# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

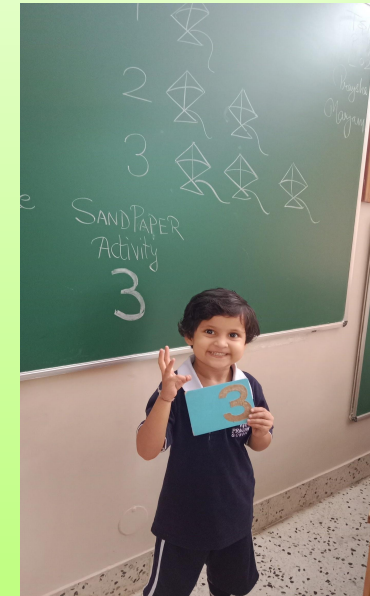
# HINDI

# CIRCLE TIME

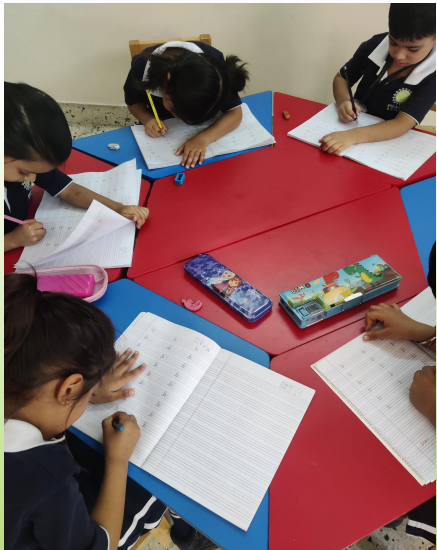
In Circle Time, students discussed various fruits, their colors, and shared their favorites, promoting language skills, social interaction, and an appreciation for diverse fruits and preferences.



# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH

During the week, letters j and b were introduced through engaging methods like flashcards and real-life objects to enhance recognition. The children also practiced writing the letters j and b, reinforcing their learning through hands-on activities.



# HINDI

This week, the Hindi swar (vowels) औ and अि were introduced, and children practiced writing them in their notebook. They also learned to identify the distinct sounds of each swar through engaging activities and pronunciation exercises.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of General Awareness, children learned about different types of healthy foods and discussed the differences between healthy and junk food. The session aimed to encourage healthy eating habits through interactive discussion and visual aids.



# MUSIC

This week in music classes, the students actively practiced vocal exercises, focusing on Alankars like Sa Re Ga Ma Pa. Along with this, they also learned a new song, Ekta Ka Geet, which beautifully highlights the message of unity and harmony. The children sang with enthusiasm and sincerity making the session melodious.



# DANCE

This week, the students enjoyed their dance classes with great enthusiasm. They practiced on the lively and cheerful song ‘Such a Beautiful Day.’ The children showed wonderful coordination and energy as they learned new steps.





# ENGLISH

During the English session, students revised words containing the 'sh' digraph and participated in a practical exercise where they constructed 'sh' words using flashcards. This activity facilitated improved recognition and application of phonetic patterns, contributing to enhanced literacy skills and language proficiency.



