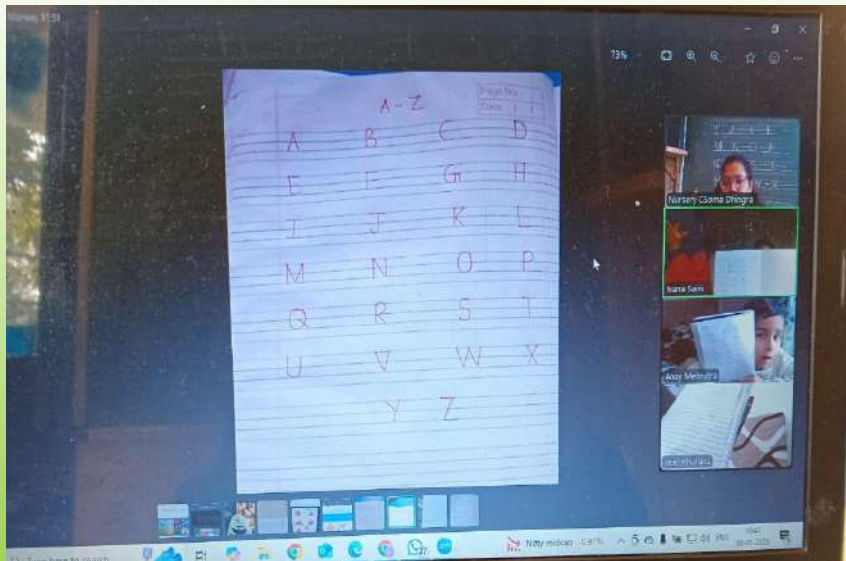

NURSERY



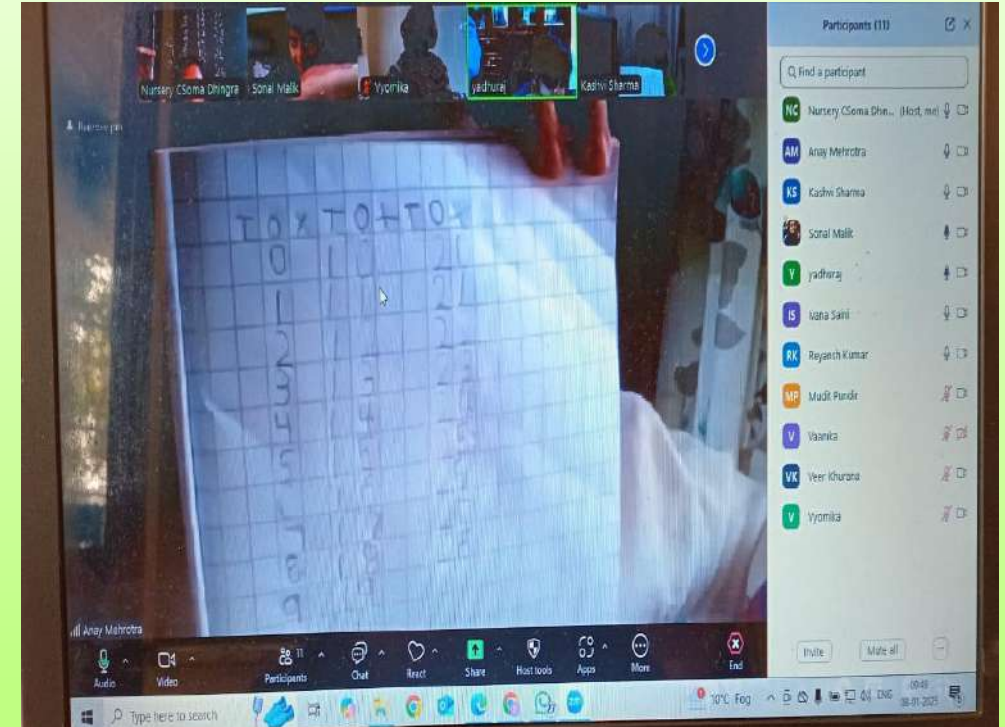
ENGLISH

This week in EASP, nursery students energized their bodies with exciting online sessions, exploring general exercises and dynamic warm-ups, fostering physical growth and coordination.



