# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Students successfully revised letters V and W, and were introduced to letter K in English. Through engaging worksheets and activities, they practiced phonics sounds and writing, reinforcing their understanding of these letters. The class demonstrated satisfactory progress, showcasing their growing literacy skills and ability to recognize and write these letters confidently.

# HINDI

This week, students were introduced to the akshar ऌ through pronunciation, vocabulary, and engaging activities. They completed the colouring worksheet with interest and revision of previously learnt akshars was also conducted to reinforce recognition, writing, and foundational language skills.



# MATH

This week, students were introduced to number 10 through value recognition, writing formation, and interactive activities. They completed related worksheets with interest. Revision of numbers 1 to 9 was also conducted to reinforce counting skills and numerical understanding.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY

Nursery students excelled in hands-on activities, showcasing balance and coordination. The Pick and Sit activity reinforced number recognition as they sat on corresponding numbered chairs. Additionally, they demonstrated responsibility by packing their bags properly. These engaging experiences promoted active learning, problem-solving, and teamwork, making education both fun and effective for young learners.



# EASP

In EASP, nursery students enthusiastically participated in obstacle training, learning to overcome challenges with patience and perseverance. They navigated through various obstacles, developing problem-solving skills and building confidence. This engaging activity promoted physical fitness, teamwork, and resilience.



# JADUI PITARA

Through Jadui Pitara, students explored the letters ठ and ढ. A dictated story incorporating these sounds engaged them, introducing new vocabulary. By listening and participating, students enhanced their phonetic awareness and language skills. This interactive approach made learning fun and effective, helping them grasp the sounds and usage of ठ and ढ in everyday words.



# KINDERGARTEN

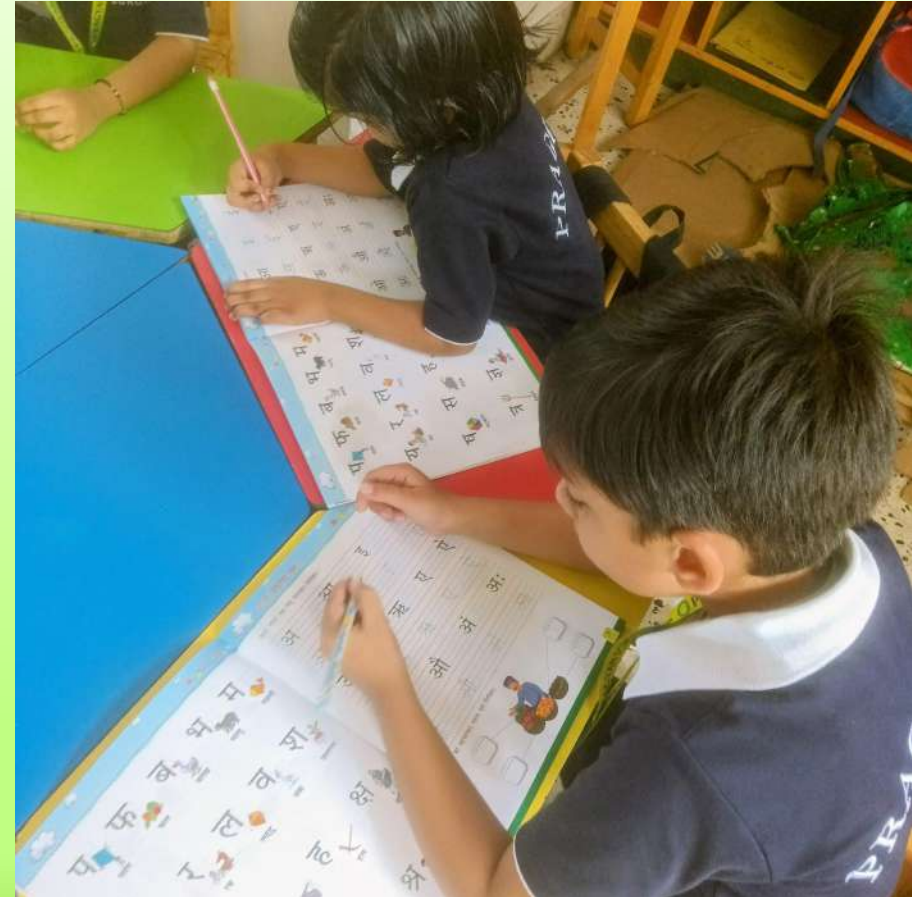
## ENGLISH

This week, the letter s was introduced. Children also revised the letters they had learned earlier, practiced phonics sounds, and worked on letter writing using worksheets, showcasing an improvement in their literacy skills.



