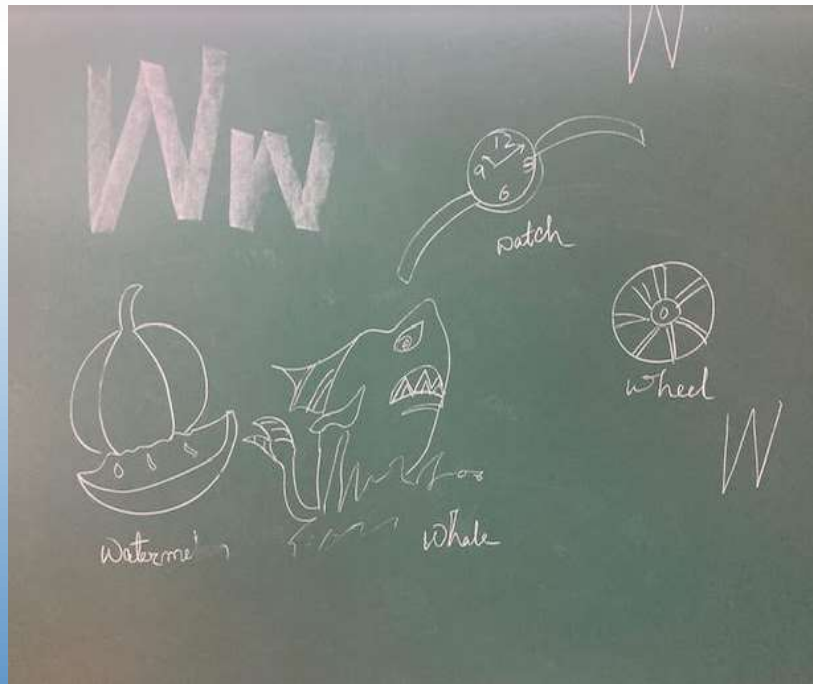


English: Introduction of letter W was done with the phonic sounds by doing the worksheets where children wrote the first letter of the given picture, matching the picture with the starting letter of that picture.

