English - Revision of letters A-Z , matching of lowercase with uppercase was done in English Workbook and in 4-lines notebook.

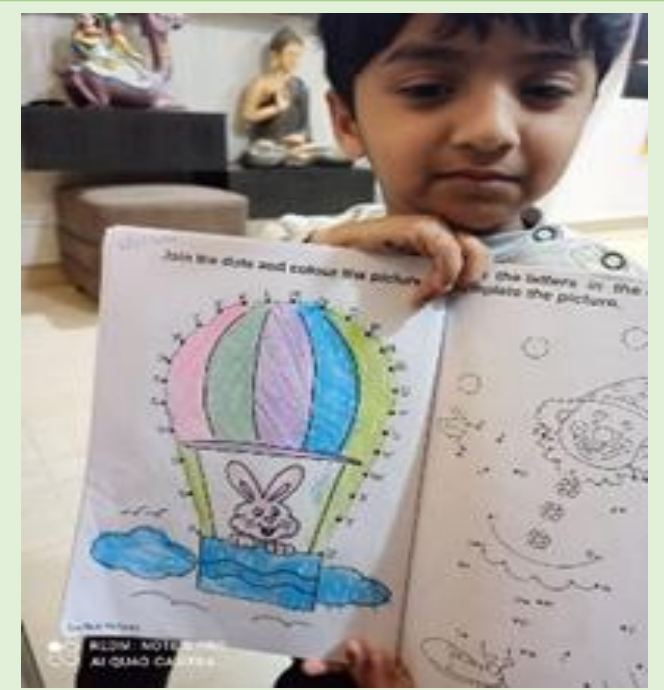




**Maths** - Rote counting 1-100 and sequence writing 0-20 were done in the class.

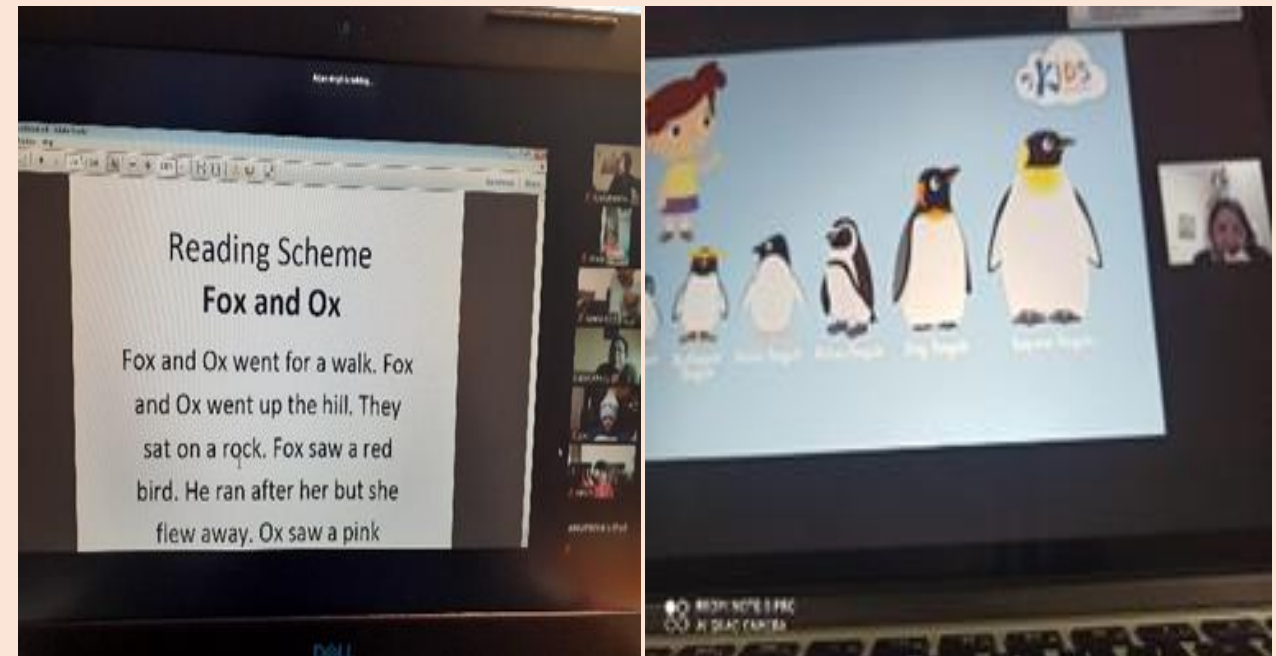


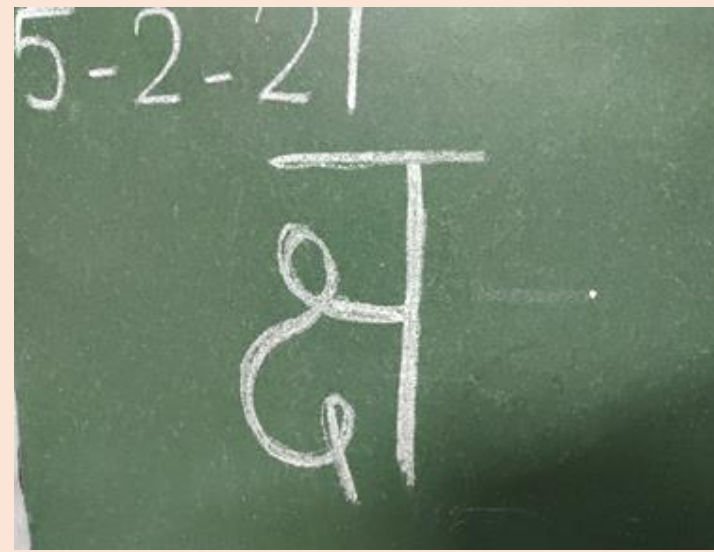
# KINDERGARTEN

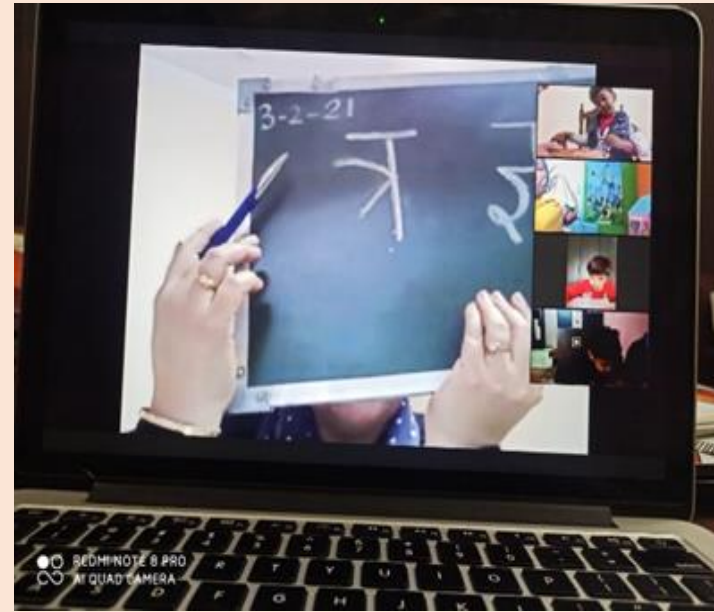
