English – Revision Of letters A-Z was done by doing the sequence writing, missing letters, circle the lowercase letters in the notebook. Story Sky is falling was shown to the children through audio-visual.

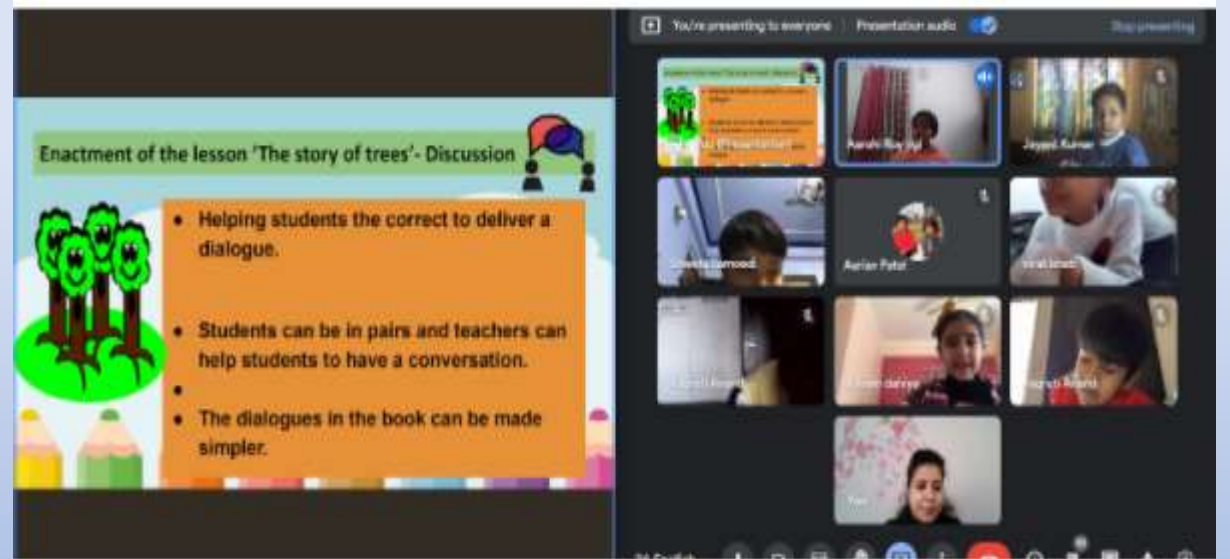
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

