NURSERY



ENGLISH

This week letter N was introduced to the students along with the revision of letters A and M. Students completed worksheets and practiced letter revision through engaging activities, including sand and salt writing. The students demonstrated a strong grasp of letter recognition and handwriting skills, showcasing their progress in literacy.

HINDI

This week, the Nursery students were introduced to the letter झ through engaging activities. They learnt its sound, formation, and related vocabulary with enthusiasm. The students enjoyed colouring the worksheet based on the letter झ. Previous letters were also revised to strengthen recognition, recall, and application in learning.



MATH

Nursery class explored the number 8, completing related worksheets and activities. Students enthusiastically participated in engaging exercises, reinforcing their understanding. A fun-filled revision of previous numbers was also conducted, ensuring a strong foundation in numeracy. The students demonstrated impressive learning skills and active participation.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Students explored good habits through colourful worksheets. They learned about oral hygiene, cleanliness and handwashing. Students understood the importance of these habits in maintaining health and developing responsibility. Interactive activities reinforced their learning, fostering a strong foundation for good habits and a healthy lifestyle.



EASP

This week, Nursery participated in the Bean Bag Balance Race practice, showcasing excellent balance and coordination skills. They enthusiastically balanced the bean bag while racing, demonstrating teamwork, sportsmanship, and physical agility.



JADUI PITARA

Students explored the Jadui Pitara, learning stories based on letters **A** and **M**. The teacher narrated engaging stories incorporating these letters and phonics. Students creatively crafted their own stories using objects from the Jadui Pitara starting with **A** and **M**, demonstrating innovative thinking and phonetic awareness. This activity enhanced their language skills and creativity.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH

This week, the letters n and u were introduced. Children learned vocabulary related to these letters and practiced their phonetic sounds. A revision of previously learned letters and their phonics was also conducted. Children also practiced reading 'a' family words. Additionally, sight words were revised to reinforce reading fluency.



HINDI

The vyanjan ष was introduced this week. Children completed related writing and colouring worksheets. They also practiced writing two-letter words such as पग, मग and नभ in their notebooks. Revision of previously learned vyanjan and swar is being done regularly as part of a continuous learning process.



MATHS

This week, the counting from 60 to 70 was introduced. Children practiced forward counting from 0 to 70 and backward counting from 70 to 0 using practice sheets and their notebooks. Additionally, the concept of What comes after was revised to reinforce number sequencing skills.



ORATORY SKILLS

As part of auditory classes, the teachers narrated the story of *The Dove and the Ant*. Later, the little ones joyfully enacted the story in their own way, bringing the characters to life with expressions and actions. The activity helped them enhance their listening and speaking skills while learning the value of kindness and gratitude.



SCIENCE DEMO

The kindergarteners enjoyed exciting science experiments related to air. They learned that air is all around us, it occupies space and has weight. This was demonstrated through a balloon activity, and understood why air is important through simple hands-on demonstrations.



SKILL BASED LEARNING

This week, the skill-based learning classes focused on eating etiquettes. The kids learned about good table manners through flash cards and enjoyed hands-on activities where they practiced placing the plates and laying a mat properly on the dining table. The sessions were fun and helped children develop important life skills in an engaging way.





ENGLISH

This week in English, students completed a worksheet related to is, am, are, and the ph digraph in their workbook. They practiced the usage of is, am, and are in their notebook. They also read blend words from their English learner book and read words from Fitzroy.

HINDI

This week, in Hindi, students completed worksheets related to आ की मात्रा in their workbook as well as in shabd parichay. They also attempted to read words and sentences that included आ की मात्रा. This activity likely helped them practice reading and writing Hindi words with the आ sound represented by the "ा" diacritic mark.



MATH

This week in maths, students practiced the concept of what comes after from 120 to 160. They also wrote numbers from 120 to 160 in order from smallest to biggest in their notebook. They also solved addition problems using a number line in their book. These activities helped them practice number sequences, ordering numbers, and using a visual tool.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week in general awareness class, students learned about community helpers by answering questions about them. The students also drew a picture of their favorite community helper in their notebook. This activity helped them learn about the people who help us in our community and let them show which helper they like the most.