**Reading scheme**- Students enjoyed reading the story of 'Fox and Ox'

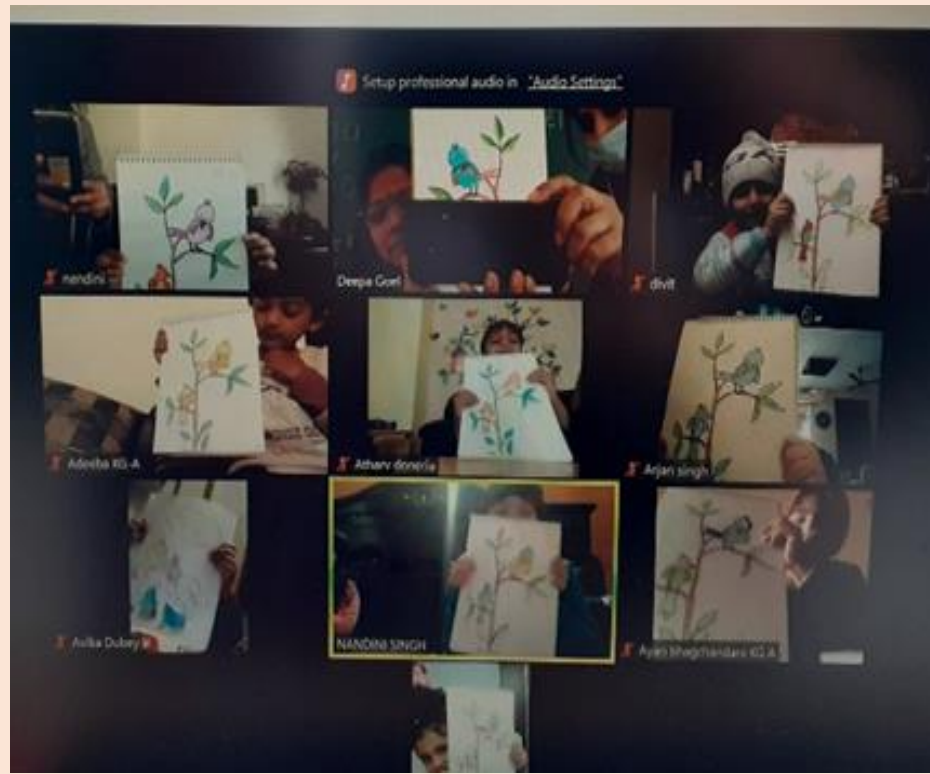


MATHS – Subtraction and number name 13 was introduced in class. Addition was also revised during the class.

Art and craft -students enjoyed colouring in page 17 of sparkle book.

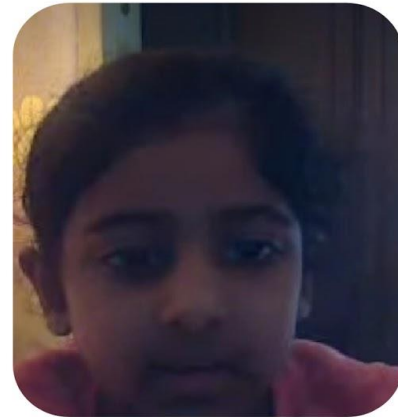
Music - Students enjoyed singing ‘ped lagao’ song in their music class.

