Dance- students practiced the dance on 'Boogie woogie'.

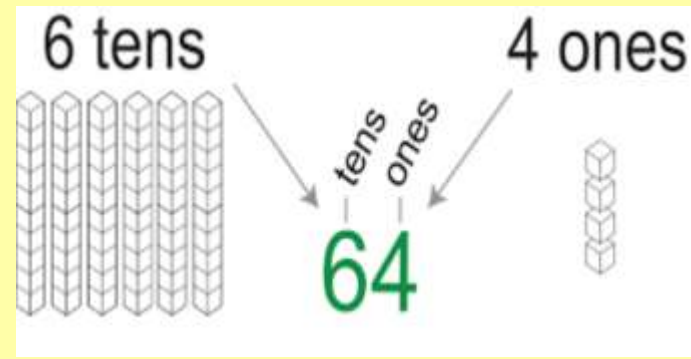


Children of class 1 learned the number names and Tens and ones concept for the numbers 60-69.

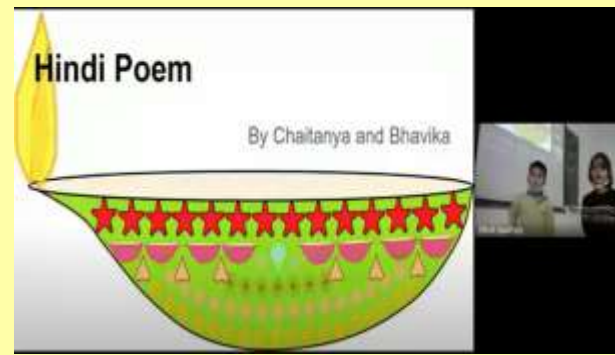


