NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week, students practiced writing A, M, and N in a 4-lines notebook and revised previous letters. The Salt Tray activity enhanced their writing skills through interactive learning. Understanding was deepened through hands-on experience.



HINDI

The students this week learned the vyanjan ढ, understanding its pronunciation. They coloured worksheet based on this vyanjan and revised previous vyanjans. Students were encouraged to find new words starting with ढ, promoting active learning and vocabulary building in a fun and engaging way.



MATH

This week, students practiced writing numbers 1, 2, 3 in their small square notebooks and numbers 7-8 in their big square notebooks. A thorough revision of numbers was also conducted, reinforcing their understanding and fine motor skills. The students demonstrated progress and enthusiasm in their number writing practice.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week students explored good habits through engaging rhymes and activities. They coloured worksheets and answered questions about good habits confidently. An activity reinforced positive behaviors, encouraging students to develop good habits. Students actively participated, learning about the importance of good habits in daily life.



EDUCATIONAL OUTING

Students of the nursery visited the local green grocer on 26th August, 2025 as part of their educational outing. The students explored various fruits and vegetables, discovering their colours, textures, and shapes. They enthusiastically shared their observations and answered a few questions related to various fruits and vegetables, making it a fun and learning experience. The educational outing not only fostered learning but also encouraged bonding with peers and teachers outside the classroom.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

Students of nursery learned the value of washing hands through hands-on activity. The teacher demonstrated and explained the process, and students practically applied it by washing their hands. This activity taught them a vital good habit, promoting cleanliness and hygiene, and instilling a lifelong healthy practice.



YOGA

This week in yoga class, students revised Padahastasana, Ardha Dhanurasana, and Marjariasana. They learned new asanas: Ashwa Sanchalanasana, Dandasana, and Bhujangasana. Students demonstrated improvement in flexibility, balance, and focus, enjoying the practice of various yoga poses that promote physical and mental well-being.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

This week, students practiced the letter u, focusing on both its phonetic sound and written formation. The children engaged in various activities, including tracing, identifying and colouring objects that begin with the letter u, and practicing correct pronunciation. They showed keen interest and growing confidence in recognizing and using the letter in words. Additionally, there was a thorough revision of previously learned sight words and 'a' family words.