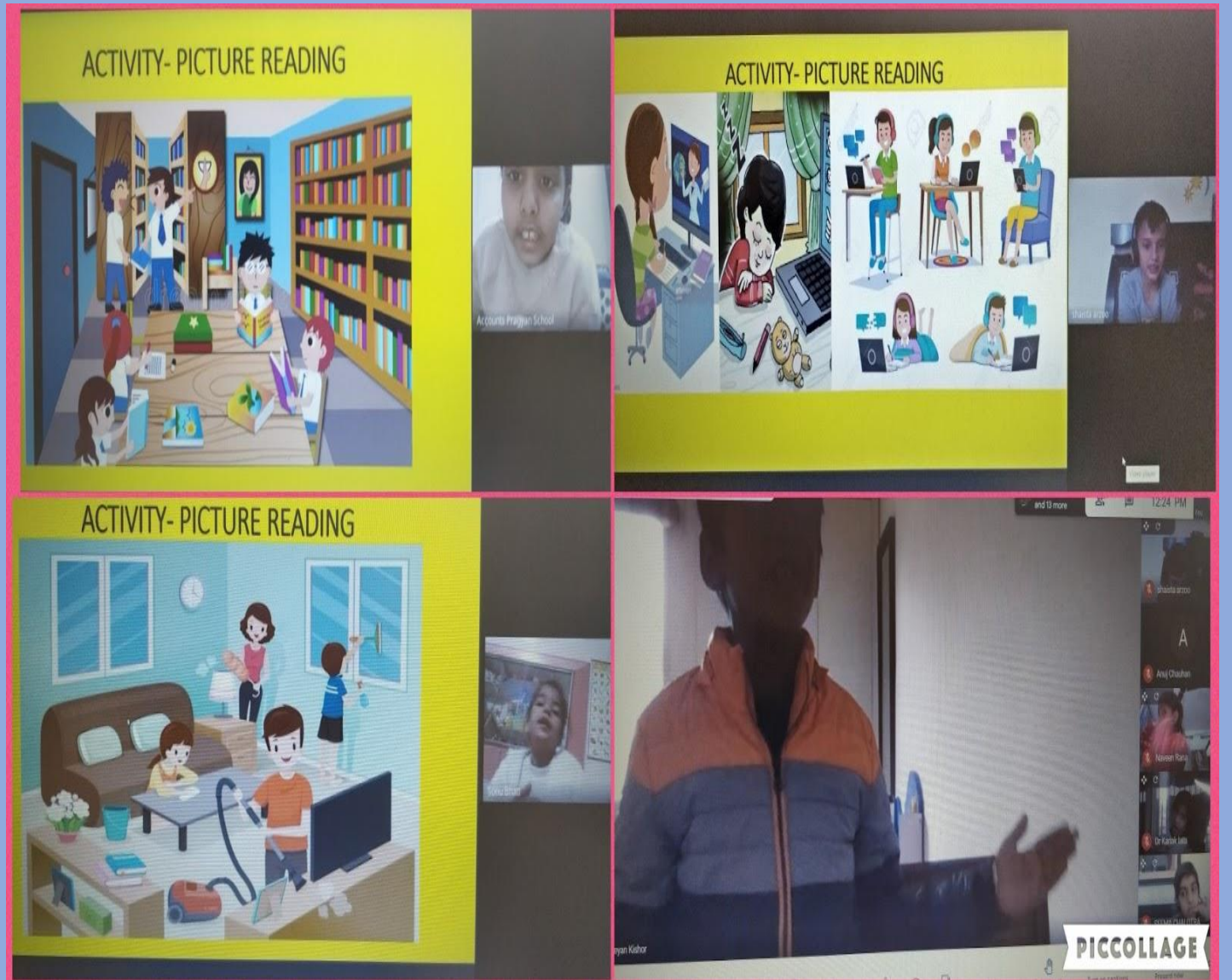
# COLLABORATIVE ACTIVITY

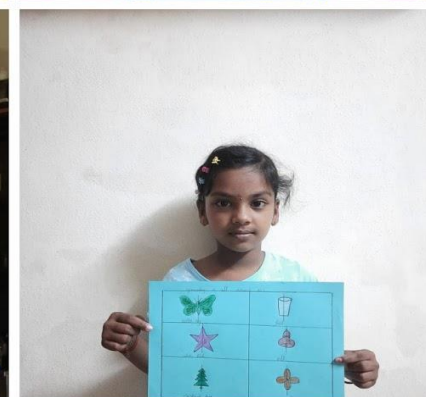
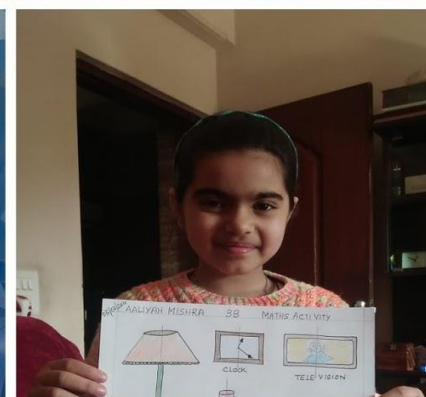
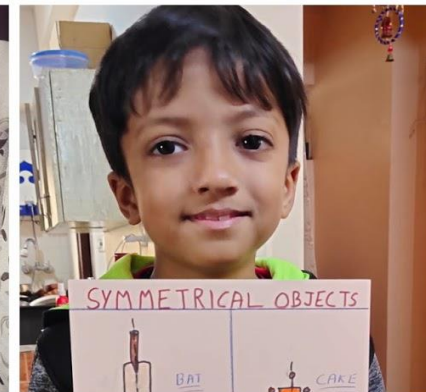

Students of class 3 drew and pasted various symmetrical objects that they see around them. They enjoyed the fun filled activity of identifying their line of symmetry.