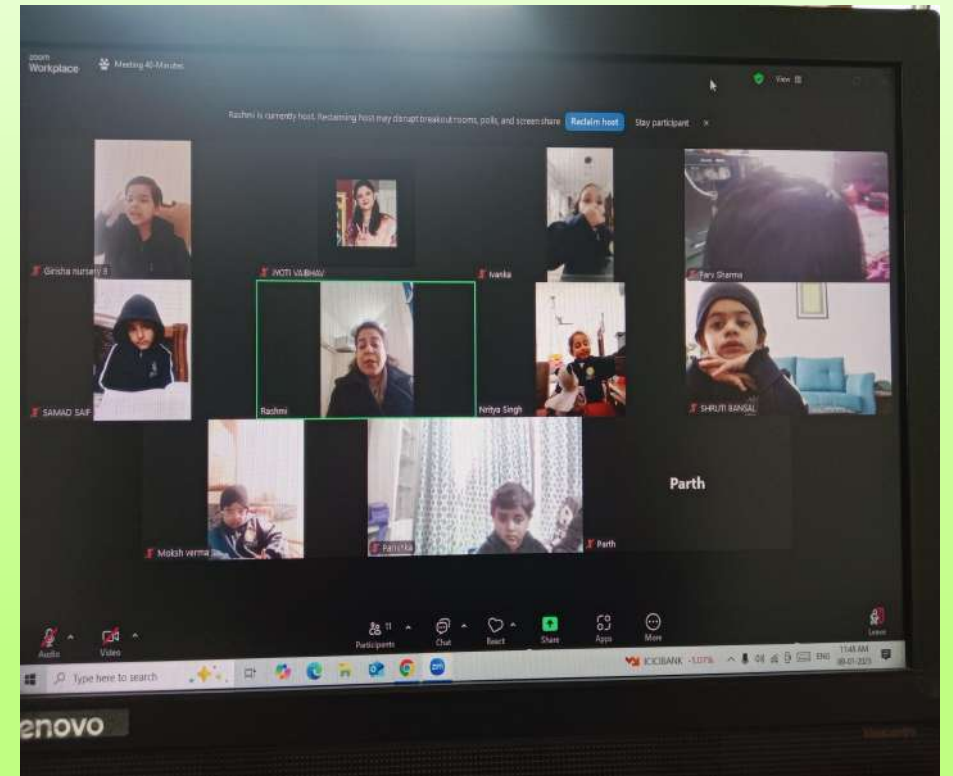
MUSIC

READING SCHEME

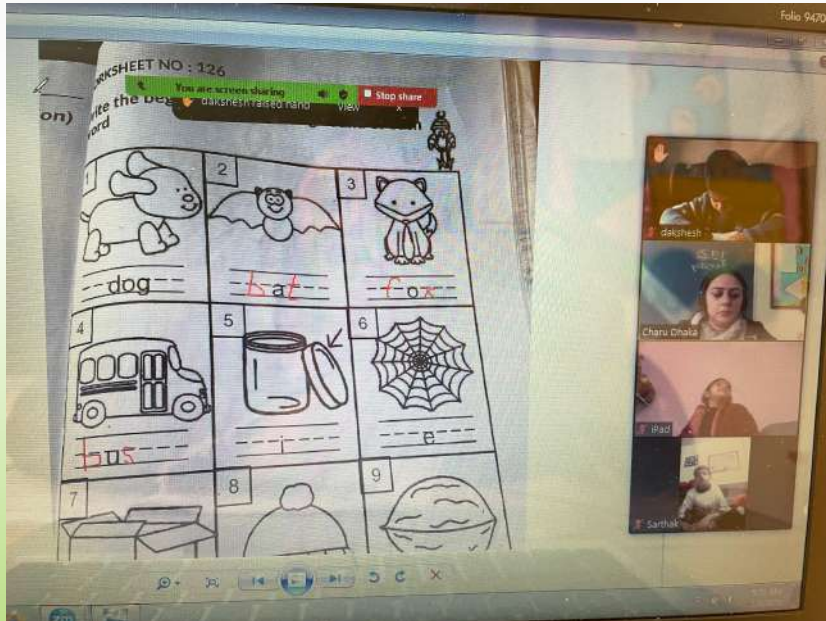

KINDERGARTEN

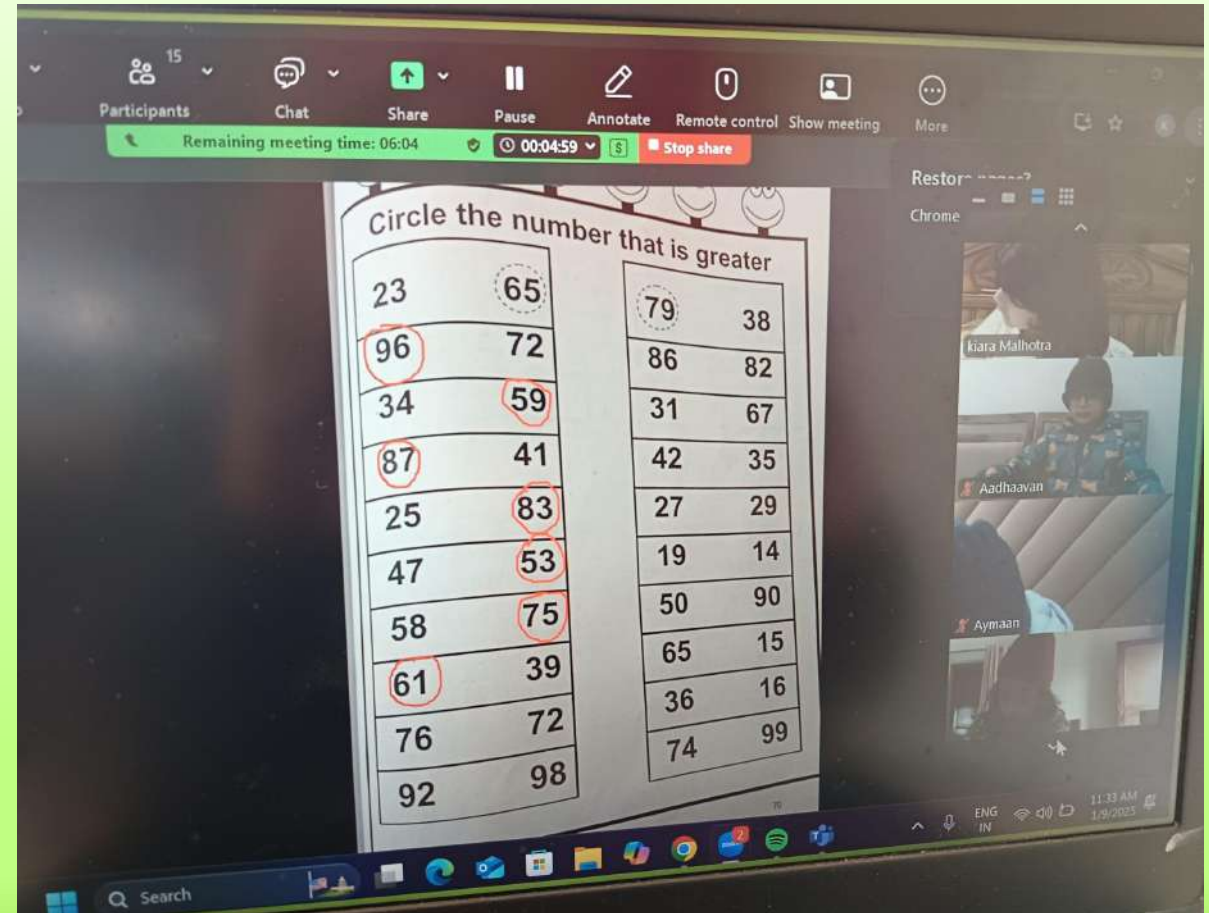
ENGLISH

This week, students revised all the family-related words taught so far. They also completed a worksheet related to these words.



