Craft – Students enjoyed doing the craft work of underwater scene.

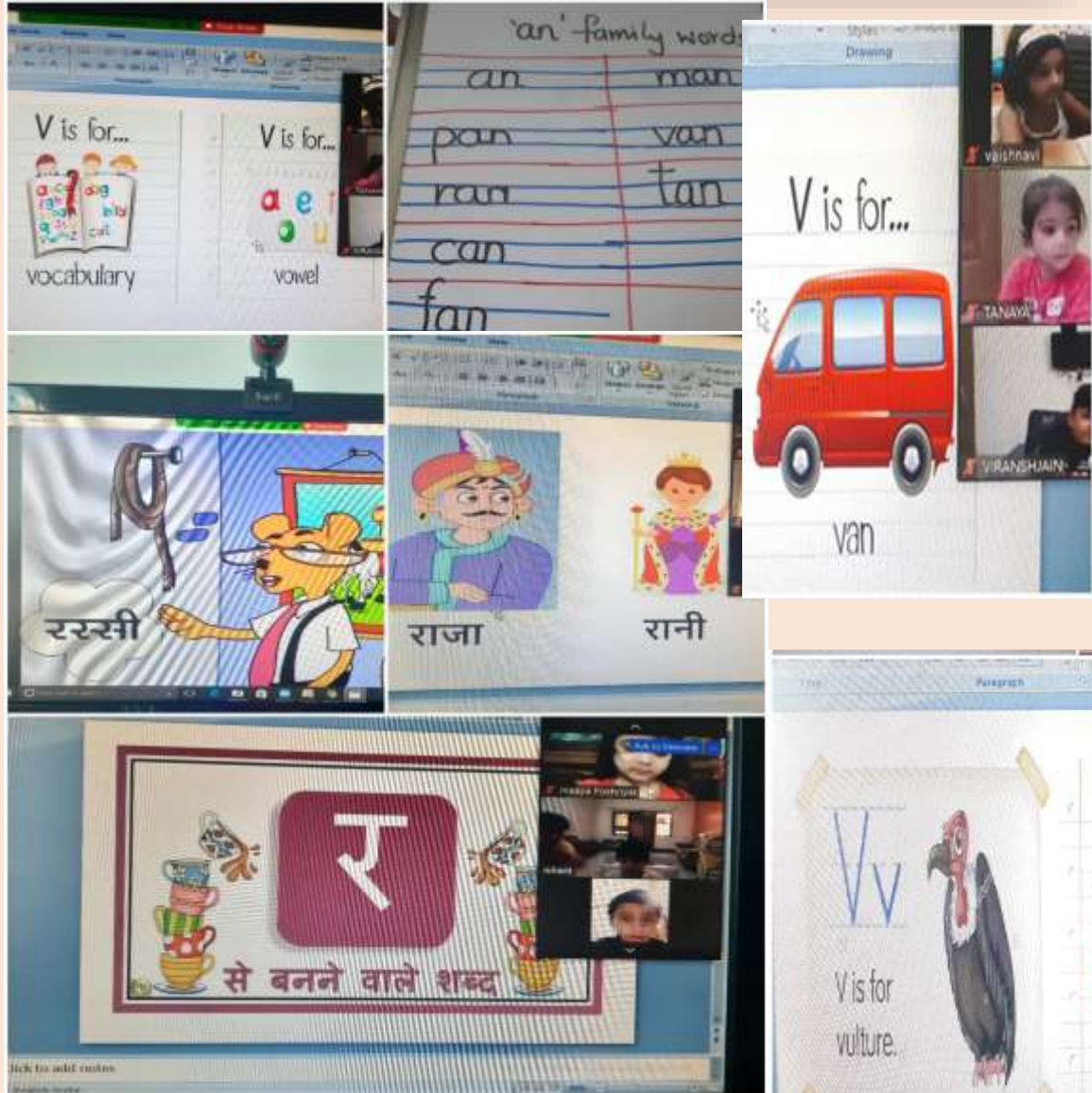
Dance - Students practiced the ‘Dandiya dance’.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

With the ongoing SA1 assessment cycle, students of grade 5 successfully completed their EVS Recapitulation assessment this week. Along with this, the students were also introduced to the world of history with the introduction of L-9: Indian heritage and Culture. The significance of monuments in our country was discussed in detail. Detailed discussion on various monuments like Qutab Minar, Humayun's Tomb, Fatehpur Sikri, Konark Temple and Taj Mahal was done with respect to its location, origin and styles of architecture.

SUN TEMPLE OF KONARK

- The Sun Temple, situated in the eastern state of Odisha.
- It is constructed as a chariot with seven horses (symbolising the seven days of the week) and twelve pairs of wheels (symbolising the twelve months of the year), which carry the sun god, Surya, across the heavens.
- The temple was built by King Narasimhadev (1238-1264 ce) of the Eastern Ganga Dynasty to celebrate a military victory.
- UNESCO has declared this temple a World Heritage Site.



5C Online EVS Class (2021-09-30 at 22:12 GMT-7)

TAJ MAHAL

- Built on the banks of River Yamuna in Agra, the Taj Mahal was constructed between 1631 and 1653.
- A World Heritage Site today, it was built by Shah Jahan in loving memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal.
- This white marble wonder has a central dome that is 73 metres high.
- The structure combines the Persian, Indian, Islamic and Turkish styles of architecture.



FATEHPUR SIKRI & PARLIAMENT HOUSE

- Built in the sixteenth century by Emperor Akbar, Fatehpur Sikri (the City of Victory), is a complex of monuments and temples. It also has one of the largest mosques in India, the Jami Masjid.
- The Parliament House in New Delhi opened in 1927. It is a circular structure and has 144 pillars and broad corridors. The world's largest democracy functions from this building.

POSHAN MAAH CELEBRATION

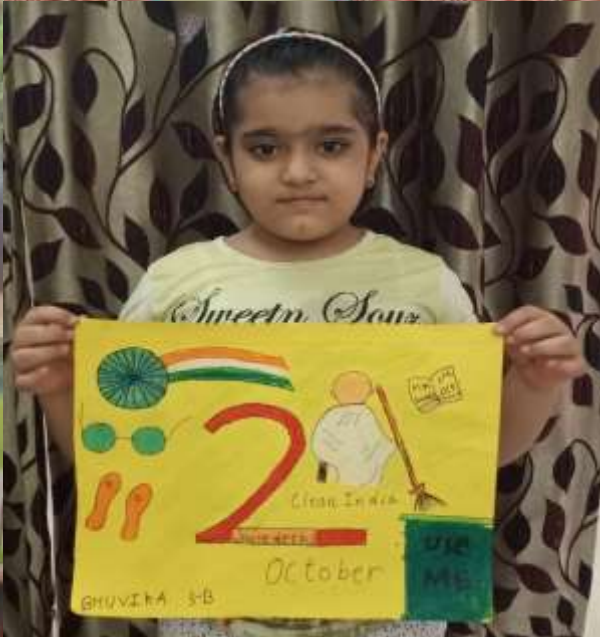