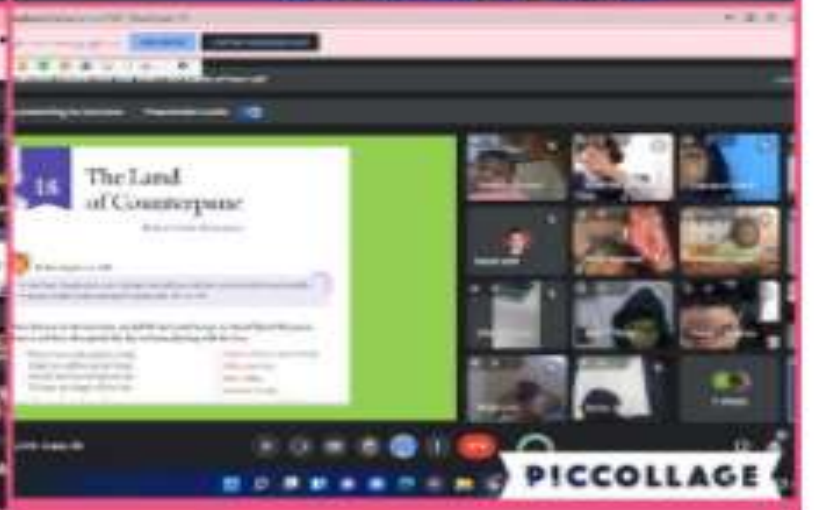
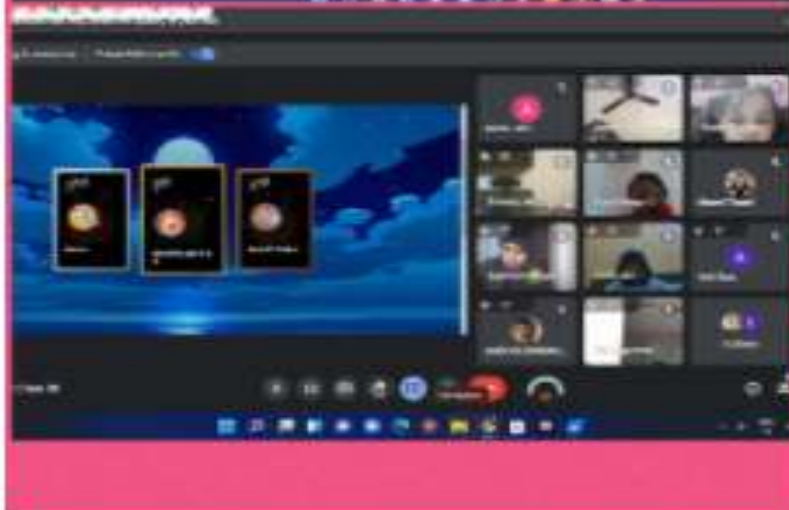
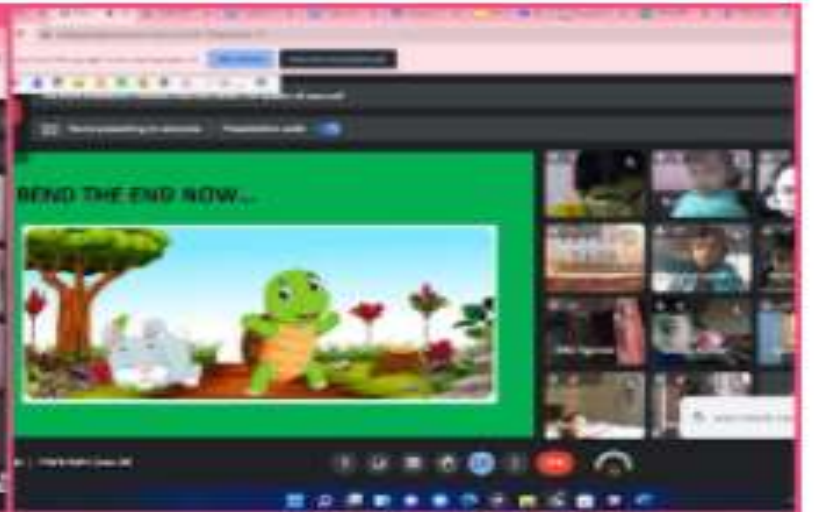
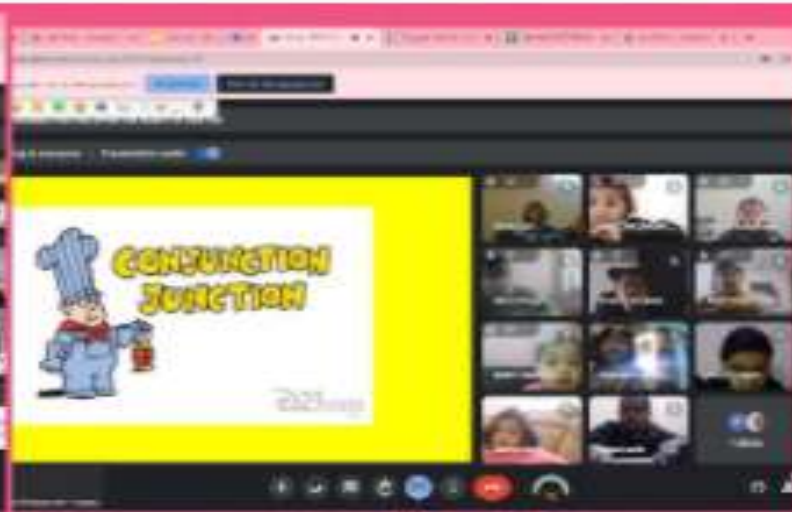


