23 November 2022. The students of class X had their educational outing to The Indian Air force Aircraft Museum located at Palam. It is a must visit place, Not only preserving the rich and glorious past of IAF, with attractions. But also, the Photographs of 2nd world war heroes & the heroes of the three wars India fought since Independence. Remnants of various aircraft, weapons, tankers, jeeps, canters captured in Pakistan war. It displays 15 aircrafts used since then, historic photos, uniforms & personal weapons, war trophies, electronic equipment, mementoes & captured enemy vehicles. Displaying photographs and memorabilia from the foundation of the Indian Air Force in 1932 till recent times, the crowning glory of the IAF Museum is the hangar where actual planes - from early 20th century turboprops to state-of-the-art MiG-29s - are archived with dignity and honor befitting the service these planes and those who flew, engineered and maintained them over the years. It is a well fortified museum which has many war artefacts and relics specially those from the 1971 Indo-Pakistan war. The trip was truly informative.
