# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Students dived into the world of letter O, and its related story .They practised writing, solved and coloured the worksheets, and revisited previous letters through the Magic Box. This activity boosted phonetic awareness, vocabulary, and language skills.

# MATHS

This week, nursery students learned the number 18. They practiced writing the number and completed worksheets to understand it better. The children also revised the previous numbers they had learned and did number-concept activities to strengthen their understanding. These simple and engaging tasks helped the students recognize and write the number 18 confidently.



# HINDI

This week, students explored the letter **ब**, learning words associated with it and colouring worksheets. Through the Jadui Pitara activity, they discovered new vocabulary and revised previous letters as well. Students practised correct pronunciation reinforcing their understanding.



# JADUI PITARA

Our Nursery students explored letters G and O through the Magic Box activity. They participated in engaging stories and objects starting with these letters. The interactive approach helped them grasp phonics concepts easily. The children enjoyed participating in letter-related tasks, enhancing their vocabulary and language skills.



# KINDERGARTEN



## ENGLISH

This week, in English class the kids practiced “e” family words with enthusiasm and enjoyed revising them through reading and repetition. They also completed worksheets related to the e family words in their workbooks. Children also learned the pronunciation and writing practice of ig and it words such as pig, dig, fit, and lit.

# MATHS

This week kindergarten children were introduced to the concept of addition. They engaged in hands-on activities that helped them understand how numbers come together to form a total. Along with addition, the children also practiced arranging numbers in ascending order, which strengthened their number sense and improved their ability to compare quantities with confidence.



# HINDI

This week, the children were introduced to ढ and ढ. They also practiced writing ढ, ढ, and ढ, which helped strengthen their letter formation skills. Along with this, they enjoyed colouring worksheets that made learning more engaging. Simultaneously, revision of all previously taught letters was carried out, allowing the children to reinforce their understanding and build greater confidence in the language.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

The children became more aware of the important roles of various community helpers in their daily lives. They participated enthusiastically in short role-plays and confidently spoke 2–3 lines about each helper, making the activity both engaging and educational.



# SCIENCE DEMO

This week, the little learners enjoyed an engaging Science Demonstration Class. The teacher explained the formation of day and night using a globe, helping the children understand how the Earth rotates on its axis. Through this hands-on demonstration, the kids clearly observed how sunlight falls on different parts of the Earth, creating day and night.





## ENGLISH

This week in English, students did worksheets related to ai sound words and also did worksheets on the topic a and an. They also read blend and digraph sounds. These activities enhanced their understanding of vowel sounds, blends, and the correct use of articles. They improved their reading skills, writing skills, and ability to recognize sounds in words.

