NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter Z was introduced to the children with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of the letter Z. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook and in their notebook. They excelled in English letter recognition, matching letters with pictures and demonstrating phonics skills. They identified letters, recognized phonetic sounds and linked them to words.

MATHS

The numbers 26 and 27 were introduced to the children using blocks. They did worksheets related to the numbers. Children also did counting using different objects. They practiced sequence writing of 0-27 in their notebook.



GENERAL AWARENESS

During the week discussion was done on different domestic animals, wild animals, their homes as well as their young ones. Students also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic. They also did shape activity and tear and pasting in their workbook.



CRAFT

Nursery students created stunning Christmas crafts, coloring trees and bells with crayons, adding sparkles for a festive touch. Their artwork showcased creativity, fine motor skills, and holiday cheer, making it a delightful Christmas celebration activity.



YOGA

Nursery students participated in a yoga session, learning Tadasana, Vrikshasana, Trikonasana, and Virabhadrasana. They demonstrated flexibility, balance, and coordination, showing great enthusiasm and energy during the session.



CIRCLE TIME

Students of Nursery participated in a lively circle time, recapitulating about domestic and wild animals. They answered basic questions, and shared their favorite animals. The interactive session sparked curiosity, fostering awareness and appreciation for the animal kingdom among the young learners.

MATHS

The students practiced addition to strengthen their understanding, using flashcards as a helpful tool under the teacher's guidance.

HINDI

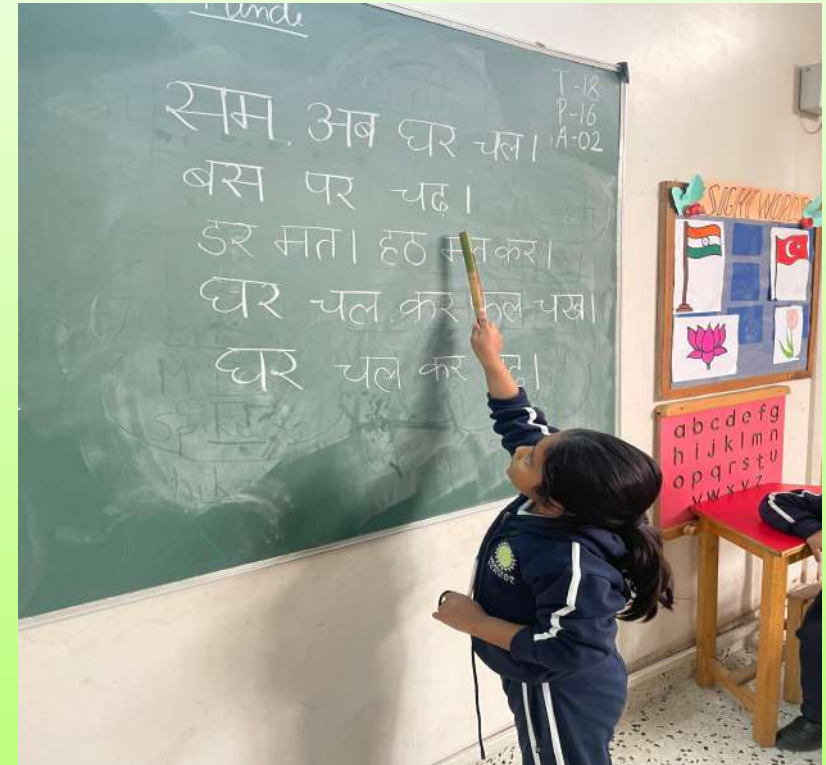
ESAP (UK & UKG)

HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

SKILL BASED LEARNING (KG)

This week as part of skill based learning students of kindergarten were engaged in activities like peeling, cutting, and chopping fruits and vegetables. Students were also asked to focus on hygiene, teaching them to wash their hands, use clean tools and handle food safely.





