GA: Types of transport was introduced in the class. They were told about importance of it. Students enjoyed the Traffic light rhyme.



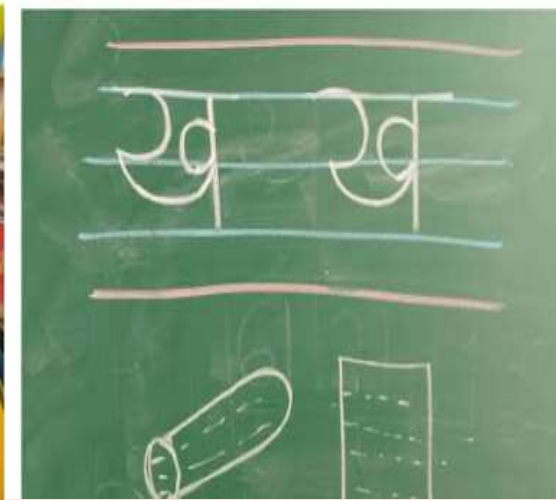
Hindi: Vyanjan ‘थ’ was introduced in the class where children enjoyed coloring in the workbook.

KINDERGARTEN



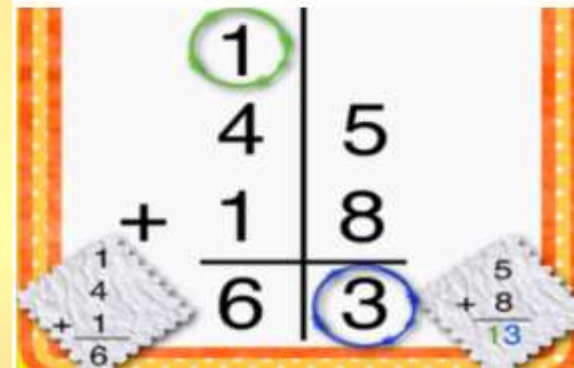
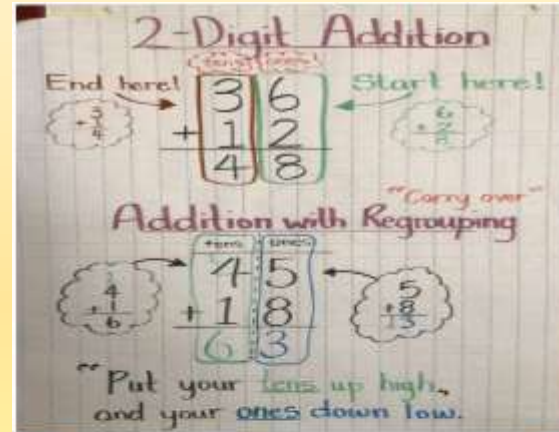
GA -Discussion on community helpers was discussed like community helpers play an important role in society. Students of KG enjoyed watching ppt on Gurupurab.

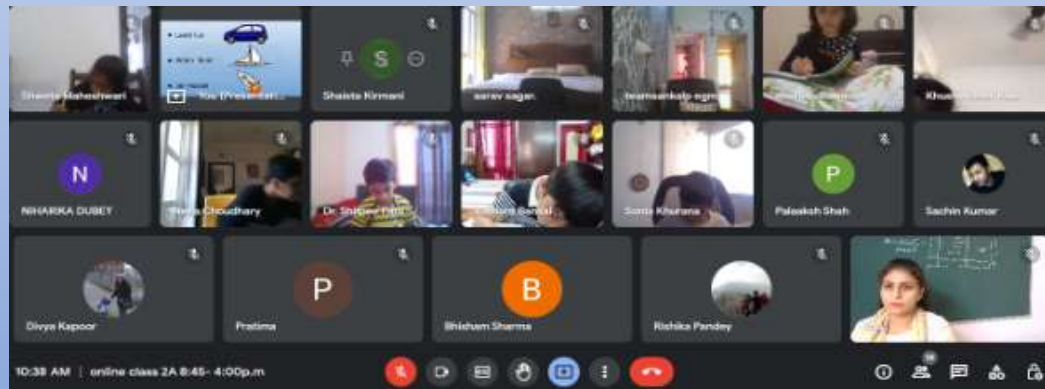

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is the movement of goods and people from one place to another. Early humans did not have any means of transport. To get from one place to another, they had to walk or run. Later, when humans started domesticating animals, they used animals such as camels and horses, to carry heavy loads.

They also learnt to build roads to transport themselves and their goods from one place to another by road. The wheel, which was invented, enabled transport made it possible for humans to travel greater distances and transport heavier loads than before. Today, we travel from one place to another using air, land and water transport.



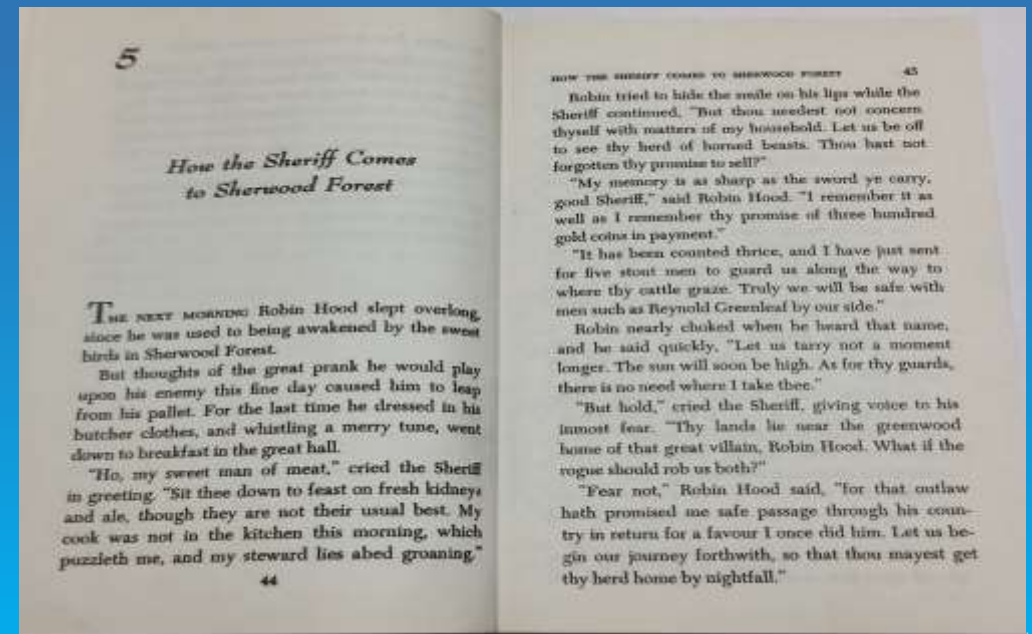
