EVS - 'Pigeon' was introduced through audio-visual and by colouring the worksheet. Students enjoyed the craft work of pigeon.

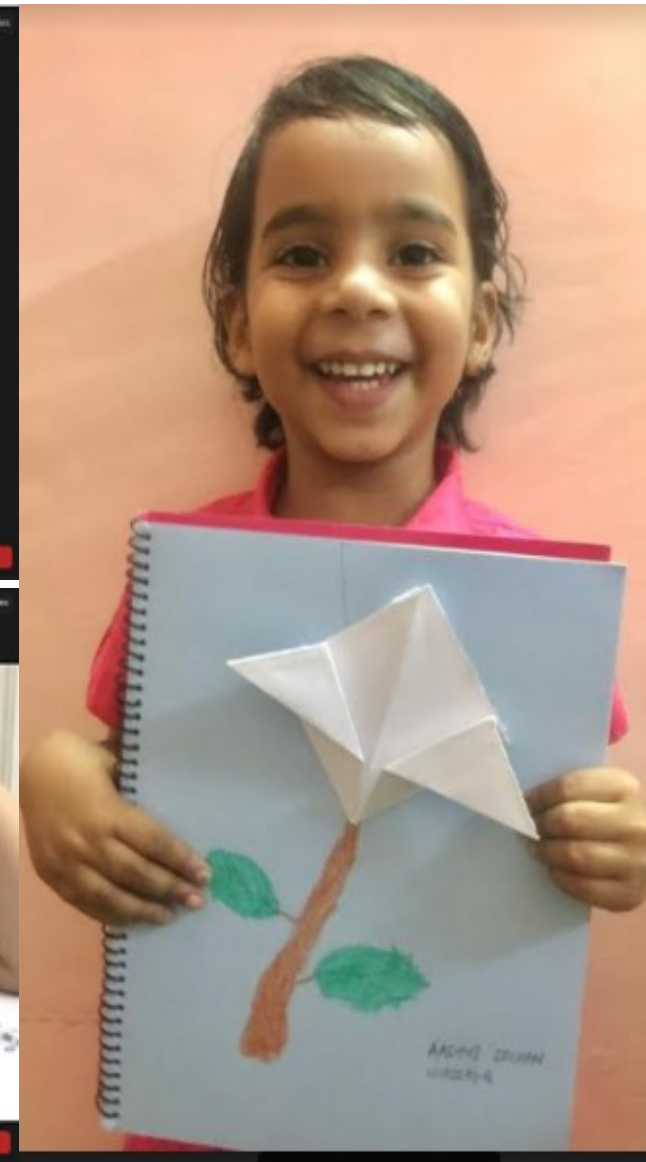

Students enjoyed ‘**Pouring**’ and ‘**folding**’ activities which help them to develop their fine motor skill.