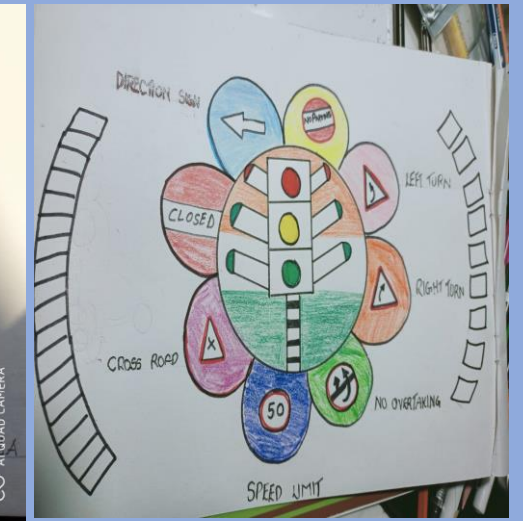

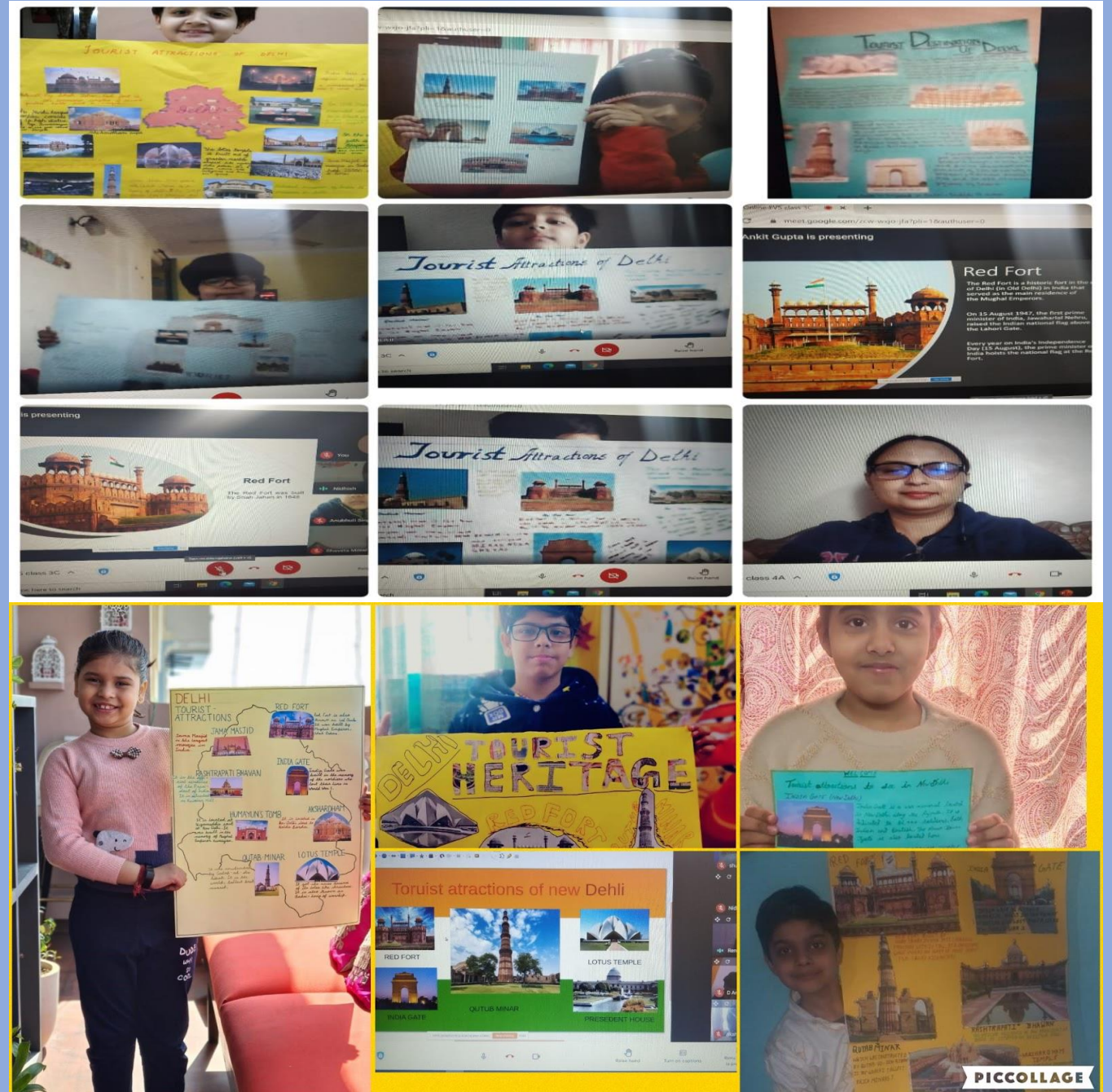
Students of classes 3A ,3B and 3C made fantastic rangolis on 'Road Safety.' They enthusiastically worked on it to spread awareness on traffic rules.

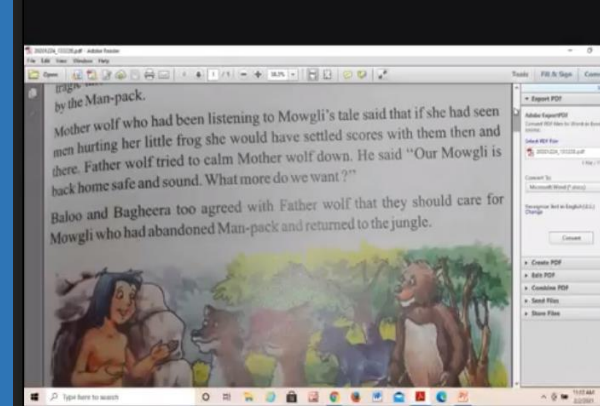
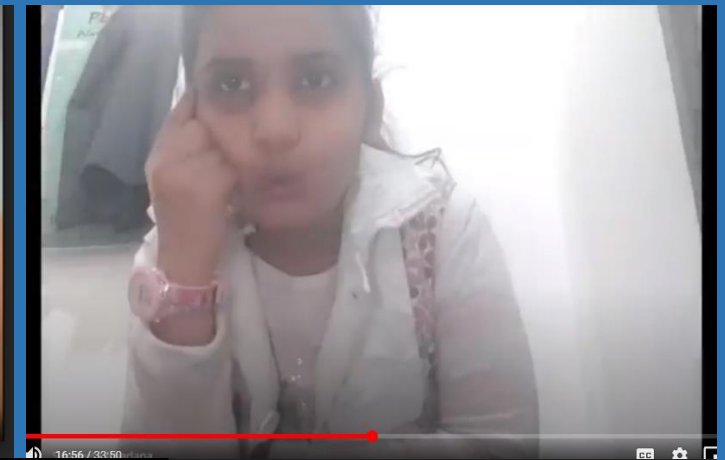
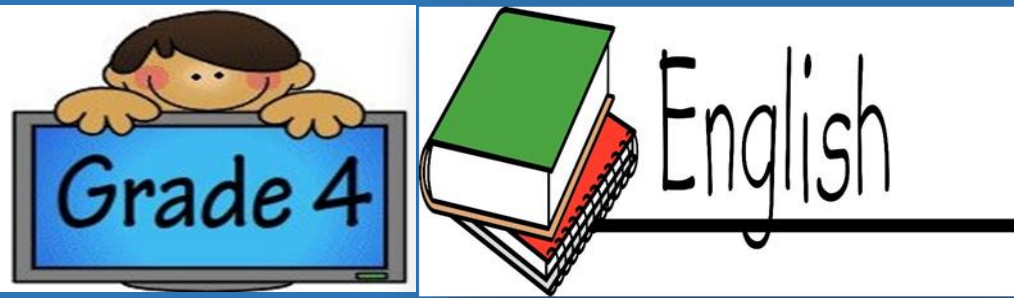




