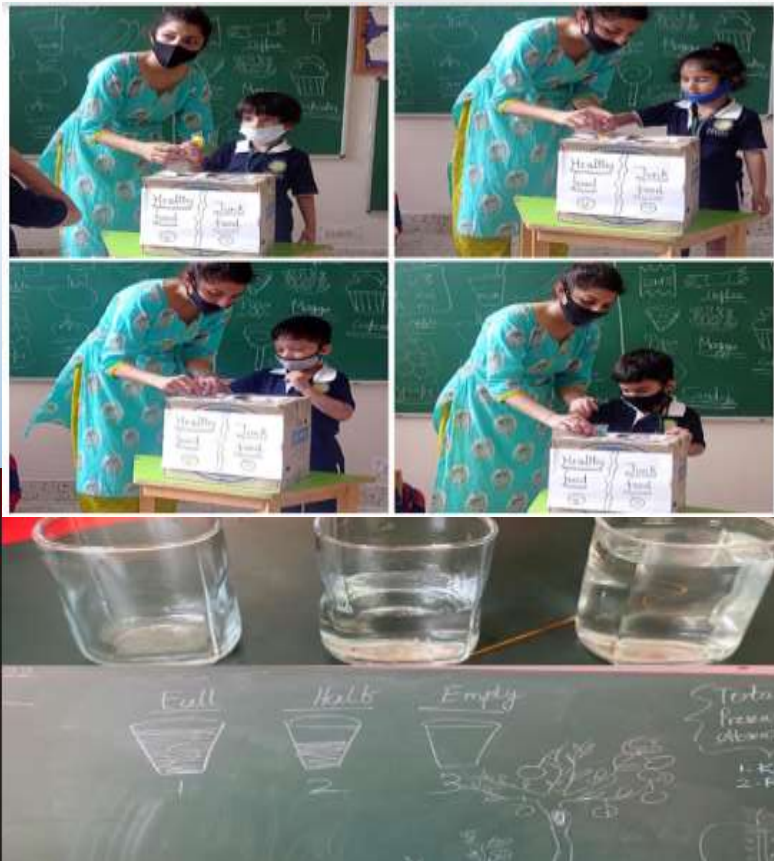
NURSERY

KINDERGARTEN



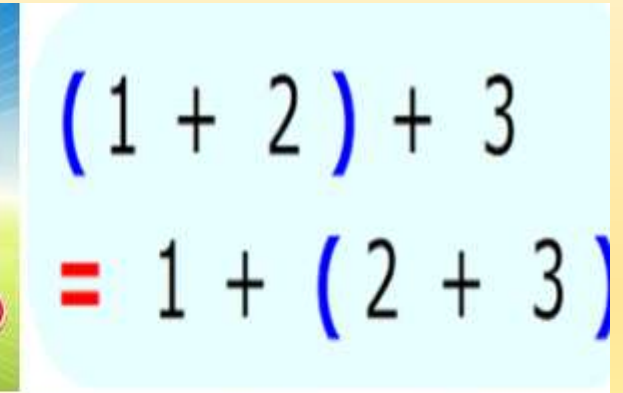
Hindi- Introduction of swar 'ॡ' was done with flashcards and pictures. Written practice was also done in the class.

