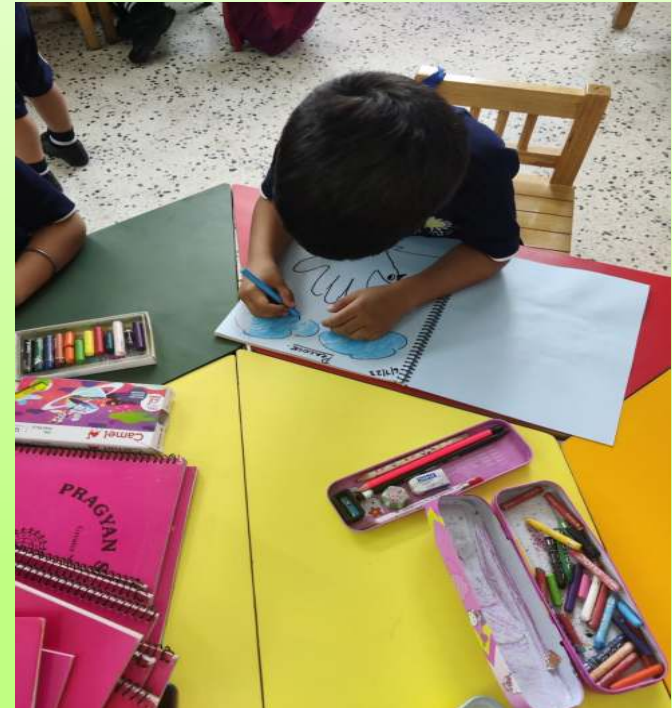
# EVS

# हिन्दी

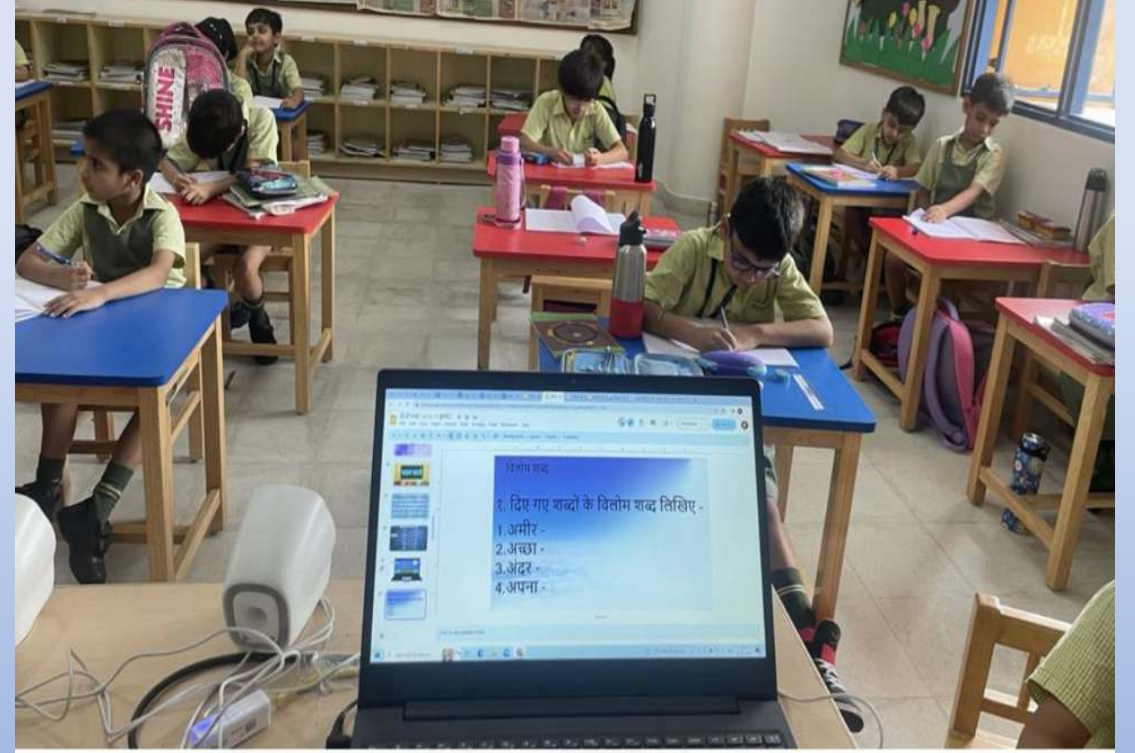

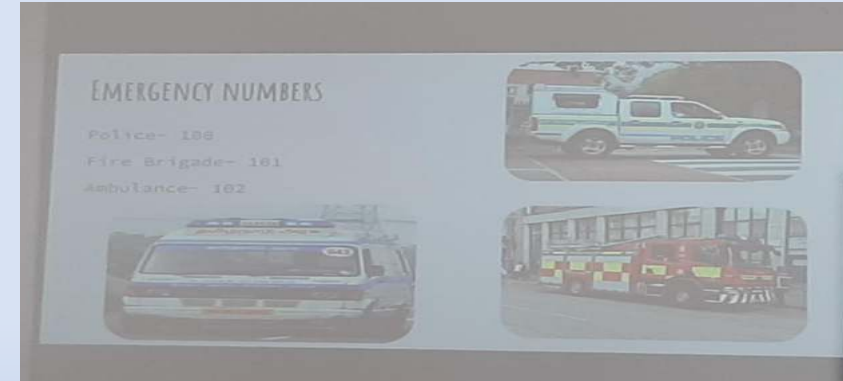

Students of class 4 studied the chapter “Sahayta Ka Uchit”, new words of the month, poem and