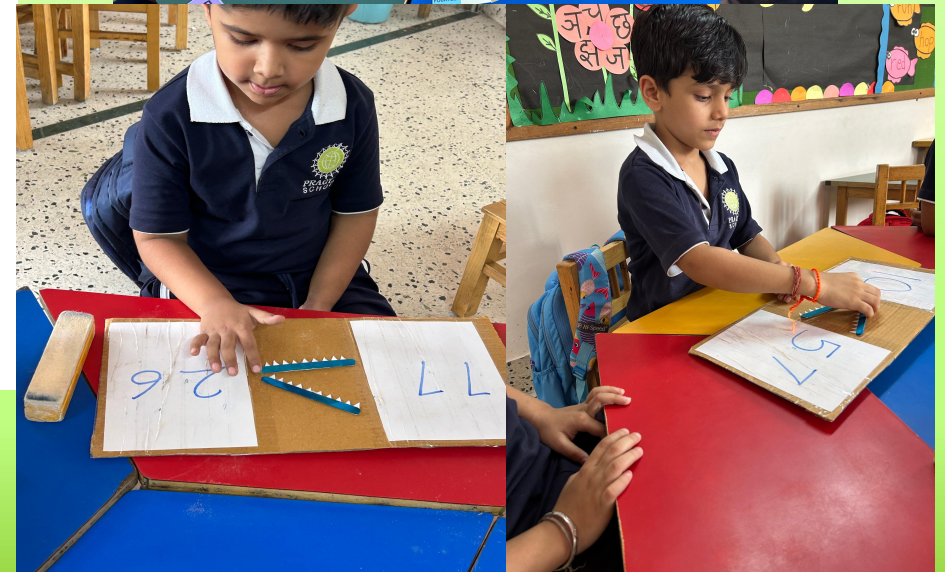
# HINDI

During the Hindi session, students revised four-letter words and participated in an interactive activity where they created words using flashcards. This practical approach facilitated improved recognition, pronunciation, and retention of four-letter words, contributing to enhanced language skills and literacy.



# MATH

Students participated in an interactive activity to reinforce their understanding of comparison operators (greater than, less than, and equals to) and number sequencing in ascending order through flash cards. Additionally, students were introduced to the concept of addends and practiced on the board and in their workbooks, solidifying their foundational math skills and building a strong foundation for future learning.



# EASP

During the sports period, students began with a warm-up exercise to prepare their muscles for physical activity. They then enthusiastically participated in engaging activities, jumping on the hoola hoops and running through cones, which helped improve their coordination, agility, and overall physical fitness.



# JADUI PITARA

As part of Jadui Pitara, students participated in a fun-filled activity where they read words related to 'sh' and 'ch' sound. This helped in reinforcing their phonetic awareness and vocabulary skills. This interactive exercise enabled students to connect sounds with words, promoting a deeper understanding of language patterns.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

As a part of general awareness, students explored the topic of neighbourhood places through flashcards. Interactive conversations encouraged students to express their feelings and experiences about local landmarks, fostering a sense of community and connection. A hands-on activity further reinforced their understanding, where students matched pictures of neighbourhood places with their correct names, developing their observational and critical thinking skills.

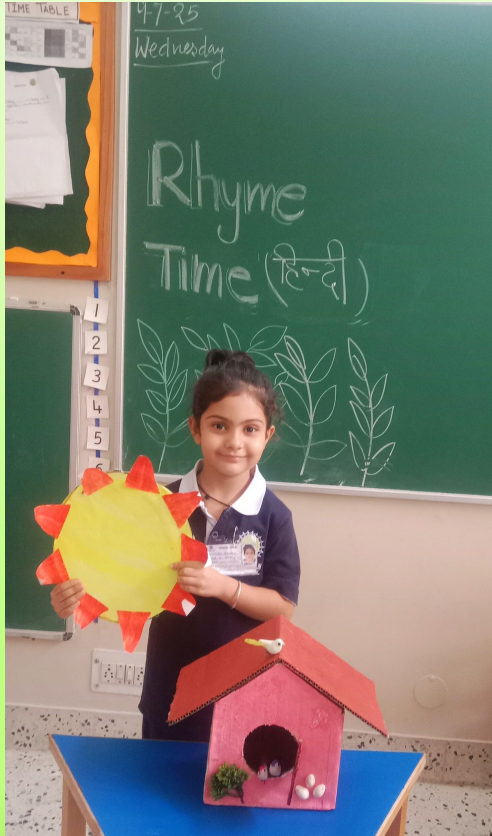


# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY





During the week, children actively participated in the *Poem* and *Words of the Month* sessions, which helped strengthen their vocabulary and boost their confidence. The concept of Articles (*a*, *an*) was introduced and reinforced through sentence-making exercises. Additionally, the concept of *One and Many*—with a focus on words ending in *-ies*—was revised through various interactive tasks.