CIRCLE TIME

This week in circle time, students shared a few good habits that formed part of their daily routine like brushing teeth regularly, being kind to friends, eating healthy foods, or completing homework on time. Sharing good habits encourages students to think about their daily routines and behaviors that contribute to their well-being.



EDUCATIONAL OUTING

As part of the educational outing the students of Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten visited a nearby bakery on 18th August, 2025. The visit not only broadened their understanding of baking but also sparked a new appreciation for the work that goes into creating delicious baked goods. The children observed how the bakery worked and enjoyed watching the baking process.

Later, in the school premises, under the guidance of Mrs Anshika Tandon students also learned how to make muffins and cakes from mixing ingredients, technique of icing, to watching the dough rise in the ovens. through a fun, hands-on activity. The visit was both enjoyable and educational, giving the little ones a sweet learning experience.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

As part of hands-on activities, in Hindi, students did activities related to आ की मात्रा through picture recognition, word making, and putting the matra in the correct place. In English, in hands-on activities, students did activities related to blends. These activities helped students practice and understand आ की मात्रा and blending sounds in a practical and interactive manner. Doing activities in different ways probably made learning more engaging and helped students grasp these concepts better.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

This week, the Nursery, Kindergarten, and Upper Kindergarten students enthusiastically participated in the Inter-Class General Awareness Quiz. The quiz included simple yet thoughtful questions from the topics covered in April, May, and July. It was a participatory activity for the Nursery students, whereas the students of Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten with maximum number of correct answers competed with each other. The students will be awarded with the certificate of merit, who showcased their knowledge with confidence and excitement.



VALUE BASED STORY

This week as part of a value-based story session, students narrated the story of The fox and the stork using props in front of the class. Using props likely helped the students make their storytelling more engaging and interactive for their classmates. It encouraged creativity, public speaking skills, and sharing values through the stories they told.





This week, students of class 1 delved into a rich and engaging learning experience centered around the lesson “I Want a Garden.” They began by reading and enjoying the story together, which sparked a vibrant class discussion about gardens—fuelling curiosity, idea-sharing, and deeper comprehension through active discussion. Following this, the children participated in a hands-on activity: creating a list of items needed to plant a garden. To bring their ideas to life, they expressed creativity by drawing and coloring a beautiful garden scene.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह, कक्षा 1 के छात्रों ने हिंदी विषय में अधिक गहराई से काम किया। उन्होंने "ए" मात्रा वाले शब्दों का पठन-लेखन अभ्यास बड़े उत्साह के साथ किया, जिससे उनका समझ और उच्चारण दोनों सुधार हुआ। साथ ही, चित्रों को देखकर उनका नाम लिखना भी किया गया, जो दृश्य-लेखन कौशल को बढ़ाने में सहायक रहा। इसके अलावा, बच्चों को आ, ए, ई और ऐ मात्राओं वाले शब्द बनाने और पढ़ने-लिखने का व्यापक अभ्यास कराया गया।





This week, our young learners of Class 1 enthusiastically revisited skip counting by 2's and 3's, strengthening their number fluency and understanding of patterns. They practiced these sequences through dodging—focusing on the multiplication tables of 2 and 3.

Alongside this, students worked on writing and understanding number names from 60 to 69, exploring the concepts of tens and ones within this range. These activities deepened their grasp of place value, essential for all future number work.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week, the children explored the theme of Food through notebook work and identified different kitchen tools. They also enjoyed a quick recap of the chapter Food with the help of audio-visual aids, attempted to fill in the blanks, and drew healthy and unhealthy food items with great enthusiasm.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह बच्चों ने अपनी पठन क्षमता को बढ़ाने हेतु पाठ “पानी” का अध्ययन किया। कक्षा में अध्यापिका ने पानी की आवश्यकता, उसके स्रोतों और जल संरक्षण पर चर्चा की। बच्चों ने सुंदर चित्रों के माध्यम से नदी, तालाब, कुआँ और वर्षा जैसे जल स्रोतों को पहचाना। सभी ने समझा कि पानी जीवन के लिए अनिवार्य है और इसका संरक्षण आवश्यक है। बच्चों ने माह की कविता “प्यारा हिन्दुस्तान” का सामूहिक वाचन किया तथा लिंग बदलो और विलोम शब्द का अभ्यास उत्साहपूर्वक किया। इस प्रकार सप्ताह की गतिविधि ज्ञानवर्धक और आनंददायक रही।