SPECIAL ASSEMBLY- REPUBLIC DAY 2022





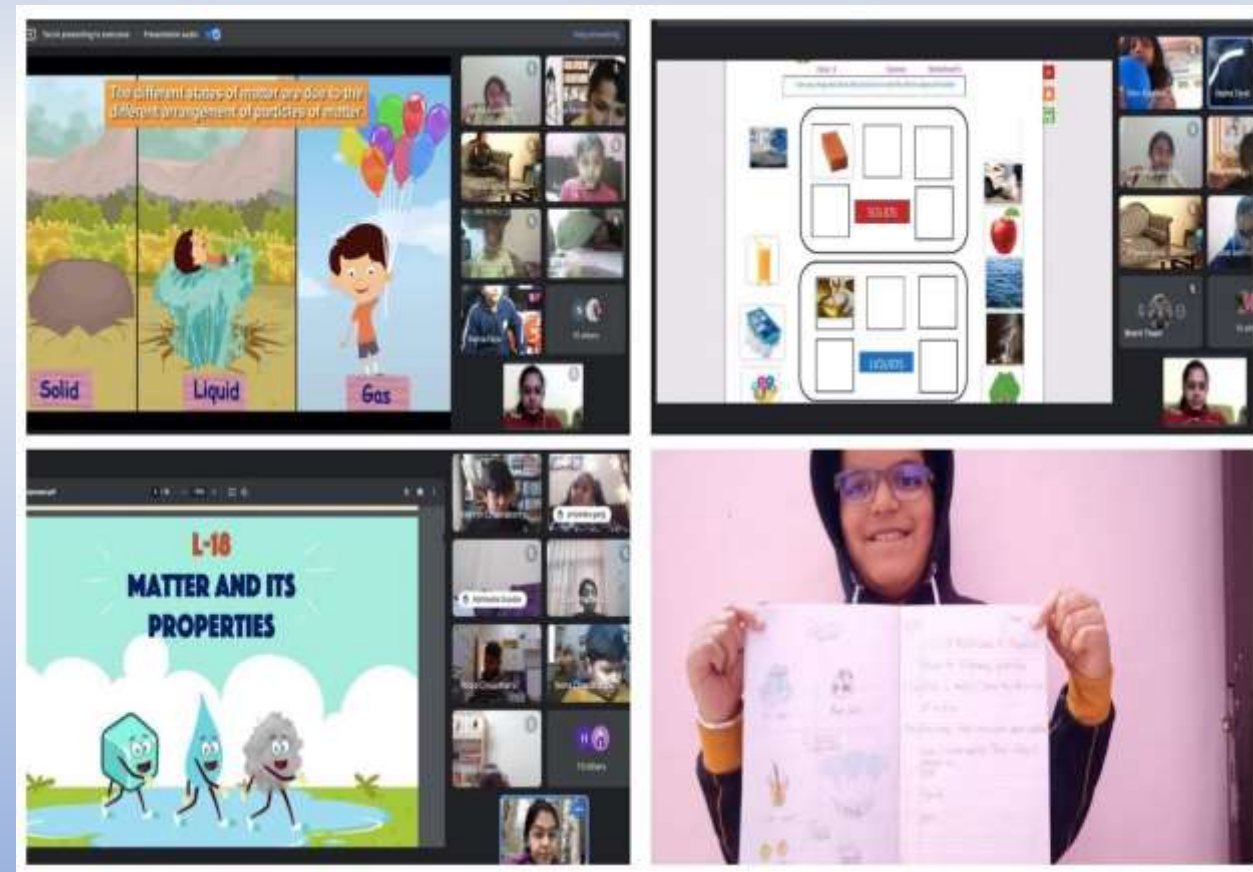

- Soluble impurities, such as salt and sugar, are removed using the process of evaporation or distillation.
- The process of water turning into water vapour is known as evaporation.
- The impure water solution is allowed to evaporate.
- When water evaporates, the soluble impurities like salt and sugar are left behind.