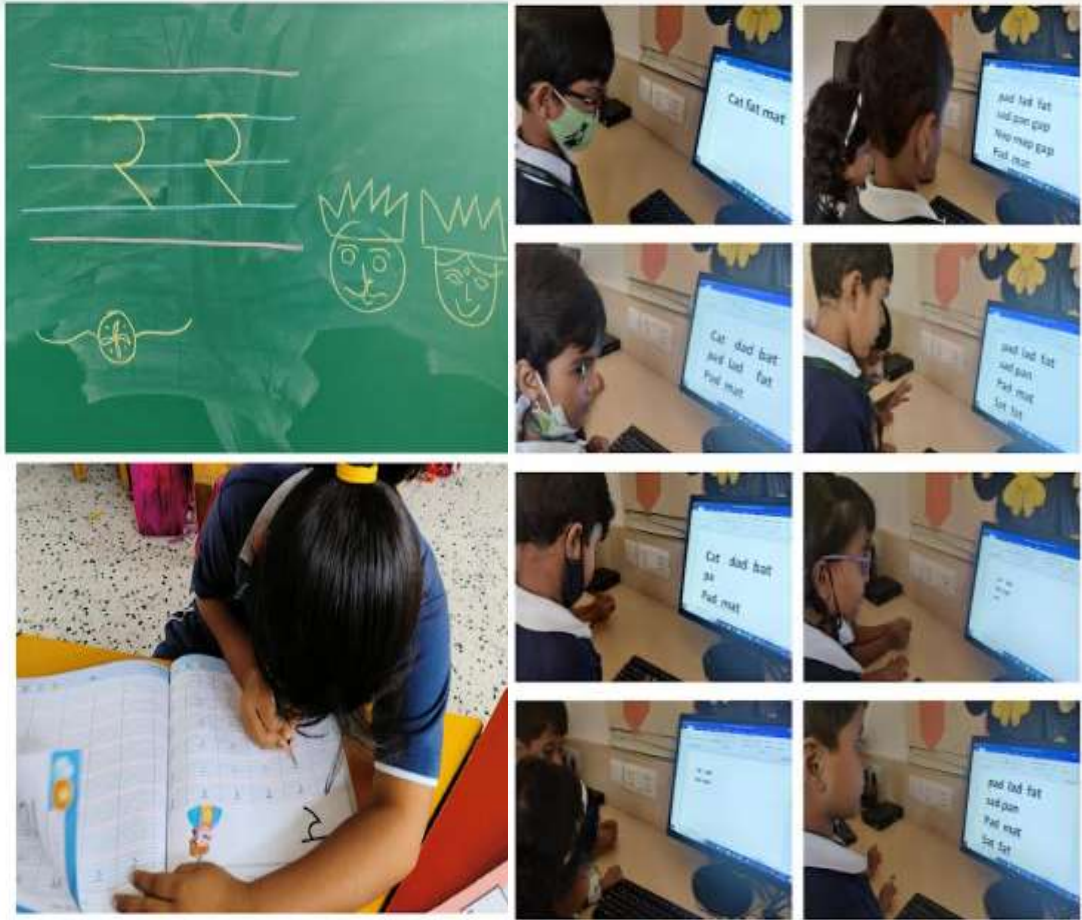


English - Revision of letters were done and letter 's' was introduced in the class and Written practice was also done during the English class. Revision of sight words were also done.

KINDERGARTEN



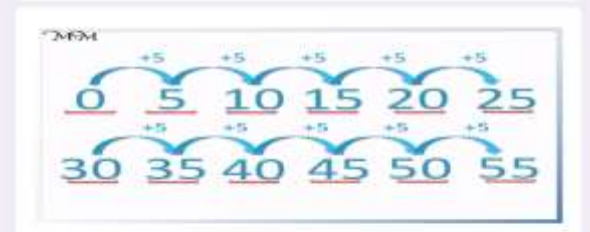
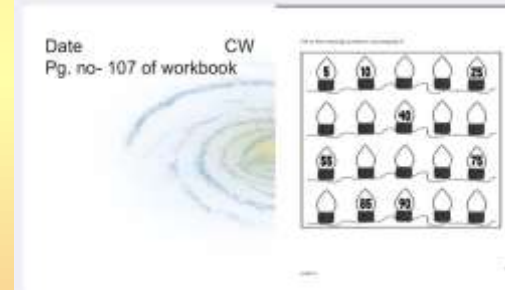
Computer- Students of kindergarten wrote three letter words on MS Word. They are getting familiar with the keyboard terminology like space bar, enter and backspace.

