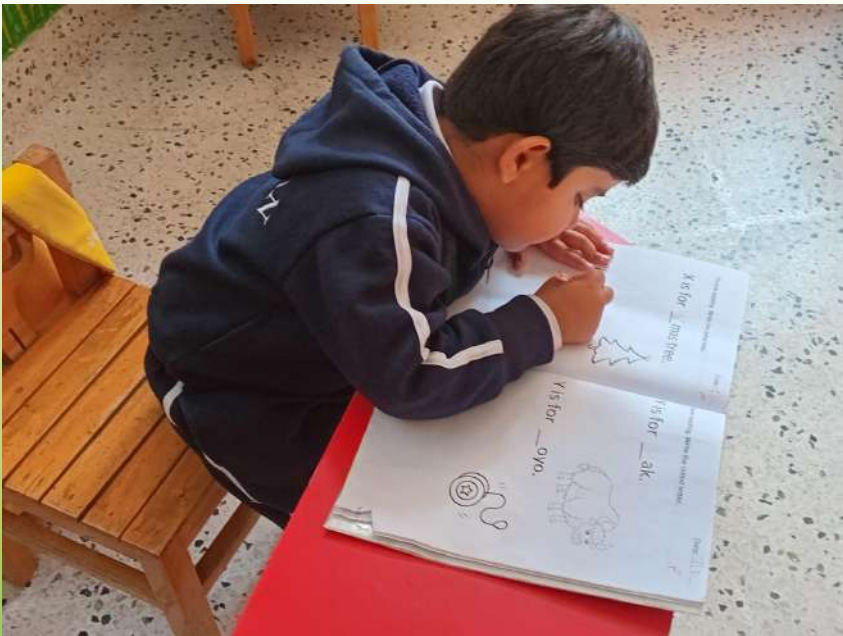

NURSERY



ENGLISH

Children practiced writing letters A-Z in their notebook and enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of letters. They also tried writing the missing letters in their workbook.

MATHS

During this week children practiced writing sequence number 0-30 in their notebook and also did oral counting from 0-30. They also did the concept of after number, missing number and before number in their notebook.



HINDI

Vyanjan **ञ** was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the vyanjan in their Hindi letter book.



VALUE EDUCATION

Nursery students enjoyed listening to the story 'Milo: The Monkey's Clean Day'. They learned the importance of cleanliness, keeping their room tidy, and washing hands before meals. This engaging story helped them develop essential habits and values for a healthy lifestyle.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Students are now able to copy sentences from the blackboard, ensuring they write neatly within the lines and maintain proper spacing. This helped the students to enhance their writing skills and correctly punctuate at the end of each sentence.

MATHS

Students reinforced their understanding of descending order by independently completing a worksheet, helping them solidify the concept effectively.



HINDI

As part of their revision, students were asked to identify pictures and write in their Hindi workbook the first Vyanjan (consonant) related to the picture.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Discussion on good habits and cleanliness was done in the class. Students enthusiastically participated and shared their daily habits they follow and also enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic.



CRAFT

The students of Kindergarten painted pistachio shells to create bird figures, allowing them to refine their colouring skills and practice using watercolors effectively.



YOGA

Yoga is a great way to keep the body flexible and the mind calm. This week, students explored two beneficial asanas: Shalabhasana (Locust Pose) and Paschimottanasana (Seated Forward Bend). This pose strengthens the back, improves posture, and enhances digestion.

Paschimottanasana is a great stretch for the spine and hamstrings, this asana calms the nervous system, improves flexibility.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

Students were given flashcards of Vyanjan (consonants) and were tasked with identifying them, forming two- or three-letter words using the flashcards, and reading them aloud.





ENGLISH

During this week students once again practiced picture composition by filling the blanks with suitable words. They also discussed their views on pets during class discussion and practiced creative writing on the topic My Pet.



MATHS

This week students did three digit addition and subtraction to solidify the concepts while doing mixed bag sums. They also did number line sums as part of HOTS questions and enjoyed a lot.



HINDI

During this week students had revision of matras by doing related work in their notebook. They also practiced and wrote the words on the blackboard as part of the dictation.



CRAFT

This week students made fishes using techniques of origami and paper cutting. They decorated the fishes by using poster colours and papers.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During this week students participated in discussions related to natural things and man made. While doing this activity they observed the things in their surroundings to find and differentiate between man made and natural things. They enjoyed making illustrations related to the topic.