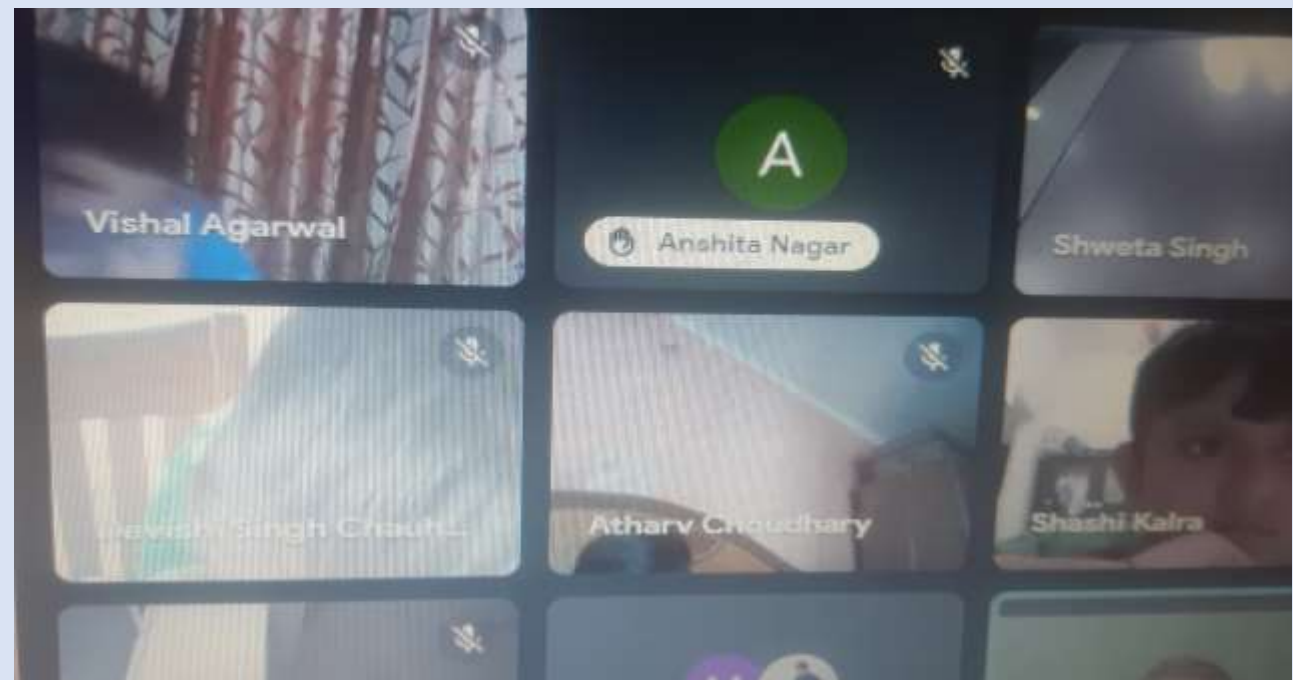


ASSEMBLY

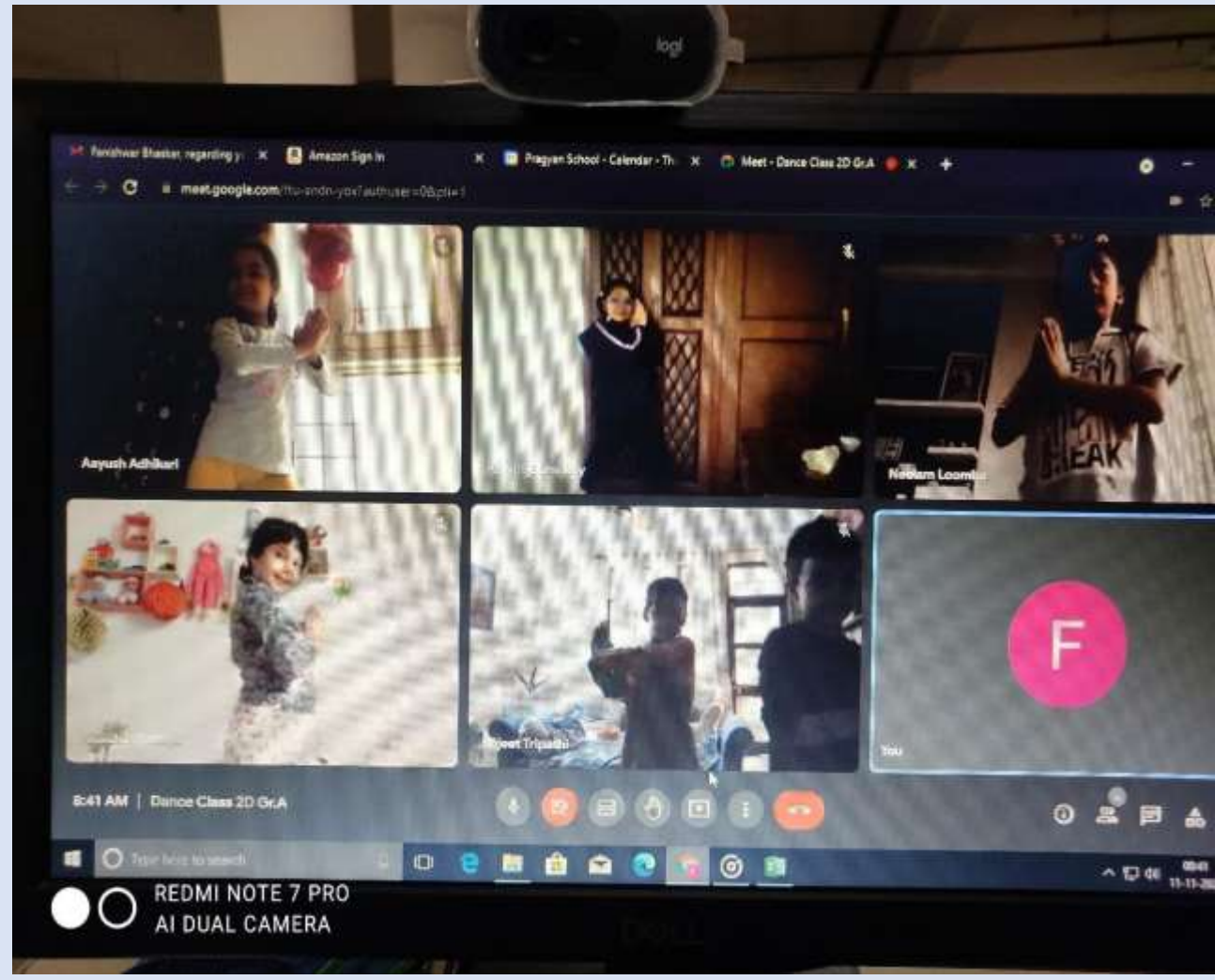

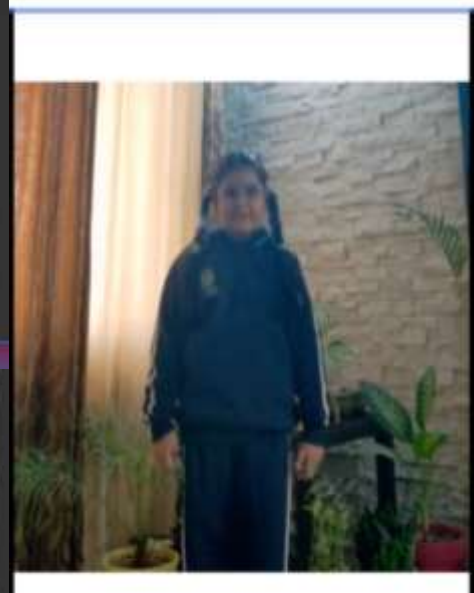


SPECIAL ASSEMBLY - CHILDREN'S DAY: CLASSES 1 & 2

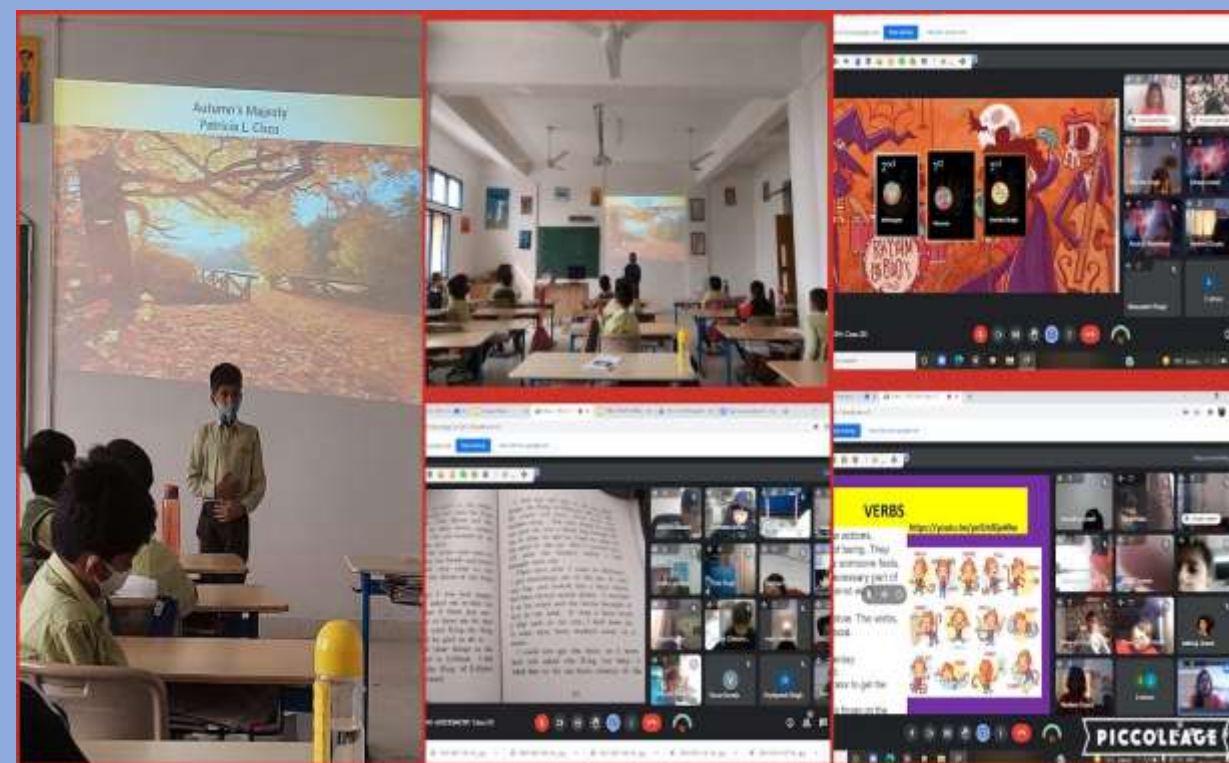
The assembly concluded with the blessings, accolades and best wishes from our headmistress, Ms. Divya Kapoor.

Students of class 3 did the “Poem of the month and New words”. They also wrote new words in notebook during their classes. Assessment of Hindi Activity was also conducted during this week.



