NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week, nursery class explored the letter P, its phonetic sound, and related words. Students discovered new words starting with P and revised letters V, W, and K. Through writing practice, worksheets, and engaging activities like Salt tracing and Scavenger Hunts, they reinforced their learning. These interactive sessions promoted effective learning and participation.



HINDI

This week, Nursery students were introduced to the letter त with interactive activities. They practised its sound, formation, and learnt related vocabulary. The children enthusiastically coloured the worksheet connected to the letter त. Revision of previously introduced letters was also done to reinforce recognition, recall, and learning continuity.



MATH

This week, nursery class introduced the number 11, focusing on counting and related concepts. Students also revised numbers 1 to 10. Through writing practice, worksheets, and engaging activities, they reinforced their understanding of numbers. These interactive sessions promoted effective learning and participation.



YOGA

This week, students learned and practiced Vrikshasana (Tree Pose) and Ardha Chakrasana (Half Wheel Pose) in their Yoga class. These asanas helped improve their balance, flexibility, and overall physical well-being. The students enthusiastically participated and demonstrated a keen interest in Yoga, showcasing their growing awareness and control over their bodies.



ART & CRAFT

This week, Nursery students creatively assembled parts of a plant in their scrapbooks, pasting colourful cuttings of flowers, stems, and leaves. With effective arrangement, they formed a complete plant. This engaging activity developed their fine motor skills, creativity, and understanding of plant structures.



CLAY MODELLING

This week, students engaged in a clay modelling activity, creating trees with various parts such as stems, roots, leaves, and fruits. Through this hands-on experience, they gained a better understanding of tree structures and developed their fine motor skills, creativity, and spatial awareness.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

This week, the children were introduced to the at and am family word, as well as the letter r. It was an exciting milestone, as it marked their first time writing three-letter (CVC) words. They actively participated in reading and writing exercises, which significantly supported the development of both their oral language skills and writing abilities.

HINDI

This week, the children were introduced to the letter **ल**, along with continued reading and writing practice of two-letter words. These activities are helping to lay a strong foundation for early literacy, further enhancing their reading fluency and writing confidence.



MATH

We had another fun and exciting week in math. The children learned to count from 80 to 90, which helped them get better at recognizing and saying bigger numbers. They also practiced ascending numbers with objects and later with numbers later. They were introduced to skip counting by 5.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

This week, the kids enjoyed a hands-on activity where they learned about different animals and sorted them into groups. In math, they practiced concepts like ascending order and before–after, making learning both fun and engaging.



EASP

This week, the children enjoyed their sports class where they practiced regular exercises to stay fit. They also participated in different races and engaged in throw-and-catch activities with great enthusiasm.



JADUI PITARA

In the Jaadui Petara classes this week, children picked pictures from the magic box and wrote CVC words they had learned earlier. They also enjoyed sorting cutouts of different animals, identifying wild and pet animals. It was a fun way to learn through play.





ENGLISH

This week in English, students were introduced to "ee" sound words. They completed worksheets related to these words and practiced reading them aloud. Through these activities, students improved their reading, pronunciation, and vocabulary skills. They also became more confident in recognizing and using "ee" sound words in context.



HINDI

This week in Hindi, students completed worksheets related to इ की मात्रा . In their notebooks, they formed words by joining letters. They also practiced reading words with इ की मात्रा. These activities helped improve their reading, writing, and word formation skills in Hindi.



MATH

This week in Math, students completed worksheets on single and double-digit subtraction. In their notebooks, they practiced arranging numbers in ascending order from 161 to 180. These activities helped improve their subtraction skills, number sense, and understanding of number order.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week in General Awareness, students completed worksheets related to festivals. They drew pictures of different festivals in their workbooks and coloured them. Through these activities, students learned about various festivals celebrated in India and their importance. These tasks helped improve their general knowledge, creativity, and fine motor skills.



SCIENCE EXPERIMENT

In the Science experiment this week, students were introduced to the word *germination*. The concept and process of germination were explained to them verbally. Students listened carefully and learned how a seed grows into a plant. This activity helped improve their listening skills, understanding of scientific terms, and ability to follow verbal instructions.



ORATORY

This week in Oratory, students narrated the story of *The Shepherd Boy and the Wolf* using props. They understood the moral of the story — that no one believes a liar, even when they tell the truth. This activity helped improve their speaking skills, confidence, expression, and understanding of moral values.