# HINDI

This week, children revised the previously learned swar and vyanjans. They also practiced writing the vyanjan ऋ and enjoyed colouring worksheets related to it. These activities helped strengthen their letter recognition and writing skills in a fun and engaging way.



# MATH

This week, children were introduced to numbers 81–90. They practiced arranging numbers in ascending order and skip counting of 2 to strengthen their number sense and early mathematical thinking. Various engaging methods, such as using flashcards and forming number rows, were used to support their learning in a fun and interactive way.





## ENGLISH

This week in English, students were introduced to the "oo" sound. They learned how this sound appears in different words, like "moon," "book," and "food." To help them understand better, students completed worksheets that included reading, matching, and writing activities. These exercises helped them practice the sound in a fun and easy way. The lesson improved their reading and pronunciation skills and made them more confident with new words.

# HINDI

This week in Hindi, students revised the इ की मात्रा and did worksheets related to it. They practiced reading and writing words using इ की मात्रा . The various activities helped students remember how to use the matra correctly in different words. It improved their reading, writing, and pronunciation skills in Hindi.



# MATH

This week in Maths, students practiced backward counting from 180 to 161 and also did ascending order from 161 to 180 in their notebooks. These activities helped them understand how numbers can go up and down in a sequence. Backward counting improved their ability to count in reverse, while arranging numbers in ascending order helped them recognize how numbers increase. These exercises made their understanding of number patterns stronger and improved their counting skills.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

Students did worksheets related to festivals. The activities included true or false, fill in the blanks, and match the following. Through these exercises, students learned about different festivals, their importance, and how they are celebrated. These activities helped improve their general knowledge, reading skills, and understanding of cultural traditions.



# ART & CRAFT

This week, students did craft work for the Gala Day. They used water colours, did pasting, and created colourful artwork related to the theme. The activity helped improve their fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and ability to follow step-by-step instructions. Students enjoyed the process and felt happy to take part in the preparations for the special event.



# CIRCLE TIME

This week as part of circle time, students participated in the discussion on festivals using flashcards of various festivals. Each flashcard showed a picture of a festival, and students spoke a few lines on that festival. This activity helped improve their speaking and listening skills. It also helped them learn more about different cultures and traditions. Using flashcards made the discussion fun and helped students remember the festivals better.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY

This week, as part of Hands-on Activities, students enjoyed learning digraphs **ch, sh, wh, ph** in English and **इ की मात्रा** in Hindi. They learned through engaging hands-on activities, which helped improve their phonics, pronunciation, and word recognition in both languages. Students became more confident in reading and writing, and the fun learning experience made it easier for them to understand and remember the concepts.



# VALUE BASED STORY

Students narrated the story "**The Shepherd Boy and the Wolf**" using flashcards during the story session. They showed different flashcards to represent the characters and important events in the story. This helped them tell the story in the correct order and made it more interesting.





This week, our young learners began with a cheerful recitation of the poem “A Bright New Day,” filling the classroom with energy and positivity. To enrich their vocabulary, the “Words of the Month” were introduced. A joyful Thinking Routine Activity encouraged children to express their ideas with confidence. They also practiced Reading Comprehension, strengthening both understanding and fluency. The week concluded with a fun sentence-making activity, where the little ones creatively applied their learning with enthusiasm.





