NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week, students learned about Letter C, its sound, and writing practice. Engaging worksheets made learning fun. They also revised previous letters and reinforced their knowledge with Jadui Pitara. Students showed enthusiasm and confidence in recognizing and writing letters. The interactive approach helped solidify their understanding.

MATHS

This week, students introduced and learned number 16, practicing writing and completing worksheets related to it. Musical chair activity also conducted to reinforce previous numbers, while outside-inside concept was introduced with an engaging worksheet and activities. Students showed enthusiasm and progress in numeracy and spatial awareness.



HINDI

This week, Nursery students learned the letter 'प'. They engaged in word-finding activities, identifying words starting with 'प'. The class also revised previous letters, reinforcing their understanding. Students demonstrated enthusiasm and participation, showcasing progress in phonetics.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Community helpers make a difference, one helping hand at a time. Nursery students explored community helpers, learning about their roles and contributions. Through interactive activities and colouring worksheets, students developed awareness and appreciation, fostering social awareness and gratitude. They enthusiastically identified helpers and connected learning to real-life experiences.



VALUE BASED STORY

Students were told the story 'Grandma's Cloth Bag', highlighting the importance of eco-friendly practices. They learned about the harmful effects of plastic bags and the benefits of cloth bags. Students understood the moral of keeping the Earth clean and safe. This value-based story encouraged students to adopt sustainable habits and reduce plastic use.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Children learned en family words such as pen, den, and men through fun reading and writing activities. They also revised all the letters of the alphabet to strengthen their phonetic awareness and improve their writing skills.

MATHS

Children practiced descending order by arranging numbers from the largest to the smallest using a variety of hands-on activities and worksheet exercises. They engaged in fun tasks such as ordering number cards to visually understand how numbers decrease in value.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Children learned about community helpers, their important roles in our society, and why we need and appreciate them. Through discussions, they developed a sense of gratitude towards people who help us every day. Children also enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic, making the learning experience fun and meaningful.



DANCE

The children of Kindergarten enthusiastically practiced their steps for the upcoming class assembly. They enjoyed learning the movements and performing together with great energy and coordination.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

This week, during the hands-on activity, the children enjoyed engaging learning experiences in both English and Hindi. In English, they explored 'e' sound words through colourful flashcards. They matched the pictures with the correct letters and created words with enthusiasm. In Hindi, they learned two-letter words using flashcards. The teacher called out the words, and the children eagerly picked the correct flashcards to form the words.



SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

Assemblies foster a sense of community, social skills, and build confidence and public speaking abilities. With an aim to create, nurture and serve as platforms for holistic development, a special assembly was held on 7th November, 2025 on the theme Friendship by the students of Kindergarten. The little ones beautifully showcased the value of friendship through delightful dances, melodious songs, heartwarming skits, engaging stories, and cheerful rhymes on the theme. Their confident performances and joyful expressions filled the atmosphere with warmth and happiness, making the assembly a memorable and meaningful experience for everyone.

ENGLISH

This week in English, students were introduced to the long vowel sounds oa and ai. They also completed worksheets related to these sounds. Through this activity, students improved their phonics and pronunciation skills. Their ability to identify and read words with long vowel sounds was enhanced. They also developed better listening, reading, and word recognition skills, which helped in building their vocabulary and overall language understanding.

MATHS

This week in Maths, students did counting from 201 to 250 in their notebooks and books. They improved their number writing and recognition skills. Their understanding of number order was enhanced, and they became more confident and accurate while writing numbers.



HINDI

This week in Hindi, students practiced ई की मात्रा in worksheets and in notebooks and read आ, इ and ई मात्रा वाले शब्द . The revision of reading, writing, and pronunciation skills improved, their मात्रा recognition and vocabulary building.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Students were introduced to the topic Transport. They discussed different means of transport and shared their knowledge about them. Through colouring activity, students segregated the pictures of different modes of transport and improved their speaking and listening skills.



JADUI PITARA

This week in Jadui Pitara, students practiced the concept of These and Those, recapitulation was done of ई की मात्रा in Hindi, exercises on addition, and transport activity in General Awareness. These activities improved their thinking, observation, and communication skills and enhanced their concept understanding and confidence in learning.



CLASS ASSEMBLY (UKG A&B)

This week, the class assembly was conducted on 3rd and 4th November, 2025 respectively by UKG A and UKG B on the topic “Food and Festivals.” Students showcased their talents through rhymes, skit, science demonstration, dance, and music. The assembly helped develop their knowledge about different festivals and foods and they learned to perform confidently on stage with teamwork and creativity.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During hands-on activity, students participated in various activities related to transport, which improved their observation and communication skills. Recapitulation of numbers from 201 - 250, was conducted through a play way method which enhanced their number writing, recognition, and understanding of number order





This week, the students enjoyed reading the story *Who Will Be the King?* and explored its interesting characters. They participated actively during the reading sessions and completed the related book exercises with excitement. As part of the Art Integrated Learning activity, the children wrote four lines on *My Favourite Vegetable* and drew it. They also attempted an unseen passage to enhance their comprehension skills. It was a week filled with fun, learning, and expression.