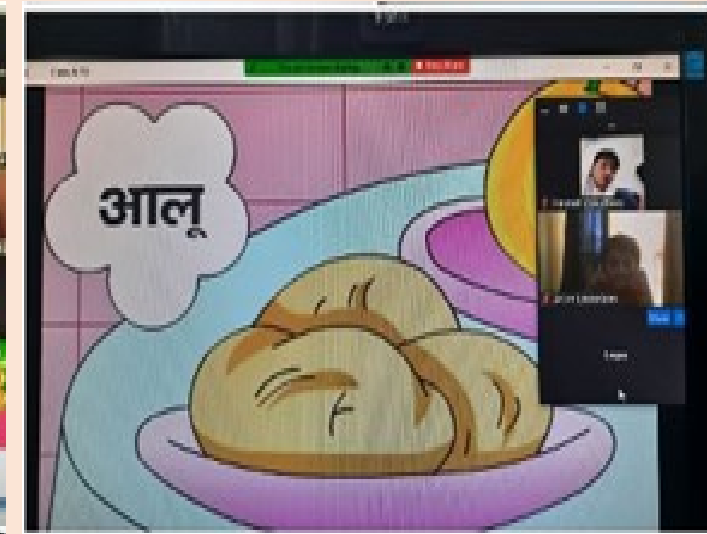
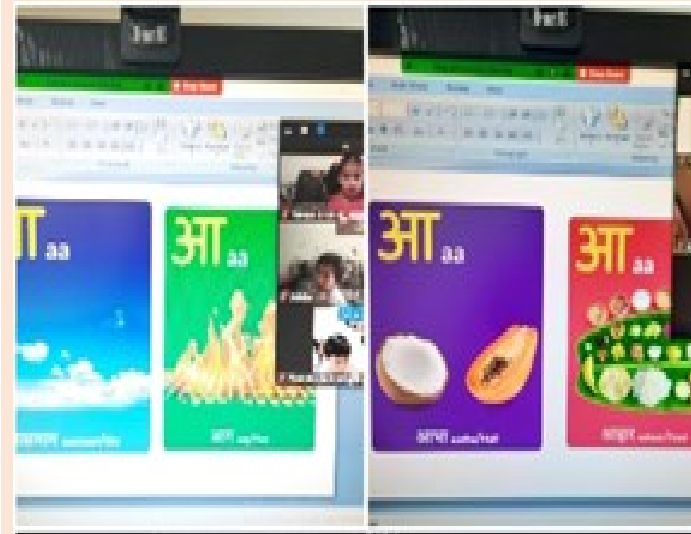
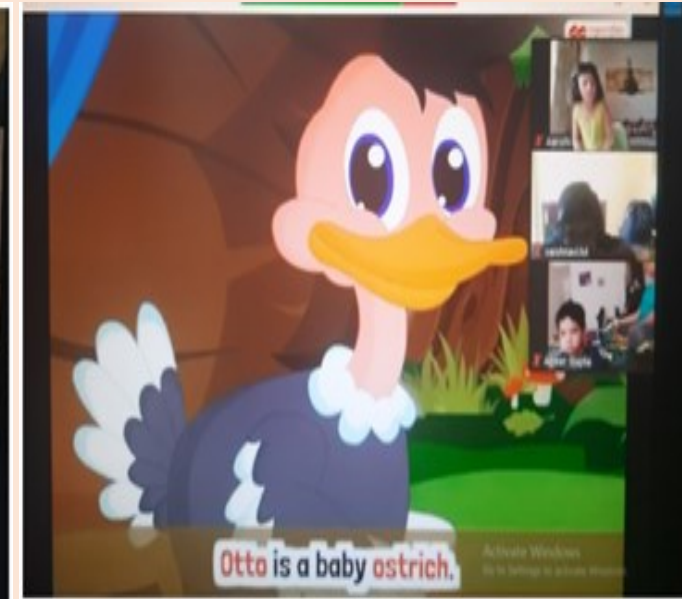
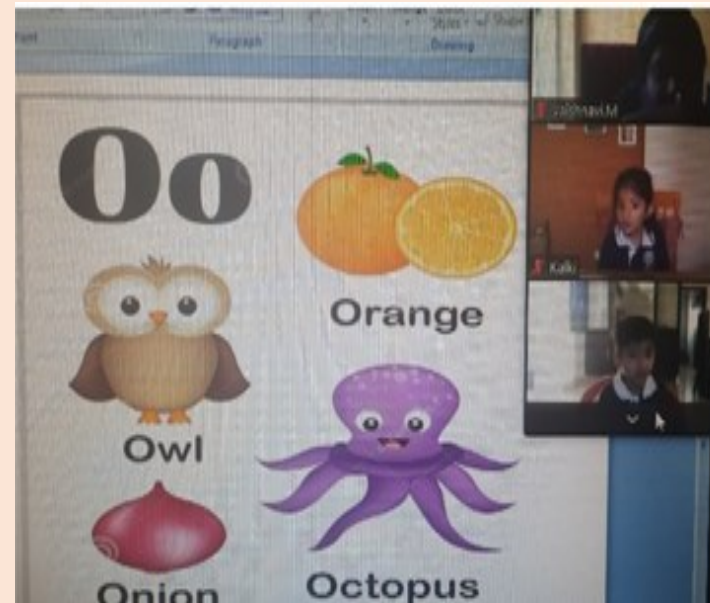


KINDERGARTEN

Hindi - swar अ, आ were introduced with the help of flashcards and with story. Written practice was also done in workbook and busy bee book.