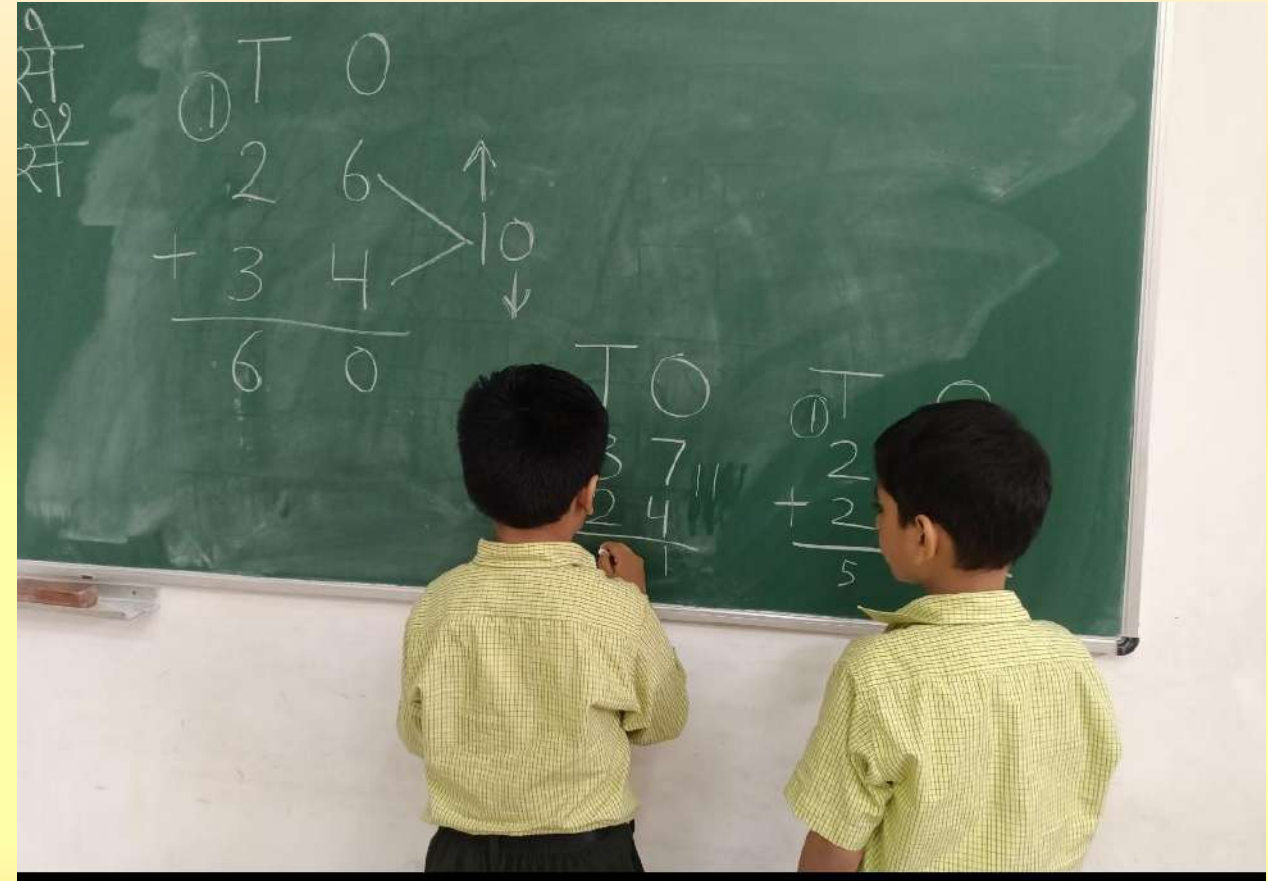
# हिन्दी

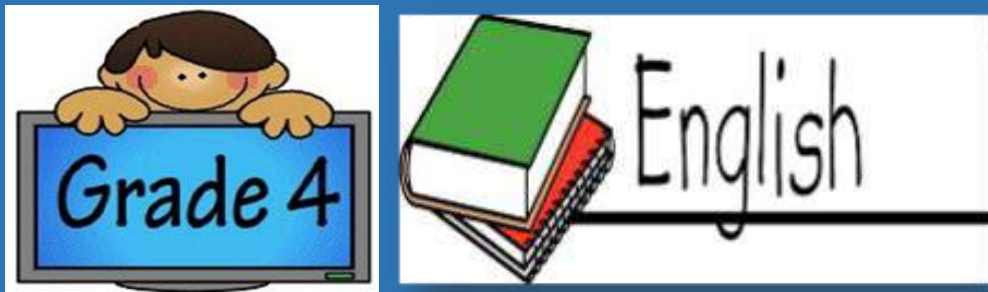




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

