NURSERY



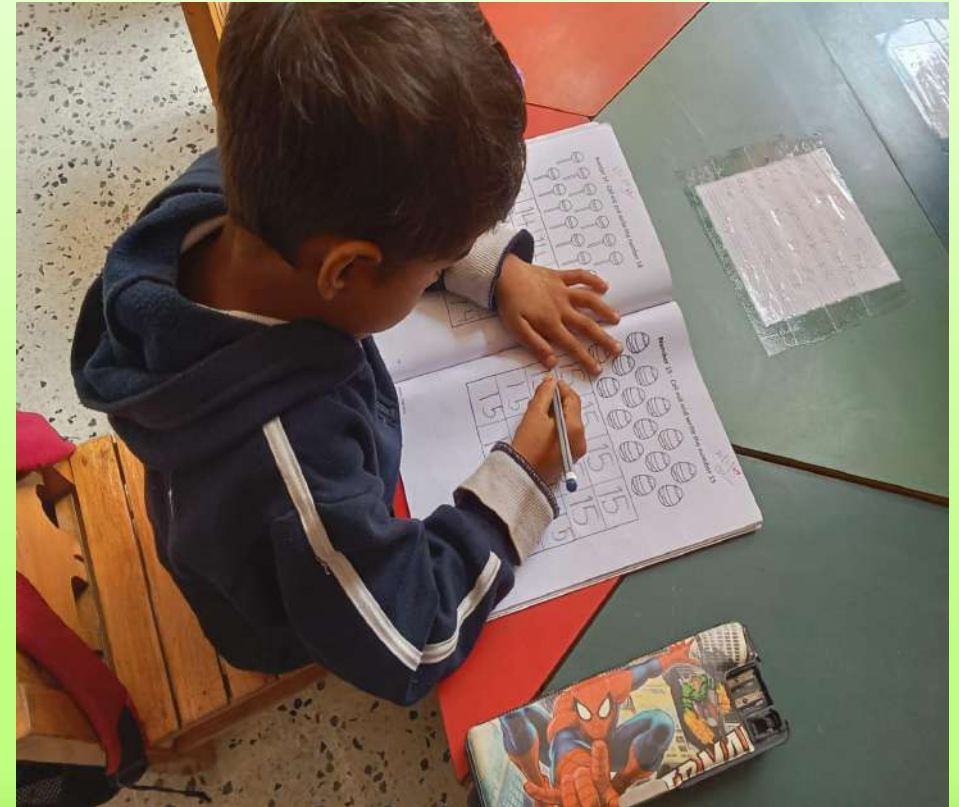
ENGLISH

Letter R was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards and they practiced the sound of letter R. Students coloured R related pictures in their Letter Book and traced the letter in their workbook.



MATHS

Number 15 was introduced to the students. They did counting of number 15 using blocks and also practiced writing the number in their workbook. They also did a worksheet related to the after number.



HINDI

Introduction of Vyanjan 'प' was done with the help of pictures. Students did colouring and tracing of 'प' in their letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, a few community helpers were discussed with the nursery children. They enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.

KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Students of kindergarten learnt 'eg' and 'en' family words. They practiced writing words of these families in their notebook. Recap of sight words was also done during the week .

MATHS

Skip counting of 10's was introduced through flash cards. Recap of skip counting of 2's and 5's was done. Students learnt the number names of one and two. They did worksheets based on these concepts.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week the children were introduced to a few more community helpers, i.e. firefighters and carpenters. They learnt about how these people help us, what tools they use. They also enjoyed reciting the poem, Ten little firemen related to the concept.



RESOURCE ACTIVITY

During the week students of Kindergarten learnt a lot of things in the form of experiential learning. Some of the activities included, sorting activity for rhyming words, ascending order by pegging the numbers on the strings, to improve their fine motor skill. They also explored their surroundings and collected a few materials to differentiate between living and non living things.



MUSIC (NUR & KG)

Children naturally love to move and sing. Students of Nursery enjoyed learning the song 'Dadi Dadi Nana Nani' and the children of Kindergarten learnt the song 'Jaise Suraj ki kiran' during practice session.



YOGA (NUR & KG)

Regular yoga practice promotes a healthy lifestyle and fosters a positive body image. Students of class nursery and kindergarten practiced asanas to remain fit and improve body posture.



CLASS ASSEMBLY (KG)

Assemblies play an important role in promoting and building up confidence in students. This week the children of KG A , B and C presented their class assemblies on Transport. Children confidently spoke about different modes of transport and recited different poems.

Students of class 1 were introduced to the chapter “ The parrots and the flower” during their English class They participated in class discussions and oral questions related to the chapter. Later they enjoyed creating the chapter through pictorial presentation.

Children of class 1 enjoyed learning about the concept of money. Different Indian currency images were shown to children for recognition. Real money was also shown to children for better understanding. Addition of money was also discussed. Number names 80-89 and tens and ones for the number 70-79 and 80-89 were also done in the class. Related videos and PPTs were shown.

Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed practicing previous notes on C scale and on tabla boal practice. Tabla include improved coordination, dexterity, breathing techniques, stamina, and rhythm.