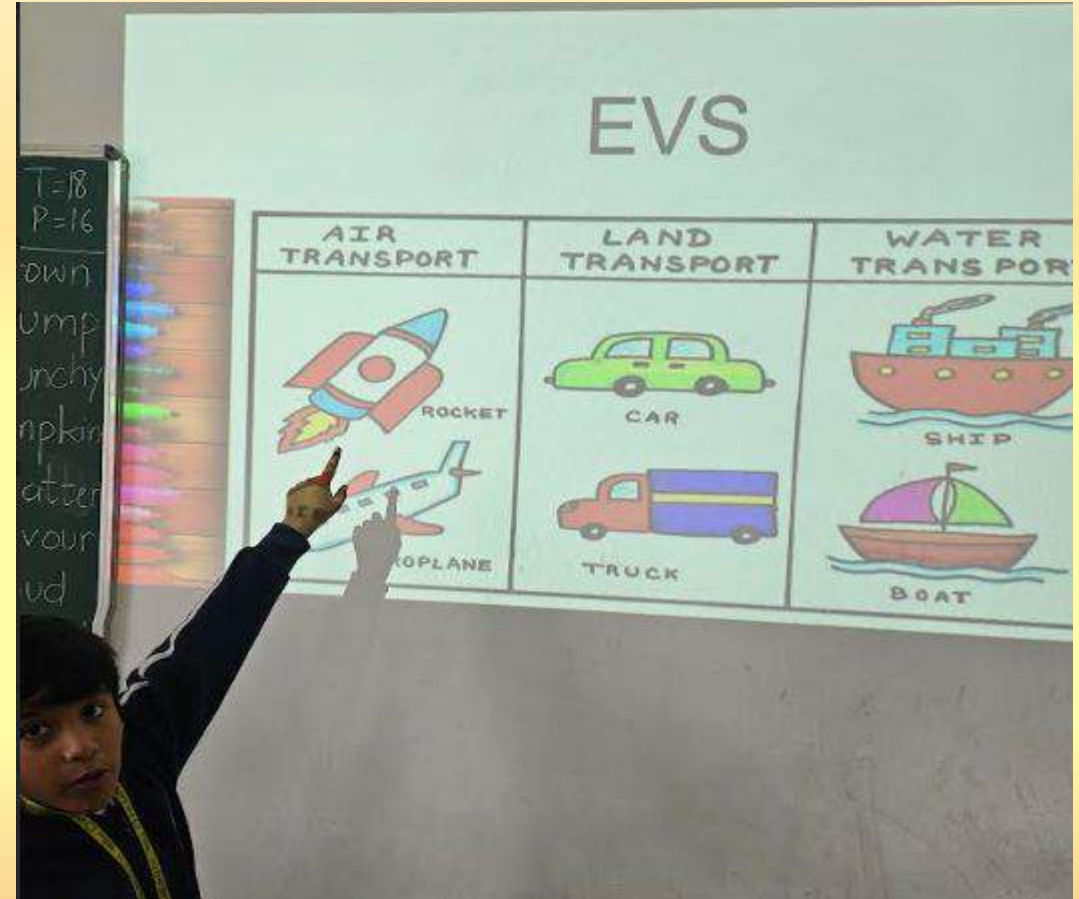




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week, the students explored the chapter Means of Transport and Communication with great enthusiasm. They were introduced to various modes of transport and communication and discussed how these make our lives easier. The children enjoyed reading the lesson and actively participated in the related book exercises.

They also completed notebook work, including fill-in-the-blanks, true or false, and short question answers. To enhance vocabulary, students practiced making sentences orally using the words of the month. It was a week full of learning, interaction, and joyful participation.





Children of Class 1 enjoyed learning skip counting by 10 and the table of 10 with great enthusiasm. They also revised skip counting by 2, 3, 4, and 5, reinforcing their understanding of number patterns through fun-filled classroom activities and games. The students participated eagerly and took delight in reciting the tables aloud, making it a joyful and engaging Math learning experience for all.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह कक्षा 1 के विद्यार्थियों ने हिंदी विषय में 'अं' की मात्रा का परिचय और उसका अभ्यास किया। बच्चों ने 'अं' मात्रा वाले शब्दों को पहचानना, सही ढंग से पढ़ना तथा लिखना बड़े उत्साह के साथ सीखा। कक्षा में माह की कविता का भावपूर्ण पठन कराया गया और उसके कठिन शब्दों की पुनरावृत्ति कराई गई, जिससे बच्चों का शब्द भंडार समृद्ध हुआ।

