MUSIC

Students of the nursery enjoyed their music class and tried to match the tune of the song along with the teacher.



CRAFT (NUR-UKG)

Students of Nur - UKG enjoyed the activities like Headgear, tear & paste and Stick Puppet as part of takeaways in the first week of their school.



YOGA (NUR-UKG)

This week Nur - UKG students had a wonderful time learning easy yoga steps. They enthusiastically participated and showed great interest in doing the asanas.



NATURE WALK (NUR-UKG)

Students of Nur - UKG fondly participated in the nature walk in the first week. They were made aware of their surroundings that helped them focus their attention and take in the details of things around them.



CLAY MODELLING (NUR-UKG)

This week students of Nur - UKG were engaged in a clay modeling activity. They enthusiastically participated in creating a few articles with clay.



DANCE (NUR & KG)

Students of nursery and kindergarten tapped their feet on dance and action song “Bhalu wala aaya”. Dance provides opportunities for students to perform in front of their peers, helping them build confidence and self-esteem.



PUPPET STORY

Learning through play is fundamental to children, helping them develop the necessary skills in life. Puppets stimulate imagination, encourage creative play and discovery. Students of Nursery, KG and UKG enjoyed a puppet story enacted by the teachers on 5th April, 2024. It was an interactive session where students participated and answered the questions based on the story.





Students of class 1 were introduced to blend letters where they revised the -ch sound during their English class. Kids were taught the pronunciation of the sound with a few examples. They were shown a video for better understanding which includes reading of certain words with the same sound. Later they participated in an activity where each child got an opportunity to explore and share five different words which they wrote in their notebook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Children of class 1 enjoyed a virtual tour of ‘A Trip to a Zoo’ in which they learned interesting facts about animals. They also studied the chapter ‘My body’ which enabled them to learn the vocabulary of body parts and their functions. They learned about body movement, which helps to work and play. They all participated in the Quiz: Know your Body which they really enjoyed. They drew parts of their bodies in their EVS notebook.

Children of class 1 enjoyed doing number art where they showed their creativity. Children revised number names and numbers which they have already done in their previous class. Also they made a craft based on number names.

They participated in an interactive activity called "Plant Warriors," creating headgear and adorning it with leaf impression art. This engaging activity combined fun and educational elements, enhancing their learning experience.

Art Integrated Learning is a teaching-learning model which is based on learning 'through the arts' and 'with arts'. Students of class 2 tried their hands on Number Art. They drew different pictures with the help of digits 1-5. They also revised forward counting, Number names, before, after and between, concept of lesser than, greater than or equal to during the week. Kids enjoyed online game on number names and prepared a miniature table book as a takeaway activity.

COMPUTER(1&2)

VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)



“Words make you think. Music makes you feel.” Students of classes 1 and 2 enjoyed their vocal music class and practiced singing their prayer “Hey gyan roopi bhagwan” during their music class. Also they learnt and practiced sargam geet and ॐ pronunciation.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Students of class 1 and 2 learnt different rules to be followed during their movement from class to any other area. They were also told about how to line up with proper distancing. They also practiced movements following directions (left and right) followed up by a few recreational activities.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

Students of class- 1 visited their school library during the week and went through pictures in the books related to colours, fruits, numbers, vegetables etc. they also were narrated a story by the teacher from the story book. Students of class 2 read different books of their choice.

As we begin with a new session, it is important for our young minds to know and understand the classroom and school rules. A general discussion on discipline, hygiene and punctuality was done in the class. A detailed PPT was shown and ideas were exchanged.

Drawing helps students to process information and consolidate their thinking. It allows students to express their thinking in a way that is accessible to them. Drawing also helps with the development of fine motor skills with students in the early years. Keeping this in mind and to explore the creative potential in the young minds of our children, “Draw and Colour activity” was conducted on Wednesday during the enrichment class where each child got an opportunity to draw and colour a picture of their choice. It was a fun-filled activity.

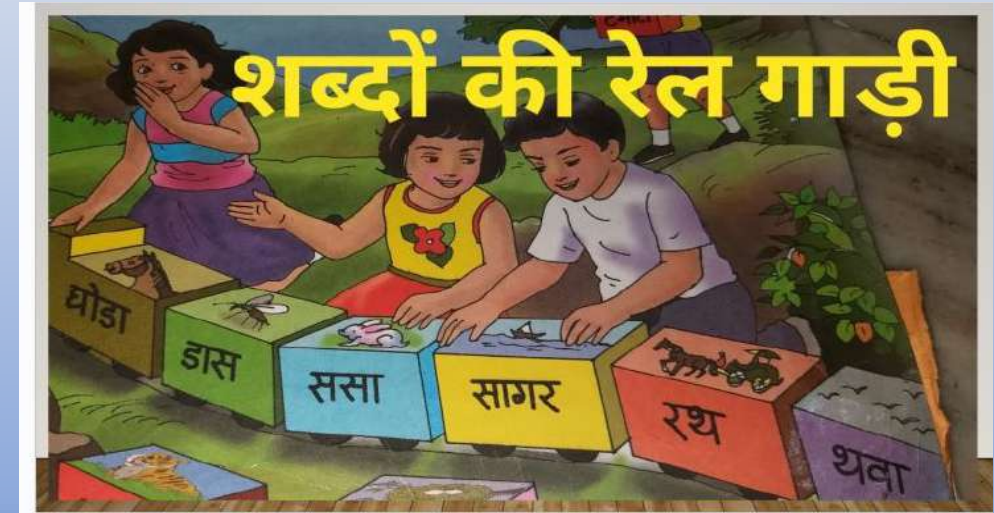

Students of class V revised the concept of nouns this week. They did an exercise based on it in the notebook and workbook. They were also introduced to the new words and poem of the month.

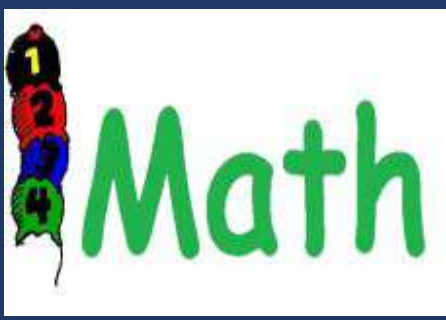




हिन्दी
