NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter **W** was introduced to the children with the help of flashcards. They also did Jolly phonics song of letter **W** which they enjoyed. Students did sandpaper tracing and worksheets related to the letter in their workbook.

MATHS

This week the concept of 0 was introduced and children also learnt to write and read number 10 using blocks and they also did worksheets related to the number. Children did counting using blocks and different objects.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'ठ' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'ठ' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, students were introduced to plants and their parts in the class. Students participated in class discussion about how plants grow and also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



The letter 'u' was introduced to the students using flashcards along with its Jolly phonics sound. The students also revised the "at" and "ap" family words and completed a worksheet related to the letter 'u'.

HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan ष. To make learning more engaging, students were encouraged to colour pictures beginning with vyanjan ष. This helped them associate visual creativity with language learning.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week, students learned about community helpers and completed a worksheet by colouring it. The facilitator explained the roles of helpers like teachers and doctors, and the students eagerly shared their own experiences. It was a fun and engaging way to share the importance of community helpers in our daily life.



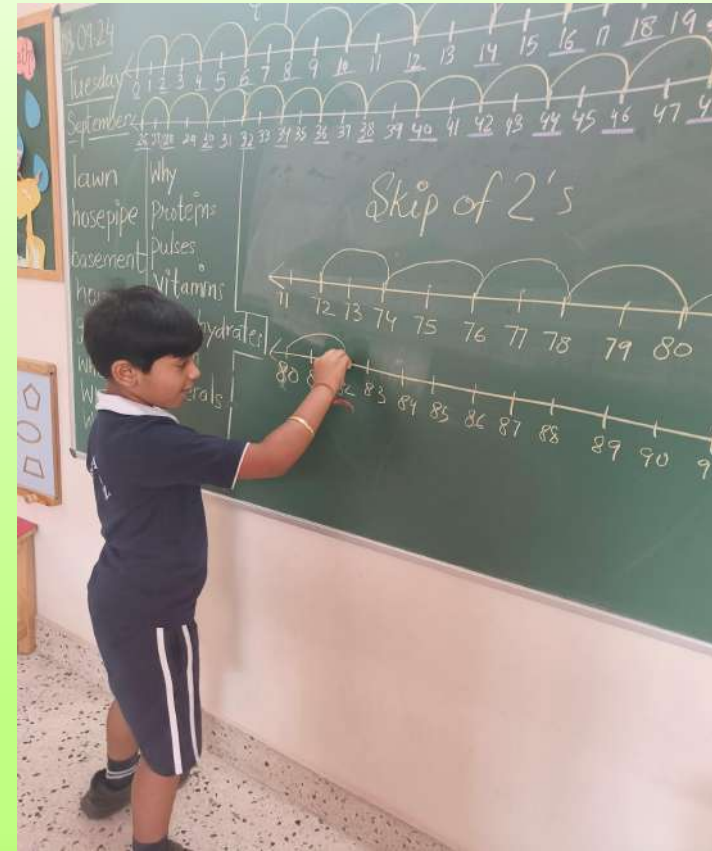


ENGLISH

During this week students did revision of sight words through an activity. They read the passage 'Theo the thief' in their workbook and did questions and answers related to it.

MATHS

During this week students did skip counting by 2' through a number line. They also did counting from 160-180, before and after numbers (160-180) in their workbooks.

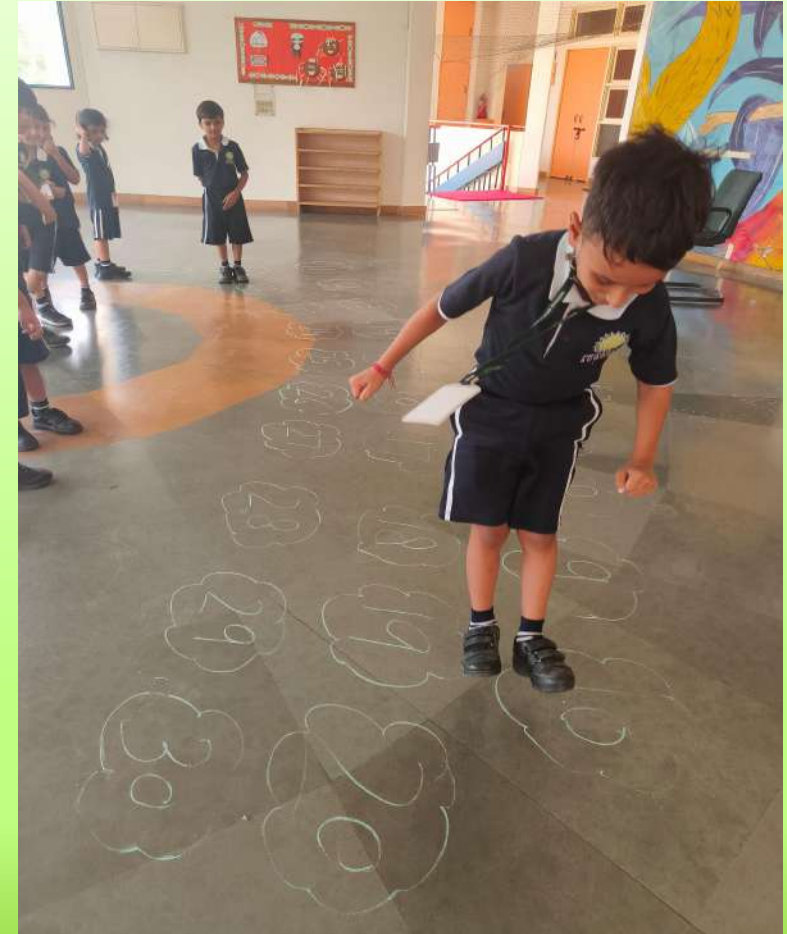
HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

