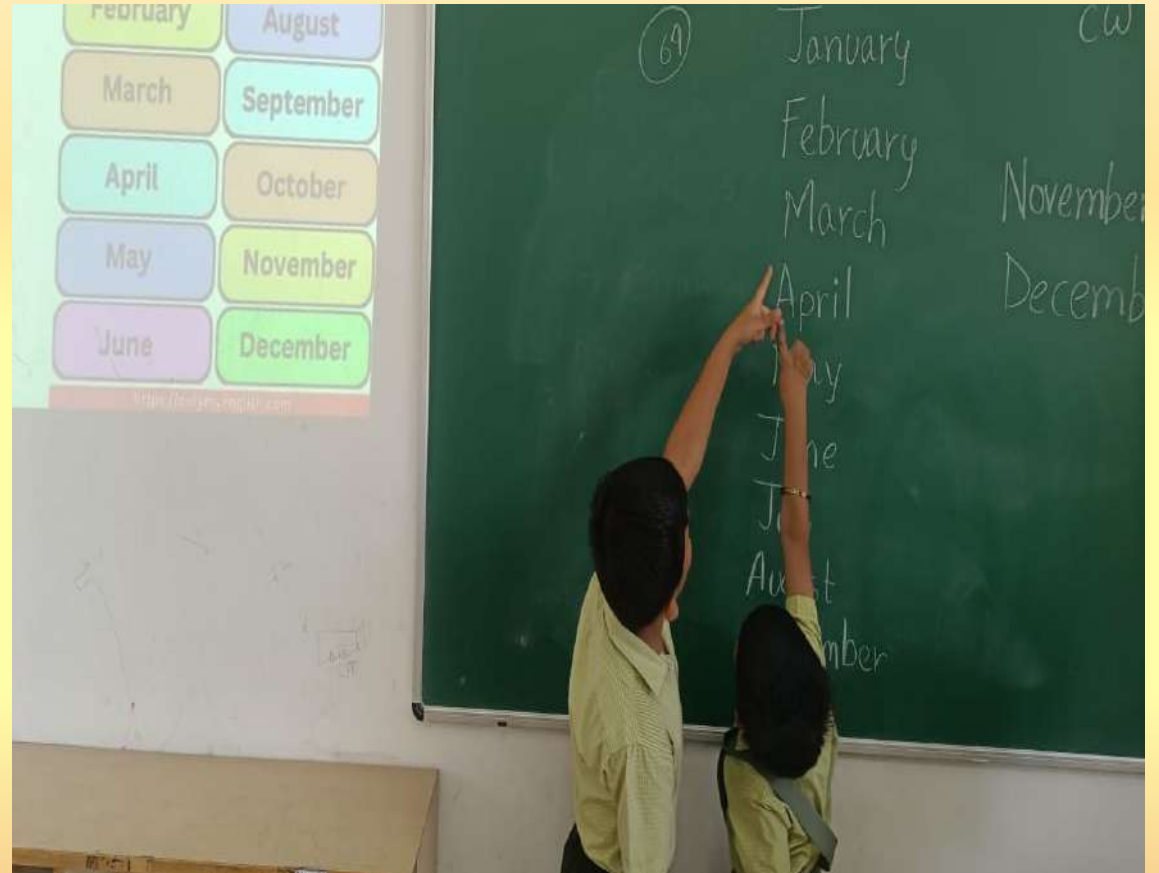




Math

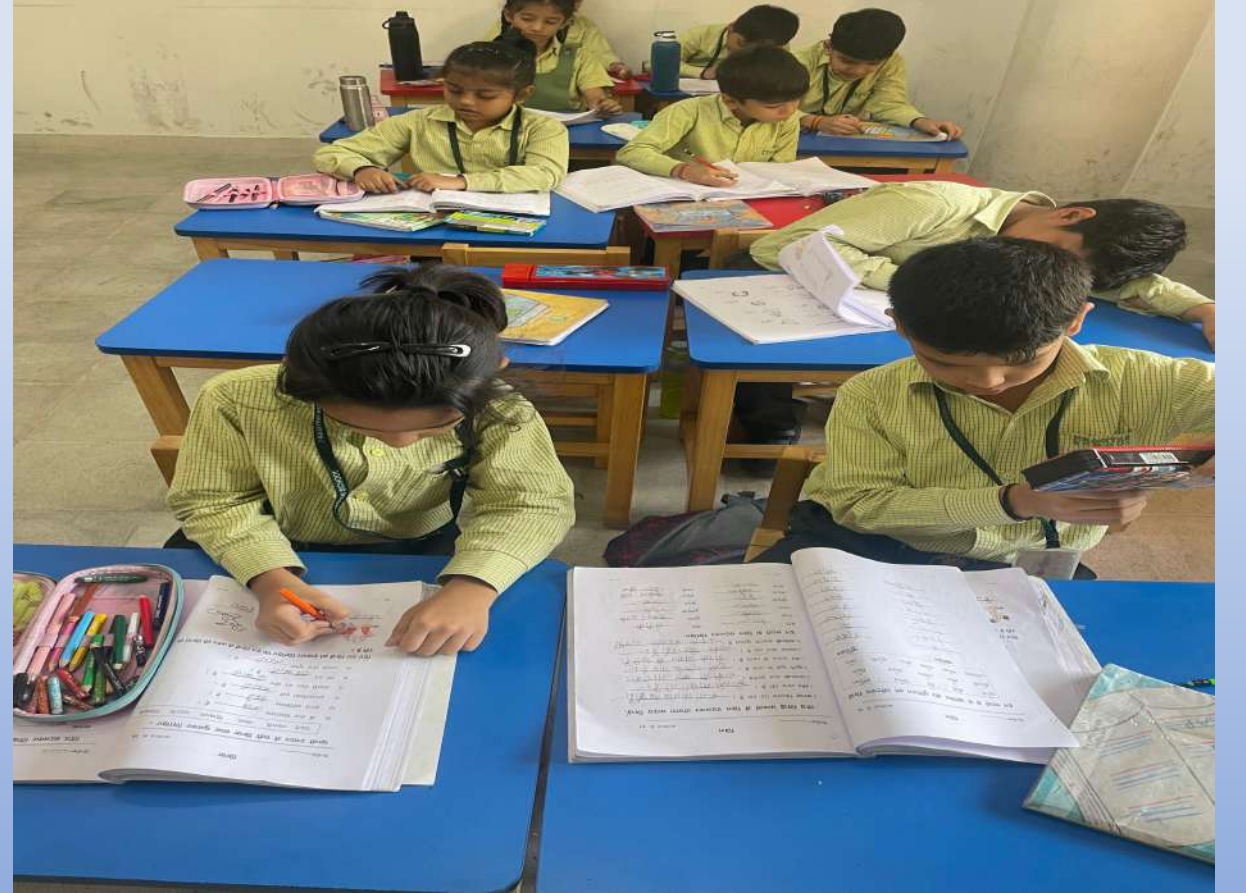

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children enjoyed doing general exercises, relay races and sprint races. Relay races or even just relays are really fun ideas that can work on gross and fine motor skills as well as teamwork, cooperation and social skills. All this while the kids are active and playing.



CIRCLE TIME/ VALUE EDUCATION

This week students of class 1 and 2 were introduced to triumphs Good over Evil during value education period. A video was shown to help them better understand the concept. In circle time they were asked what qualities they want to acquire in their life to become a good human being.



CLASS ASSEMBLY (1B)

Morning assemblies provide students with opportunities to actively participate and showcase their abilities. Whether it's delivering speeches, reciting poems, or performing in cultural activities, these experiences help students build confidence in public speaking and self-expression. Children of class 1B presented their class assembly on the topic Believe in yourself. It started with a few exercises, prayer followed by thought, news, talks, facts, poem and dance. Children were really excited and happy to present their assembly.



INTER CLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY(1&2)

Relay Races are a great way to teach kids how to be part of a team as well as learn social skills. This week students of grade 1 and 2 participated in the relay race. Children passed the flag to their friends and finished the race by reaching the finishing line with the flag. Children learned teamwork and cooperation which made the bond stronger among them.



WELLNESS SESSION(1&2)