# हिन्दी

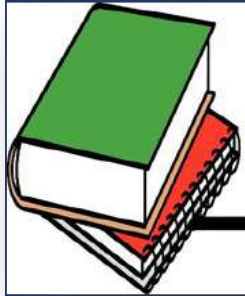

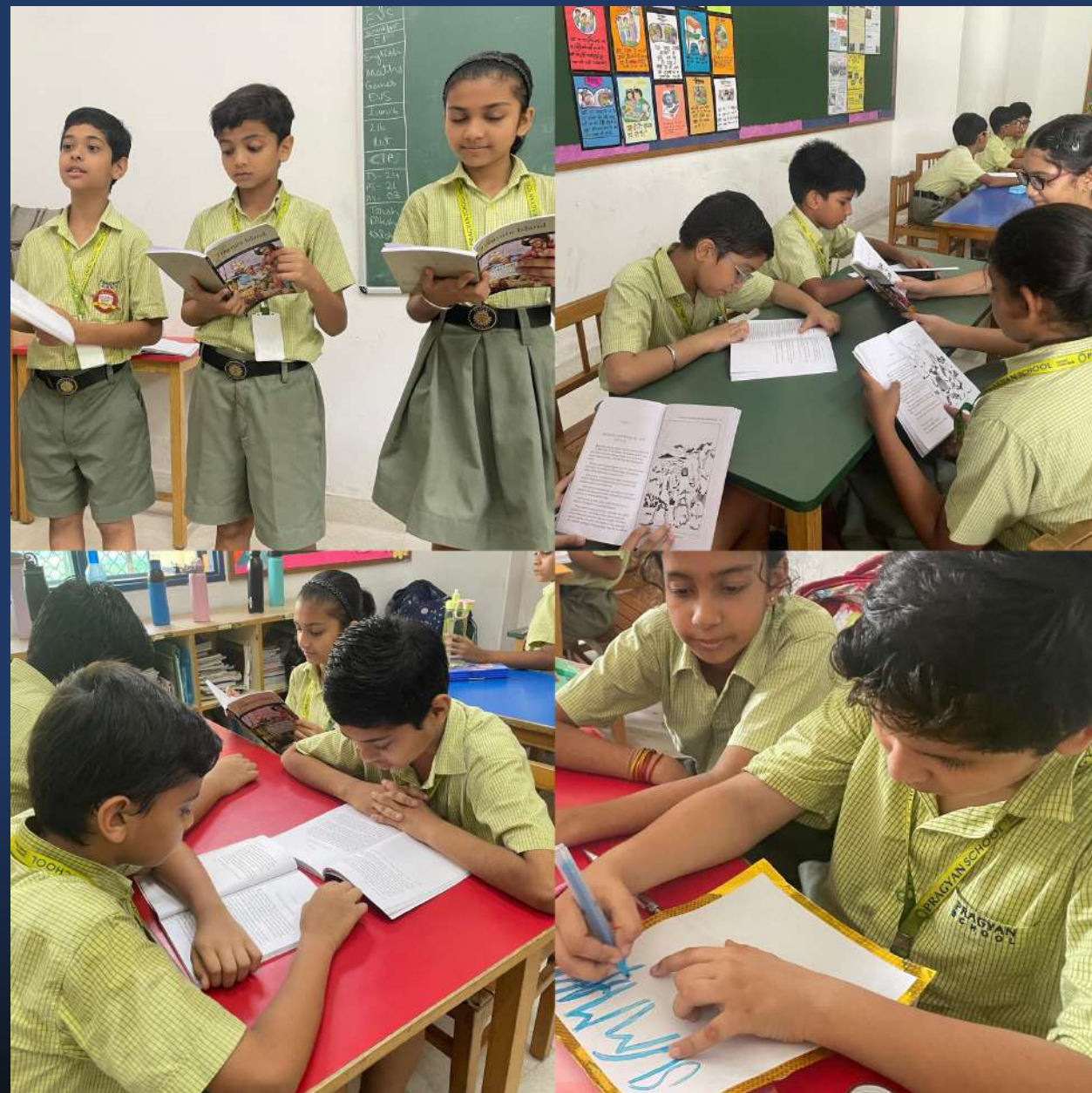

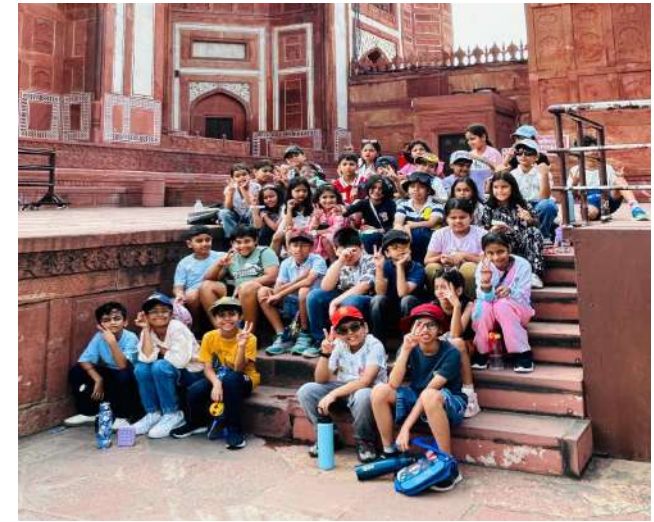
