ENGLISH

Revision of letters L, T, I, H, E, F and A, N, M was done with the children through written practice in their notebooks and through their phonic songs.



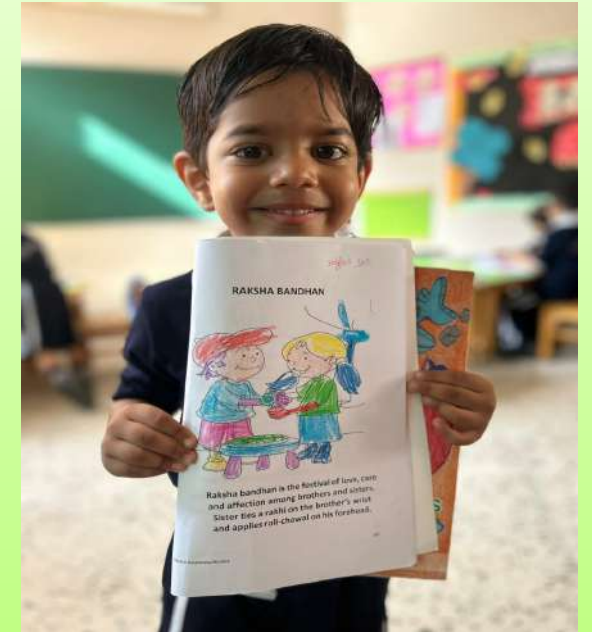
MATHS

Recapitulation of number 2,3,4,5,6,7 was done through written practice in their notebook. Children also revised oral counting of number 1-40 and did tracing of the triangle pattern in their worksheet.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Revision on the topic of food and its importance was done in the class. Also children enjoyed the discussion on Rakshabandhan festival and really had fun colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Revision of two letter words was done in class. Introduction of the small case letter 'm' was done using flashcards and story.

MATHS

Introduction of numbers from 100 - 110 was done through flashcards. Students practiced by writing it in their notebook. They also did back counting from 70-0.



HINDI

Recap of vyanjans (व,ब,क,म,भ) and two letter words was done in Hindi class. Students were introduced to vyanjan न through flash cards, pictures and stories.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Students of Kindergarten had a quick revision of the topic of food on the importance of food, dairy products, healthy and junk food. Discussion on the festival Raksha Bandhan was done in the class. They enjoyed reciting poems, and colouring rakhi in their drawing books.



EVS

This week the children were introduced to another wild animal Gorilla. They learnt about its habitat and also coloured a worksheet related to the topic.



CRAFT

Creating things with hands helps children improve their motor skills. Students of KG enjoyed making kite with paper during craft class.



MUSIC

Music is a vital part of different human moments. Students of KG enjoyed learning and doing practice of folk songs of different languages.





This week Collage making activity was conducted in class 1. Students made a collage by collecting pictures of various animals and their young ones. Students collected information from various sources and executed the things very well. It was a rich learning experience for our young ones.

Festivals are often a time of great celebration and help believers to remember important beliefs in their religion. Religious celebrations bring communities together to celebrate these shared beliefs and values. This week children learned about the diverse religious festivals and the ways we celebrate them. They also did Rakhi making activity related to the topic and also did notebook and workbook work.

Children of class 1 enjoyed learning skip count by 3's. As the name suggests, forward skip counting by 3 is a process of moving forward by adding 3 to each number and obtaining the next number in the series. Children enjoyed doing the activities and worksheets related to it. Related videos and PPT were shown to students.

Learning shapes not only helps children identify and organize visual information, it helps them learn skills in other curriculum areas including reading, math, and science. Students of class 2 were introduced to the Chapter: Shapes, where they could recognise a few 2D shapes. They practiced solving sums of subtraction and multiplication in their notebooks. And also revised facts of multiplication, addition along with the tables.

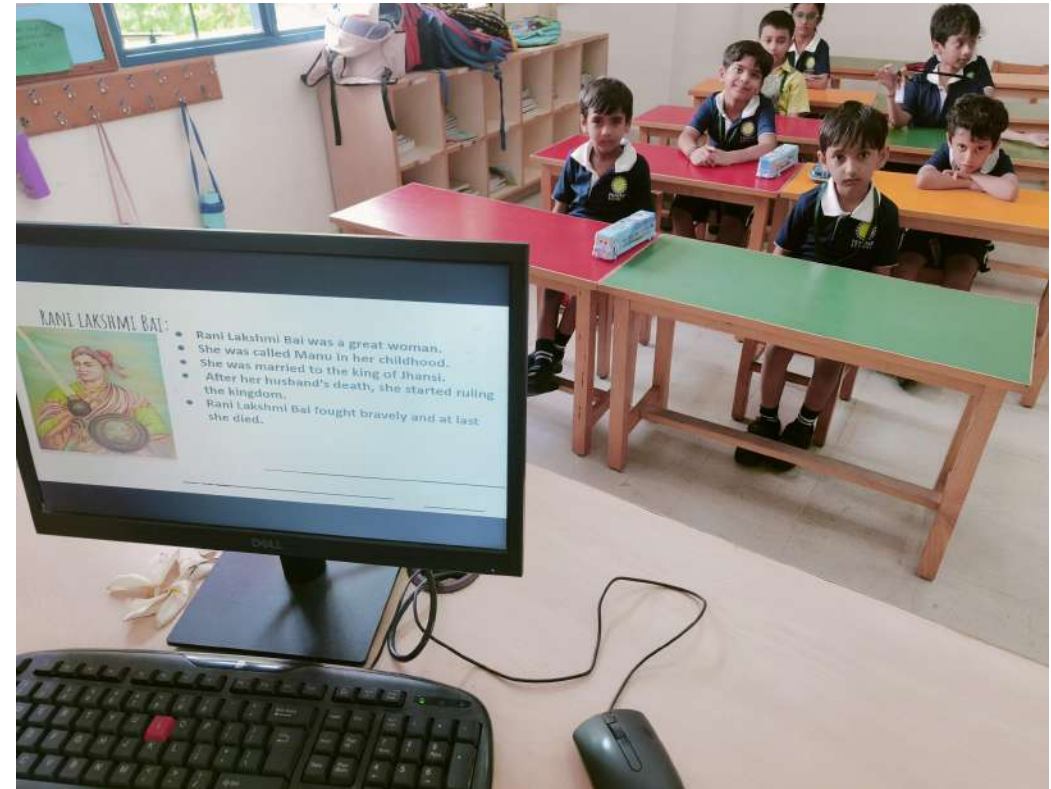
CLASS ASSEMBLY (2D)