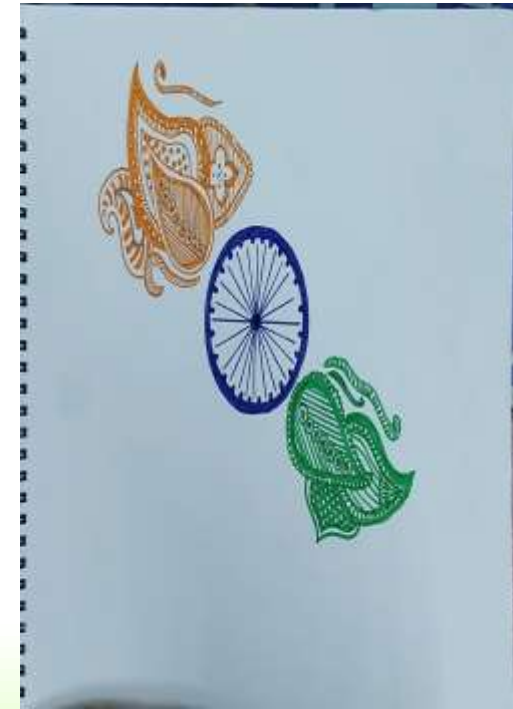
MATHS ACTIVITY (3 & 4)

SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON REPUBLIC DAY (CLASS 4)