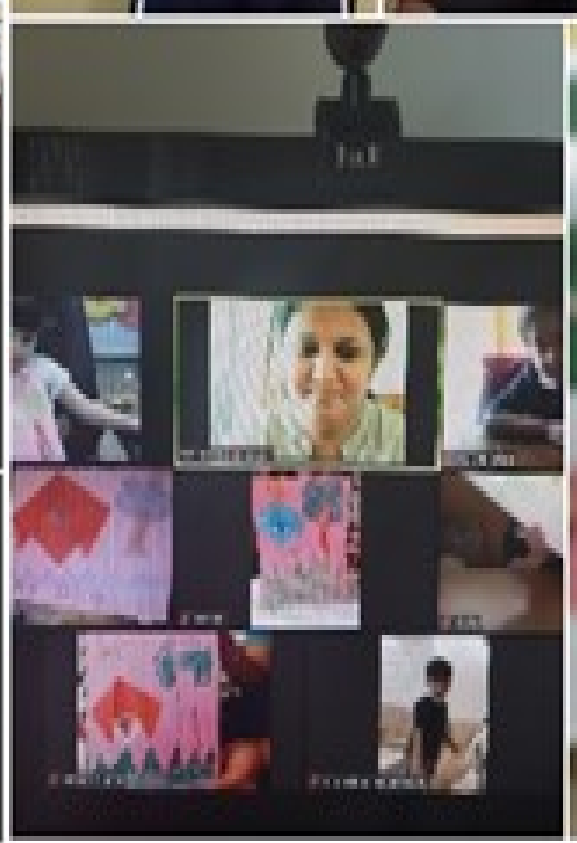


Kindergarten

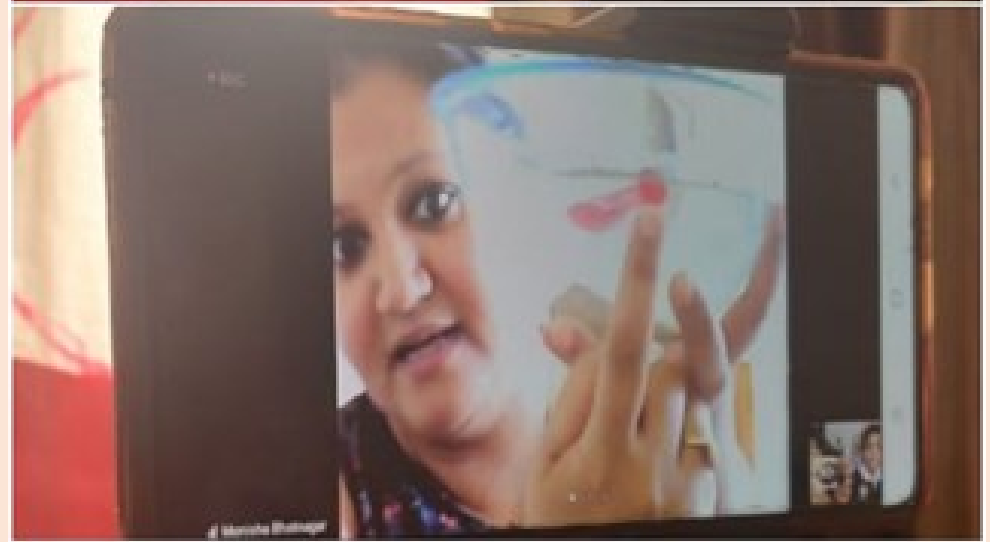
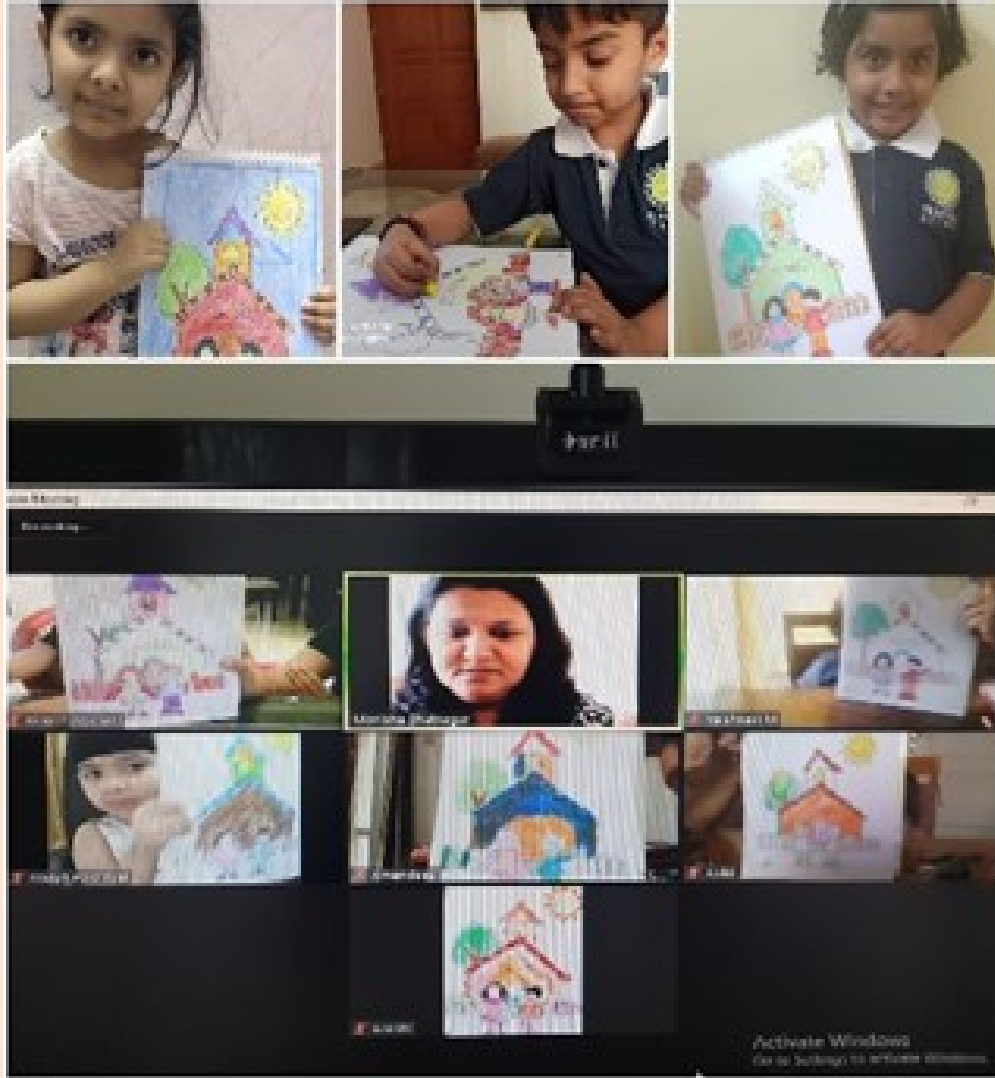
GA - 'My Family' was introduced and students were taught about family.