This week students explored family words like, cat, mat, fat, rat etc. through various activities. They enjoyed sorting words and playing matching games. These fun exercises helped to improve their reading skills while having a great time. They also enjoyed matching vyanjans with related pictures.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During hands-on activity students did skip counting of 2's through an activity. They had to skip and jump on the number that is in skip of 2's. Skip counting encourages logical thinking and problem-solving as children figure out the pattern and predict the next numbers in the sequence.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: CLAY MODELING

As part of Inter class activity students of Nursery , KG and UKG participated in a clay modeling activity that was conducted on 4th September, 2024. Clay modeling is important for students because it fosters creativity and hands-on learning. Students of the nursery showed their creativity as they crafted pineapples from clay, applying skills learned in regular classes.

Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten children created a vibrant garden scene through clay modeling, featuring a butterfly, flowers, a caterpillar, and other elements. Certificates of merit will soon be honored for their tidy and organized creations, celebrating their fine motor skills and artistic growth in a fun and interactive way.

INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: CLAY MODELING



SKILL BASED LEARNING

Kindergarten students explored this week some of the gardening tools like pruners, a teeth rake, hedge shears, a scraper, and a weeding tool. They learned each tool's function and had a chance to use them. This activity helped them develop fine motor skills, understand teamwork, and appreciate the care needed in gardening.





This week in English children had their verbal revision of describing words. They revisited the poem and key vocabulary for the month, reinforcing their learning. To enhance their learning, the teacher engaged the students with oral questions to assess their comprehension. Along with it they also did some practice work in their notebook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

In the EVS class children had their verbal revision of the chapters taught. They were also introduced to the Chapter: Food, where they got to know about the importance of eating food. Along with it they did some notebook work. Children also enjoyed the activity where they drew a picture of their favourite community helper and spoke a few lines about the same.





Students of class 2 were introduced to different types of lines like vertical, horizontal, diagonal, wavy etc. They revised 2D shapes, learnt their spellings and did the exercise based on the same in their workbook. They learnt about different 3D shapes and understood the concept of faces, edges and vertices followed by practicing questions of the same on the blackboard. They also revised subtraction with regrouping and practiced doing word problems of Multiplication in their notebooks.