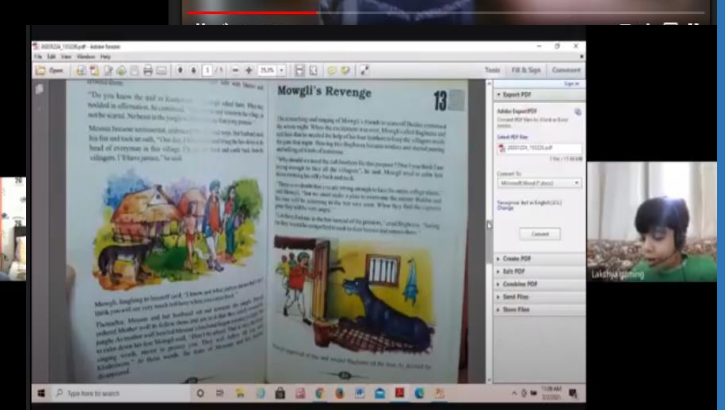
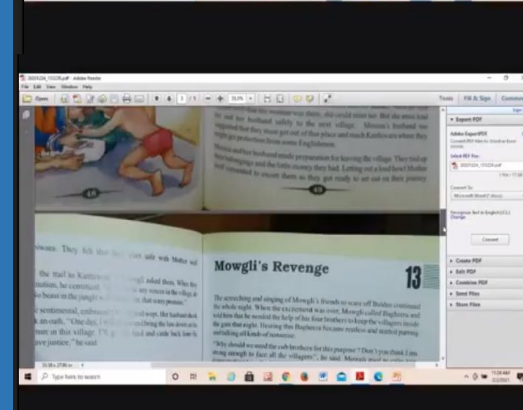
# ENVIRONMENT SCIENCE

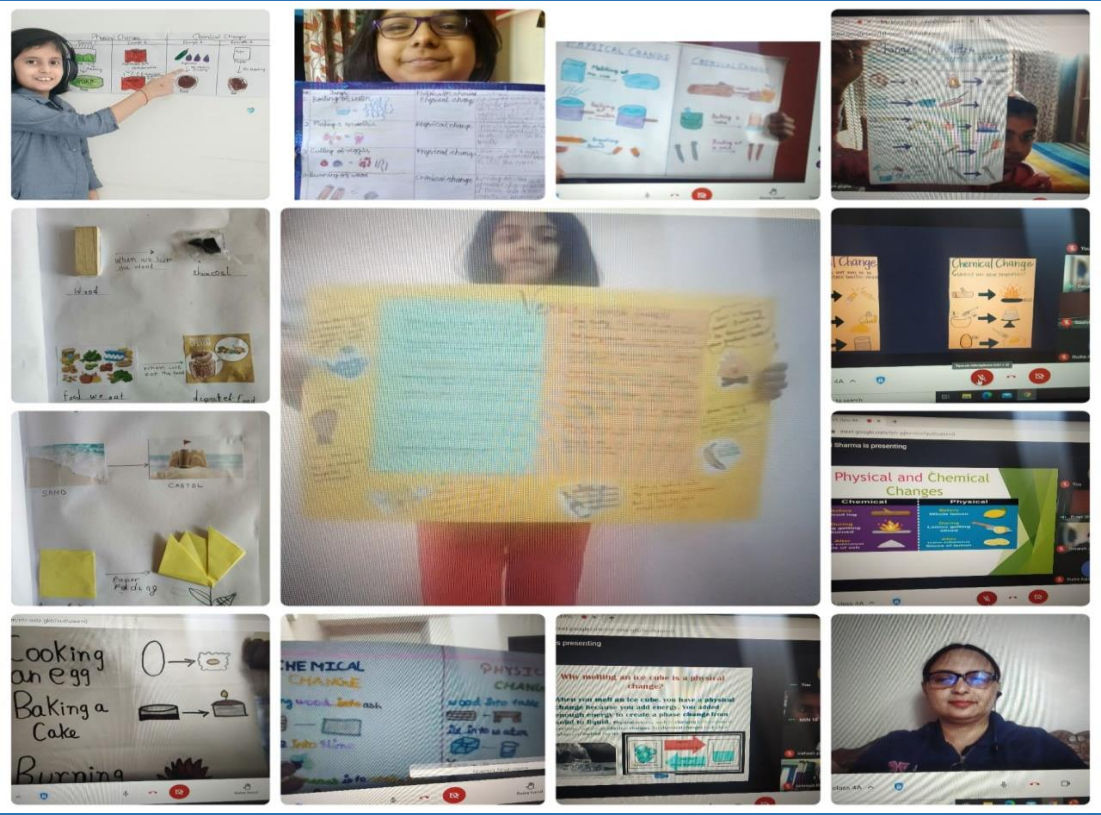
Students of grade 4 had the assessments of dictation, reading, poem recitation and activity this week. They were also introduced to the poem of the month, 'My Shadow.'

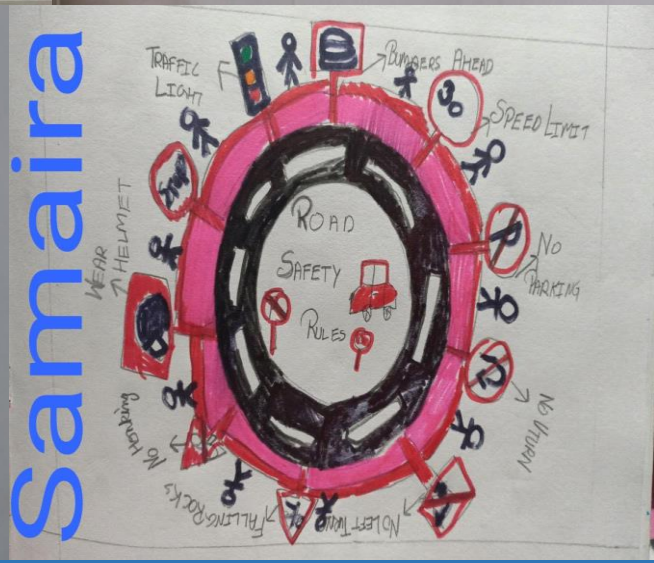
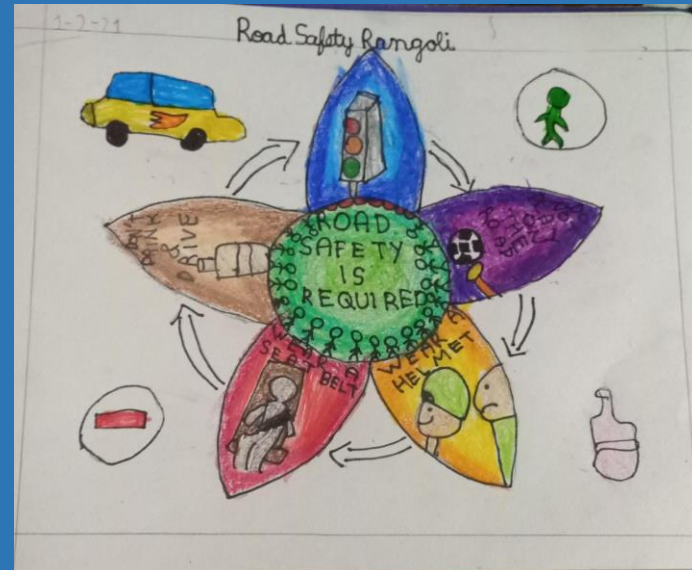