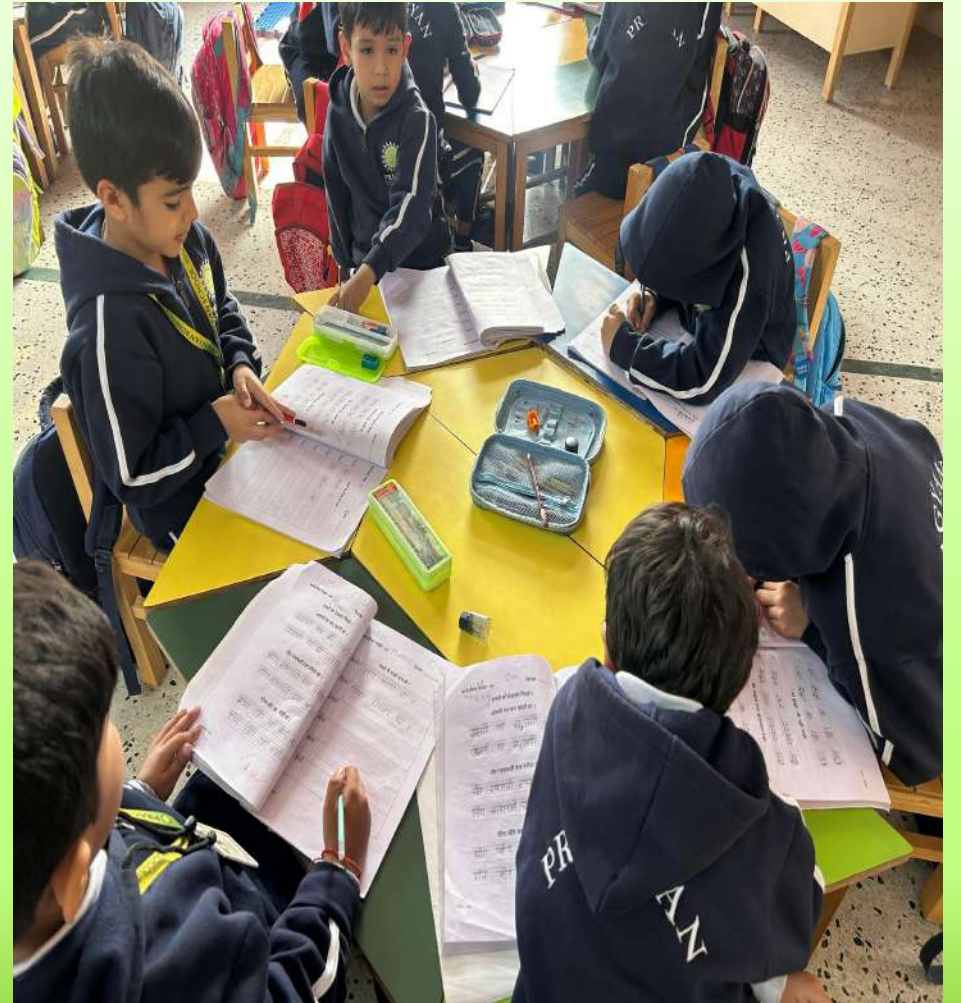
# MATHS

This week in Maths, students compared numbers in their notebooks and revised the concept of what comes after and before. These activities enhanced their understanding of number order and number sense. They improved their thinking skills, observation skills, and ability to compare and identify numbers correctly.



# HINDI

This week in Hindi, students did worksheets related to ई की मात्रा, made sentences with the given words, and revised आ, इ और ई की मात्रा. These activities improved their reading and writing skills and enhanced their understanding of different मात्राएँ. Students also became more confident in making simple sentences. They were also introduced to new words like मेरी, हूँ, है, मेरा आदि, which helped them form better and clearer sentences.



# CIRCLE TIME

This week in Circle Time, students saw the flash cards and identified the modes of transport. They also had a group discussion. These activities enhanced their knowledge about different types of transport. They improved their speaking skills, listening skills, confidence, and ability to share ideas in a group.



## SPROUTS CHAAT ACTIVITY

In continuation of the visit to the school farm—where students observed various plants, vegetables, and learned how they grow—a germination activity was conducted for the Upper Kindergarten learners. The children placed seeds in cotton, watered them, and closely watched as tiny roots and shoots sprouted over time. As part of the learning outcome, the students also prepared a sprouts chaat in school under the supervision of their class teachers. They peeled and cut vegetables, mixed the sprouts, and assembled the chaat themselves. These hands-on activities enhanced their fine motor skills, observation skills, and confidence. The children also became more responsible and developed an understanding of the importance of healthy food..

# HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

This week in hands-on activities, students did different activities related to ai and ay sound words in English and आ, इ और ई की मात्रा in Hindi. # VALUE BASED STORY

# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

This week, our pre-primary students participated in Fun with Shapes, an Inter-Class Activity conducted on 19th November, 2025 where they created a robot, transport and a scene of sea beach using basic shapes like squares, rectangles, circles and triangles. They showcased their creativity and imagination, making their pictures unique. Prior practice was given to all the students in regular classes. The activity helped develop their fine motor skills and problem-solving abilities. The best entries will soon be awarded with the certificates of merit.

# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY





This week, the children were introduced to pronouns and also revised the concept of gender. They practised using pronouns in their notebooks with interest. The concept of one and many was also revised to strengthen their understanding. Additionally, the students revisited punctuation through engaging class activities that made learning enjoyable. The week concluded with an unseen passage for reading comprehension, which the children attempted with confidence, showcasing improved reading and understanding skills.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week, the children were introduced to the topic Shelter through an engaging explanation and discussion. They read the chapter from the textbook and completed related exercises with interest. The students practised fill-in-the-blanks and other notebook work to strengthen their understanding. As part of AIL, they enjoyed drawing a kutcha house and a pucca house creatively in their notebooks.