Students of Class 2 practiced the use of punctuation marks such as full stop, question mark, and comma, and did related exercises in their notebooks and workbooks to strengthen their writing skills. They were also introduced to gender nouns through simple examples and activities that helped them understand the difference between masculine and feminine genders. Along with this, they revised the new words and the poem of the month, reciting it with expression. The activities helped students improve their grammar, vocabulary, reading, and presentation skills.





This week during Maths class, Class 2 students revised multiplication tables from 5 to 9. They practiced vertical multiplication with and without regrouping, solved word problems, and revised subtraction. As part of an AIL activity, each child picked two cards, multiplied the numbers and shared the answer with the class, making learning fun and interactive.





This week, our Grade 2 students explored the chapter “Good Habits” through thoughtful discussions and interactive activities. They learned the importance of daily routines—such as brushing teeth twice a day, washing hands before meals, eating nutritious food, keeping their surroundings clean and showing kindness to others. These good habits support their health, discipline, and sense of responsibility.



ART & CRAFT



Students of Classes 1 & 2 are actively preparing for the upcoming inter-class “Bud Painting” activity! Through guided practice sessions, they are experimenting with cotton-bud painting techniques, gaining familiarity with application of paint, control dot patterns to create designs.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC



This week, our students took their musical journey a step further, building on their earlier lessons with the keyboard and harmonium. Through attentive, hands-on instruction, they honed their finger techniques, practicing different notes and experimenting with melodic sequences. Their lively participation brought energy to each session, deepening their connection with the music and the instruments.

COMPUTER CLASS 1

This week, our Class I students dove into two engaging and educational activities—typing and strategic thinking. They began with a focused lesson on the keyboard, learning about the different key types—**number keys, alphabet keys, and special keys**. This foundational skill helps streamline typing tasks, freeing cognitive energy to focus on content and improving speed and precision. Following the typing session, students enjoyed replaying the classic **Tic-Tac-Toe** game. This simple yet powerful activity fostered **critical thinking, strategic planning, and logical reasoning skills**.



COMPUTER CLASS 2



Students of class 2 continued working on Tux Paint and Tux Typing, further enhancing their computer skills. In Tux Typing, they practiced typing words and sentences, which helped them improve their speed, accuracy, and familiarity with the keyboard. In Tux Paint, students used different tools such as brushes, shapes, stamps, and fill colours to make creative drawings. They also explored options like erasing, undo/redo, and adding text to their pictures. These activities not only made learning fun but also helped students build creativity, focus, and confidence in using computers.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The students of Class 1 and 2 enthusiastically participated in stretching and strengthening exercises. They practiced activities such as lunges, single-leg jumps, and other simple drills. These exercises helped improve their flexibility, balance, and overall fitness. The children enjoyed the sessions and showed great energy while performing.



MATIFIC

This week, our Class 1 and 2 students delved into mathematics through interactive, play-based activities that made learning both enjoyable and effective. They were engaged in Matific activities based on addition, subtraction and skip counting.



VOCAL MUSIC

The little singers of Class 1 and 2 filled the air with melody as they prepared for Gandhi Jayanti. Their sweet voices resonated with patriotic songs, spreading the message of peace and truth that Bapu stood for. The practice sessions turned into joyful moments of rhythm and harmony, making the children feel closer to the spirit of Mahatma Gandhi.