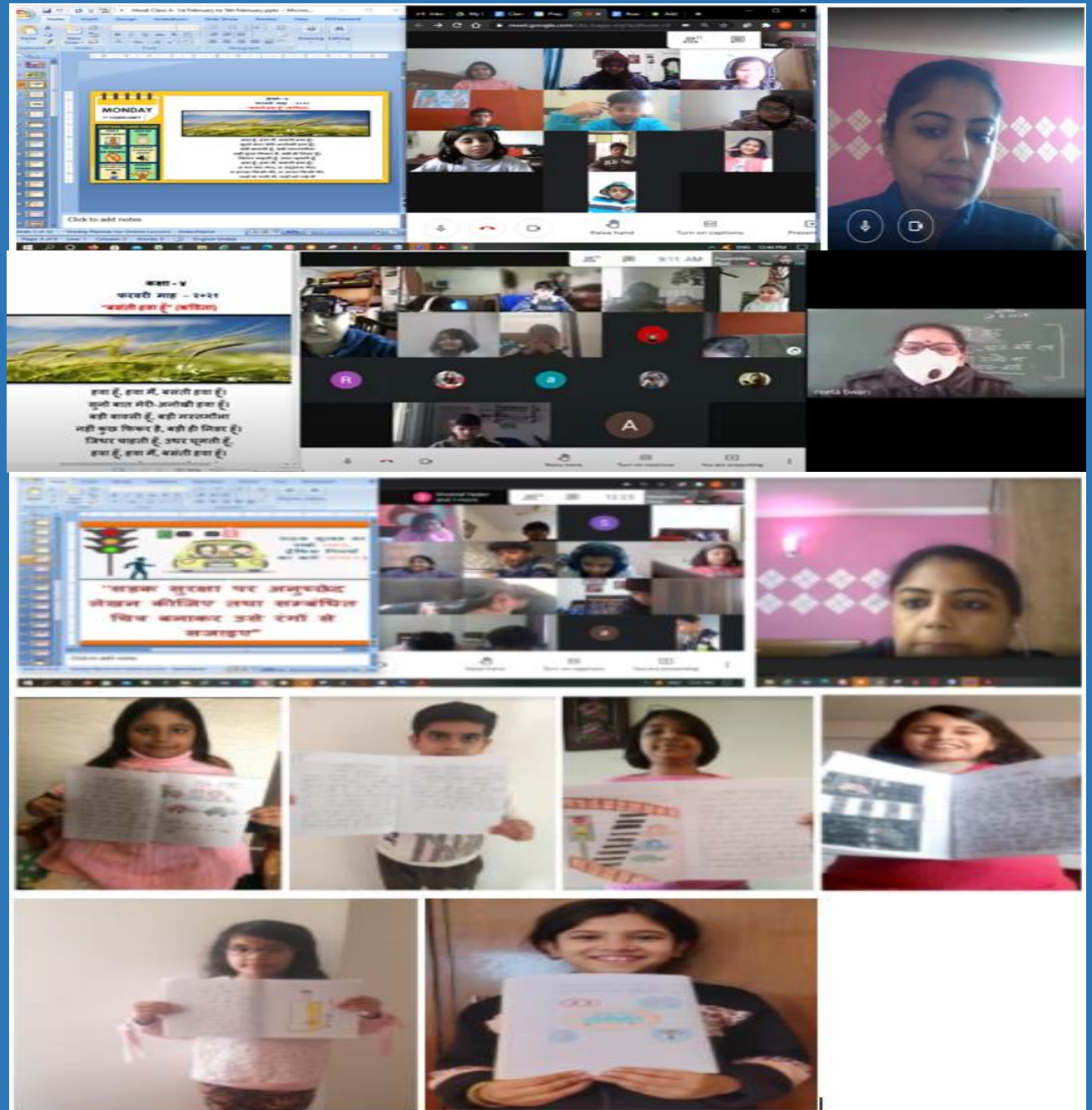
Students of class 4C created innovative rangolis on 'Road Safety.' They gave information on traffic signs and road safety rules through their rangolis.