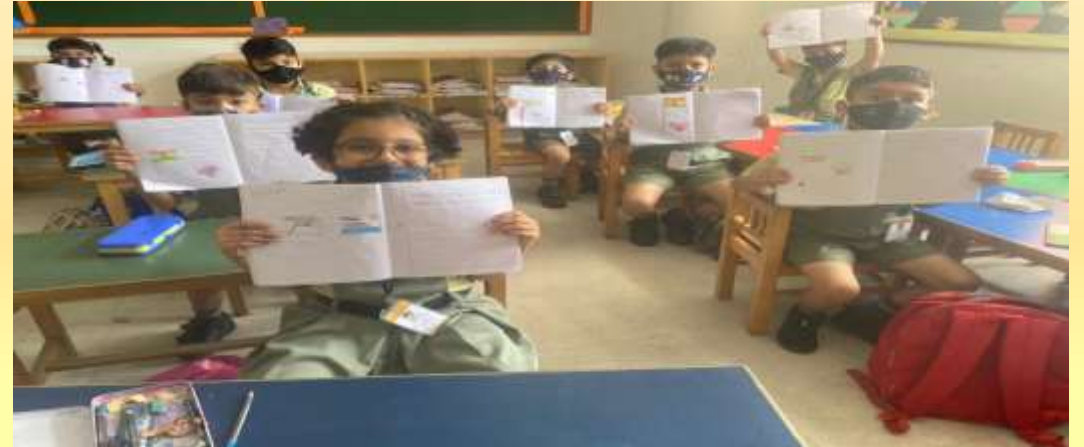

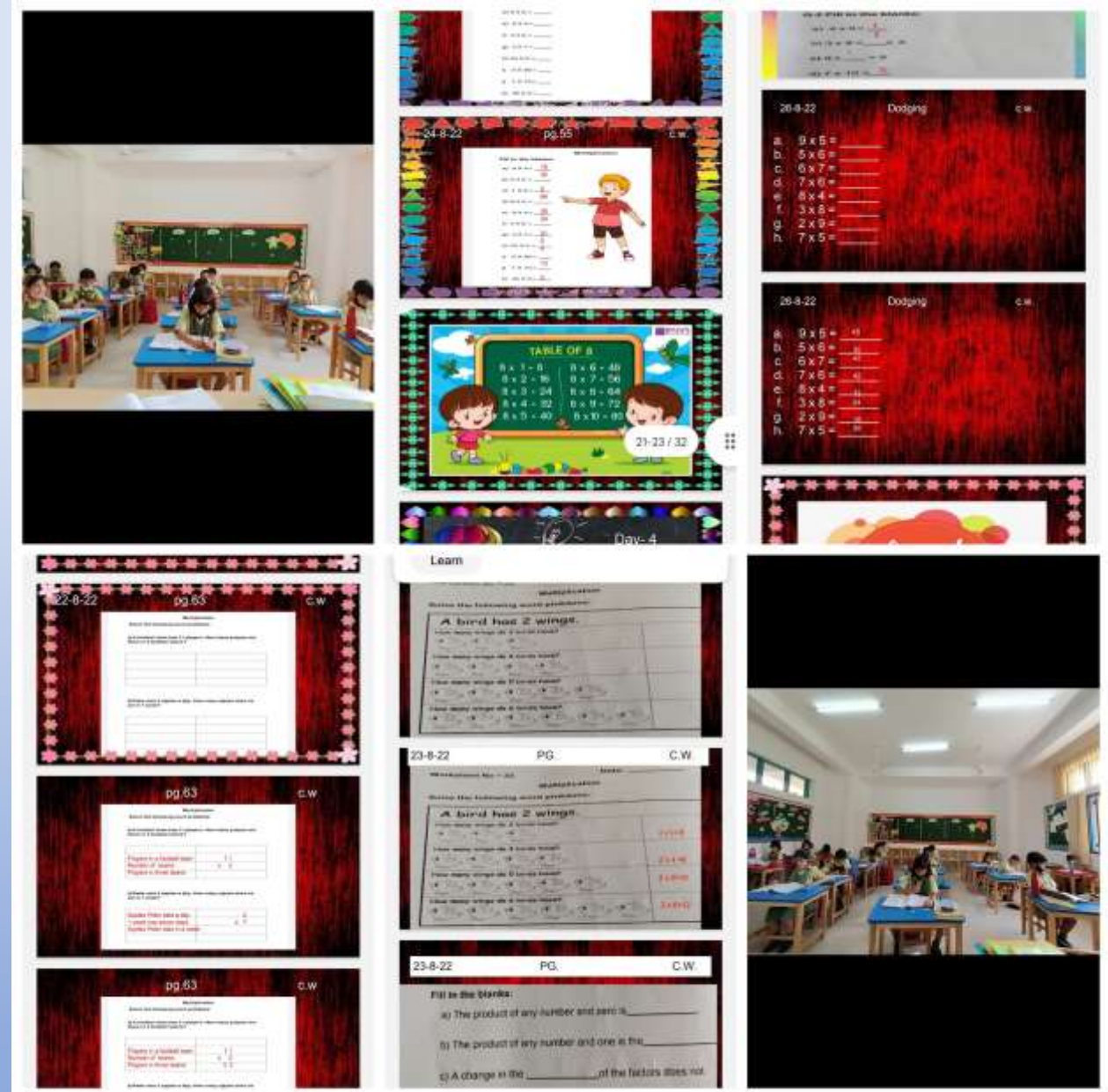

CLASS ASSEMBLY (1B)

They also learned about the neighbouring countries of India. Oral evaluation of the topics taught was also done in the class to revise the concepts. 




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of grade 5 were introduced to the deserts of the world with the introduction of Lesson 6: The Deserts. The location and climatic factors of the deserts were discussed in detail. The students were thrilled to learn about the three categories of deserts-hot, temperate and cold along with their examples and location in a world map. The various special adaptations of the plant and animal life of this region was also taken into consideration.

Animal Life:

- A large variety of animals, birds and insects, such as **camels, foxes, hyenas, hedgehogs, snakes, spiders and scorpions, are found in the hot desert.**
- To avoid the heat, some small animals live in underground shelters, where the temperature is much lower than that on the surface.



L-6: The Deserts

Location:

- Deserts occupy about one-third of the Earth's surface.
- They are mainly found around the **Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn in the northern and southern hemispheres, respectively.**
- This region receives less than 250 mm of rain a year.
- The rainfall pattern is not a seasonal one. Instead, rain usually occurs as sudden, violent thunderstorms.
- **Deserts are usually located on the western side of the continents.**