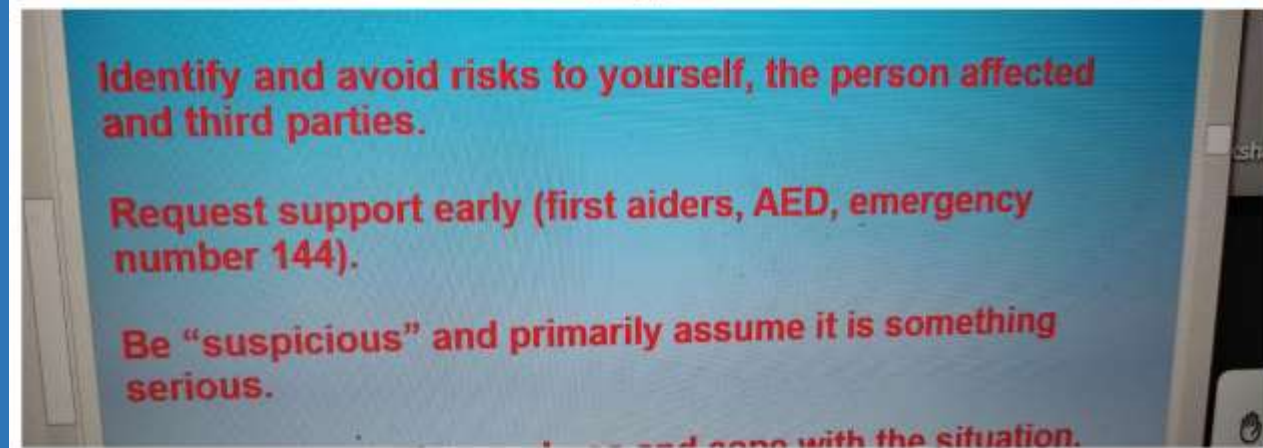
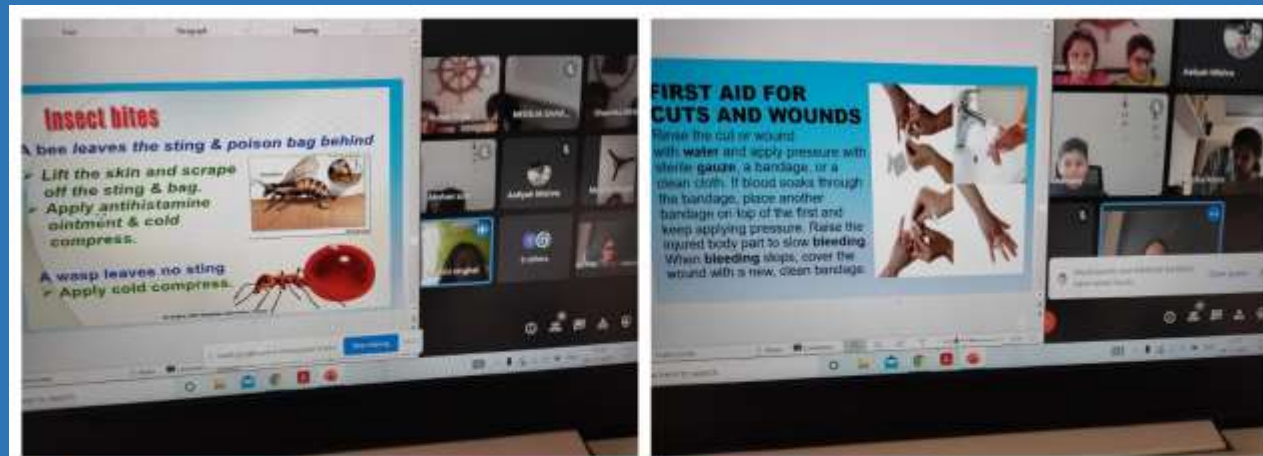

Grade 4 MATH

Causes for resentment against British Rule:

- **Political causes:** Indian soldiers, sepoys and armies were replaced by British armies and soldiers leading to unemployment.
- **Social causes:** The British were treating the Indians as second-rate citizens in their own country. They were also keen on spreading Christianity across India.
- **Economic causes:** As the British took control of the Indian market, they were forcing their policies on the traders. The powers of the Indian landlords were taken away from them and the Indian artisans were out of work.