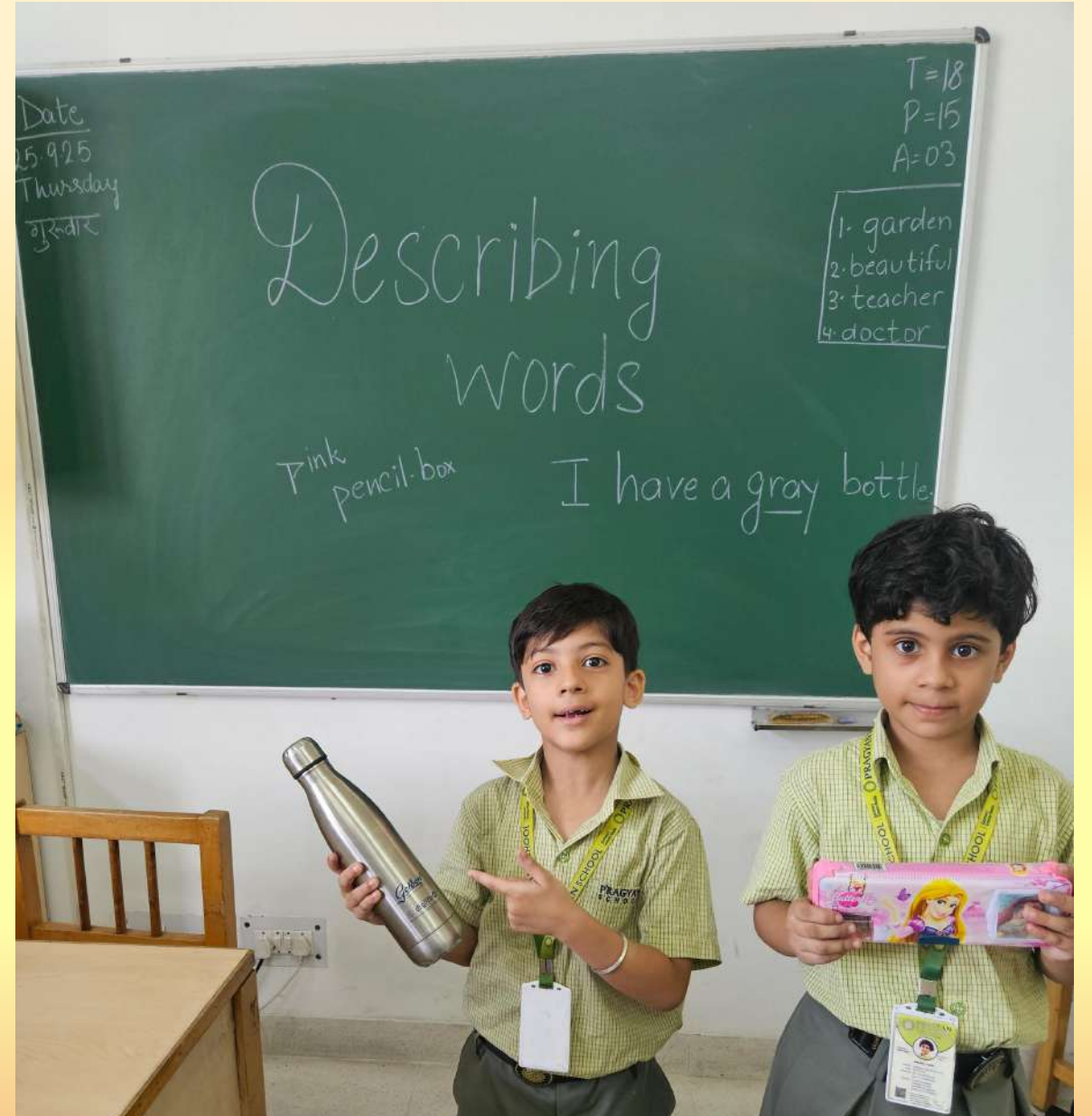
SKILL BASED LEARNING

This time in Skill-Based Learning, students learned about table manners. They were taught how to set plates, place the napkin correctly, and use cutlery such as a spoon and fork. This activity helped improve their social etiquette, fine motor skills, and understanding of proper dining habits.





