NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter 'L' was introduced in nursery through flashcards, pictures related to letter L and Jolly Phonics song. Students enjoyed writing the letter 'L' in their workbook. Students also did sandpaper tracing of letter L.



SCIENCE DEMO

Students of nursery enjoyed doing the science demo rough & smooth, hard & soft where students touched various objects with their hands and could feel their textures.



MATHS

Number 1 was introduced to the nursery children and they did worksheets of number 1 in Maths workbook and in their notebooks. Children also did counting of number 1 using different objects and sandpaper tracing of number 1 was also done in the class.

The Pre-Number Concept of “Big and Small” was introduced to the children and worksheet related to the same was done.



HINDI

Recapitulation of Vyanjan 'क' was done in the class with the help of pictures and children did sandpaper tracing of Vyanjan 'क'. Children also enjoyed learning the Rhyme "एक दो तीन."



GENERAL AWARENESS

Recapitulation of the topic **Myself** was done as part **General Awareness**. The children were encouraged to say small sentences like “I am a boy/girl, My name is during the class. Children also did a worksheet in the book “World around me” on related topic where they did colouring and thumb printing.



EVS

Recapitulation of bird Pigeon was done during EVS class with the help of pictures. Discussion about Pigeon and their habitat was done with the children.

Dance - There are shortcuts to happiness and dancing is one of them. Students of class Nursery enjoyed dancing on “Bhallu Wala Aya...Sath me Bhallu Laya” whereas students of KG enjoyed practicing Action Dance during their dance class.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Introduction of letters 'c' and 'd' was done through flashcards and pictures. Phonics sound of 'c' and 'd' was taught to children. They practiced writing the letters 'c' and 'd' in their workbook and notebook. Introduction of sight words (I, am, a, girl, boy) was done through flash cards.

MATHS

Children of kindergarten wrote 0-30 in their notebooks. The concept of back counting was reviewed through number cards. Children did worksheets based on the concept of back counting (20-0).



HINDI

Introduction of swar आ and इ was done through flash cards and pictures. Children wrote आ and इ in their workbook and notebook.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Children of Kindergarten were introduced to Our Five Senses . Discussion on the functions of each sense organ were explained to them through flash cards .



EVS

During EVS class, students of Kindergarten were introduced to the pet animal Cat. They were shown pictures of cats of different colors. Children were informed about a few facts related to cats i.e. young ones and food.

As part of Earth Day celebration, students of classes Nursery & KG were informed that the Earth day is observed every year on April 22. They were also informed of a few ways to take care of mother earth and to make this planet a better place to live in. Students of both the classes made earth badges in their regular craft class.

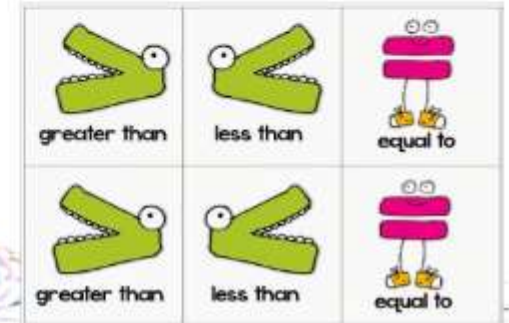

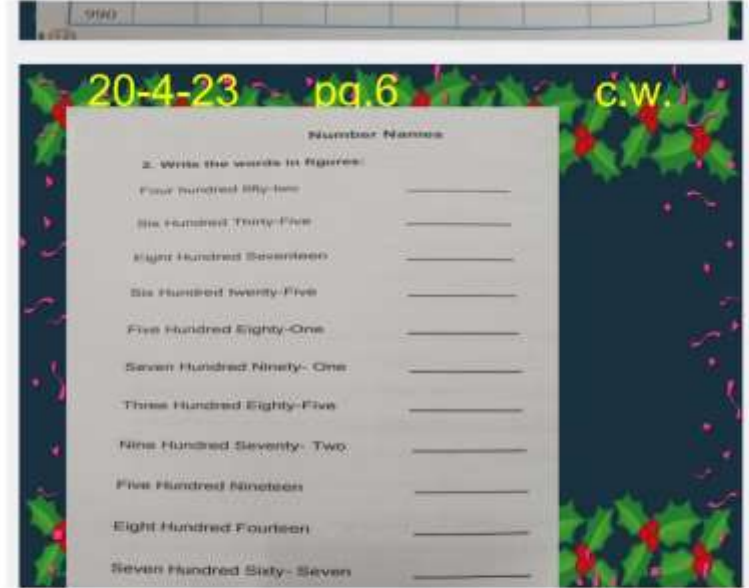




Math

It is important to know counting as when children are counting, they're performing a more cognitive activity when they're associating an object with a number to represent a quantity. Students of class 2 were introduced to counting forward from number 500. They enjoyed learning the concept of counting forward and tried doing some worksheets based on number names.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed playing the xylophone. They learnt xylophone patterns Practice & notes CDEFGABC (upward backward). Children also learnt how to play Bongo. They are learning four by four patterns in Bongo.

VOCAL MUSIC (CLASS 1)

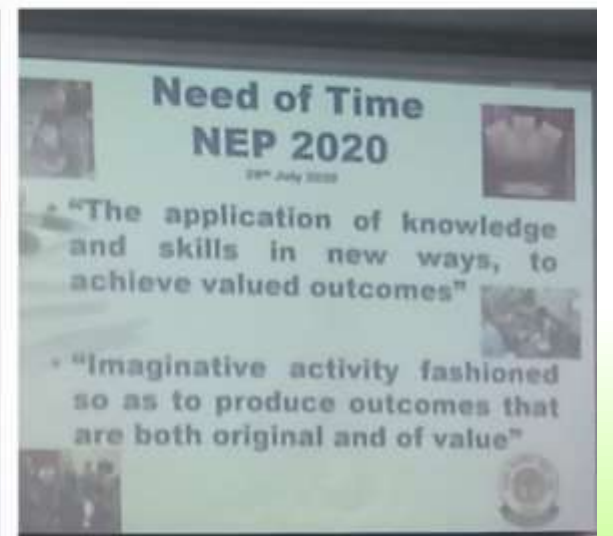
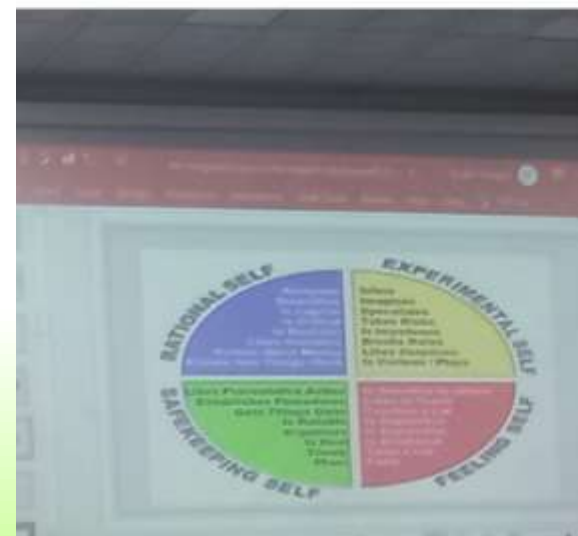
SLOGAN WRITING ACTIVITY