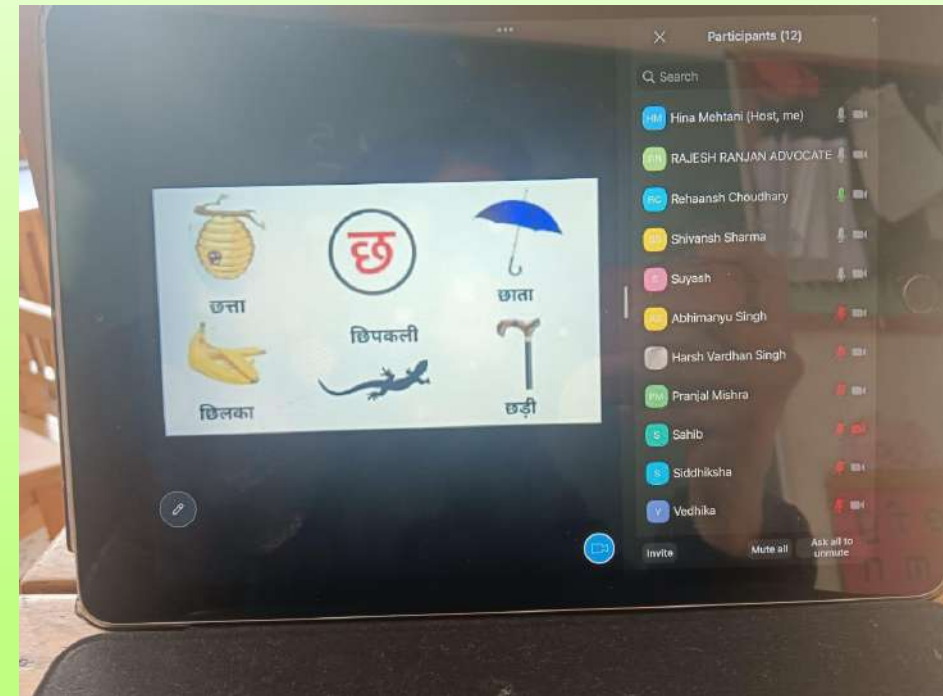
MATHS

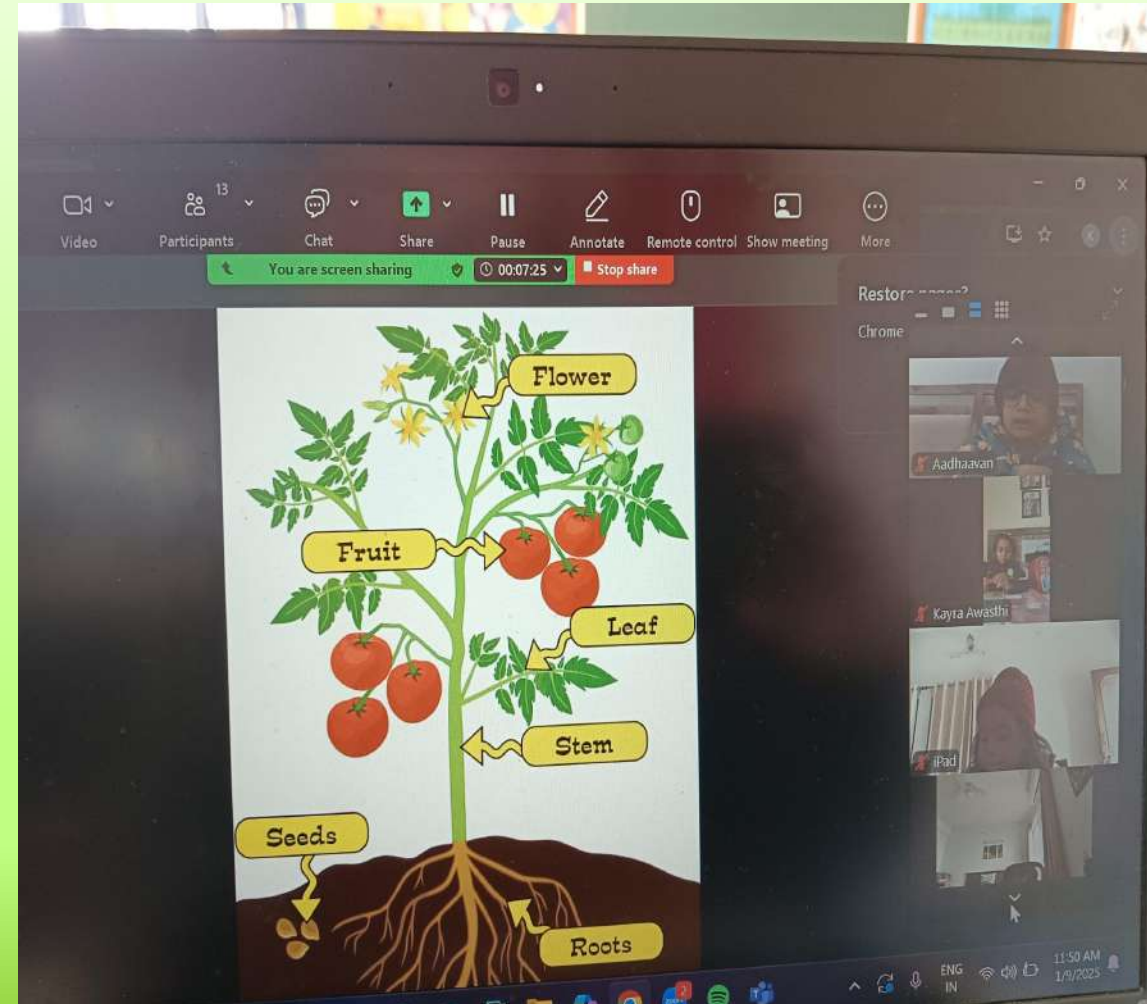
HINDI

CRAFT

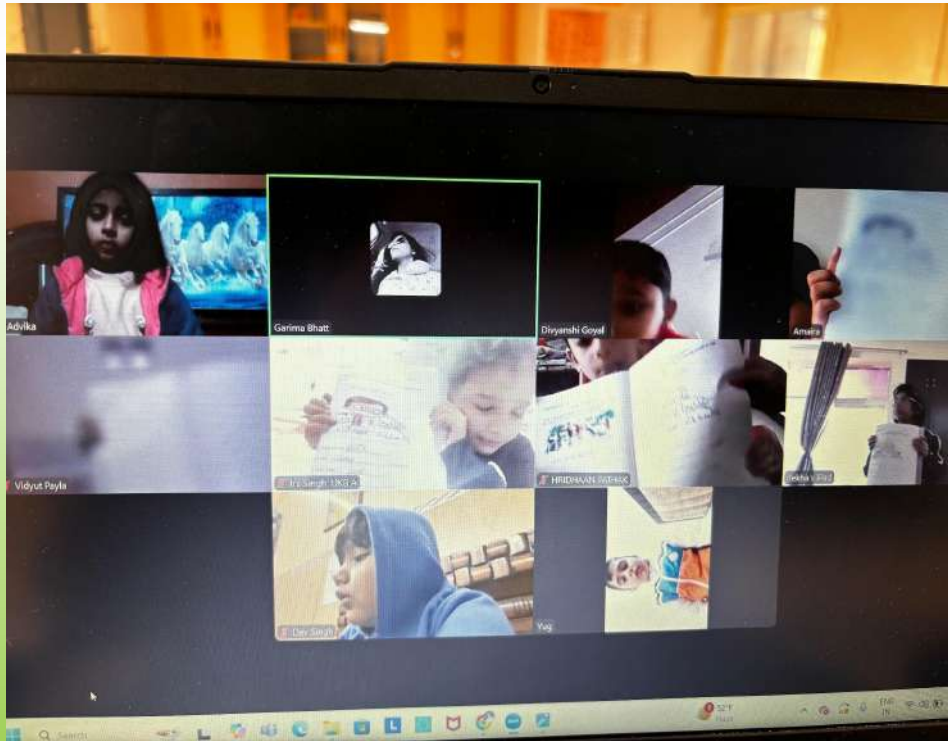

