English: Introduction of letter K was done with the phonic sounds by doing the worksheets where children wrote the first letter of the given picture, matching the picture with the starting letter of that picture.

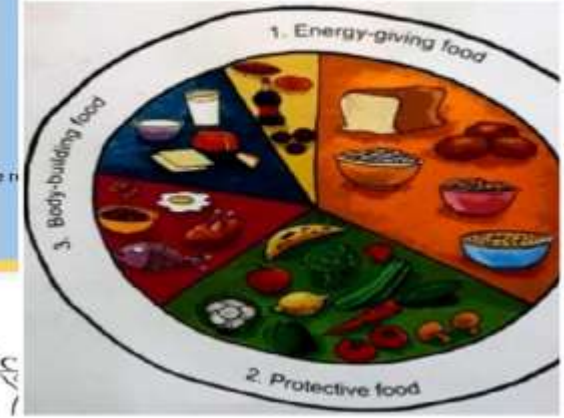