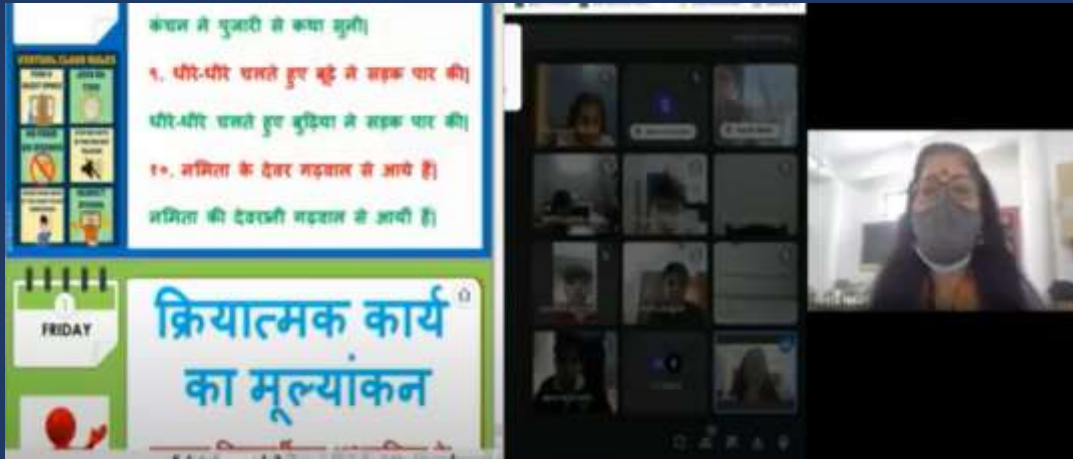

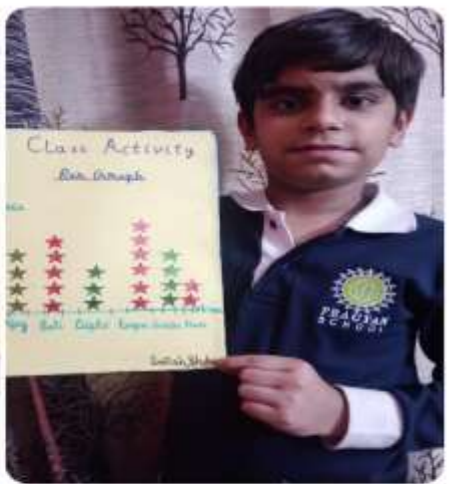

Students of class 5 studied the chapter - Maharana Pratap. They also studied new words and poem of the month for November. They also did Hindi activity as part of their minor assessment.





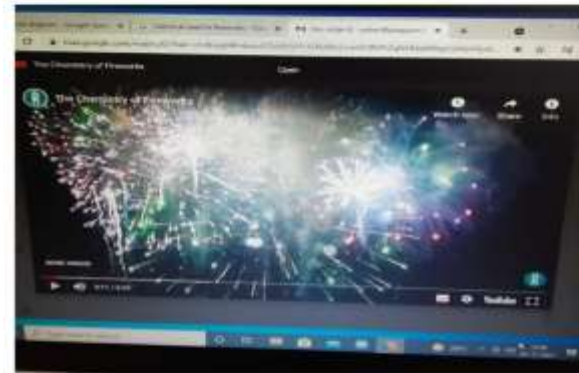
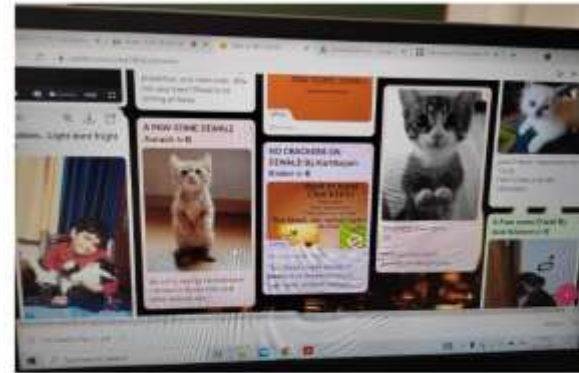
Grade 5 math

