KINDERGARTEN



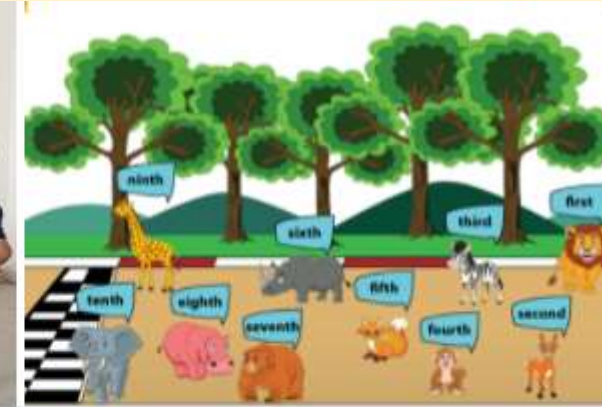
GA -New concept of community helpers was discussed like community helpers play an important role in society.

Students of class 3 had their Formative Assessment-2 in their regular English classes. They had reading, recitation, dictation, activity and writing skills as Minor English Assessments. They solved worksheets based on word problems in division in their class.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Grade 4 students studied the chapter Soil in EVS. They studied the process of formation of soil and different types of soil and the crops grown in these soil. The students also studied soil erosion and how we can prevent soil erosion. They spoke about the different methods of soil conservation and also made a poster showing these methods. Videos and ppt related to the topics taught were also shown to the students.





During the week students of class 4 had their minor assessments of FA2 in reading, recitation, writing skills, dictation and activity. They were also introduced to the poem of the month- The Sun is in My Heart. Chapter Oliver Goes to London was introduced. New words were explained and written in the notebook.