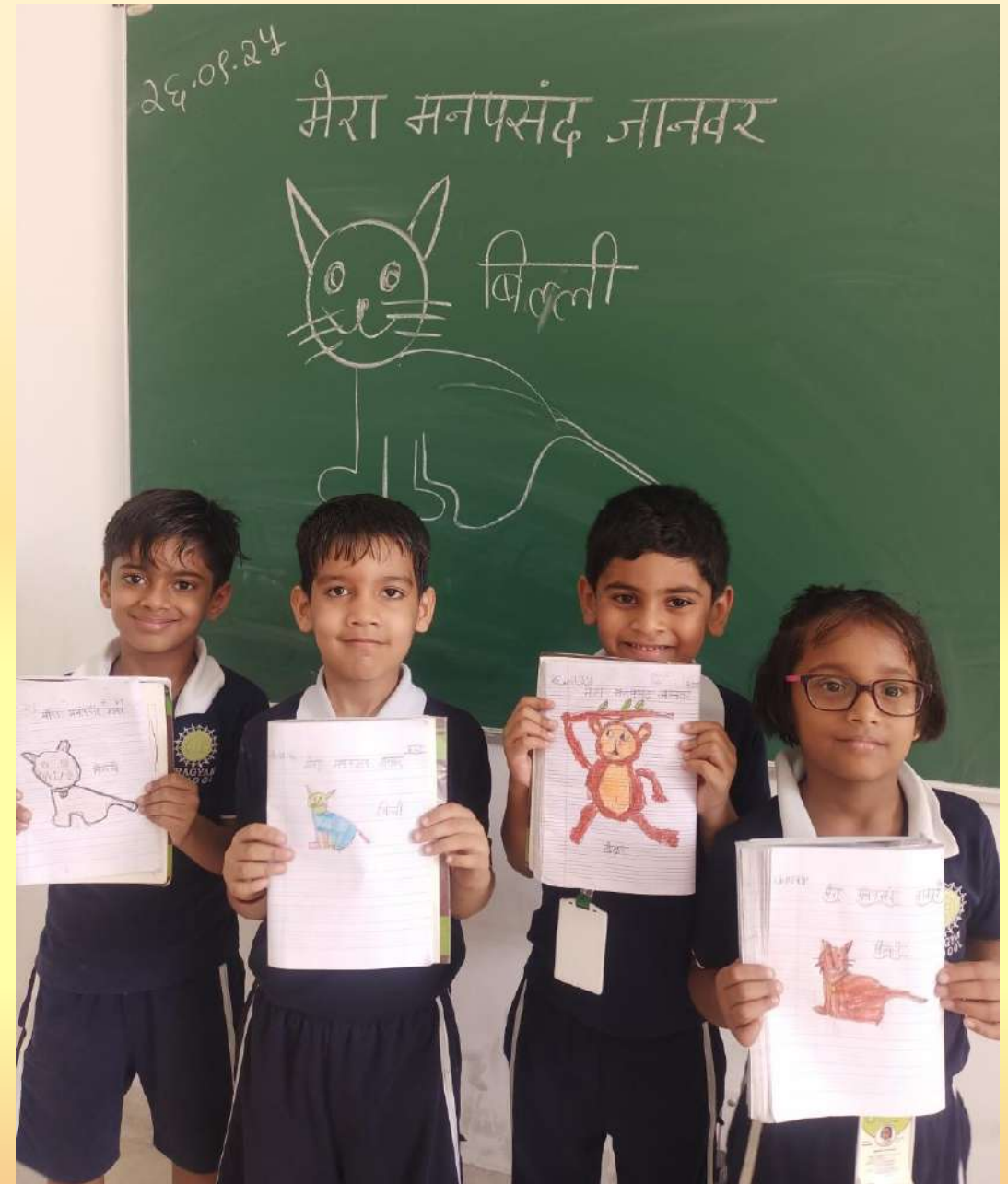
The week was filled with engaging revision sessions for our little learners. They revised Action Words and describing words with great enthusiasm and enjoyed identifying and using them in sentences. Naming Words were revisited, where children actively participated and recalled various examples from their surroundings. The concept of One and Many was revised through fun activities, which helped the students strengthen their understanding. Punctuation Marks were practiced in an interactive manner, allowing the children to learn their correct usage. The week concluded with Reading Comprehension, where students read short passages and answered questions with confidence. Overall, the revision week proved to be both joyful and fruitful for the young minds.





हिन्दी

पिछले सप्ताह कक्षा में बच्चों ने अक्षरों और मात्राओं के साथ रोचक गतिविधियाँ कीं। बच्चों को कुछ व्यंजन वर्ण दिए गए, जिन पर शब्द बनाए। इसके बाद उन्होंने इन शब्दों को पढ़ने और लिखने का अभ्यास किया। बच्चों को अपनी कल्पना शक्ति का उपयोग करने के लिए प्रेरित किया गया। उन्होंने अपना मनपसंद जानवर सोचा, उसका चित्र बनाया और नीचे उसका नाम लिखा। इन गतिविधियों से बच्चों की शब्द पहचान, पठन कौशल और रचनात्मकता में वृद्धि हुई। सभी बच्चों ने उत्साह से भाग लिया और बहुत आनंद लिया।





