SOFT SLUSH (NUR-UKG)

Clay modeling is one of the best ways to develop fine motor skills. It not only caters to the needs of pre-writing skills but also smoothens wrist and finger muscles. Children learnt to create various objects like stars, kite, leaf and owl during their summer camp.



ARTISTIC FINGERS (NUR-UKG)

During the first week of summer camp children learnt vegetable printing with onion. They enjoyed the activity and got the opportunity to explore different textures, colours and senses. They also learnt merging different colours which not only helped them to identify the basic colours but they also understood how colours work together.

Manipulating cotton balls, glue, and other craft materials helps children develop the small muscles in their hands and fingers, essential for writing and other tasks.

Cap painting was a hit, with kids stamping colorful patterns using bottle caps, teaching them about shapes and improving hand-eye coordination. Ear buds painting allowed them to create dot paintings, which boosted their precision and focus. These activities encouraged their artistic expression and supported their motor and cognitive skills.
