Hindi - revision of swar, revision in workbook.

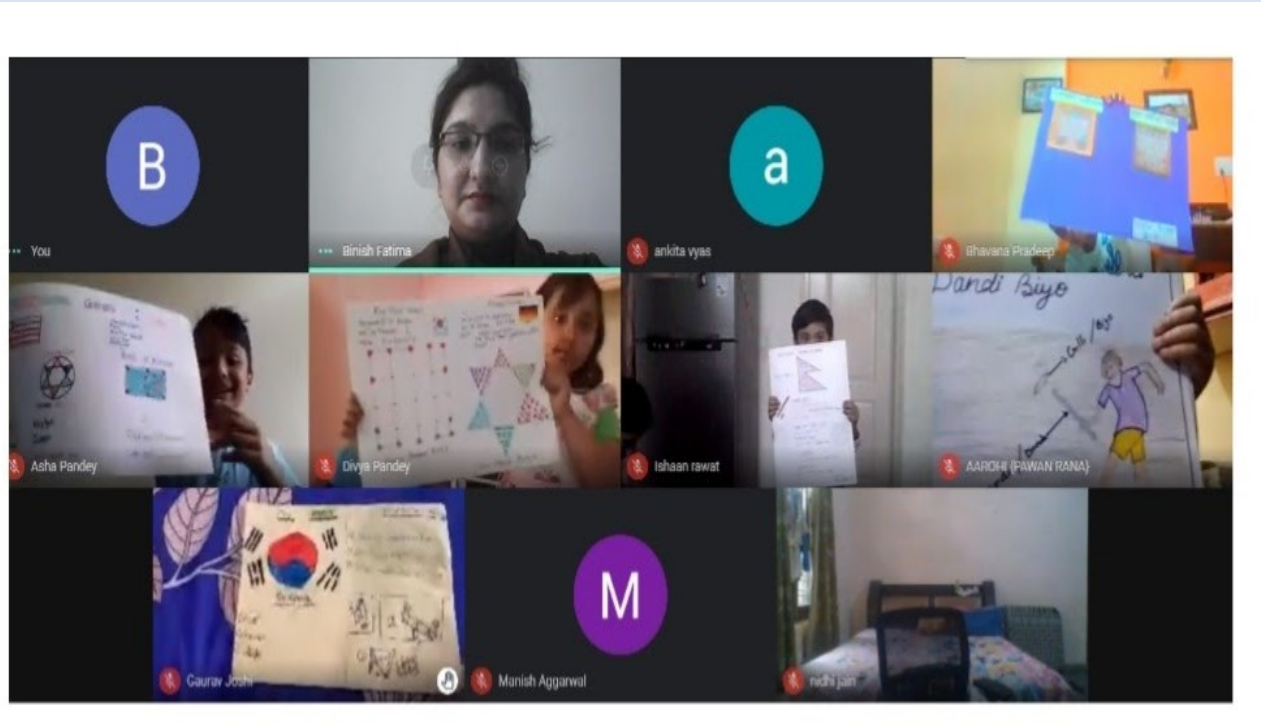
Thursday 18th March fun time - kids had discussion on festival of holi, video related to topic was shown. Students enjoyed dancing on their favourite song.