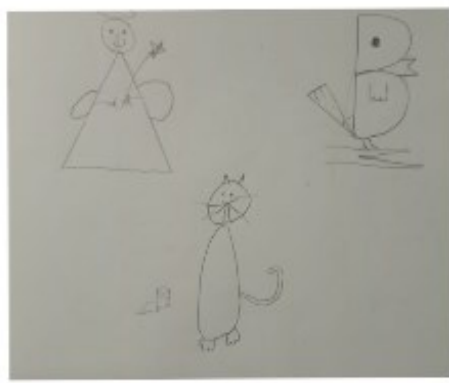
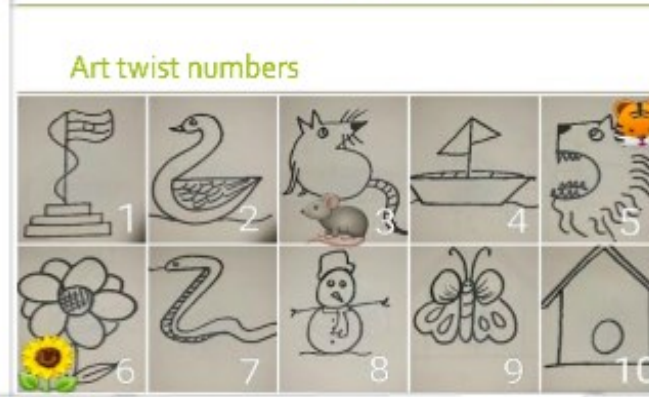
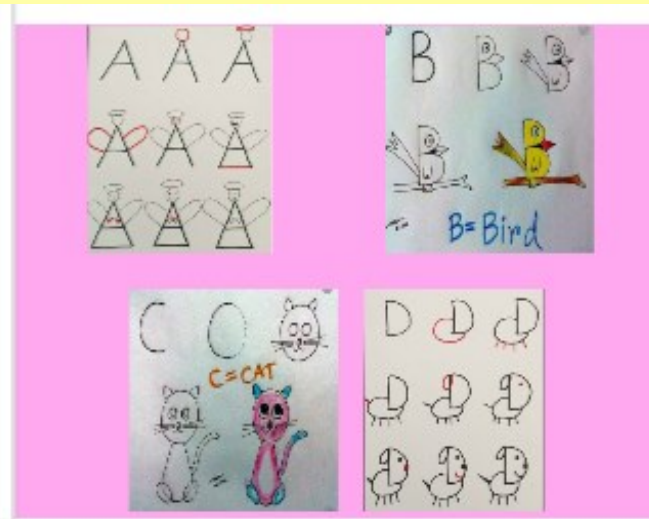
Music - Students enjoyed singing patriotic song Hind Desh ke niwasi "in the class .