Chapter “*Little Folks in the Grass*” was read aloud in class, followed by comprehension-based discussions and related book exercises.





# हिन्दी

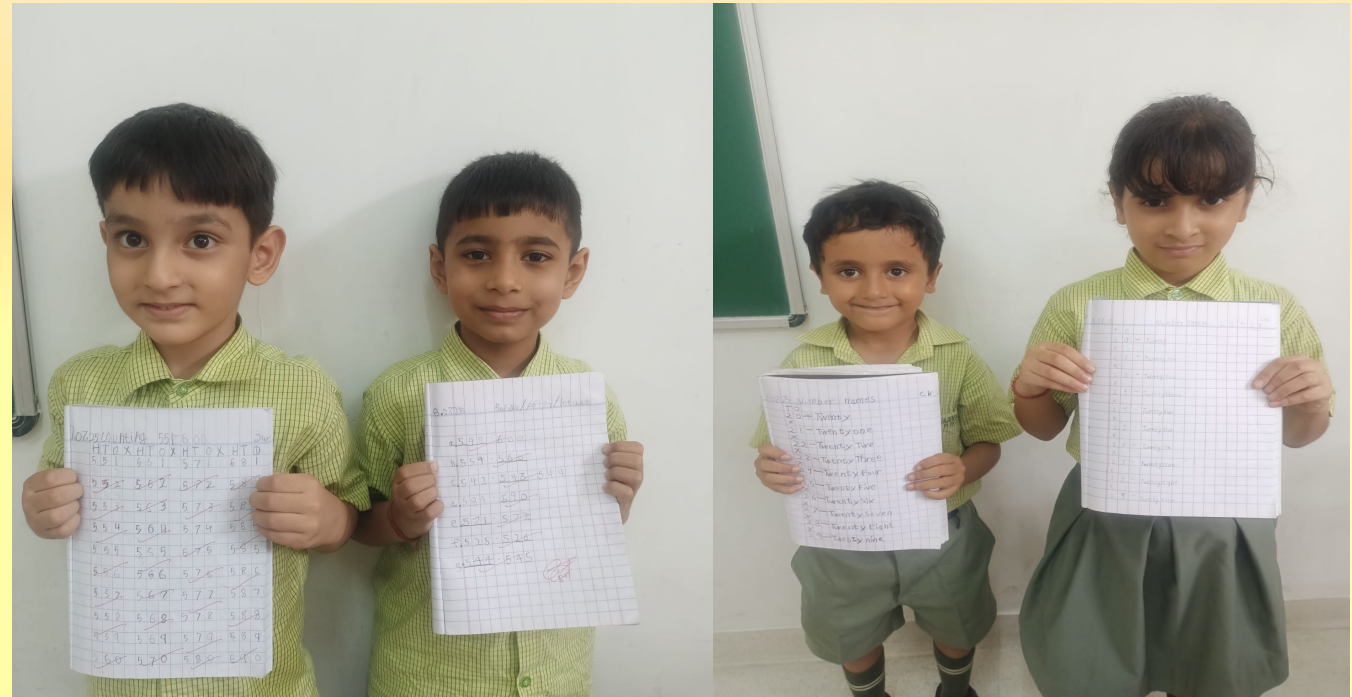

# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week was all about celebrating the everyday heroes around us — *Community Helpers!* Our curious learners explored this theme through textbook exercises, riddles, and drawing. We also went beyond the books to discover real-world roles such as plumbers, electricians, and librarians.





