English – Introduction of letter Z was done in the class where students were able to identify the pictures that start with the letter Z.

A special assembly for KG and Nursery on Christmas was held on 23rd & 24th December. We thank all the parents for participating and making our assembly a grand success.



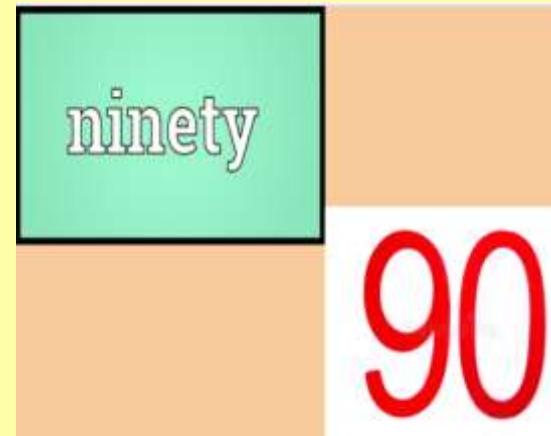
ORGANIC FARM VISIT (NURSERY)

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students enjoyed watching the video and ppt related to the topics taught to them. They also did the related worksheet in their workbooks. 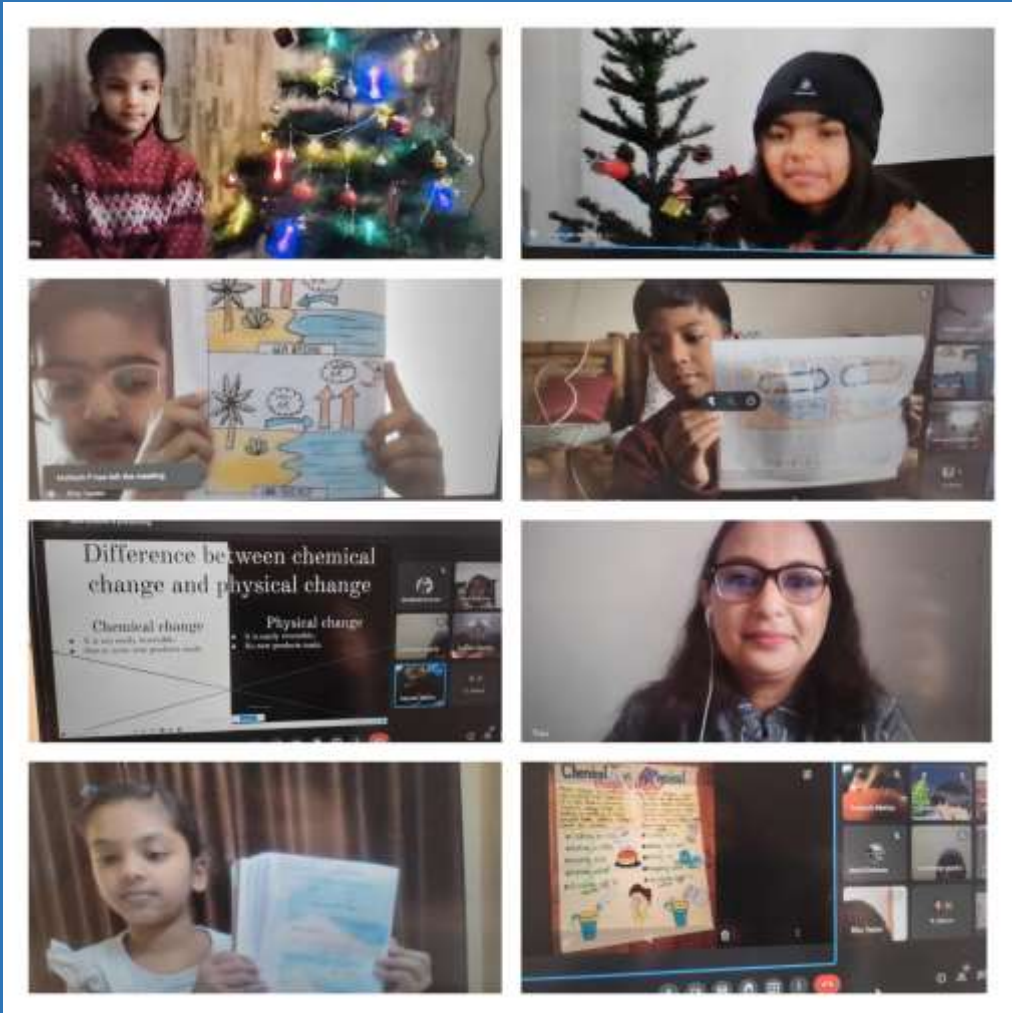


A **preposition** is a word that indicates the **position** or **relation** of a **noun** or pronoun with another noun or pronoun or verb in a sentence.