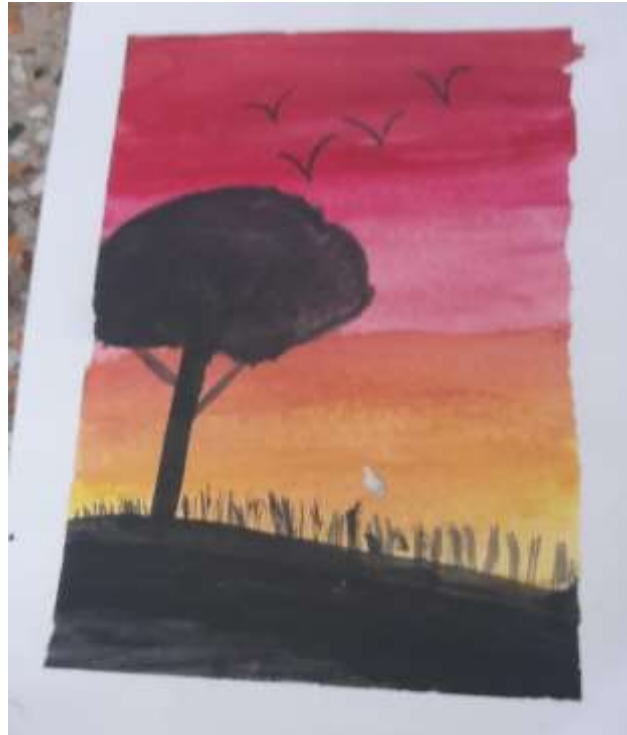
ANTI CRACKER CAMPAIGN (CLASSES 3 - 5)

Students of Grade 3 learnt the basic features of Windows. They have also done the selecting/Deselecting icons and how to change the desktop background.



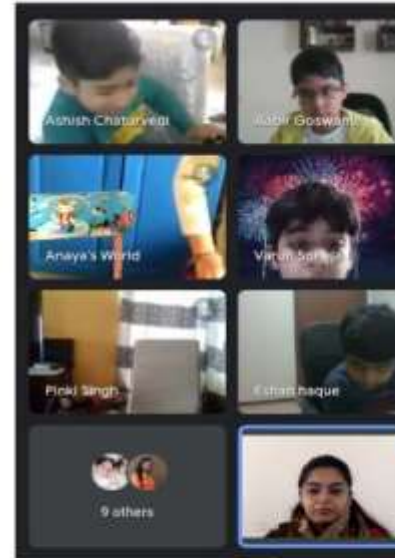
STEM SESSION (3 – 5)

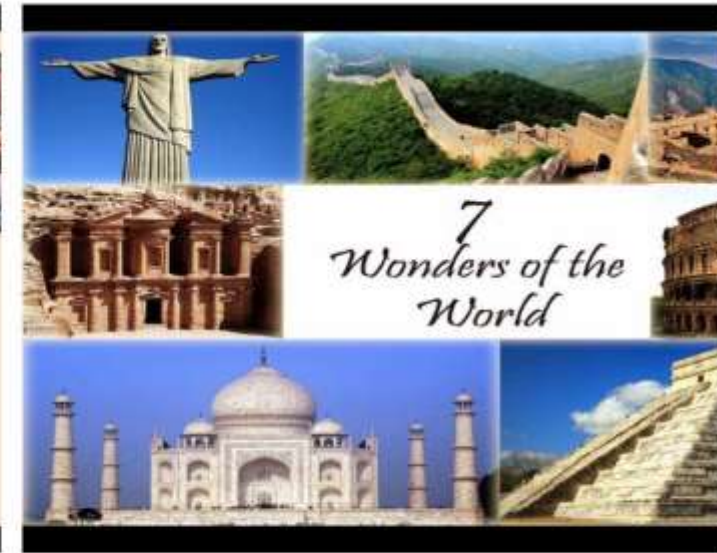
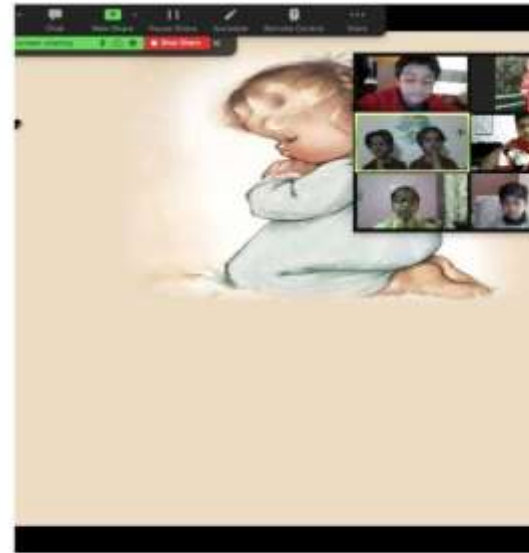
SPECIAL ASSEMBLY (CLASSES 3 – 5)