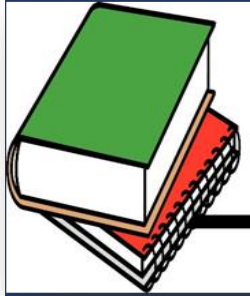




# Grade 4 MATH

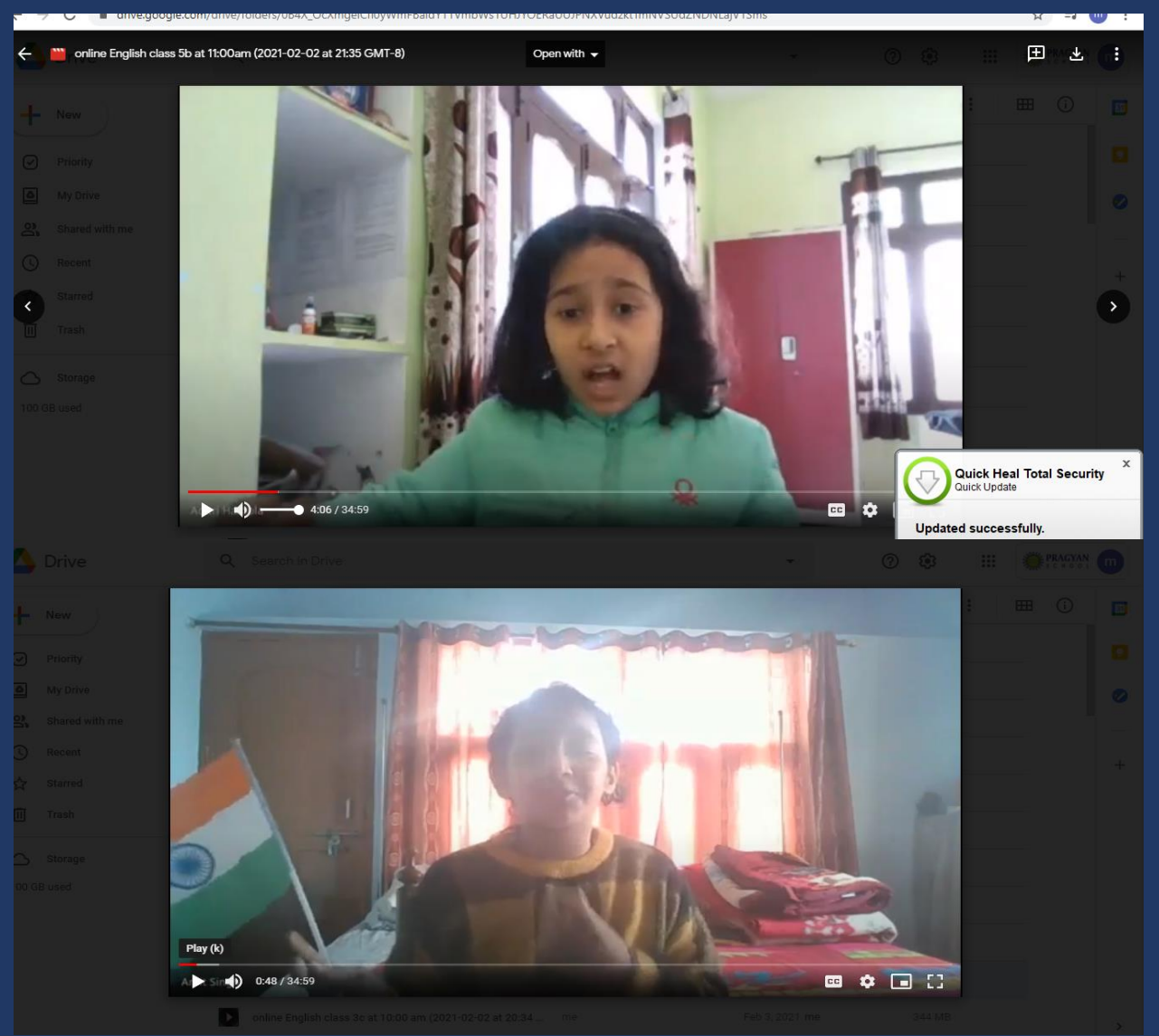
Students of class 4 enjoyed the activity based on the chapter, Time. They made timelines of their favourite personalities.

**L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?**

**Germination:**

- The process of growth of the embryo plant inside the seed is known as germination.
- Seeds require the right amount of water, oxygen, sunlight and temperature for germination.
- As the embryo starts to develop, the seed coat breaks open and a root or radicle emerges.
- The radicle is followed by the shoot or plumule, which gives rise to the leaves and stem.