STRETCHING EXERCISE

Grade 1 and 2 students actively participated in a morning stretching exercise session on Friday. The session aimed to encourage physical fitness, improve flexibility and promote healthy habits among young learners. The children enjoyed the exercises and learned simple stretching techniques to keep their bodies active and fresh. Such activities help in building strength, improving posture, and enhancing concentration throughout the day.



KATHAK

Class 2 students are introduced to the basic hand movements of Kathak with simple counting. They learnt to move their hands gracefully while keeping rhythm. This helps the children build coordination between hand gestures and beats. Through practice, they begin to enjoy expressing themselves with both movement and rhythm.



CONTEMPORARY DANCE

This week, our Class 1 and 2 students experienced the joy of movement as they learned and practiced a new dance sequence. It was more than just mastering steps—it was about expressing emotions, building discipline, and strengthening cognitive abilities.





Class 3 students practiced the grammatical concept of Sentences. They did jumbled words, jumbled sentences and completed the sentences too. They made sentences with the new words from the lesson, “The History of Chocolate”.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह कक्षा ३ के सभी विद्यार्थियों को गोल मटोल अनमोल के प्रश्नोत्तर, शब्दार्थ और अभ्यास कार्य का लिखित दोहराव कार्य करवाया गया। व्याकरण में सर्वनाम का लिखित दोहराव कार्य हिंदी कॉपी ३ में करवाया गया।





Students of grade 3 solved combining addition and subtraction questions and estimation in addition and subtraction in their notebooks. They also practiced dodging tables. They continued practicing estimation and multiplication in their workbook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of class 3 were introduced to the chapter “Physical India,” where they wrote the new words and question answers in their notebooks and learned about the Great Himalayas, Plateau, Plains, Coastal Regions, Deserts, Mountains, Peninsula, and the Indian Subcontinent. In addition, they explored the topic of birds through a nature walk, where they observed a nest on a tree and collected feathers, twigs, and sticks used by birds for making their nests. This activity helped them connect their classroom learning with real-life experiences and encouraged curiosity about the natural world. They also did pages 87-92 in their workbook.





This week, students of grade 4 wrote questions and answers based on the lesson, *Rainmaking*. In grammar, they learned about prefixes and suffixes and practiced these concepts through exercises in their notebooks and workbooks.





हिन्दी

Students of Grade 4 practiced multiplication in workbooks. They learned the concept of estimation in multiplication and practiced questions in notebooks with revision of dodging tables. They continued practicing Critical Thinking questions in notebook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The Class 4 students successfully completed the chapter “**The Coastal Regions and the Islands,**” along with the related notebook and workbook exercises, strengthening their knowledge of India’s diverse physical features. They were also introduced to the new chapter “**The Human Body,**” where they began exploring the different organ systems and their functions.





This week, the students practiced diary entry writing and revised for poem recitation and dictation. They also recapitulated the poem *The Fisherman* and clarified their queries through a doubt session. The week was largely devoted to revision, helping them reinforce their learning with confidence.

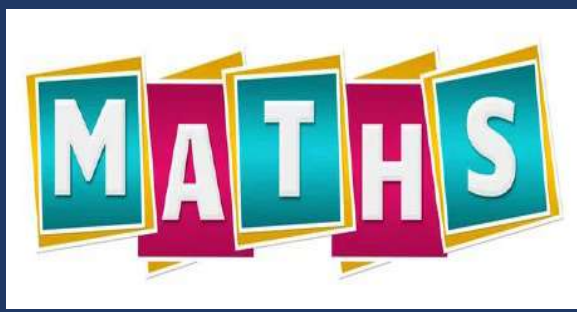




हिन्दी

The students of Class 5 were introduced to Fractions this week. To begin, they engaged in a hands-on warm-up activity using folded paper circles, where they identified and represented fractions through shaded portions. This activity helped them visualize the concept in a fun and interactive way.