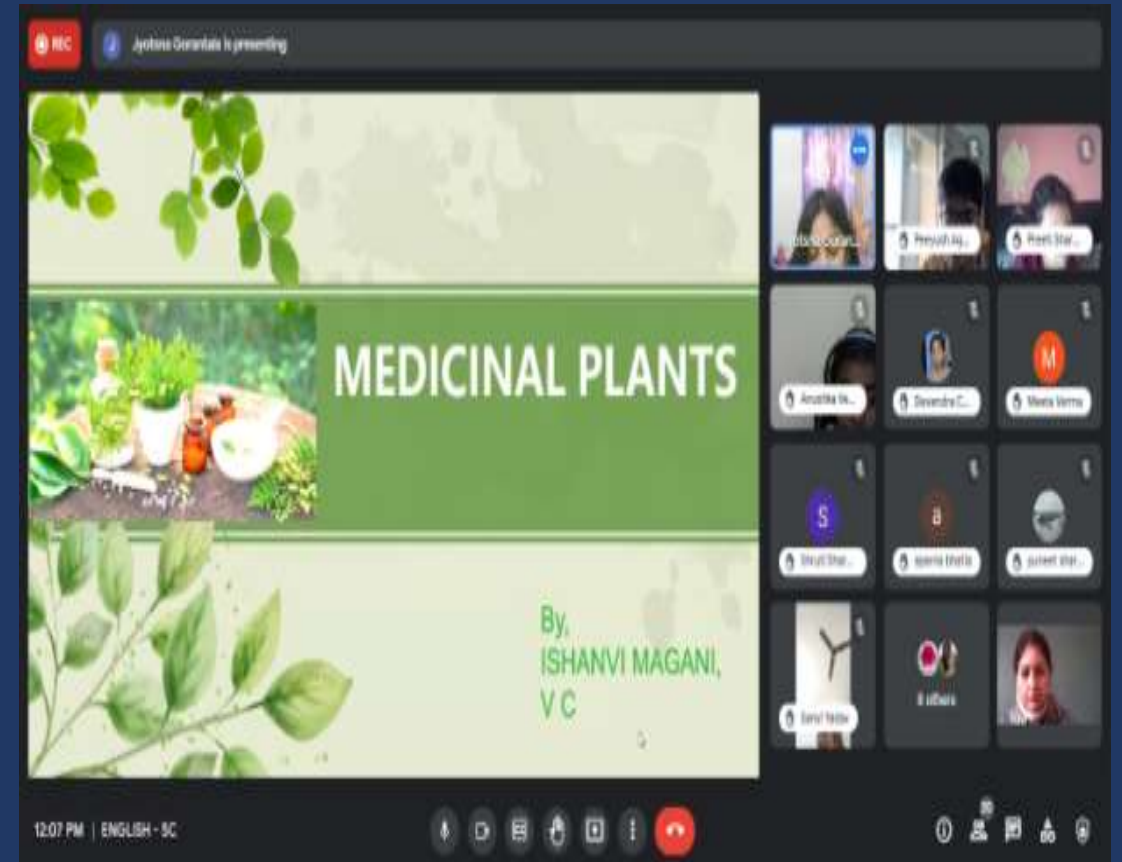

They loved playing quiz on proverbs on the Quizizz platform. Students wrote question - answers and reference to the context of the lesson, An Old Friend in their notebooks. They enjoyed doing the activity on medicinal plants where they collected information and made a PPT/booklet on it and shared it in the class. ASL was also taken up this week where they tried to answer the questions after listening to the audio clip. They revised the concept of articles too.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 5 were introduced to the world of energy and its application in our daily lives through the introduction of L-25: Energy. The concept and application of the various forms of energy-mechanical, heat, light, sound, chemical and electrical was discussed in detail. Students were also shown how to draw an electric circuit. Videos related to the conversion of energy into various forms were also shown to strengthen the understanding of the students.

L-25: Energy

What is Energy?

- **The word energy means the capacity to do work.** For example, a light bulb will light up when it is provided with electricity, which is a form of energy.
- Energy cannot be created or destroyed. Forms of energy can, however, be interchanged.
- A car's engine burns fuel, converting the chemical energy in fuel into mechanical energy. Solar cells change light energy into electrical energy.





Types of Energy

Electrical Energy:

- Electricity is a form of energy. **Electricity can be produced using solar energy, wind, petrol, coal, water, oil, natural gas and chemicals.** The electricity we use every day in our homes moves along wires. This movement of electricity is known as a current.
- **Materials that allow electricity to flow through them are called conductors.** Copper and silver are good conductors of electricity.
- **Materials that do not allow electricity to flow through them are called insulators.** Rubber and wood are insulators.