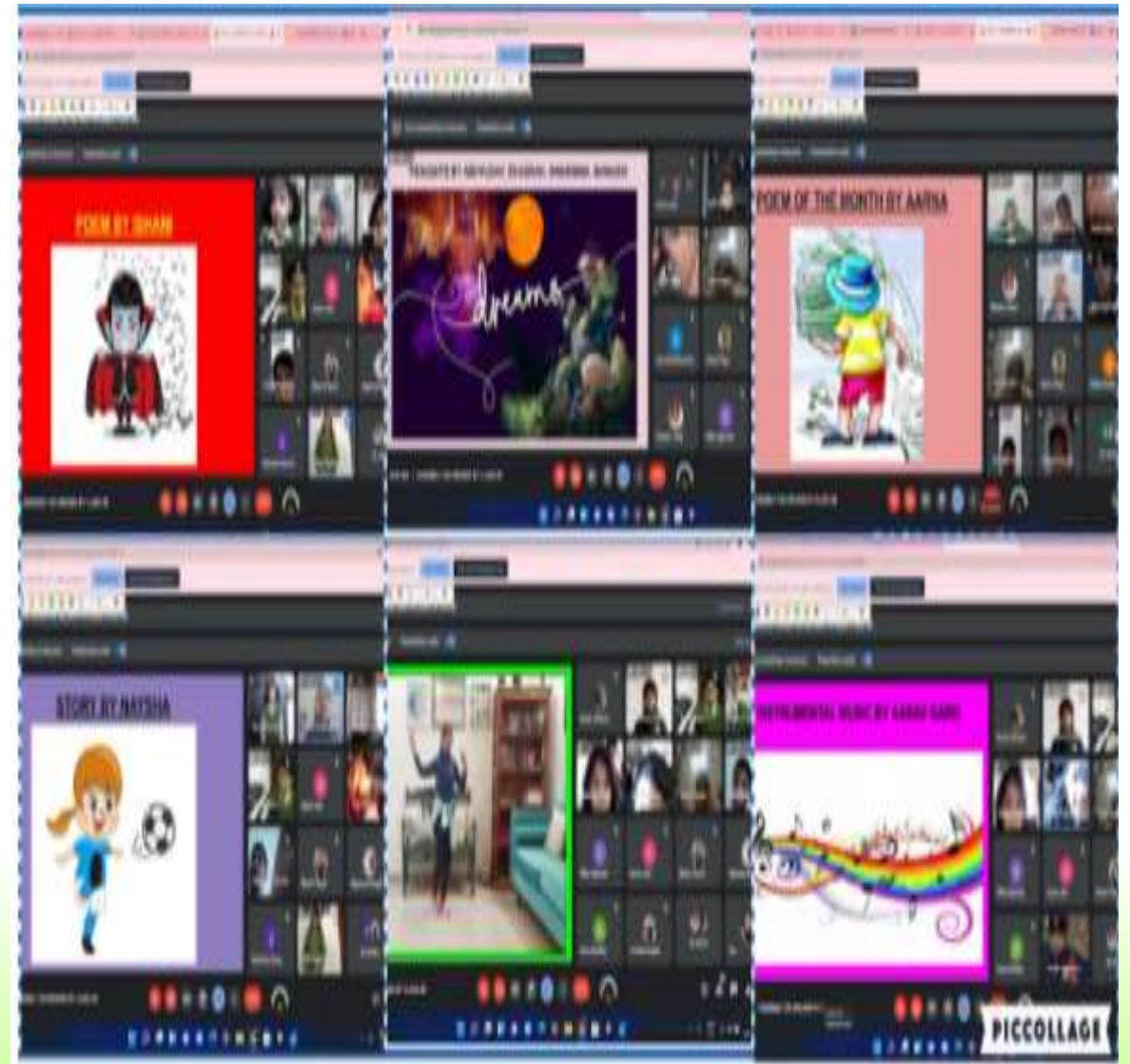

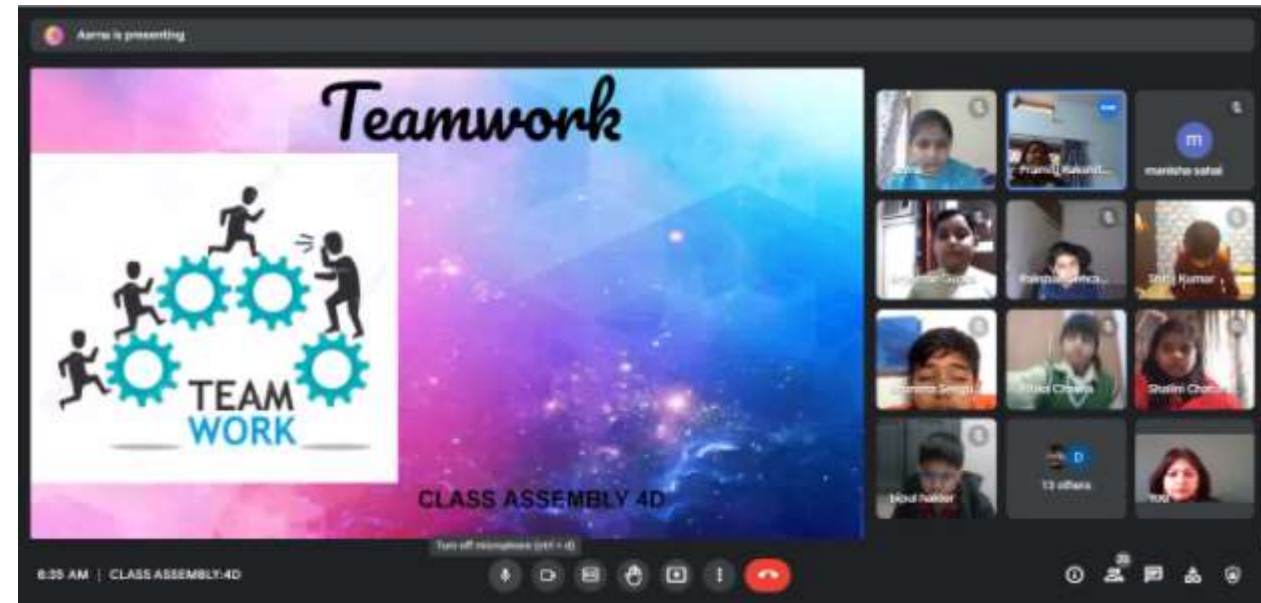
CLASS ASSEMBLY 3B
