NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter A was introduced to the children with the help of flashcards and different objects. They also did Jolly phonics song of letter A which they really enjoyed. Students did worksheets related to the topic in their workbook.

MATHS

This week number 6 was introduced to the students using blocks and they also did worksheet related to the number. Children also practiced tracing curve pattern in their workbook.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'ऊ' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'ऊ' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, students were made aware of the festival Diwali in the class. Students participated in class discussion how they enjoy making rangoli and decorate their house with colourful lights on diwali. They also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



EDUCATIONAL VISIT(NUR)

Students of nursery, enjoyed an educational trip to a green grocer on 9th August, 2024, exploring and learning about various fruits and vegetables through hands-on experience. They touched, felt, and identified fruits/vegetables, broadening their knowledge and fostering curiosity about healthy food choices in a fun, interactive way. As part of learning outcome, students spoke about the fruits and vegetables they saw during their visit.



KINDERGARTEN



HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan ऋ using flashcards. They named objects that start with the corresponding vyanjan and completed a worksheet related to the topic.

MATHS

The students were introduced to counting from 50 - 60. They also completed the corresponding worksheet in their workbooks, practicing their new counting skills.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

The students randomly picked up flashcards and, upon seeing the number, identified it. After recognizing the number, they had to say the number that comes before it. They learned the concept of preceding numbers in this fun and engaging way. To revise the alphabets taught, children were also asked to recognise the picture as per the letter announced.





ENGLISH

This week students were introduced to the digraph 'ph'. They were introduced to the sound and they listed out some objects with the digraph 'ph' like phone, photo, phonics. They did worksheets related to digraph 'ph' and also drew the pictures for the words.

This week in music students of nursery, learned 'Chhoti Chhoti Gaiya', demonstrating improved pitch and rhythm awareness. Kindergarten students practiced a beautiful patriotic song 'Iss tarah chale chalo ki kafilā bana rahe' for the upcoming assembly. They enthusiastically sang, showcasing their musical growth and joyful spirit.



VALUE BASED STORY(UKG)

As part of a value based story, students of UKG were introduced to the story The fox and the stork with the help of puppets and flash cards. The students listened to the story with curiosity and involved themselves in the interaction during story presentation.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

To make hands-on activity a little interesting, this week students were asked to choose different puzzles according to their interest and try to solve them. To solve the puzzle they had to read the words and then only they could fix the puzzle on animals, days name, month name, transport and abacus.



EDUCATIONAL VISIT(KG-UKG)

Students of Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten embarked on an exciting educational visit to a local bakery on 5th August, 2024. The visit not only broadened their understanding of baking but also sparked a new appreciation for the work that goes into creating delicious baked goods.

Under the guidance of Mrs Seepika Singh, students of Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten learned about the art of baking cake, from mixing ingredients to watching the dough rise in the ovens. EDUCATIONAL VISIT(KG-UKG)





“Poetry - The Swing”. Students of class 1 were taught the poem of the month during the week. They learned the poem during the class and practiced the same with voice modulation and actions. Later this week, they were introduced to blend words where they revised the ‘sp’ sound during their English class. Kids were taught the pronunciation of the sound with a few examples.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week in EVS students of class 1 did verbal revision of the chapters taught. They were also introduced to the Chapter: Festivals, where they got to know about religious festivals and their importance. They also tried reading the chapter by themselves and could do some exercises related to the topic in their notebook.





Learning to skip count can help students improve their counting fluency and recognize number patterns. Children of class 1 enjoyed learning skip count by 2's. Relevant PPTs and videos were shown for better understanding.

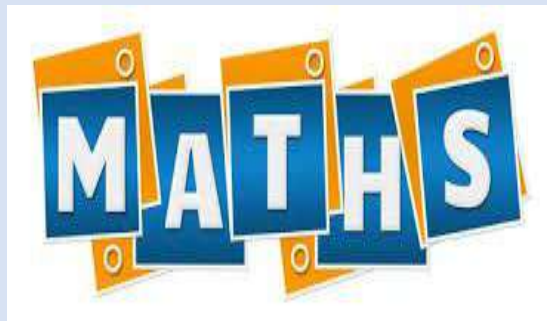
Students of Class 2 recited the monthly poem “Our lips and ears” and learned new vocabulary words, which they also wrote down as part of their classwork. Additionally, they participated in a "thinking routine" where they imagined an elephant with a small nose and discussed its challenges and advantages. This engaging activity was closely related to their lesson "The Elephant's Nose."

VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)

DANCE (CLASS 1)

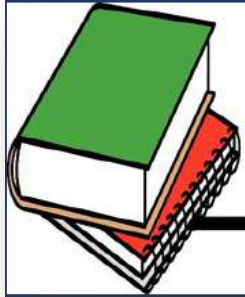




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