As a part of interact club, children of classes 1 and 2 enjoyed doing wellness session taken by Ms. Reeta. Under this session children did some yoga asanas and meditation. A wellness program is a comprehensive health initiative designed to maintain or improve well-being through proper diet, exercise, stress management, and illness prevention.





Students of class 3 were introduced to the new lesson 'Anna's Experiments with Weather'. They learnt the meaning of the new words and wrote the questions and answers too. They revised the grammatical concept of Adjectives and did the written exercises. They were also introduced to the grammatical concept of Is/ Am/ Are. The students even wrote a paragraph on My Favourite Food. Revision of the poems of September and October were done too.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

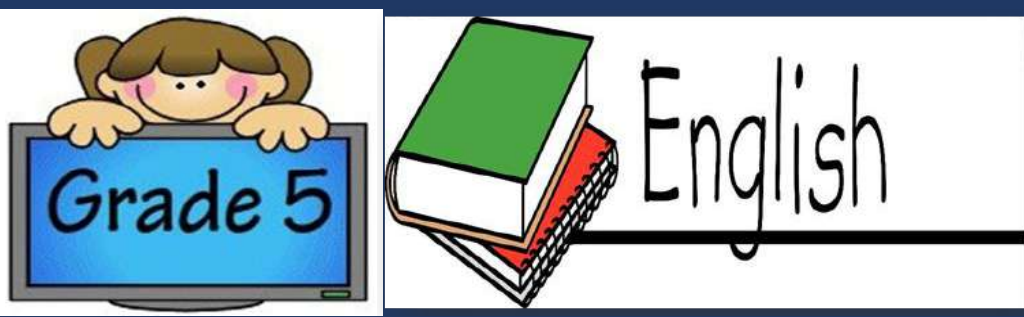

Students of grade 5 were introduced to the different monuments, paintings, literature and crafts of the prehistoric times with the introduction of Lesson 9 - Indian heritage and culture. The important monuments like forts, temples, towers, pillars and stupas were discussed in detail. The students were thrilled to know the various monuments constructed at different occasions in history by rulers and kings of different dynasties. The architecture and designs of the various monuments were also taken into consideration. Various PPTs and videos were also referred during the teaching of the same topic.





Students of grade 5 wrote the question answers of the lesson, Tintin in Tibet. They did a worksheet on tenses in the workbook and a few exercises in the notebook and Engaging English Workbook. They were also introduced to Homonyms and did an exercise related to it in the book.