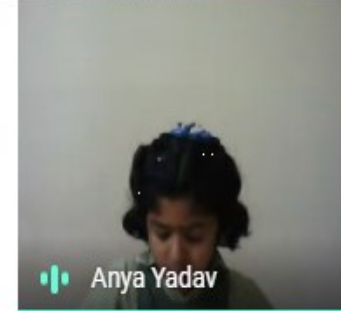
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

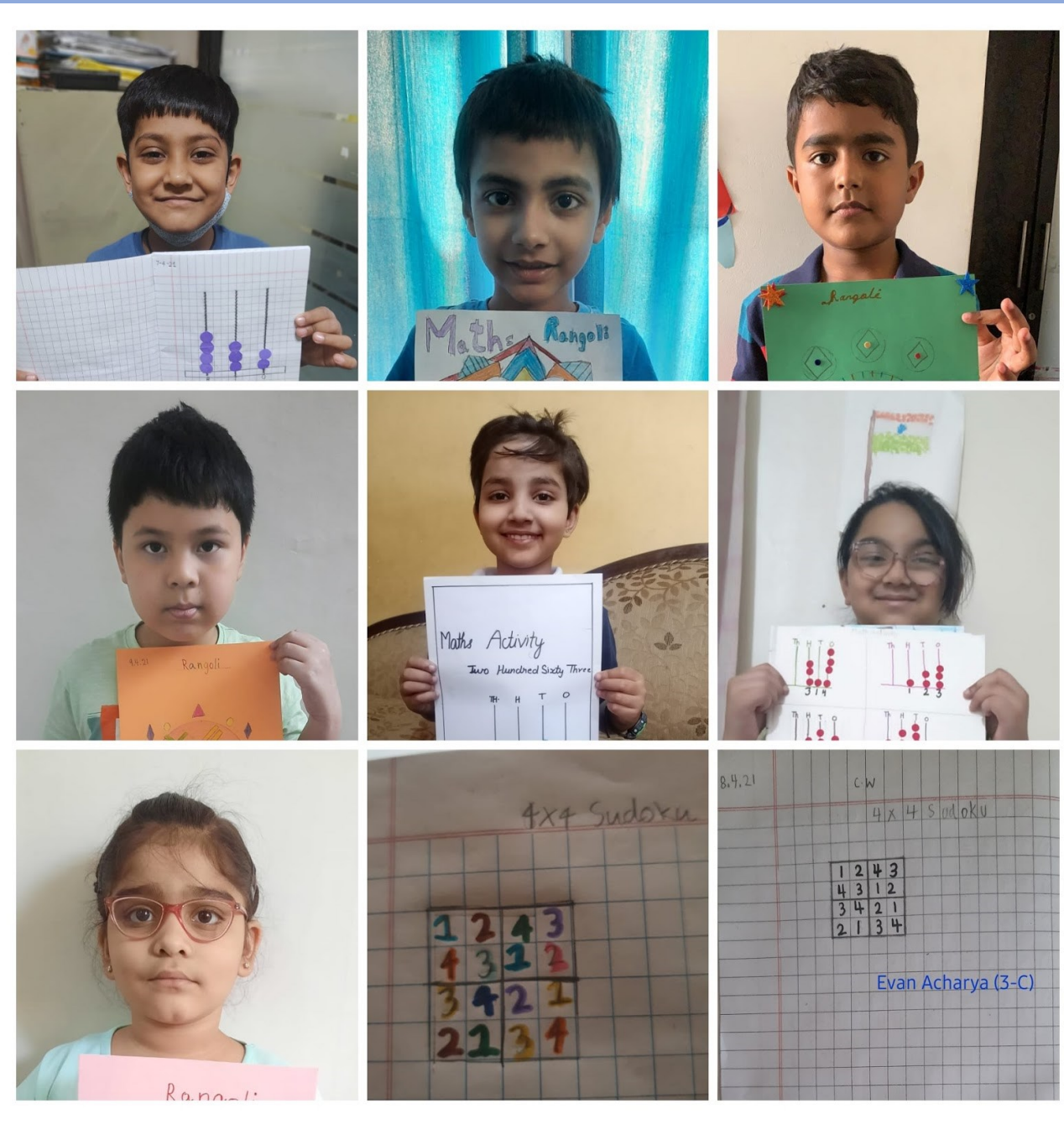
SCIENCE

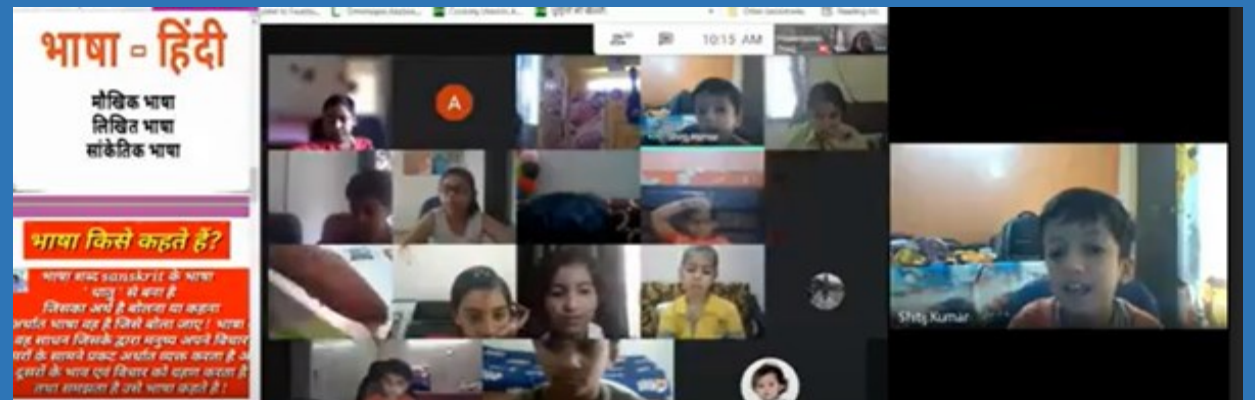
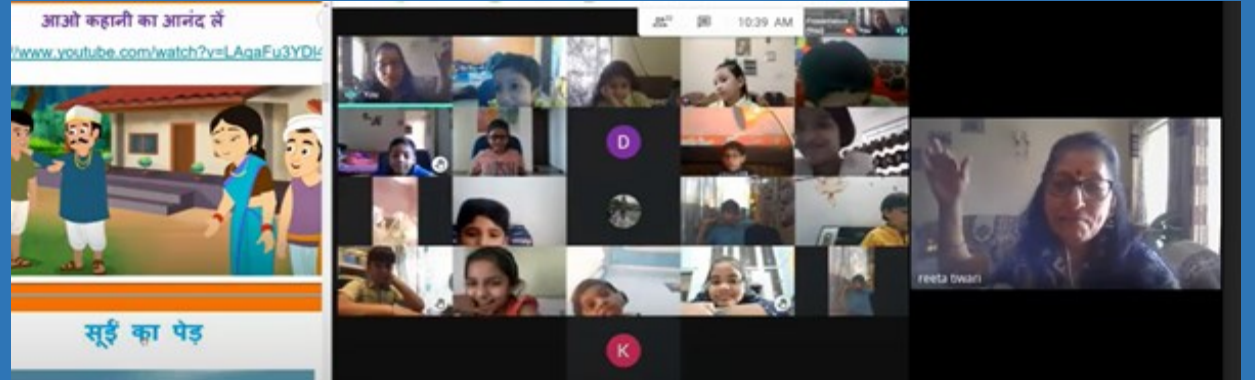