They then revised key fraction-related terms and explored the different types of fractions in detail. They also wrote the types of fractions in the notebook and tried converting mixed fractions to improper and vice versa.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Grade 5 students were introduced to the chapter “**Temperate Zone**”, where they explored the important grasslands of the world. They learnt about their location, climate, vegetation, wildlife and human life in these regions. To make learning more engaging, videos related to the topic were shown in class. Students also enjoyed a **map activity**, where they marked the important grasslands of the world on a world map. Question–answers of the chapter were discussed and completed in the class.



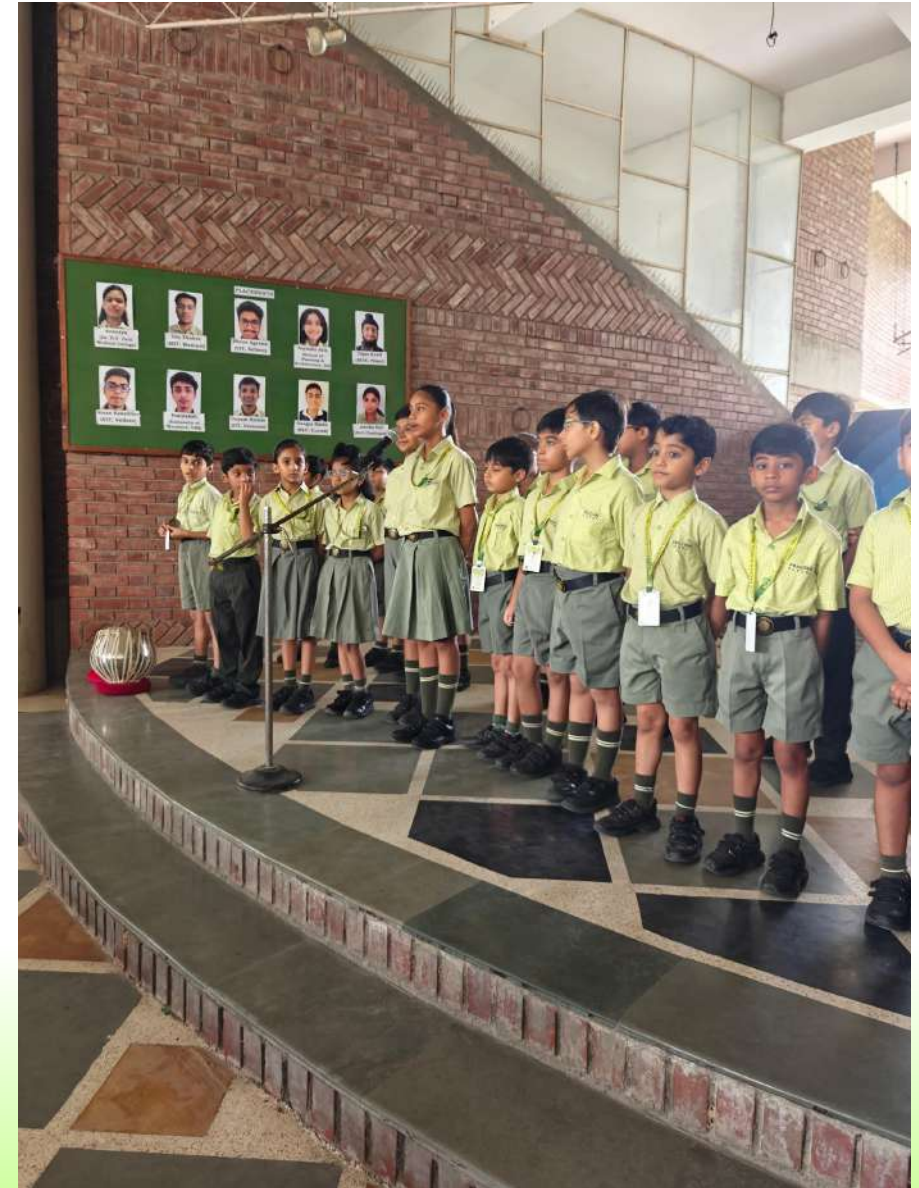
CLASS ASSEMBLY 3D