This week Class 1 focused on reading and comprehension skills with an emphasis on understanding stories and answering questions. They worked on fluency, voice modulation and expressions. This helped the students feel more confident and fluent when reading aloud, making their reading smooth and enjoyable.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Class 1 were introduced to a new chapter: Seasons. They learned about the different types of seasons and how our clothing choices change accordingly. Their curiosity led them to explore the unique characteristics of each season. They were also able to complete worksheets on the topic independently, demonstrating their understanding. Additionally, a revision session on Air, Water, and Weather was conducted to reinforce previous learning.





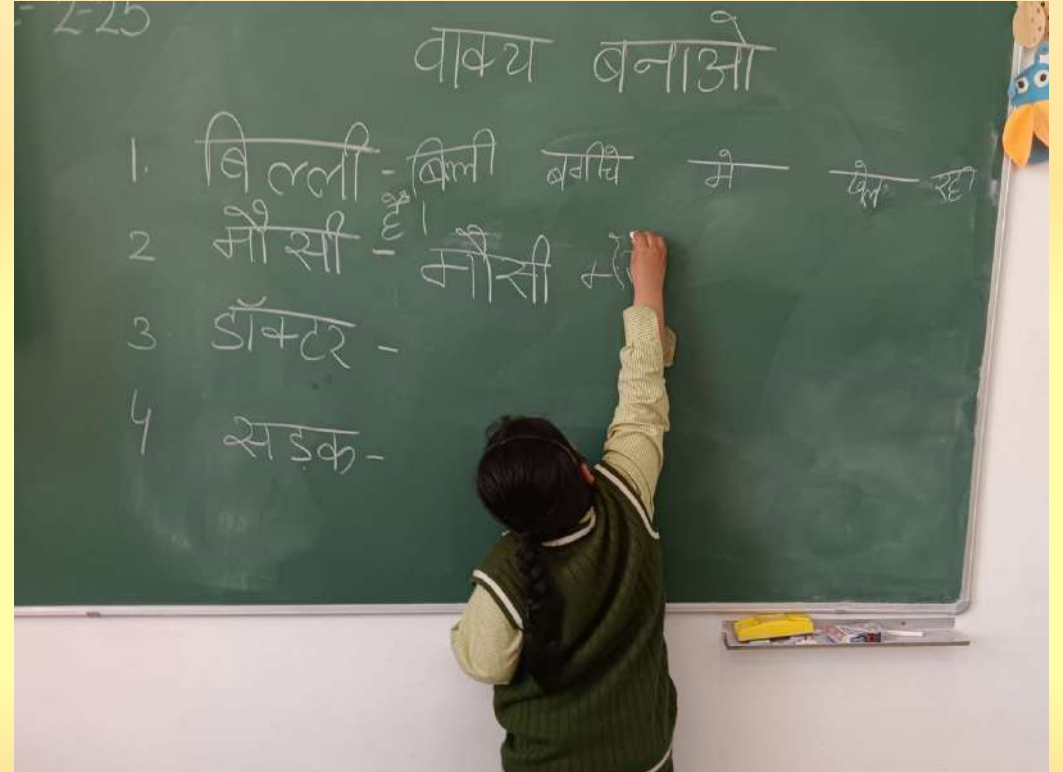

Poem recitation helps young children develop language skills, memory, emotional expression, and confidence in public speaking while making learning fun through rhythm and vocabulary. In February, Class 2 students recited the poem Tiptoe, enjoying a playful moment as they tiptoed around each other. They also revised the concepts of conjunctions and prepositions and completed a class assignment based on them.





This week, our Class 2 students reinforced their learning through a comprehensive revision of the chapters 'Plants', 'Animals', and 'Universe'. The revision exercises included both verbal and written activities, helping to solidify their understanding of these key concepts.





This week, Grade 2 students focused on the importance of revision in math, especially with multiplication tables, which are essential for building strong mathematical foundations. They revised key concepts such as metric measures, tables, and story questions involving multiplication and division. Students also worked on several worksheets in their notebooks and workbooks, specifically on pictographs, to enhance their skills in representing data. This hands-on exercise helped them better understand data visualization while making the learning process fun and engaging.