पाठ पठन के माध्यम से विद्यार्थियों ने अपने पठन कौशल को निखारा और सीखे गए शब्दों से सुंदर वाक्य बनाए। सप्ताह के अंत में रचनात्मक गतिविधि के रूप में बच्चों ने रंग-बिरंगी तितली का चित्र बनाया और उस पर दो-दो वाक्य लिखे। इस गतिविधि ने न केवल भाषा कौशल को सुदृढ़ किया बल्कि बच्चों की कल्पनाशक्ति और चित्रकला के प्रति रुचि को भी प्रोत्साहित किया।

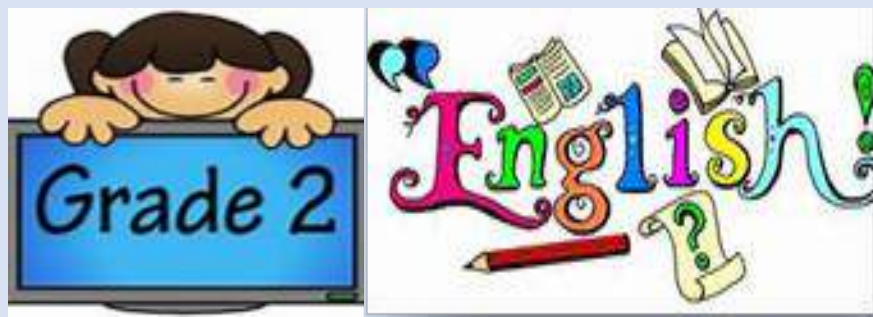




हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह विद्यार्थियों ने “क्रिया” (कार्य बताने वाले शब्द) का अध्ययन किया। इससे उन्होंने सीखा कि क्रिया वे शब्द होते हैं जो किसी कार्य के होने को दर्शाते हैं, जैसे – खाना, पीना, खेलना, दौड़ना, सोना आदि। विद्यार्थियों ने ‘स्वच्छता अपनाओ, बीमारी भगाओ’ पाठ का भी अध्ययन किया और घंटी के कटआउट पर स्वच्छता से संबंधित एक सुंदर नारा लिखा। बच्चों ने स्वच्छता के महत्व को समझते हुए जाना कि स्वच्छता हमारे जीवन का आवश्यक हिस्सा है। उन्होंने यह संदेश दिया कि — कूड़ा हमेशा डस्टबिन में डालना चाहिए, स्वच्छता से स्वास्थ्य अच्छा रहता है, साफ-सुथरा रहना हमारी जिम्मेदारी है और “स्वच्छ भारत, सुंदर भारत” का सपना हमें साकार करना है।





Students of class 2 were introduced to the poem and new words of the month. They practiced verbs in class with some engaging exercises. Additionally they did the related exercises for helping verbs and their uses in sentences. In AIL activity, the students were engaged in drawing a few flowers to help them better understand the uses of the verbs.





This week, our Grade II students have been introduced to a new chapter titled “Communication and Transport.”

Through engaging textbook readings, classroom discussions, and reference videos, students explored how people connect and travel from one place to another. The sessions helped them understand different means of communication and various types of transport including land, water, and air transport.





This week, our young learners of Class II began a new topic in Mathematics — “Division.” Through engaging activities and practical examples, they explored the concept of sharing and grouping equally. The students learned how division helps in distributing objects into equal groups and understood the relation between multiplication and division. The lesson aimed to develop a clear understanding of division while building confidence in solving simple division problems with ease and accuracy.



ART & CRAFT (1&2)



This week, the students of Class I beautifully coloured a rainbow in their Sparkle book, joyfully blending vibrant shades to create a splash of colour and happiness. Meanwhile, the students of Class II showcased their creativity by completing Warli art, drawing and colouring traditional patterns in their Sparkle book. It was a truly creative and delightful art session, filled with imagination and fun.

MATIFIC



“Maths is fun”, students of class 2 practiced mathematical concepts through the technological platform Matific within the school. They were allotted a few activities during their Maths class based on Patterns.

VOCAL MUSIC



This week, during the music class, students were introduced to the beautiful Christmas song “Neele Gagan Par Nikla Ek Taara.” They learned the first stanza with great excitement and enthusiasm. The teacher explained the meaning of the lyrics, helping them understand the spirit of Christmas and the joy it brings. The young singers sang melodiously, filling the classroom with festive cheer and happiness. Their lively participation and joyful voices made the session truly musical and heartwarming.

YOGA



Grade 1 and 2 students participated in a Yoga and Breathing Exercise Session on Friday. The session aimed to help children relax, improve concentration, and develop healthy breathing habits. Students learned and practiced Anulom Vilom Pranayam along with other simple breathing exercises. These activities helped the children experience calmness, focus, and joy while understanding the importance of mindfulness in daily life. Students also received Book Hero from Ms Saira for donating their books to the school library.