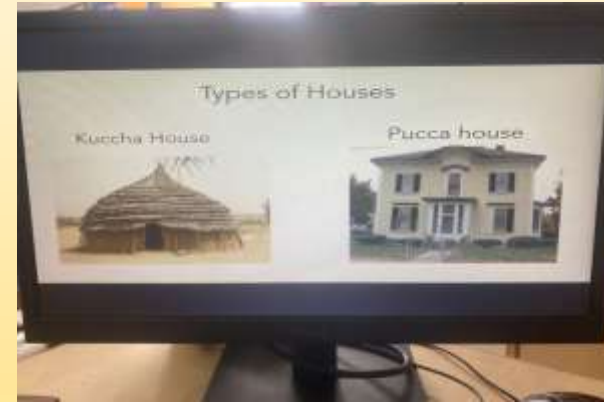

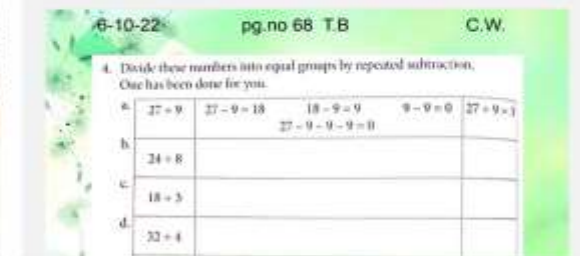
एक सिक्के की कहानी

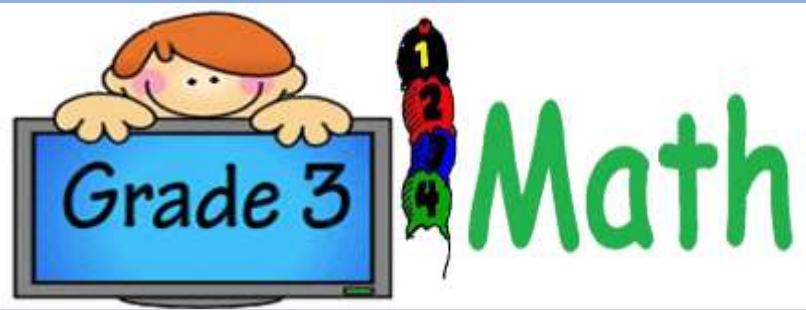

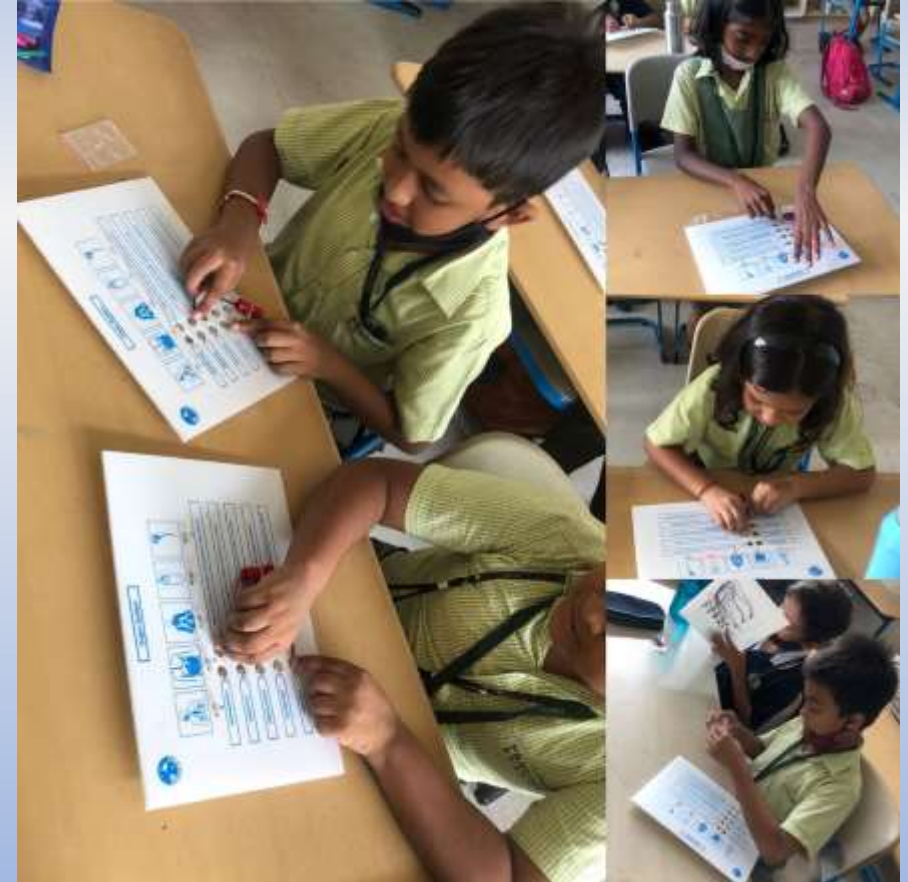
Students of Class 3 revised their concepts of division and facts related to it. They also learnt division using multiplication facts and reverse multiplication.