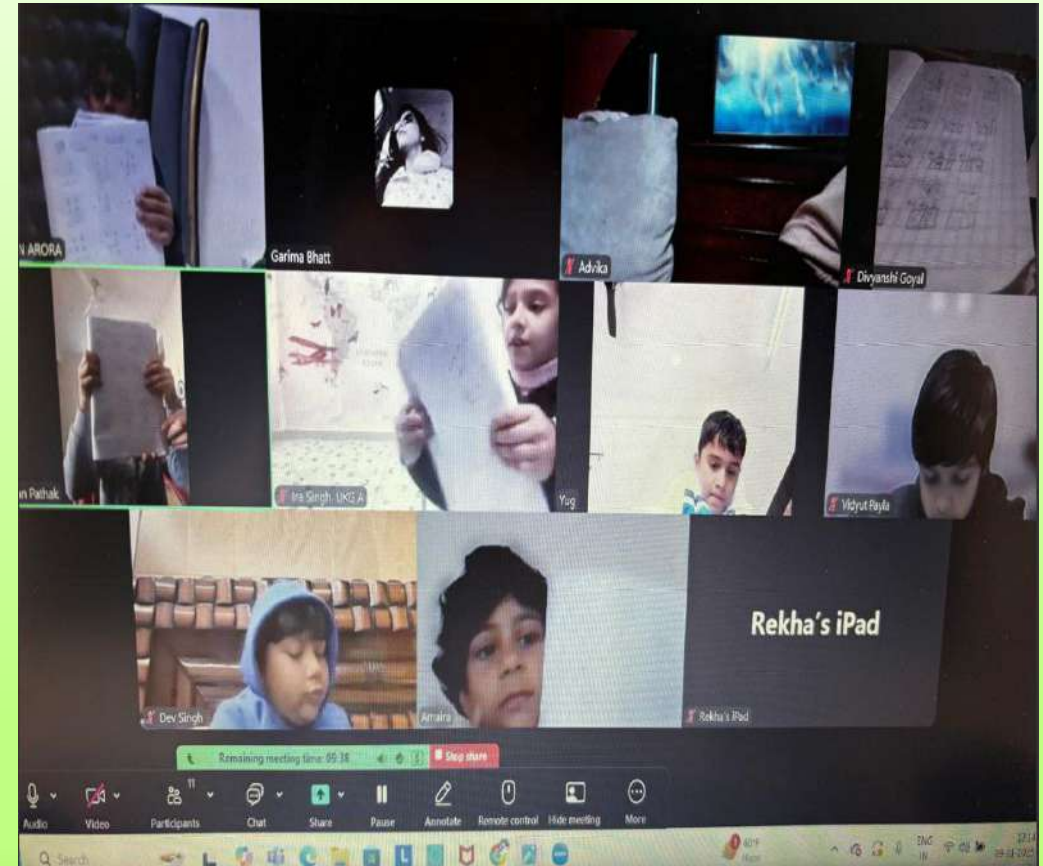
ENGLISH

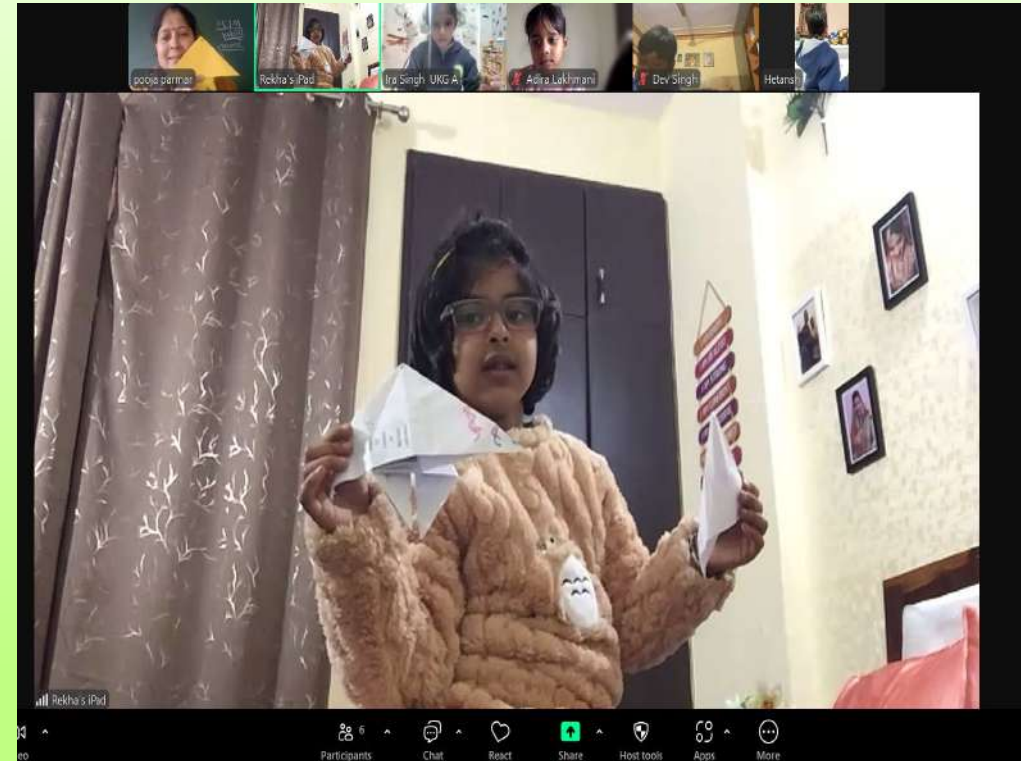
GENERAL AWARENESS

This week, students of UKG got the opportunity to showcase their creativity by making fish. This activity helped to reflect their imagination, hand eye coordination and fine motor skills.