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

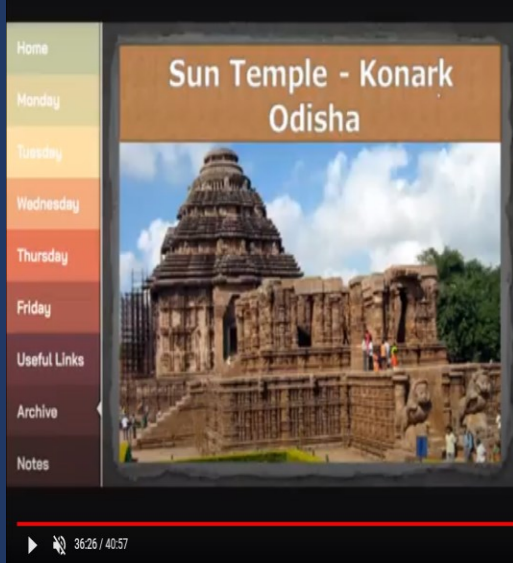


ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

5C Online EVS Class (2021-04-04 at 23:31 GMT-7)

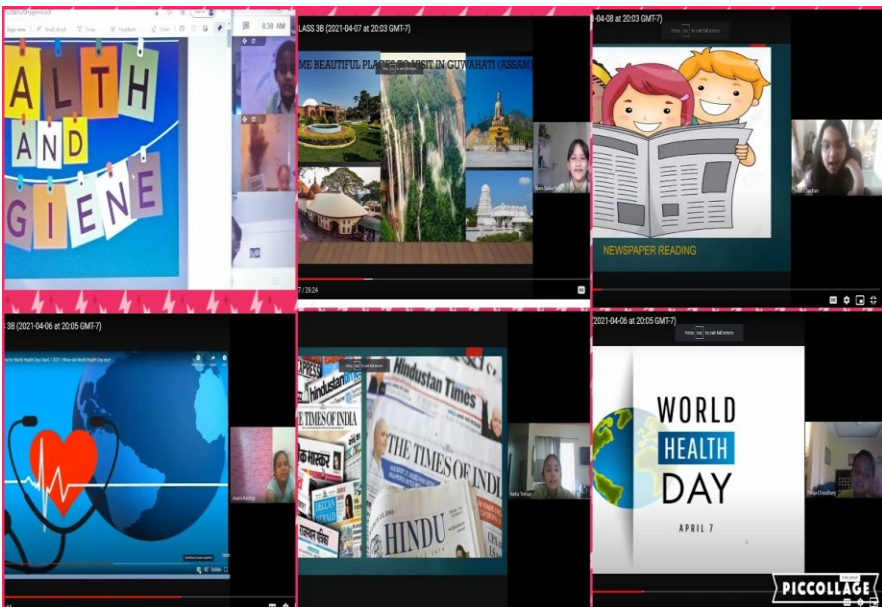

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD



The week concluded with a discussion on Importance of Reading Newspapers. The various benefits of reading newspapers for students were put forward. The students realised how it helps in building vocabulary, writing and speaking skills too.



SRCC SUMMIT PARTICIPATION-XII

Students of class XII, participated in Economy De La Ville of the 10th Annual Economics Summit, Shri Ram College of Commerce on 8th April, 2021.

Students were asked to organize themselves in groups, representing different schools of economic thought. So, if some young minds represented the philosophy of Karl Marx, there were others who represented the free spirit of Capitalism espoused by Adam Smith and others. The group represented by Pragyan students was given, to articulate Marxist theory, through which they offered solutions to a hypothetical country facing the challenges of unemployment, low savings, and investments. The event gave the young minds the much-needed exposure of thinking beyond their classroom teaching and tackle the economic situation provided with the designated school of thought.



SOLUTIONS: FINANCIAL SECTOR

- ❑ As the financial system of Hoatzin, though being stable, is in a bad shape due to the high NPLs. The ratio of Gross NPLs to Total Loans was 24% in 2020.
- ❑ Surely, this lead to non-availability of loans which leads to more caution from the banks' side which in turn leads to reduced advancement of loans in the economy.
- ❑ Also the informal sector bear the most brunt as formal sector still could get loans due to availability of collateral which further reduced the meagre amount of loans the informal sector used to receive.
- ❑ It could be possible that the growth the country has witnessed in the last few years could be simply due to loans advanced by the banks without much scrutiny which had led to increase in growth in the short term but ultimately led to slow down due to high NPLs. Therefore, the government must nationalise all major private banks. It will serve two purposes. Firstly, this will protect the informal sector from exposing itself to the informal source of lending where they are charged high interest rates. Secondly, it will prevent the advancement of loans to capitalists who exploit workers in name of earning more profits.