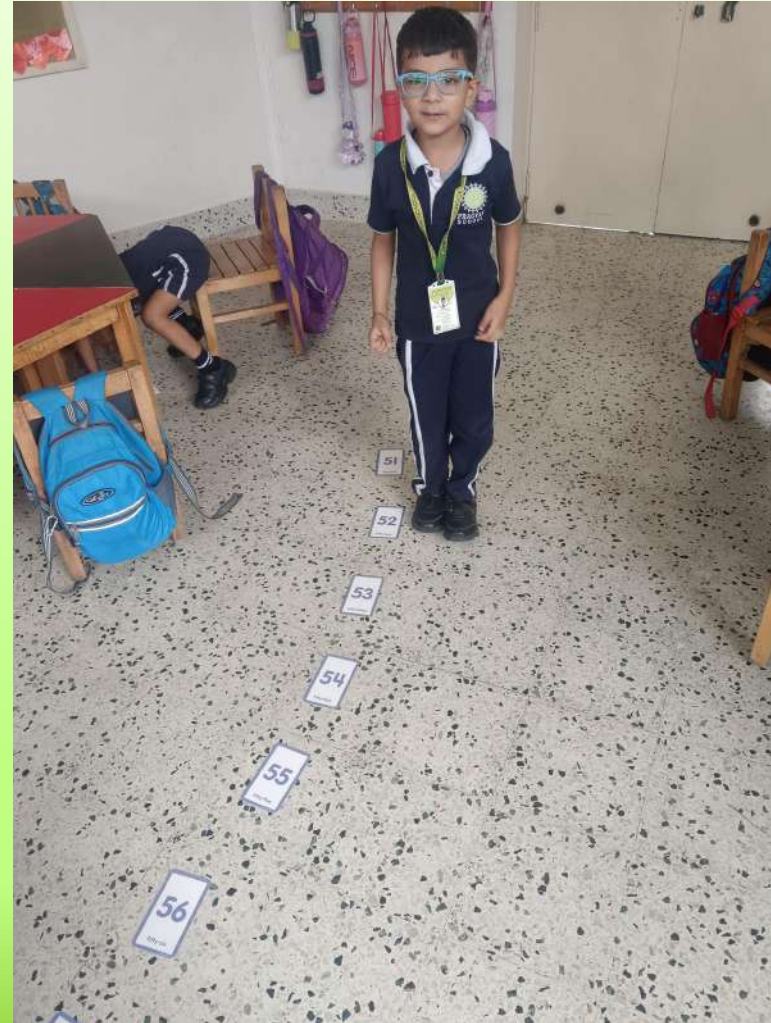
HINDI

Children practiced two-letter words and revised the Swar. They actively engaged in a variety of worksheets and activities designed to strengthen their reading and writing skills. The children showed increased confidence and ease in recognizing, pronouncing, and writing two-letter words correctly. Their improved fluency and participation reflect steady progress in early language development.



MATHS

The week began with the introduction of skip counting by 2s, which the children found engaging and enjoyable. In addition to this, the children practiced the concepts of what comes before and what comes in between through structured exercises in both their notebooks and workbooks.



JADUI PITARA

During the Jadui Pitara activity, the children enjoyed exploring flash cards. In Hindi, they picked out cards of swar and vyanjan and confidently identified them. In English, they drew flash cards of sight words and read them aloud with enthusiasm. They also pulled out flashcards with numbers, recognized them, and spoke them aloud. In General Awareness, they picked flashcards of their favourite festivals and confidently shared a few lines about them.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

The kindergarteners enthusiastically participated in a hands-on activity where they explored the different types of festivals celebrated in India, both national and religious. Through this joyful theme, they also practiced math concepts like before–after and greater–lesser in a fun and engaging way, making learning both meaningful and enjoyable.





ENGLISH

This week in English class, the digraphs "wh" and "th" were introduced. Students completed worksheets related to these digraphs and wrote "wh" and "ph" words in their notebooks. They also revised the use of "is," "am," and "are," and wrote sentences using these in their notebooks. These activities helped develop their phonics skills, vocabulary, sentence construction, and grammar understanding.



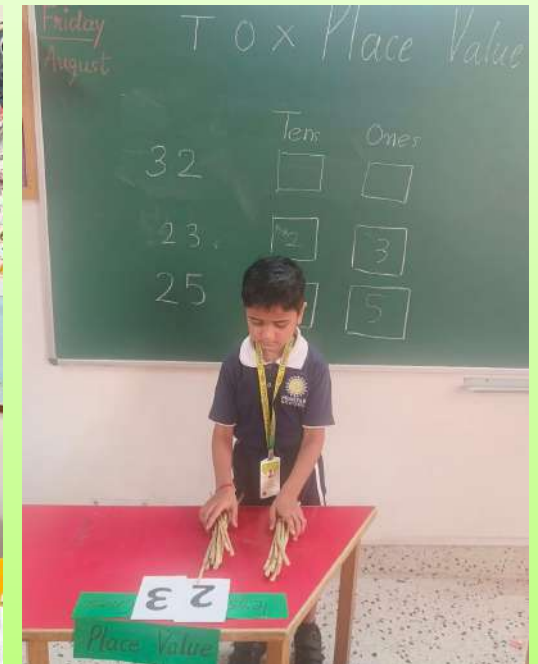
HINDI

This week in Hindi, students revised आ की मात्रा, completed worksheets related to आ की मात्रा and practiced reading them aloud. These activities helped develop their reading fluency, pronunciation, and recognition of आ की मात्रा in hindi .



MATH

This week in Maths, students were introduced to **place value** with a focus on **tens and ones**. They engaged in a hands-on activity to gain a clear understanding of the concept and also completed worksheets related to place value. These activities helped students understand numbers better, improve their counting skills, and learn how tens and ones work.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week in General Awareness class, students revised the topic of community helpers. They completed worksheets related to the topic and participated in a conversation related to different community helpers. These activities helped students improve their speaking and listening skills, learn to express their thoughts more clearly, and gain a better understanding of the important roles community helpers play in our daily lives. It also encouraged them to appreciate the people who serve and support the community.