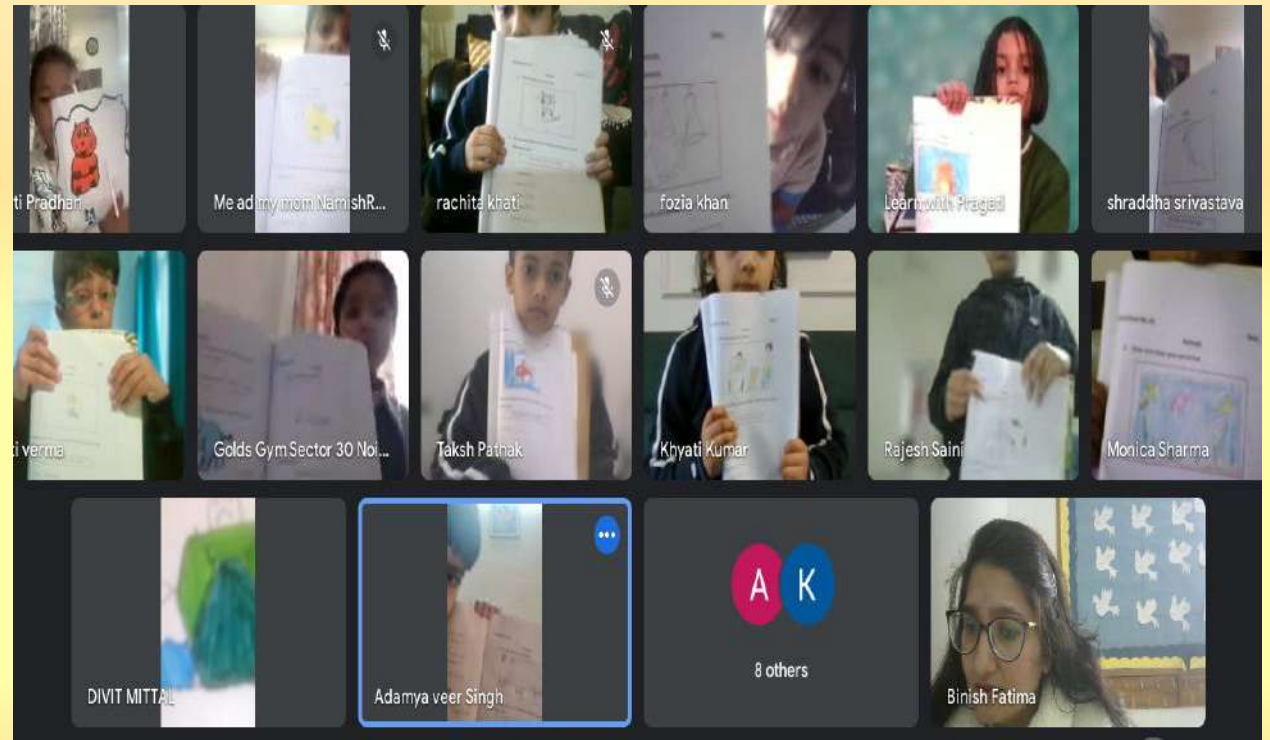

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