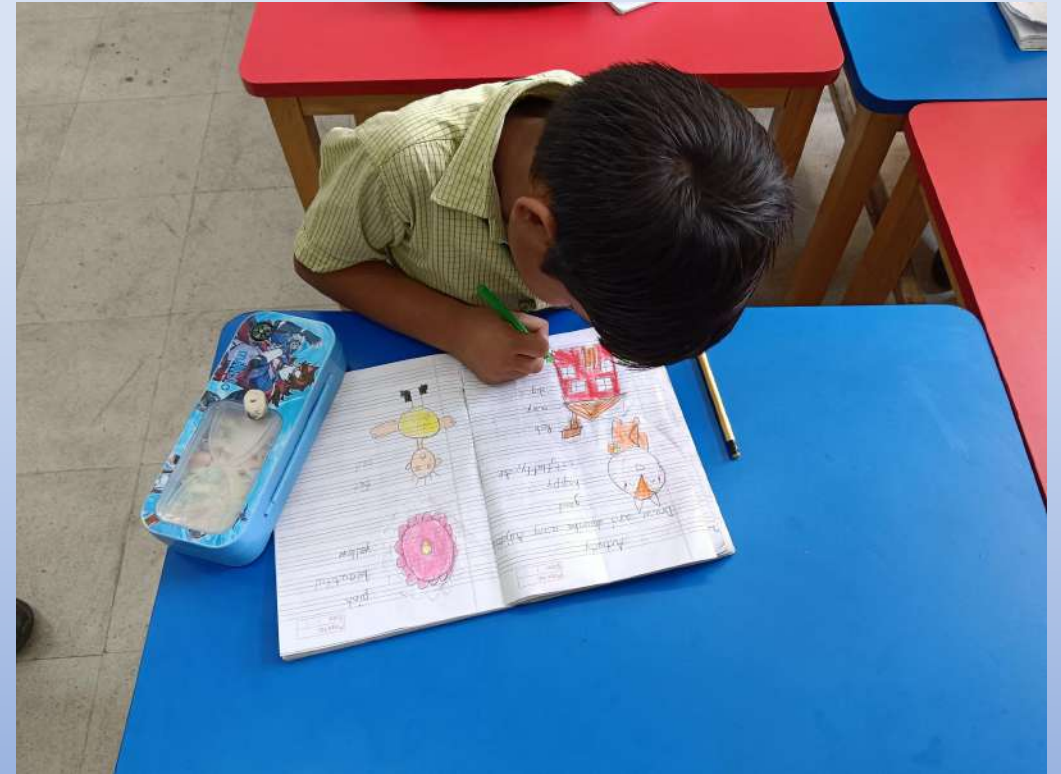
हिन्दी

Continuing with the concept of describing words, the children of class 2 participated in an art-integrated activity (AIL). They were asked to draw pictures and describe them in one word using adjectives. The children approached this activity with great enthusiasm, which further enhanced their understanding of describing words.





In the beginning of the month students were introduced with some new words during their EVS class. They also read the chapter - 'Clothes' and illustrated the diagrams of cotton and woollen clothes of their choice. Revision of the chapter - 'Work & Play ' was also done during the regular periods.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Introducing children to music during early development aids in their understanding of sounds and word meanings. Building on their previous work with the birthday song, the children were taught the verse (antra) of the song, which they learned with great enthusiasm.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Landscape painting, also known as landscape art, is the depiction in painting of natural scenery such as mountains, valleys, rivers, trees, and forests, especially where the main subject is a wide view. Grade 2 students have done landscape drawing in their art file. Students of grade 1 have done the leaf art in their art file.

COMPUTER(1&2)



Students of class 1 were introduced to Tux Typing. They learned how to open Tux Typing Software. They enjoyed Fish Cascade Activity of Tux Typing.

Students of class 2 were introduced to Tux Paint. They learned how to use paint brush, fill color and eraser tools. They made chess board in Tux Paint.

VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)



Music makes our soul happy. Children of class 2 enjoyed learning and singing the welcome song 'Saanson ki Sargam bole Suswagatam'. Class 1 enjoyed singing the song 'Aare badal kale badal'.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed doing yoga, Obstacle training and regular exercises. Navigating through an obstacle course builds strength and improves body maps. Pressure to the joints and muscles improves awareness of where your limbs are so that you can be more coordinated in your movements and not bump into things.



VALUE EDUCATION

Students of grade 1 & 2 had a class discussion on the importance of respecting others. The teacher discussed how it feels to be respected and how it feels when somebody speaks to you politely. The kids also watched a PPT and understood the meaning and importance of respecting others.

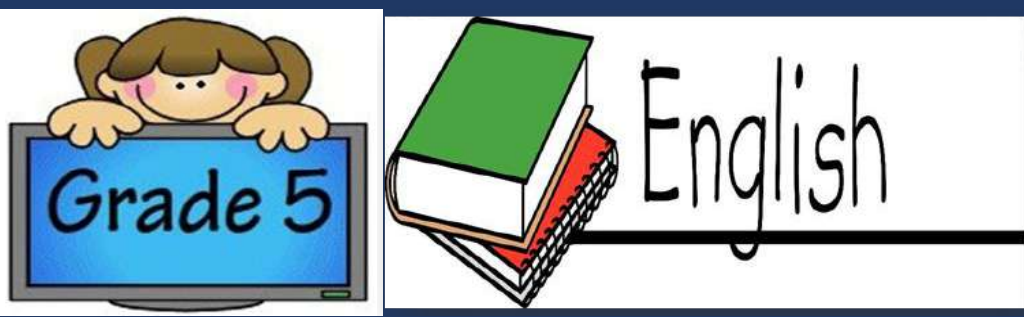




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