ORATORY SKILLS

In the oratory class, students narrated the story of "The Fox and the Stork" in their own words, using props to make the storytelling more fun and engaging. After narrating the story, each student shared the lesson they learned. This activity helped students improve their public speaking skills, boost their confidence, and learn how to express their thoughts clearly. It also developed their creativity, presentation skills, and helped them understand the importance of moral values through storytelling.



SCIENCE DEMO

As part of the Science demonstration this week, students were introduced to the topic of air and pressure. They learned that air is all around us, even though we cannot see it, and that air occupies space and gives shape to an object. They discovered this through a simple and fun experiment where students had the chance to perform the experiment themselves. This hands-on activity helped them to understand the properties of air better.



SKILL BASED LEARNING

During skill-based class, students learned this week about good eating habits and basic hygiene. They were taught the importance of wearing an apron and washing their hands before and after eating to stay clean and healthy. As part of the activity, students also made lemonade. While making it, they learned how to measure ingredients, stir properly, and pour carefully. This fun, hands-on activity helped them understand the importance of cleanliness and also improved their basic kitchen skills.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

An inter-class activity was held on Wednesday, 27th August 2025, in which the students participated with great enthusiasm. The nursery kids took part in the Clean My City race, the kindergarteners enjoyed the Bean Bag Race, and the upper kindergarteners participated in the Obstacle Race. The finalists from each event were awarded certificates, making the day joyful and encouraging for all.





This week, the children of Class 1 were introduced to *Opposites* through engaging activities and notebook practice. They enjoyed identifying and writing opposites, along with reading comprehension exercises that deepened their understanding. The concept of *Punctuation* was also introduced, where students practiced framing sentences using correct punctuation marks. The week concluded with a thorough revision of the topics, making learning both enjoyable and effective.





हिन्दी

पिछले सप्ताह बच्चों ने कक्षा में कई रोचक गतिविधियों में भाग लिया। उन्होंने नए शब्दों का अभ्यास किया तथा अपठित गद्यांश (आ, इ, उ, ऊ, ए, ई, ऐ) पढ़कर सही शब्द लिखने का अभ्यास किया। बच्चों ने सेब का चित्र बनाकर उसमें रंग भरे और उसके बारे में कुछ सरल पंक्तियाँ बोलते हुए फल खाने के लाभ भी साझा किए। कक्षा में 'मैना और मकड़ी' पाठ का पठन एवं अभ्यास कराया गया, साथ ही संबंधित अनुच्छेद पढ़कर रिक्त स्थान पूरे किए गए। इन सभी गतिविधियों ने बच्चों की पठन, लेखन और अभिव्यक्ति कौशल को और समृद्ध किया।





The children of Class 1 practiced three-digit addition in their notebooks and also solved related word problems. These exercises helped them gain a deeper understanding of the concept and apply it in different situations. They further worked on number writing from 601–650 and continued with 651–700, which improved their accuracy and speed. To reinforce their learning, the students also completed relevant workbook pages. The children showed great enthusiasm throughout the activities, strengthening both their numerical skills and problem-solving abilities.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week, the children of Class 1 explored the chapter Clothes through a series of fun and interactive activities. They enjoyed the Fabric Feel Activity, where they touched and identified fabrics like cotton, wool and silk while learning about their uses. The children also explored the clothes of various professions, connecting different attires with various jobs. The chapter was reinforced through reading and interactive exercises.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह कक्षा में बच्चों ने अनेक रोचक गतिविधियों में उत्साहपूर्वक भाग लिया। उन्होंने वर्ड वॉल के माध्यम से विलोम शब्दों का अभ्यास किया। माह के नए शब्दों के साथ अपठित गद्यांश का पठन कराया गया, जिससे बच्चों के पठन कौशल में निखार आया।