Children of class 1 enjoyed learning the concept of repeated addition through fun examples and activities. They also practised three-digit subtraction and solved sums with great interest. Students participated actively and showed good understanding of both topics. Hands-on practice helped them build confidence in their calculations.





# हिन्दी

# हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह कक्षा 2 के विद्यार्थियों ने हिन्दी में “खिलौनेवाला” पाठ का अध्ययन किया तथा क्रिया से संबंधित अभ्यास को दोहराया। साथ ही, माह की कविता का भी भावपूर्ण अध्ययन कराया गया। पाठ और व्याकरण की समझ को गहरा करने के लिए कक्षा में विभिन्न रोचक गतिविधियाँ आयोजित की गईं। बच्चों ने क्रिया शब्दों की पहचान, उनका वाक्यों में प्रयोग, तथा खिलौनेवाला अध्याय के नए शब्दों, प्रश्न-उत्तर, और कहानी की घटनाओं को समझने का अभ्यास किया। पढ़ने और लिखने के प्रति विद्यार्थियों में आत्मविश्वास बढ़ाने पर विशेष ध्यान दिया गया। बच्चों ने बड़े उत्साह के साथ गतिविधियों में भाग लिया तथा सुंदर-सुंदर खिलौने बनाकर अपनी सृजनात्मकता का उत्कृष्ट प्रदर्शन किया।





Students of Grade II have begun a new chapter in EVS titled “Directions and Maps.” They have read the chapter in class, taken part in an interactive discussion with the teacher, and watched a reference video to understand the concepts better. The children also explored simple map symbols, learnt about different road signs, and practiced identifying basic directions. On the tree, children wrote multiplication tables (6 to 9) Enthusiastically they participated in the activity.

