NURSERY

Hindi- vyanjan ट , ठ was introduced with flashcards practice of three and four letter words were done.

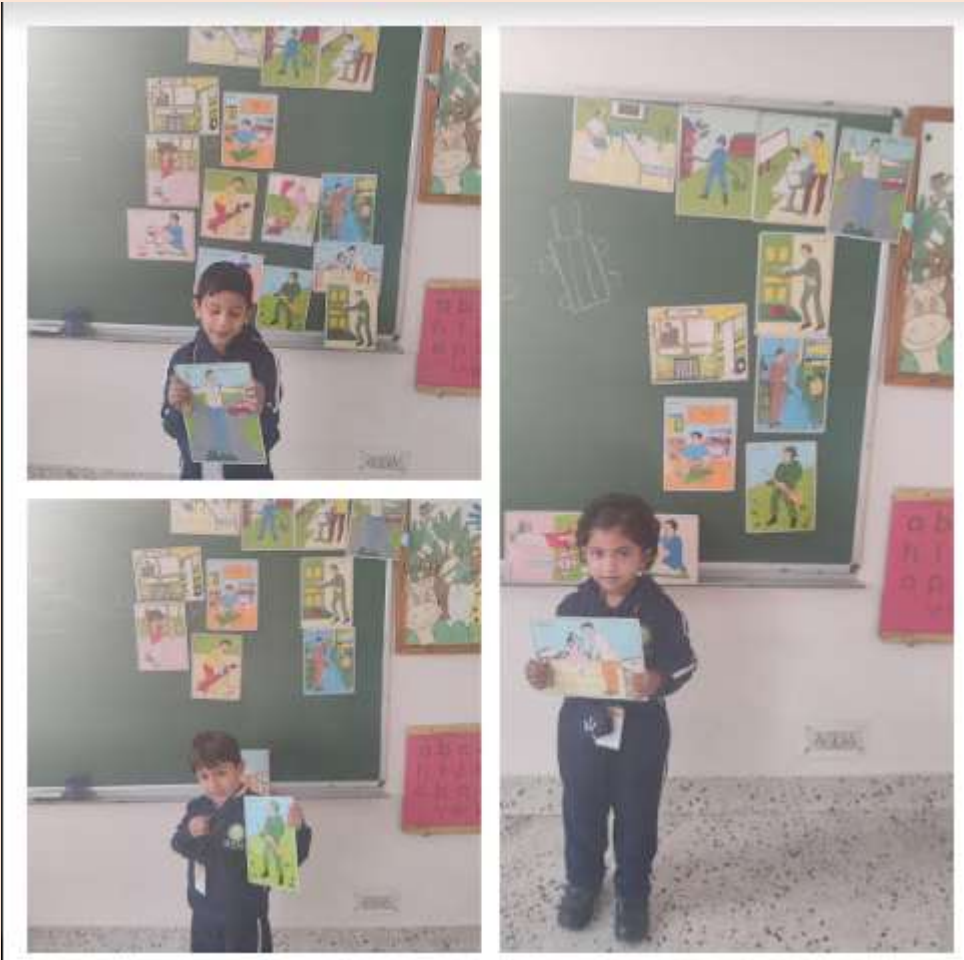


KINDERGARTEN

GA - Revision of community helpers was done .Students of KG enjoyed watching Ppt also.

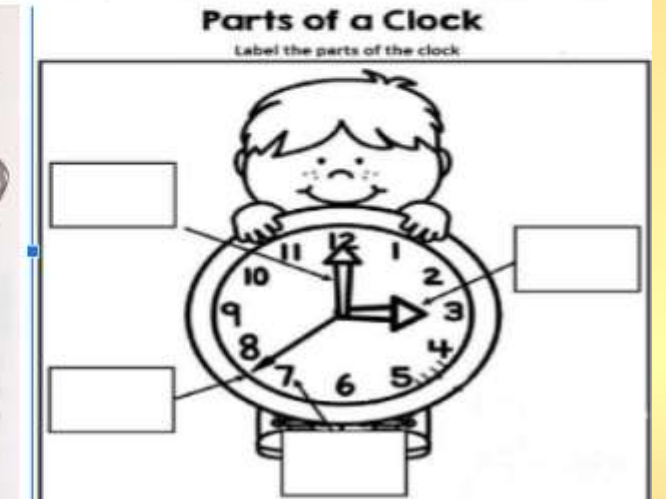
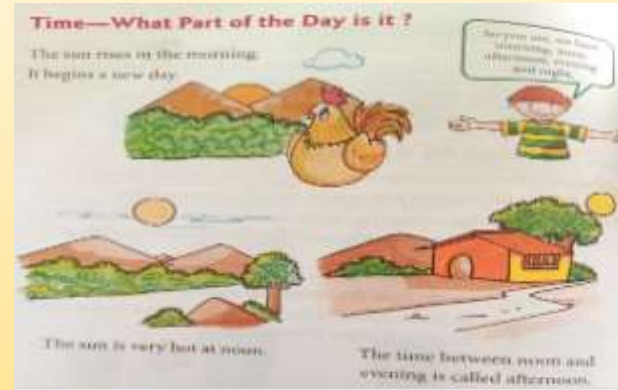
Evs- Revision of aquatic animals animals were done and related colouring worksheets were done during EVS class.

During the activity each child was given an opportunity to think about different vegetables and their importance which they could share with their classmates.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Share- Students share ideas with a larger group or whole class.




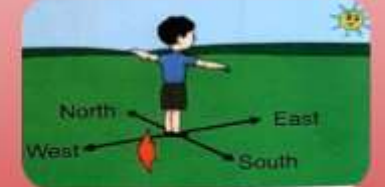
Maps are an important part of our everyday lives. Students of class 2 revised the chapter- Directions and Maps during their EVS class. Thinking Routines loosely guide learners' thought processes. Students shared various problems faced by drivers if pedestrians do not follow traffic rules.

MAPS

A map is a drawing that shows us the location of a place, a neighbourhood or a city. We use it to find our way. There are different types of maps.



The four main directions are North, South, East, West. The Sun rises in the East and sets in the West. If you stand facing the Sun in the morning, your front is towards the East and back points to the West your left hand points to the North and right hand points to the South.





STEM, an approach to learning and development that integrates the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics. This week students of class 2 got an opportunity to participate and assemble parts of a hand pump and get hands-on experience to see its working.

They had a wholesome experience visiting the gallery of handloom exhibits and handmade clothes preserved for centuries. They visited the shops and stalls put up by the local craftsmen. They also saw a documentary about how natural colours are processed and use of these colours while making wooden toys by the artisans. Students were mesmerized by the village complex where various regional villages and their habitats were displayed. The students were left spellbound at a mini concert of traditional folk music performed by local musicians. Overall, the experience was enthralling and educational for the students in many aspects.



EDUCATIONAL TRIP(CLASS 4)

Students of class 4, along with their class teachers, went for an educational trip to Humayun's Tomb on Thursday, 24th November. The students were elated to see the spectacular architecture, built entirely of red sandstone and marble.