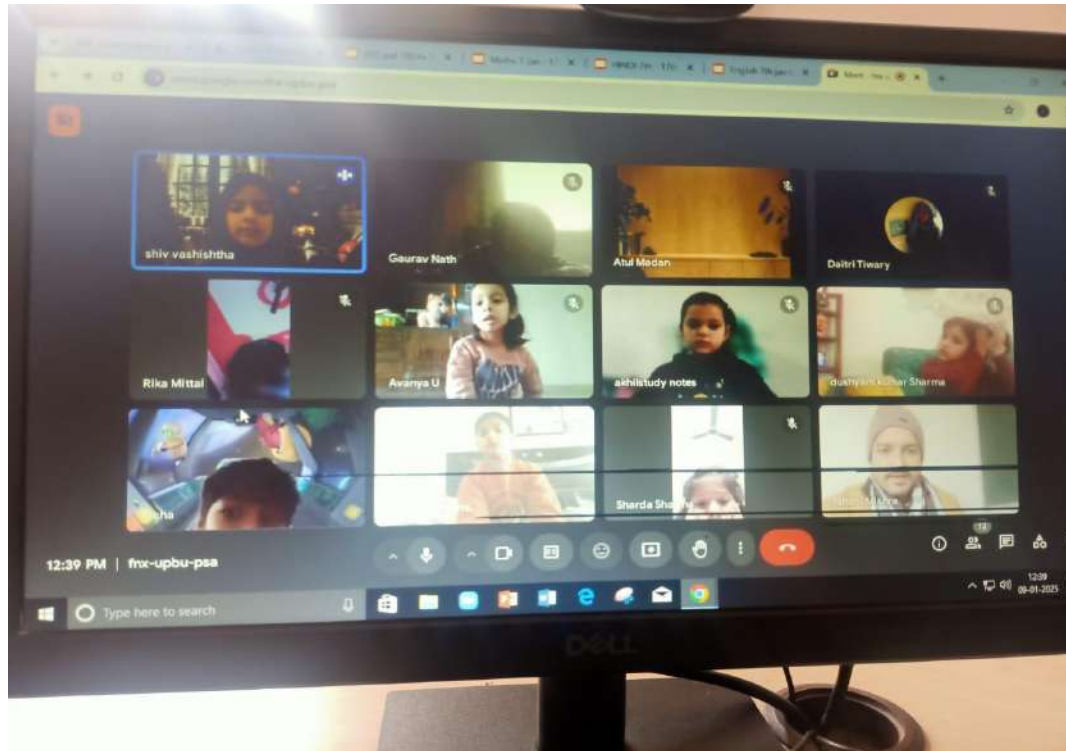

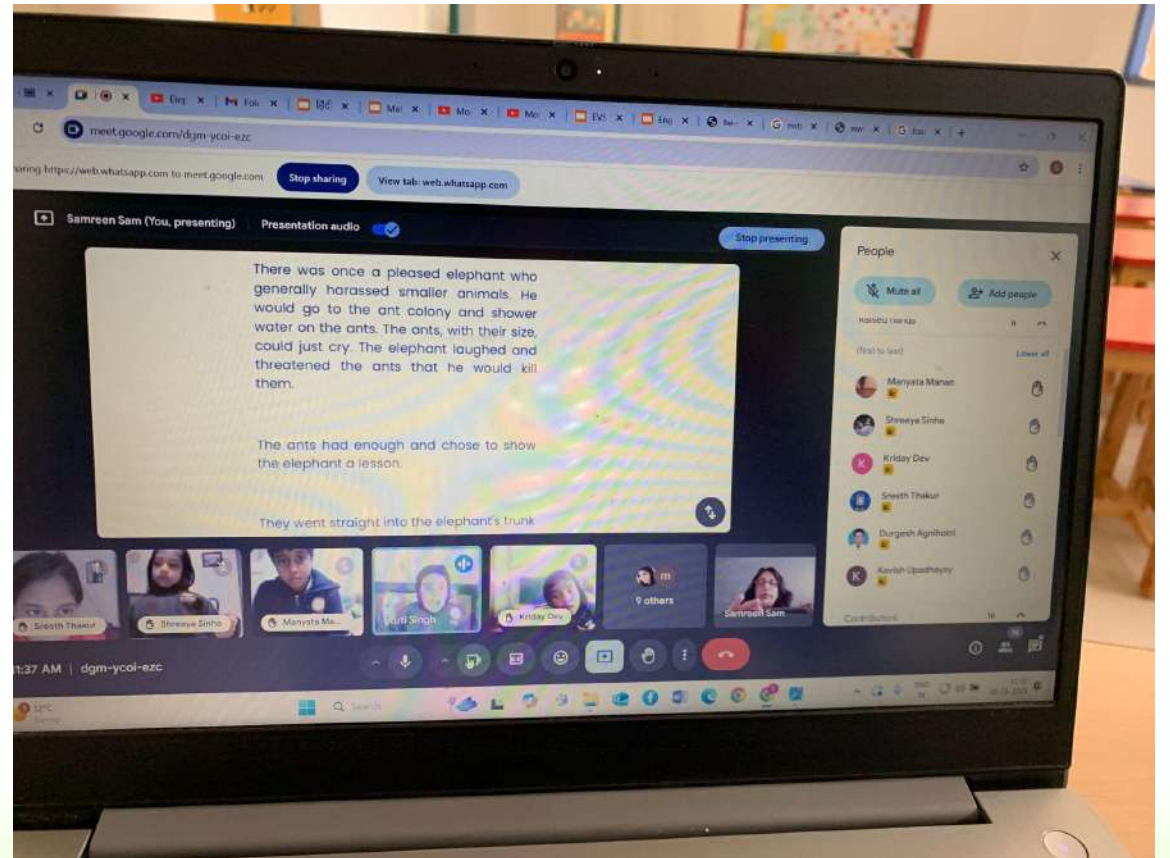
PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

