# SCIENCE DEMO

# KINDERGARTEN



## ENGLISH

Introduction of letters 'a' and 'e' was done through flashcards and pictures. Phonics sound of 'a' and 'e' was taught to children. They practiced writing the letters 'a' and 'e' in their workbook and notebook. Recap of sight words (I,am,a,girl,boy) was also done.

# MATHS

The concept of what comes after was introduced with the help of number cards. Children did worksheets based on the concept. Introduction of numbers from 30-40 was also done.



# HINDI

Recap of swar अ , आ and अक्षर was done. Introduction of swar अक्षर was done through flash cards and pictures. Children wrote अक्षर in their workbook and notebook.



# EVS

# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)

They are now given books for a week to read and develop the reading habit. A story telling session was also conducted by the librarian for Class 1 where kids enjoyed listening to the story.



# INTERCLASS WEEKLY ACTIVITY(1&2)

The shape is an important early skill in Mathematics. With an aim to help our students gain knowledge about the various shapes and understand their applications in the real world, a creative activity “Fun with shapes” was conducted for the students of Grade 1 and 2. The students created beautiful scenery using different shapes. This activity helped in enhancing their imagination and artistic skills.



# CIRCLE TIME & VALUE EDUCATION

In circle time children shared their experience of the new class. They were keen to talk about new teachers, new class and new friends etc. During the value education period students of classes 1 and 2 learnt about the valuable topic - Friendship. Students were shown a video and based on the same kids were encouraged to talk about good qualities of a good friend. They enthusiastically drew the picture of their best friend and explained their good qualities.



# CLASS ASSEMBLY (2C)

"Kindness is the language which the dumb can speak, the deaf can hear and the blind can see." Students of class 2 C presented a beautiful assembly on 24th and 25th April on the topic 'Kindness'. The assembly consisted of a thought, poem and talk on kindness, benefits of kindness etc. They effectively conveyed the message that kindness is an act of compassion, love, concern and sympathy. Being kind to others instills a positive feeling and makes this world a better place to live.



# CLASS ASSEMBLY (2D)

Storytelling is the most powerful way to put ideas into the world today. This week students of class 2D presented their first class assembly of the session on the topic- Importance of stories on 26th and 27th April. Students presented prayer, thoughts, poems, stories, musical presentation, book review along with a talk sharing the importance of stories in our lives.



# EDUCATIONAL OUTING (CLASS1)

Inside the classroom, a student gets to know about new things, new ideas, and new concepts, while outside the classroom, a student explores and experiences. Keeping this in mind an informative trip to Shankar's International Dolls Museum, New Delhi was observed on 28th April 2023 by the students of Class 1 (A B C D &E) Pragyan School, Greater Noida. The students accompanied by their teachers reached the renowned museum to witness world's largest collections of dolls which has more than 6,000 dolls from almost eighty-five countries of the world. The trip provided entertainment as well as imparted knowledge and information to the children about the physical aspects, jewellery and dress of different countries across the globe.





Students of class 3 revised the concept of collective nouns and did related exercises in their notebooks and workbooks. They wrote a paragraph on The Best Birthday I Have Ever Celebrated. They even revised Synonyms. The students participated in the class activity Imagine If...





Students of class 3 completed the questions and answers of the chapter, Bharat Ka Nav Nirman. They also did Anuched on the topic “Rashtriya Chinh ” in their workbooks.





Students of Class 3 learnt how to form the smallest and largest 4-digit numbers using given digits. They also revised their concepts of expanded form and short form by solving exercises and worksheets. They also revised even and odd numbers and were able to differentiate between the two with ease. Class 3 was introduced to the addition facts by the Sunshine Activity. They were able to write different combinations to achieve the same result using addition facts.





# Grade 3 ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Lesson “The beginning of Time” was introduced to the students of class III. The students were thrilled to learn about the life of Early humans and discoveries made by them. They enjoyed watching videos related to the topics taught. Oral evaluation of the topics taught was also done in the class to revise the concepts.





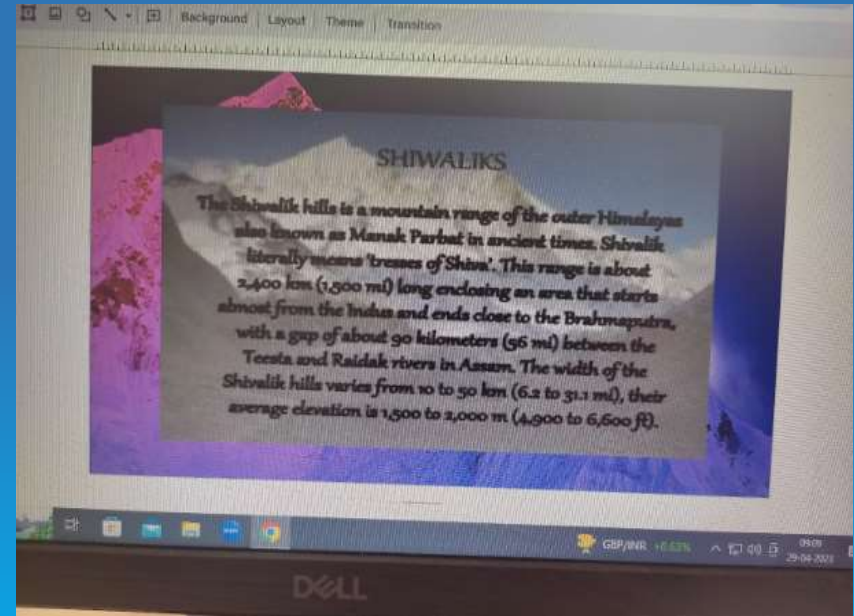

# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 4 studied the chapter Northern Mountains in which they studied about the three Himalayan ranges- Himadri, Himachal and Shiwalik. They also briefly studied about the neighbouring countries of India. New words and the question answers of the chapter were done in the note book. The students enjoyed watching the videos on the topics taught.

The names of the latitudes and longitudes along with their degrees and significance was also a part of the group discussions. The difficult words of the lesson along with the objective and subjective questions were completed in the class.





Students of class V did the new words, questions answers and reference to the context of the lesson, A New Flower in their notebooks. They revised the concepts of homophones and subject and predicate. They did worksheets based on these concepts. They were introduced to compound words too.

They learnt sprints in Athletics too. They also participated enthusiastically in activities of physical fitness components development through different drills.



## CLASS TEACHER PERIOD

Students of classes 3-5 had theme-based Enrichment periods on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The topic for the Circle Time on Monday was Importance of Cleanliness. It was discussed with the students that The first and foremost importance of cleanliness is that it means the absence of disease. Cleanliness helps us stay refreshed and hygienic on a personal level.