पाठ 'पानी' पर चर्चा के बाद विद्यार्थियों ने "जल ही जीवन है" विषय पर अपने विचार वाक्यों के रूप में प्रस्तुत किए। व्याकरण के अंतर्गत अध्यापिका ने सर्वनाम का अर्थ समझाया तथा उदाहरणों द्वारा उसका प्रयोग कराया। इन सभी गतिविधियों से बच्चों की भाषा-ज्ञान, रचनात्मकता और अभिव्यक्ति क्षमता में महत्वपूर्ण वृद्धि हुई।





Students of class 2 revised important grammar topics including plural nouns, words of the month, and gender nouns. They practiced identifying and forming plural nouns using standard rules, revisited their monthly vocabulary with sentence construction and worked on recognizing masculine and feminine nouns. The students actively engaged in AIL activity where they made monsters and used adjectives to describe the pictures made by them in their notebooks and also completed related exercises in both their workbooks, demonstrating a good understanding of the concepts.





This week, the students of Class 2 actively participated in an oral revision of multiplication tables from 2 to 9. They also revisited key mathematical concepts, including addition, subtraction and multiplication, to strengthen their foundational skills.





This week, our Grade 2 students enthusiastically explored the chapter “Good Habits.” They took part in an engaging quiz that helped them recall the importance of practicing good manners in daily life.

To further reinforce their learning, the children participated in a creative craft activity on an A4 size sheet, highlighting polite words and good habits such as *saying thank you*, *saying sorry*, *brushing twice a day*, and *speaking kindly and politely*. The activity not only sparked their creativity but also deepened their understanding of kindness, respect, and gratitude.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC



This week, our students continued their musical journey by revisiting and expanding on their previous lessons with the keyboard and harmonium. The sessions focused on strengthening their understanding of notes and the musical scale, while refining finger techniques through guided, hands-on practice. Each child had the opportunity to perform individually, showcasing their progress and building confidence.

COMPUTER CLASS 1



This week, the children of Class 1 explored the computer application *GCompris* and enjoyed the activity *Draw Letters*. They practiced tracing and forming letters on the computer, which strengthened their letter recognition and improved their mouse control skills. The activity made learning letters interactive and engaging for the students.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Children of classes 1 and 2 actively participated in the 100 m and 50 m races. The students showed great enthusiasm and enjoyed competing with their peers in a healthy spirit. Along with the races, children also took part in regular exercise sessions, which helped in developing their stamina, strength, and team spirit. These activities not only encouraged physical fitness but also built confidence and discipline among the students. It was truly a joyful and energetic experience for all.



MATIFIC

This week, our Class 1 and 2 students explored mathematics through interactive, play-based activities, making learning both enjoyable and effective. They actively participated in Matific activities focused on addition, subtraction, and skip counting, enhancing their understanding in a fun and engaging way.



VOCAL MUSIC

This week, the students were joyfully learning songs for Gandhi Jayanti. With their sweet voices, they practiced melodies that celebrate the life and values of Mahatma Gandhi. The classroom was alive with rhythm and excitement as the little ones enthusiastically prepared to sing in honour of Bapu. They also learned the bhajan “Raghupati Raghav Raja Ram” and a heartfelt prayer “Ishwar Allah Waheguru”, filling the atmosphere with devotion and harmony.

SCIENCE SPARK

This week, the students of Class 2 learned about the formation of a rainbow during the rainy season. 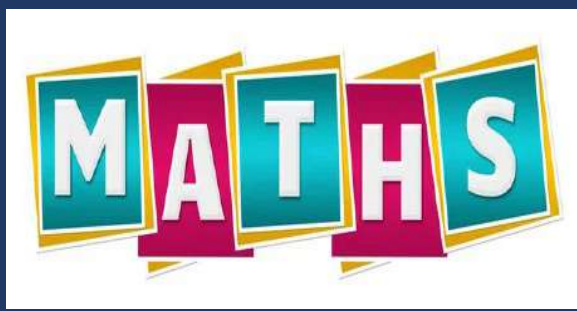




हिन्दी