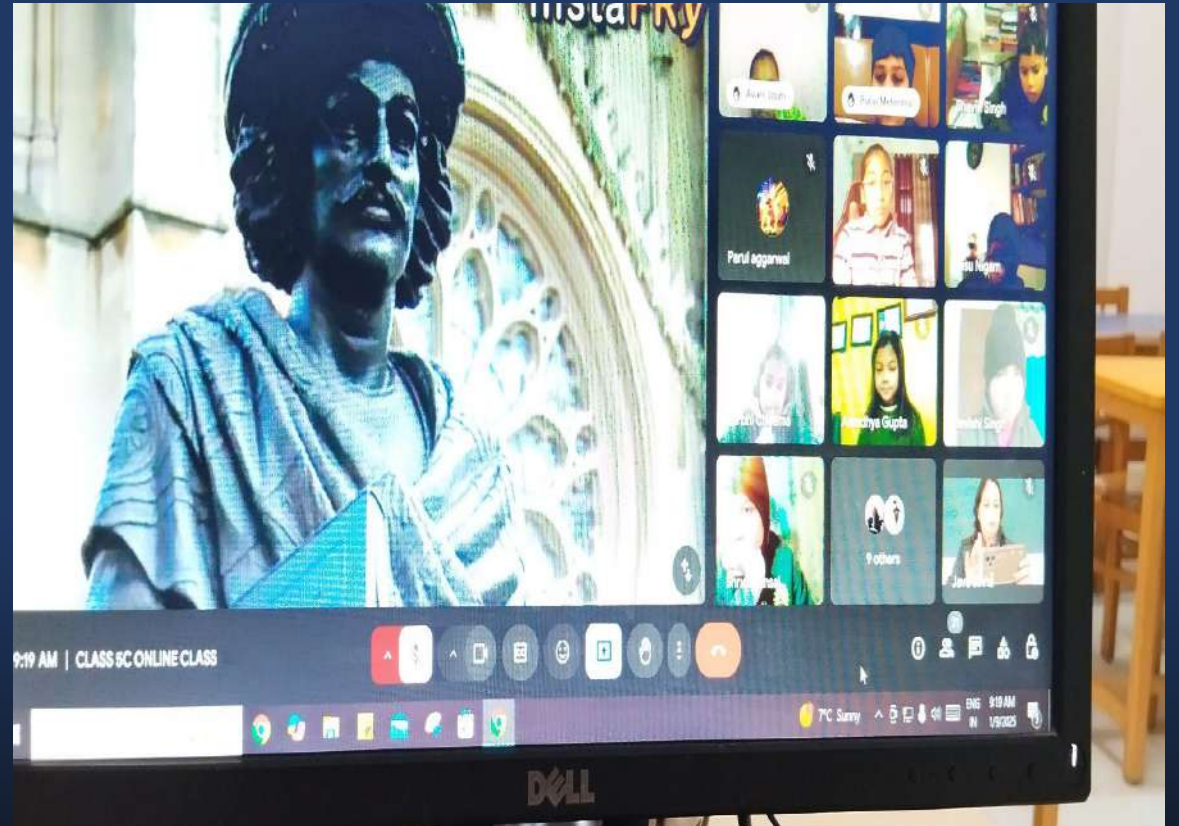

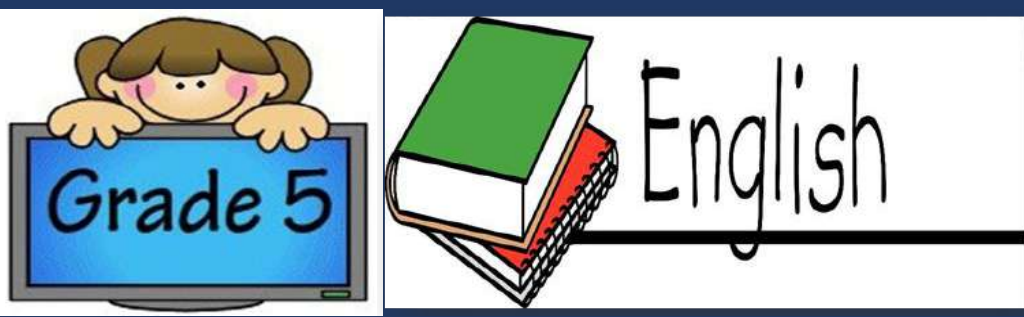




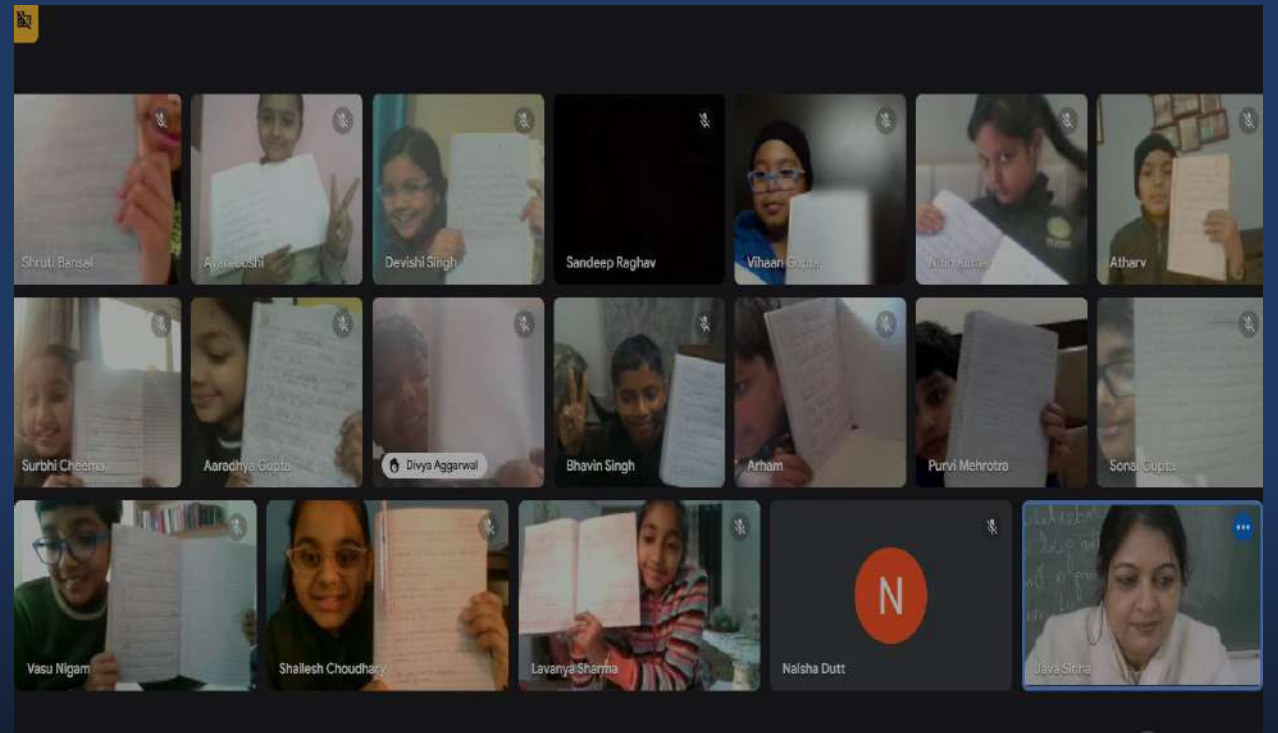
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