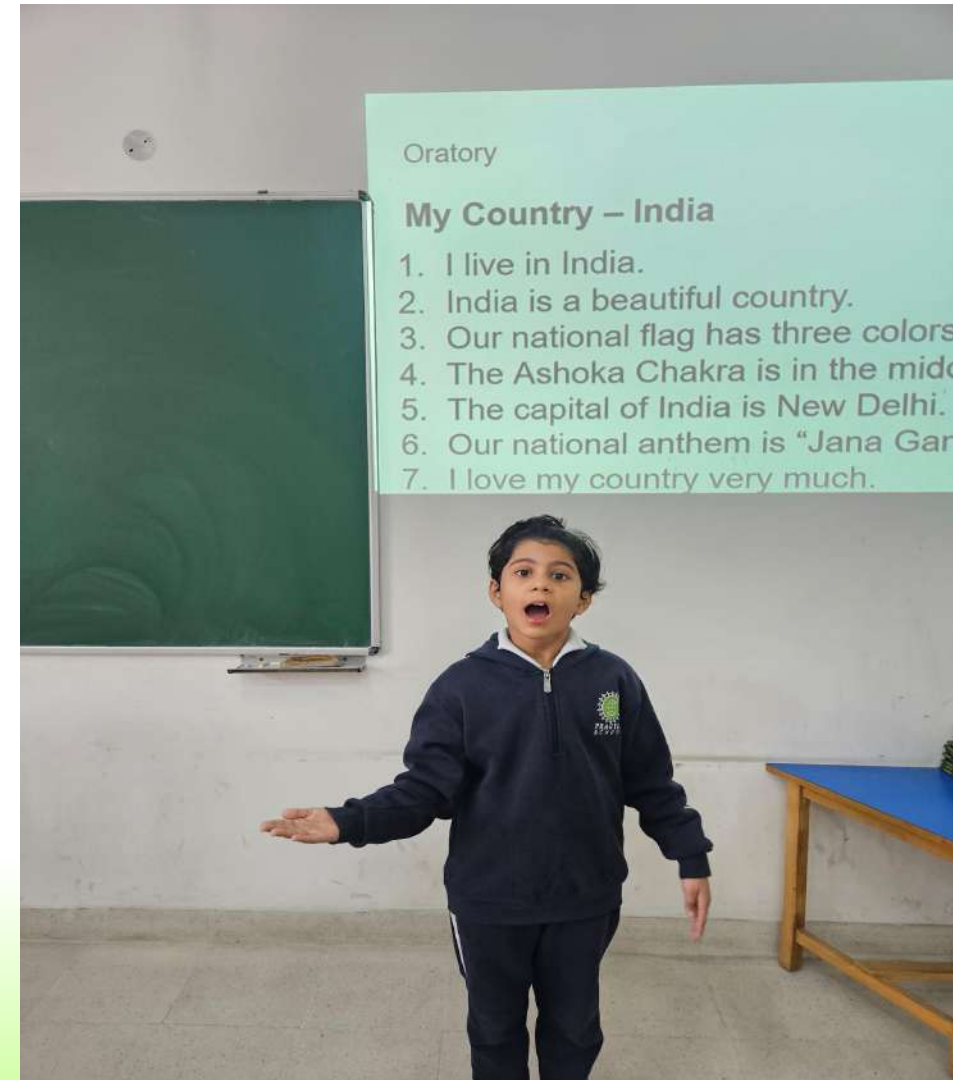
# COMPUTER

Students of Class 2 enthusiastically explored the creative features of Paint 3D in their Computer Science class. # ORATORY