# हिन्दी

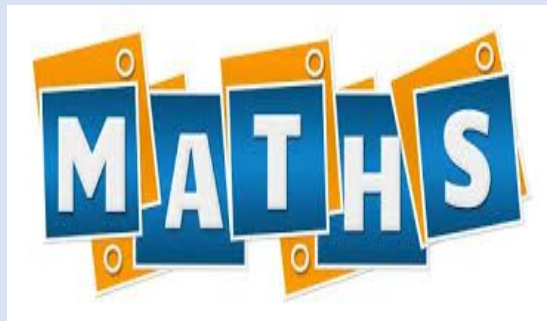




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of Grade 2 were introduced to the topic ‘*Neighbourhood*’ and the importance of neighbours in our daily lives. Through textbook references and class discussions, they learned about various places commonly found in the neighbourhood, such as a dairy, bakery, clinic, chemist shop, barber shop, and police station. Children enthusiastically identified and spoke about the people and places in their own neighbourhoods.





This week, Grade 2 students explored the concept of *Rounding Off Numbers* in their math class. They also reinforced their understanding by revisiting and practicing questions from previously taught topics.



# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)

Learning musical instruments plays a vital role in a child's development—it boosts brain function, improves focus and memory, enhances coordination, builds confidence, and nurtures creativity. This week, during the musical instrument class, students were introduced to the xylophone. They also learned to play basic *alankars* (musical patterns) on the instrument, making the session both enriching and enjoyable.



# VOCAL MUSIC



Children of Classes 1 and 2 enjoyed learning the patriotic song '*Hum Bharat Ke Bachche Hain*' during their vocal music session. The song not only introduced them to basic musical notes and rhythm but also instilled a sense of national pride and unity.

# ART & CRAFT



This week, Grade 1 students practiced gradation techniques in their *Sparkle* book, learning how to blend colors seamlessly from light to dark. This activity helped deepen their understanding of color transitions.

Grade 2 students focused on pencil shading, exploring different techniques to create light and dark effects. Through this, they learned how to add depth and dimension to their drawings, enhancing their overall artistic skills.

# LIBRARY

Students of Classes 1 and 2 regularly visit the library and explore books from various genres. While reading, they are encouraged to focus on sentences, understand new words, and grasp the overall meaning. Activities deepen understanding through practical application, fostering greater engagement, creativity, and problem-solving skills. They also encourage teamwork and enhance memory retention. This week, an inter-class talent show was organized, providing students with a platform to showcase their talents in singing, dancing, playing instruments, and more. The event was lively and engaging, with students participating enthusiastically and confidently.



# MATIFIC

Students of Classes 1 and 2 enjoyed learning Math through play-way activities. They reinforced their concepts by engaging with the Matific platform during class, making the learning experience both fun and effective.



# PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students of Classes 1 and 2 had a delightful time learning how to pass and exchange passes using the inside of the foot—a fundamental soccer skill that enhances accuracy, control, and quick decision-making. Mastering this technique helps children make short, precise passes, which are crucial for maintaining possession and building effective attacking plays on the field. It was a fun-filled, skill-building session for our young learners!



# COMPUTER

Students of Class 2 participated in an engaging activity where they used calculators to solve basic math operations and explored the application *Tux Typing* to enhance their keyboard familiarity and typing accuracy. This hands-on experience helped strengthen both their mathematical and digital literacy skills.



# MORNING ASSEMBLY 2A

Morning assemblies are an integral part of the school curriculum, fostering values and confidence among students. On July 8th and 9th, 2025, the students of Class 2A conducted a meaningful assembly on the theme *Family Values*. The assembly began with PT and the morning prayer, followed by a thought-provoking talk show titled *My Family, My Treasure*. A moral-based story highlighting the importance of family was then narrated, and students also recited the poem of the month. It was an engaging and educational presentation that beautifully emphasized the significance of family bonds.





