NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter 'I' was introduced in nursery through flashcards. Pictures related to letter I and Jolly Phonics song were also part of the learning process. Students enjoyed tracing and writing the letter 'I' in their workbook.

KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Introduction of the letter 'g' was done through flashcards and pictures. Phonics sound of 'g' was taught to the children. They practiced writing the letter 'g' in their workbook and notebook. Sight words like my, is, mama and papa were introduced through flash cards.

MATHS

The concept of what comes before was introduced with the help of number cards. Children did worksheets based on the concept. They also wrote 0-40 in sequence in their notebook



ART

Art engages children's senses in open-ended play and supports the development of cognitive, social-emotional and multisensory skills. Students of kindergarten enjoyed drawing and colouring the rainbow fish in their art file.

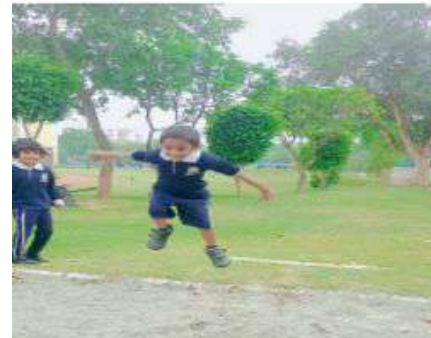
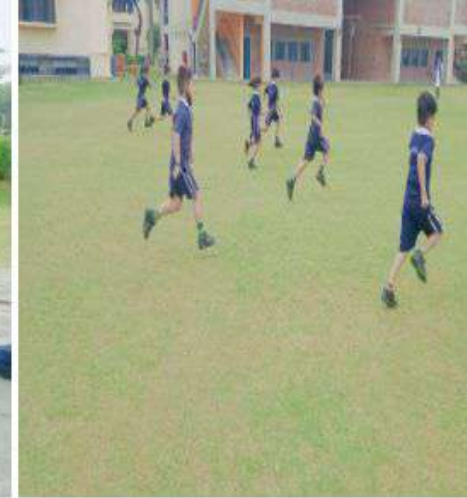
DANCE (CLASS 1)

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD



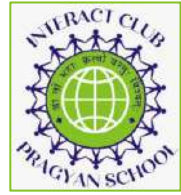