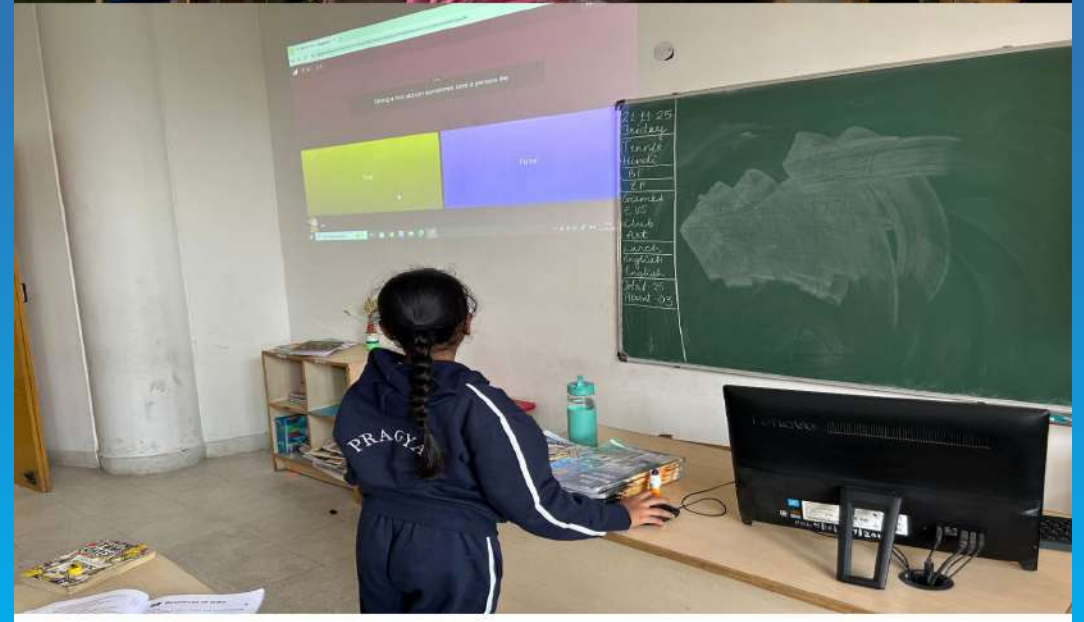

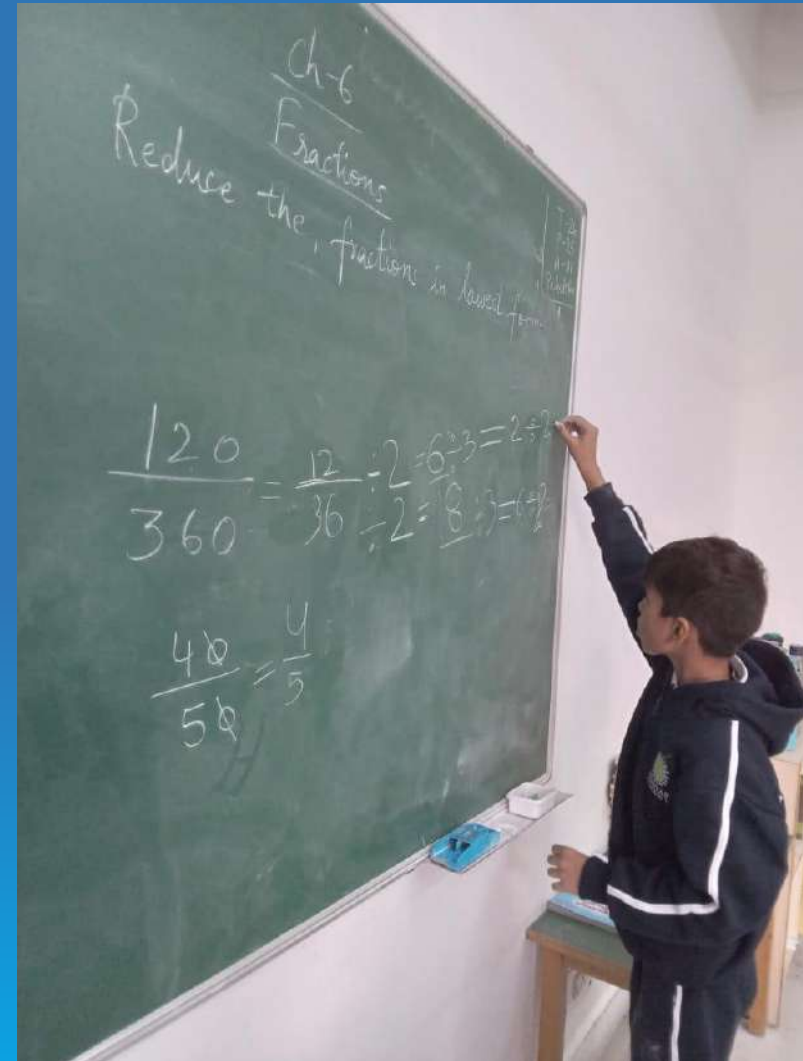
# हिन्दी

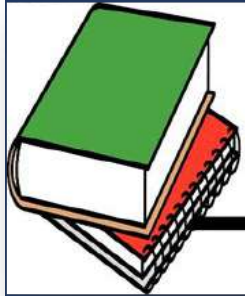




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

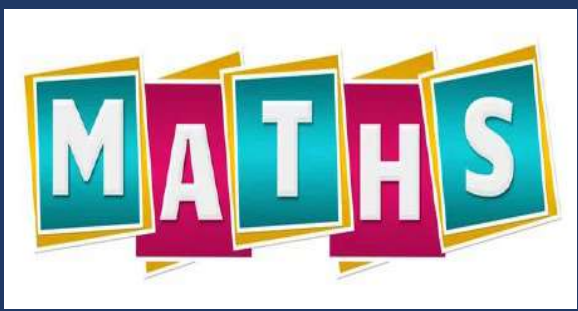




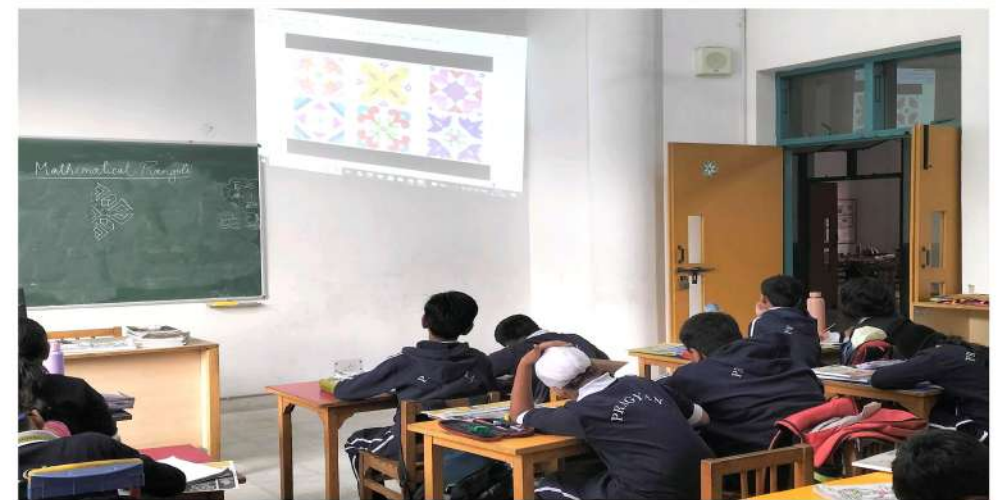
# हिन्दी