Children of Class 1 enjoyed learning counting from 701 to 999 during the last week. They also practiced forward counting and number comparison through fun classroom activities. These exercises helped them strengthen their understanding of numbers and improved their confidence in mathematics.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The week was devoted to strengthening concepts through workbook practice and revision. Children practiced workbook with focus and interest. They revised the topic of Clothes, where they identified different types of clothes and their uses. The revision of Religious Festivals added joy, as students recalled the importance of celebrating various festivals with enthusiasm. The week ended with Reading Revision, where children read passages and answered questions confidently, showcasing their improved comprehension skills. The entire week proved to be productive and enriching for the young learners. Children also enjoyed STEM activity - segregation of religious and national festivals





Students of class 2 revised the new words and poem of the month. They continued practicing with the revision of adjectives and were introduced to pronouns. They did reading of the chapter in the class to enhance their reading and comprehension skills.





हिन्दी

कक्षा 2 के विद्यार्थियों ने इस सप्ताह व्याकरण विषय के अंतर्गत गिनती का अभ्यास किया। अध्यापिका द्वारा विद्यार्थियों को 1 से 20 तक की गिनती सिखाई गई। तत्पश्चात् विद्यार्थियों ने इसे कैटरपिलर गतिविधि के माध्यम से और भी स्पष्ट रूप से सीखा। इसके अतिरिक्त, विद्यार्थियों ने माह की कविता *ज्ञान की बातें* का अभ्यास किया तथा पाठ *सबसे अच्छा जन्मदिन* पर सार्थक चर्चा की। सभी विद्यार्थियों ने गतिविधियों में सक्रिय सहभागिता दिखाई, जिससे कक्षा का शिक्षण वातावरण शिक्षाप्रद एवं आनंदमय बना।





In Mathematics, the students of Class 2 practiced exercises based on shapes. They learned about 2D and 3D shapes and related them to real-life objects. To understand better, they also drew different figures in their notebooks. The children enjoyed identifying shapes around them, like balls, boxes, and books. This activity helped them build a strong foundation for geometry in a fun and creative way.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 2 were introduced to the EVS chapter on “**Food.**” Through this lesson, the children learned about the **different types of food** –

- **Energy-giving foods**
- **Body-building foods**
- **Protective foods**

They also understood the **importance of food for our body** – it gives us energy, helps us grow, keeps us healthy, and protects us from diseases. The students actively participated in discussions, activities, and examples from daily life, which helped them connect the topic with their own eating habits.



CLASS ASSEMBLY 1A

Class 1 A conducted a delightful assembly on the theme Books. The children confidently shared thoughts on the importance of books and expressed how books are our best friends. Poems and short talks made the assembly lively and engaging. The young learners highlighted the joy of reading and the value of knowledge in a creative way. The audience thoroughly enjoyed the presentation, which inspired everyone to develop the habit of reading.



COMPUTER CLASS 1 & 2



The children joyfully used Tux Paint on the computer to create beautiful nature scenes. They explored different tools, brushes, and stamps to draw trees, mountains, rivers, and the sun. The activity encouraged their creativity and helped them learn how to use technology in a fun way. The students were excited to showcase their colorful nature drawings, making the session both enjoyable and enriching.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Children of Classes 1 and 2 enjoyed learning the pre-game skills of badminton last week. They practiced basic movements, grip, and coordination activities with great enthusiasm. It was a fun and engaging session that helped them develop interest in the game. Children learnt the basic badminton forehand toss through shadow practice and shuttle throws.

VOCAL MUSIC

LIBRARY 1 & 2

STRETCHING EXERCISE

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

This week, during the instrumental music class, students of classes 1 and 2 were taught about Alankars. Each child was also asked to play and demonstrate these Alankars on the keyboard, which they did with great focus and enthusiasm. The children are steadily learning to play the keyboard, developing both skill and interest in music.



ART & CRAFT

This week, students of Class 2 worked on pencil shading in their art files, while Grade 1 students practiced line patterns and colouring activities in their Sparkle books.





Students of Class 3 were introduced to the poem *An Animal's Prayer*. As a prelude to the lesson, students participated in a meaningful discussion on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), with a special focus on SDG 13: Climate Action. They explored how climate change affects animals and nature, setting the context for the poem, which highlights environmental concerns from an animal's perspective. They engaged with the new vocabulary and answered comprehension questions. The grammatical concept of Adjectives was introduced and reinforced through exercises. As a creative extension activity, students wrote a paragraph titled "If I were a teacher for a day", to describe their imaginary classroom experiences.

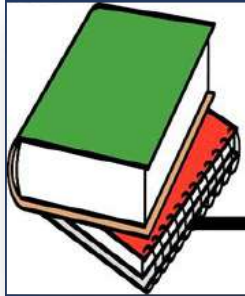




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

English
