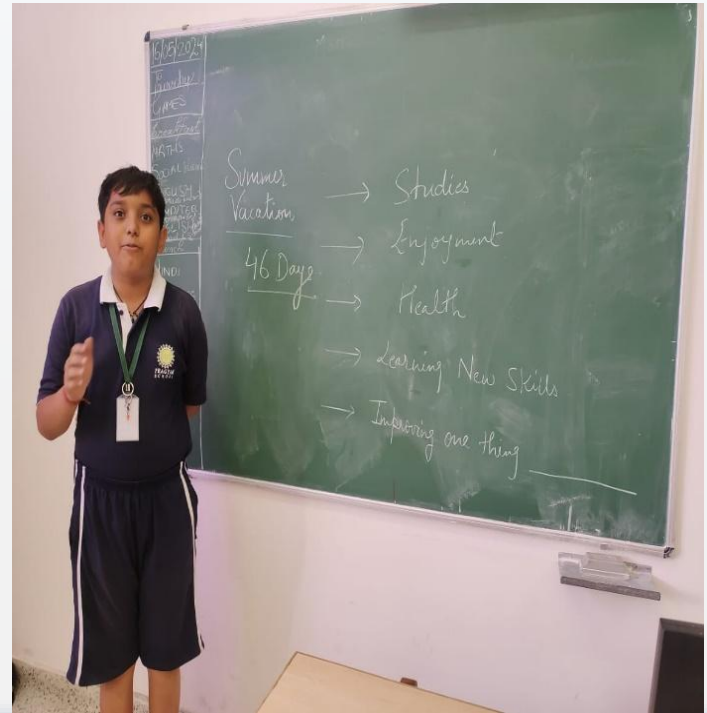
WORKSHOP IX-XII