BOARD GAME UKRAINE- ISA ACTIVITY

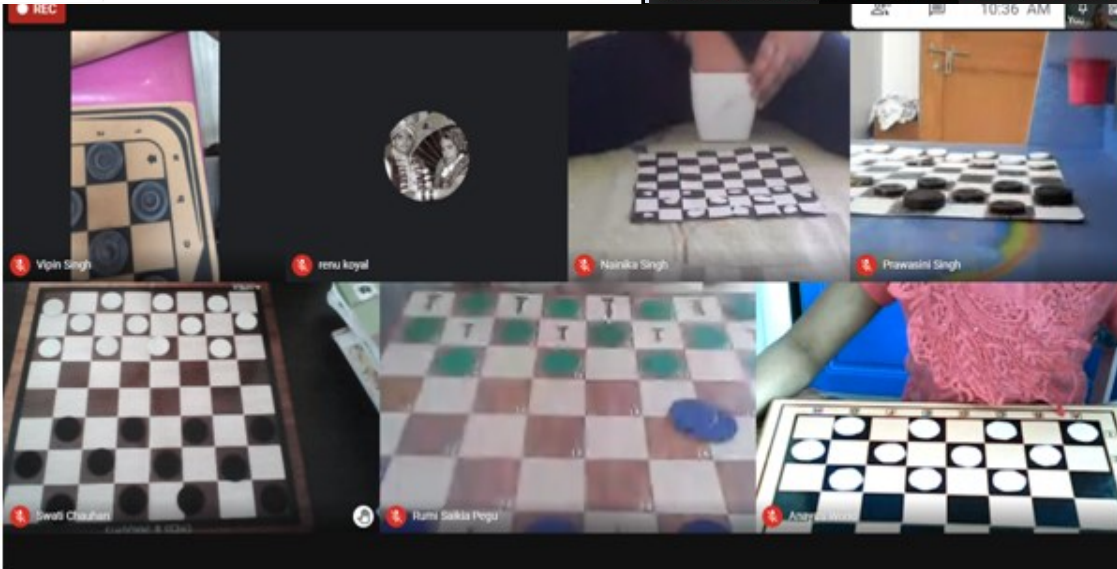

As of 2011 there were some 1483 sports schools, 189 specialized [sports] schools of Olympic reserve, and 34 school of higher sports mastery.

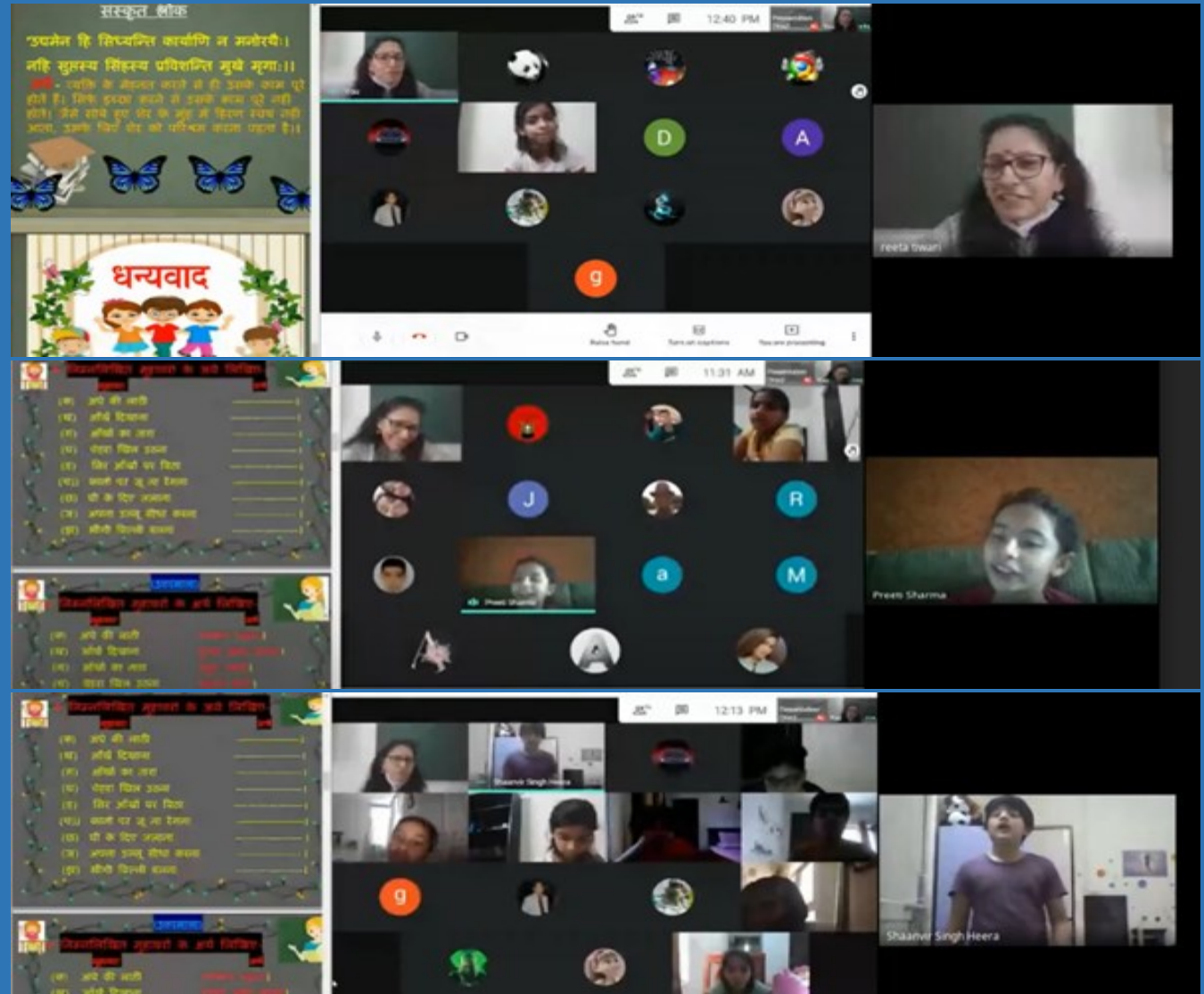




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
