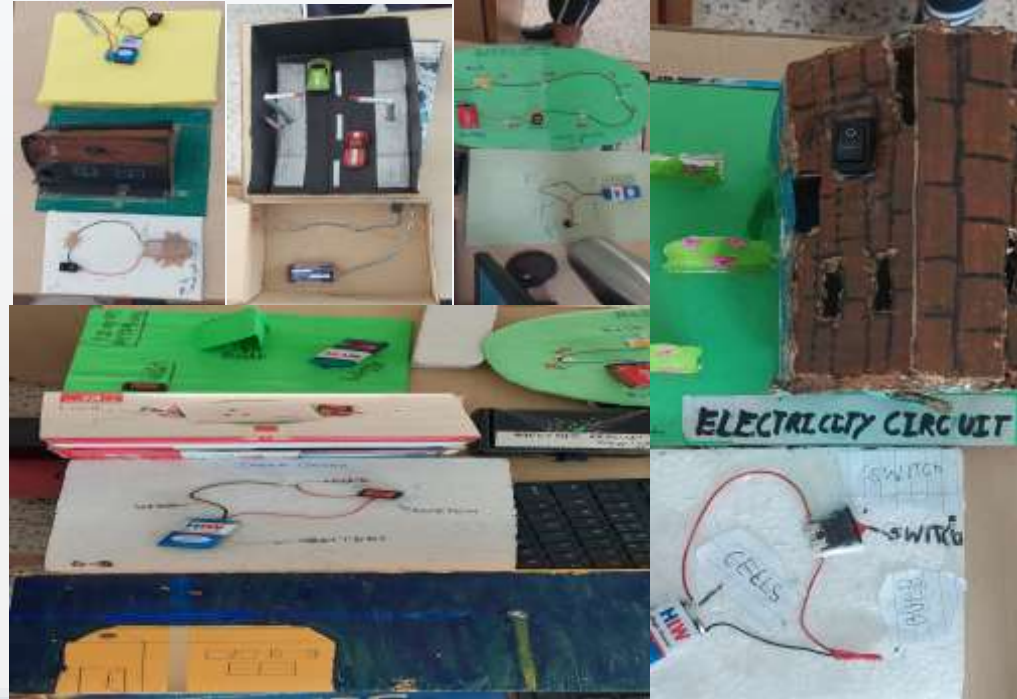
SCIENCE ACTIVITY CLASS VI

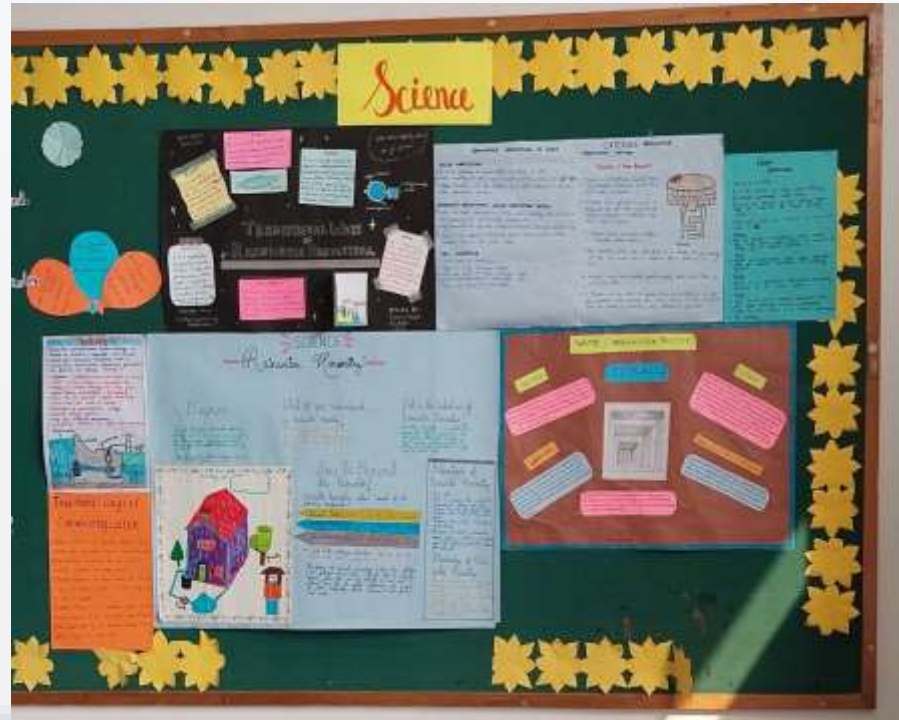
SCIENCE ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY CLASS VI

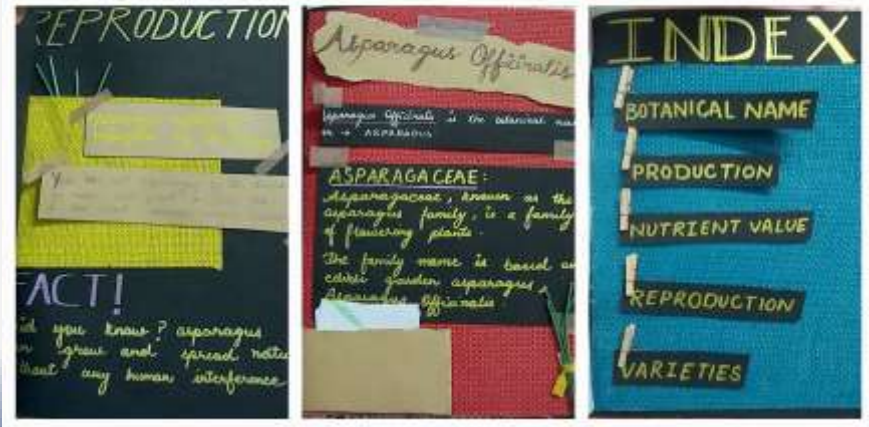
SCIENCE ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY CLASS VII