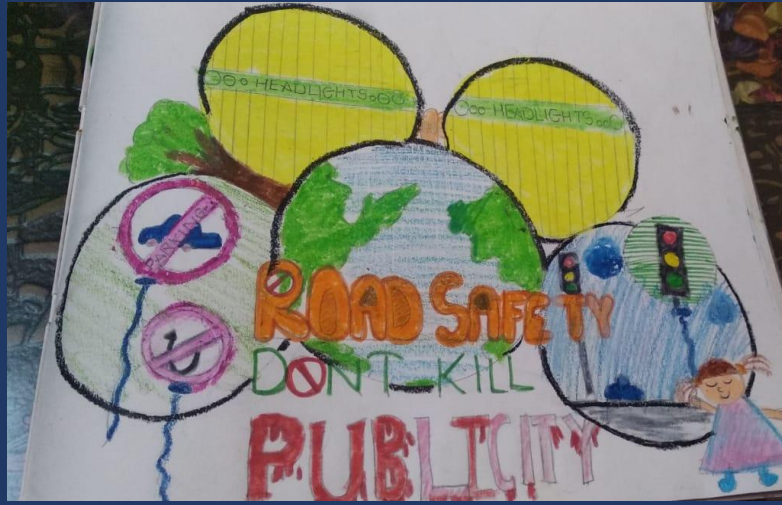

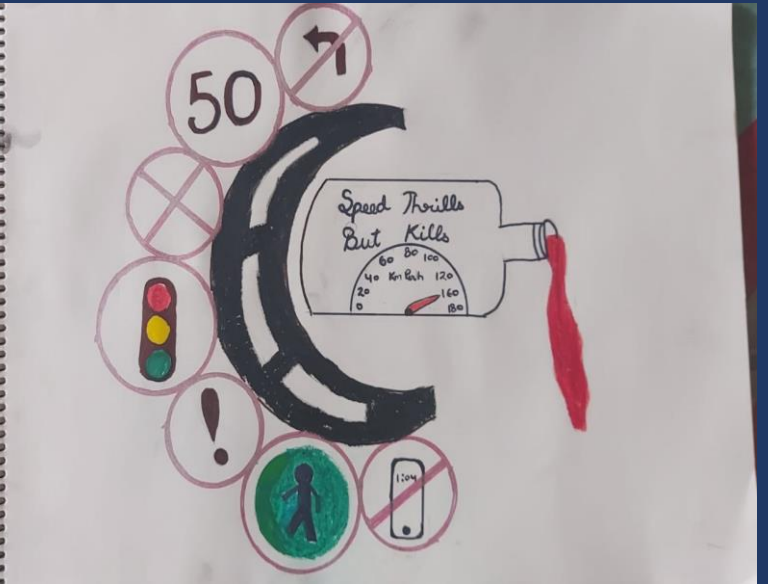
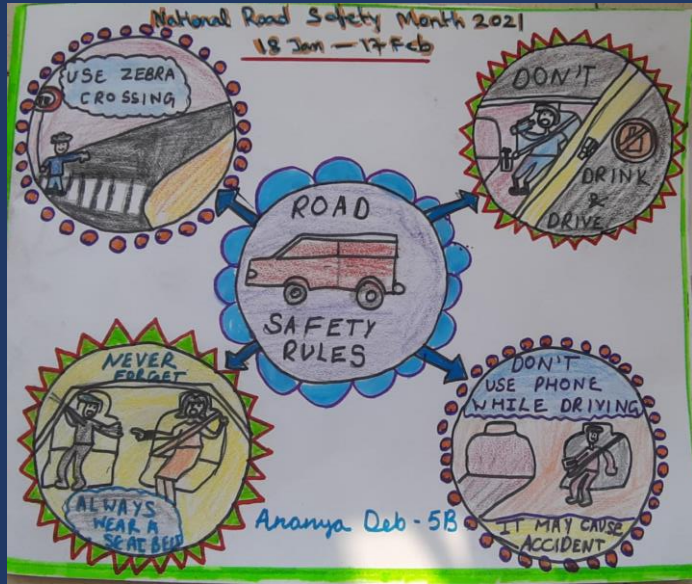
# Math ACTIVITY

Activities give students a chance to learn with creativity. Students of class 5 enjoyed the Analog-digital clock activity. They made a working model of a digital clock. .



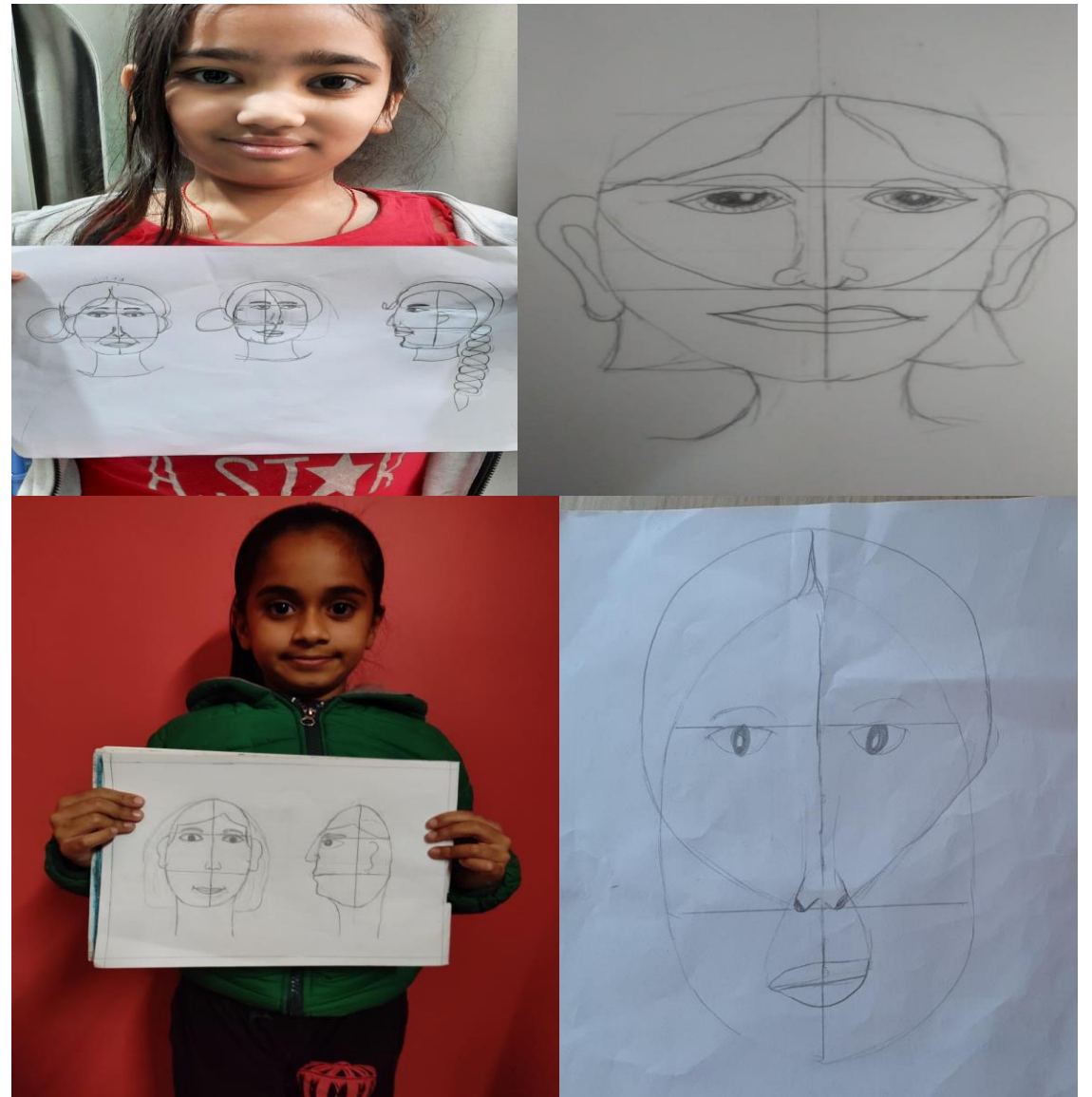


Students of classes 5 A and 5B made beautiful rangolis on, 'Road Safety.' They showed signs and traffic rules related to road safety through their rangolis.