fill in the blanks. Dictation was also done from the chapter. .

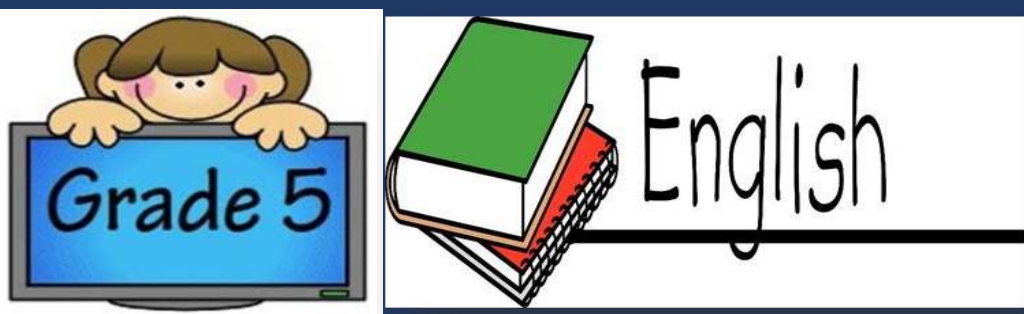




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

# WINNER OF TENNIS TOURNAMENT



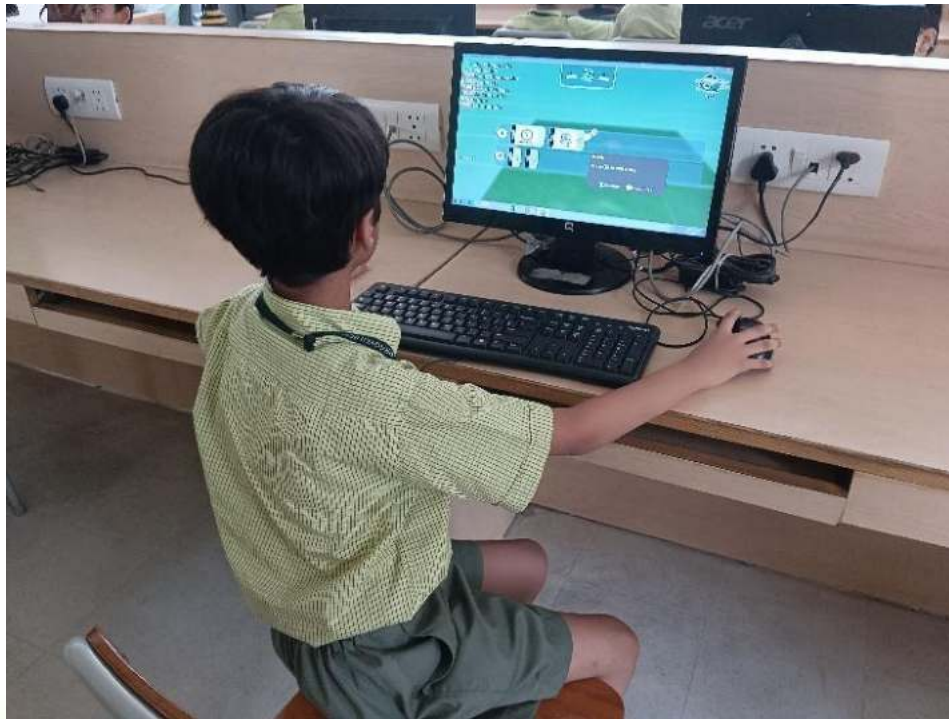