DANCE

Dance is the joy of movement and the rhythm of the soul!

This week, the students of Class 1 & 2 stepped into the world of dance with great enthusiasm. They learned a delightful dance sequence and explored some basic jumping techniques. With cheerful smiles and graceful moves, the little dancers expressed themselves freely, turning the classroom into a space filled with energy, rhythm, and happiness.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Students of Classes 1 and 2 enjoyed fun races while learning the basics of football during their games period. They enthusiastically practiced kicking with the inside of the foot, combining play, skill, and teamwork in a joyful way.



CLASS ASSEMBLY (1A)

The students of Class 1 conducted a wonderful assembly on the theme “Safety”. They confidently presented the Poem of the Month – Good Habits and the Hindi poem Bado ka aadar sada hi karna, spreading messages of respect and good manners.

READ & REFLECT

In continuation of last week's learning, the students of Class 2 joyfully revisited the story "The Donkey and the Goat" by answering interesting questions related to it. The activity not only helped strengthen their comprehension skills but also sparked meaningful discussions and laughter in the classroom. The aim was to nurture a love for reading and help every child discover the joy hidden in stories.





Students of Class 3 were introduced to the Poem of the Month titled “My Shadow.” They wrote down the questions and answers from the lesson “Breakfast.” The new lesson “Anna’s Experiment with Weather” was also introduced, along with the explanation of new vocabulary words from the chapter. Additionally, the grammatical concept of using is, am, are, has, have, and had was taught, followed by related written exercises for practice.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of Grade 3 were introduced to the chapter “The Universe and the Solar System.” They learned about the galaxy, constellations, planets, satellites, the Moon, the Earth, and the concepts of rotation and revolution. Through engaging videos and drawing activities, students explored these topics creatively and wrote the new words from the chapter in their notebooks. Questions and answers were also discussed in class to reinforce their understanding.





The students of Grade 4 were introduced to a new set of vocabulary words and the Poem of the Month. They also practiced writing an informal letter, learning how to express their thoughts in a friendly and structured manner.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 4 completed the chapter "Agriculture." They learned about different crop seasons and types of crops grown in India. To make the learning more meaningful, the students visited the school's organic farm, where they observed various crops and understood how they are cultivated. They also did the written work in their notebooks and workbooks, reinforcing the concepts learned in class through hands-on and written activities.





हिन्दी

Students of Class 4 learned to find the HCF by different methods. They practiced LCM in the workbook. They were also introduced to the concept of Coprime numbers. Graph activity was done by students to understand different arrangements of the same numbers.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The Grade 5 students studied the chapter “Advent of British Raj”, where they learnt how the British came to India and gradually took control over the country. They understood the main policies introduced by the British, such as the Subsidiary Alliance System and the Doctrine of Lapse. After completing the chapter, a flip class activity was conducted in which students took turns teaching their peers. This was followed by a short classroom debate, allowing students to express their views and deepen their understanding of the topics taught.





This week, Class 5 students explored an interesting incident from a letter by Robert Louis Stevenson and compared it with his writing in *Treasure Island*. They noticed similarities in his work, such as the theme of dual personality and the element of mystery. This activity helped deepen their understanding of the author's style and encouraged thoughtful discussion and analysis.

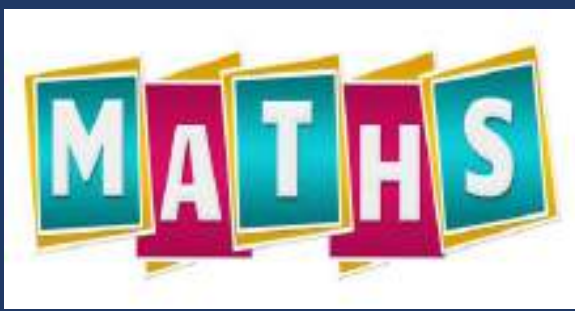




हिन्दी

Students of Class 5 revised their understanding of Decimals by solving worksheets. They also revised multiplication tables and wrote them in their notebooks. They participated in an engaging hands-on activity where they created a working model of the Decimal Place Value Chart. The activity helped them visualize the concept better and strengthened their understanding of the relationship between whole numbers and decimal fractions.



ART & CRAFT

This week Students of grades 3 to 5 completed their practice for the upcoming Pencil Shaving Art Activity. The activity aims to encourage creativity, imagination, and artistic expression among students by using simple materials like pencil shavings, glue, colours, and drawing sheets. Through this activity, students will learn to create beautiful and meaningful art using everyday stationery items, enhancing their fine motor skills and sense of design.



DANCE

Every step tells a story! Students of class 5 learned a short dance sequence and explored the art of expression through movement. They also learnt some basic techniques for jumps, helping them improve their coordination, rhythm, and body control.