MATHS

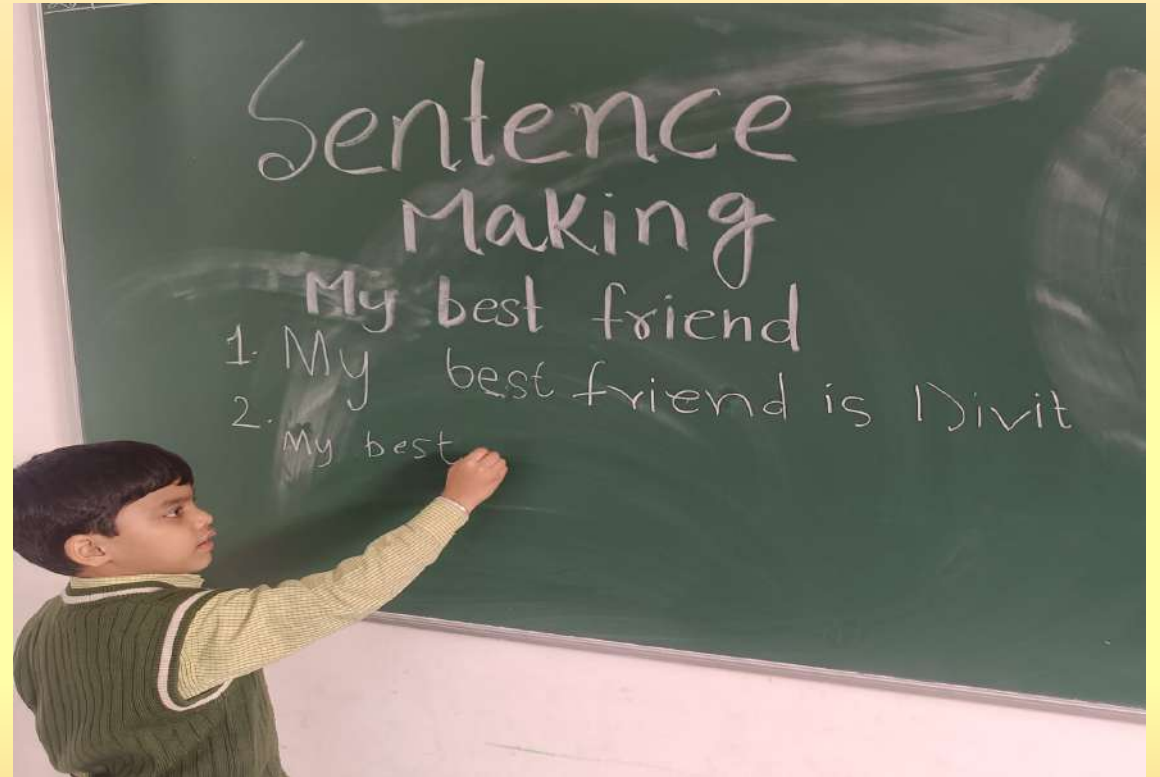


SPECIAL ASSEMBLY(KG &UKG)

Continuing with the concept of conjunctions, the students of Class 2 engaged in additional written practice in their notebooks and completed their worksheets based on the concept of joining words. Grade 2 students explored the concept of Living things and Non living things. As part of their learning, they revised new vocabulary words of the month and delved into the chapter on Living and Non-Living things. To reinforce their understanding, students completed worksheets related to the chapter in their workbook, engaging with the material in an interactive way.





This week in Grade 2, students revisited important concepts of metric measurement, focusing on understanding and comparing lengths using centimeters and meters. They engaged in a fun and interactive ice-breaking activity where they measured the lengths of their stationery items, such as pencils and colored pencils, strengthening their hands-on learning of measurements. Additionally, they practiced solving addition and subtraction word problems, improving their problem-solving skills.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)

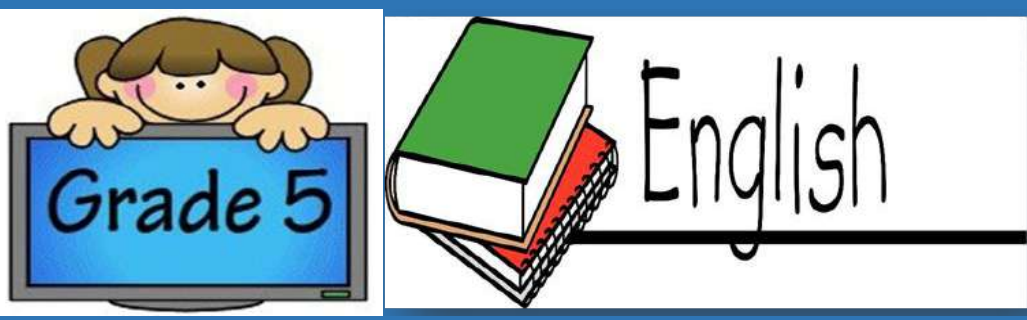