Students of class 3 were introduced to the poem of the month 'Friends' and new words of the month. The grammatical concepts of collective nouns and singular-plural nouns were revised in the class, followed by written exercises. The students read from the reader Jungle Book and comprehended the chapter. They even made a meal weekly planner, as a part of their activity. 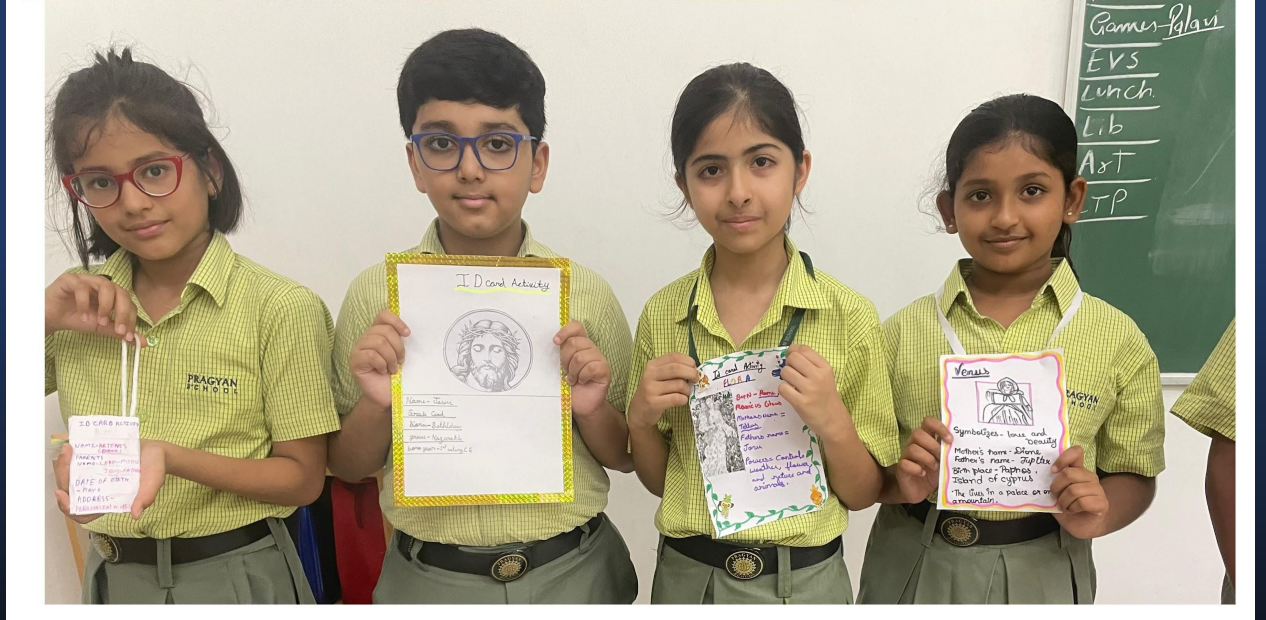
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

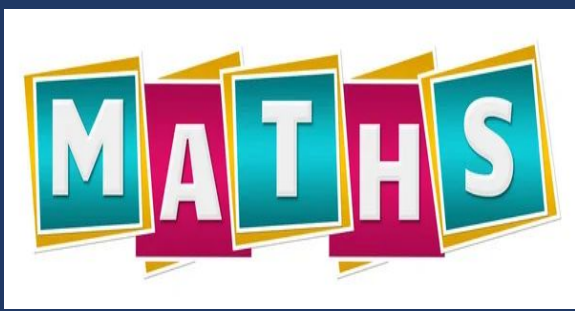




# हिन्दी

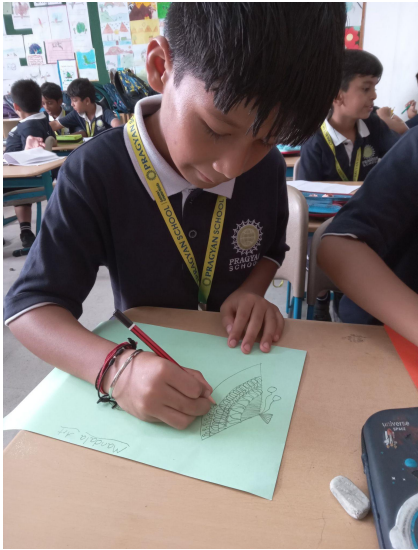
# KATHAK
