NURSERY

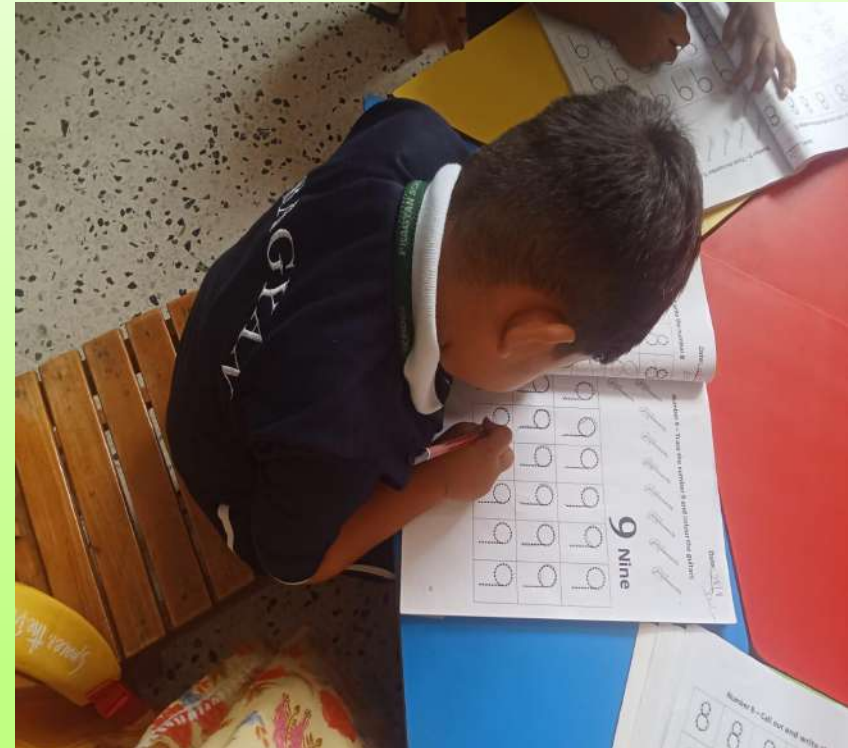


ENGLISH

Letter M was introduced to the children with the help of flashcards and different objects. They also did Jolly phonics song of letter M which they enjoyed. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook and also practiced writing letter M in their notebook.

MATHS

This week number 9 was introduced to the students using blocks and they also did worksheets related to the number. Children did counting using blocks and they also practiced writing number 9 in their notebook.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'ट' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'ट' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

The nursery students explored festivals in General Awareness this week! They learned about Eid and Christmas, understanding their significance and traditions. They discovered Christmas is celebrated on December 25th, and people enjoy decorating trees and exchanging gifts. On Eid, seviyan is a favorite treat! Colouring brought Eid and Christmas celebrations to life in their books.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Letter n was introduced to the students, they were excited to identify objects that begin with the letter and complete a worksheet on the letter taught. Additionally, a revision of sight words was conducted during the class.

MATHS

This week students learnt the skip count of 2s. They counted numbers in a play way method, known as The bunny jumping activity. The children jumped from one number to the next by adding 2 each time. Skip counting by 2s helped them to understand patterns and made counting faster.



HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan न. To make learning more engaging, students were encouraged to colour pictures beginning with vyanjan न. This helped them associate visual creativity with language learning.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

A recap of the vyanjans taught were revised using flashcards. The flashcards were spread out in front of the students, they had to identify the vyanjan on each card and name words that begin with that vyanjan. They really enjoyed this activity, and it greatly helped them to review and reinforce the concept.





ENGLISH

During the week students practiced digraphs th,wh and were able to say the sounds of these digraphs. They could segregate the digraphs according to the sounds and tried reading the passage “The Whale” given in their workbook.

MATHS

During this week students learn ordinal numbers. Ordinal numbers are used in everyday situations, such as determining the order of finishing in a race, the position of an item in a list, or the date. Understanding this helps children relate to the world around them. Learning about order helps in developing logical thinking and reasoning skills.



GENERAL AWARENESS

During this week the topic of community helper was continued, where students did various worksheets to know more and develop a better understanding on the topic. The combination of writing and colouring made the learning process interactive and enjoyable.



SCIENCE DEMONSTRATION

During this experiment students understood about air. They were explained that air has weight, it occupies space, it can move things with pressure and uses of air. To understand the concept more clearly they practically blew certain things. Students understood that the inflated balloon is heavier than the deflated balloon, by doing experiment they knew how the air occupies space.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (UKG)

During this week students did ordinal numbers during hands-on activity. They had to recognise the word, match it with its numerical value, and arrange them in proper order. They also learnt the spellings of ordinal numbers one to ten. To understand this topic better, students participated in an activity where they stood in a queue and according to their position they picked the flash card with the number.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: NUMBER FUN

As part of Inter class activity, students of Nursery participated in Number Fun Activity that was held on 28th August 2024. The children were engaged in Hula hoops with numeral flashcards arranged in a circle, with balls at the center. Individually, students recognized numbers, collected corresponding balls, and developed their numeracy skills. It was a participative activity, promoting independent learning. As part of Number Fun activity and based on the concepts taught, kindergarten students were asked to answer a series of questions and identify shapes in various pictures. They counted triangles, squares, and other shapes as part of the challenge.

INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: NUMBER FUN

The students of UKG were asked to answer a series of questions on patterns, place value, questions related to critical and logical thinking. This activity helped to understand students' mathematical skills in an interactive way. The meritorious students were awarded with the certificate of merit.





Students of Class 1 recited the monthly poem “The swing” and learned new vocabulary words, which they also wrote down as part of their classwork. During the session, the concept of helping verbs was introduced, providing them with a foundational understanding of the topic. To enhance their retention, a video was shown, which visually explained the concept. Following the video, the teacher engaged the students with oral questions to assess their comprehension.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

This week in EVS children did the verbal revision of the chapters taught. They read the Chapter National Festivals and did the worksheets based on the same, along with that they also did some notebook work.





Children of class 1 revised sums based on addition. Along with number names , tens and ones from 50 - 69 were covered in this week. Children showed excitement in learning the topics taught. Relevant videos and PPTs were also shown to enhance learning.

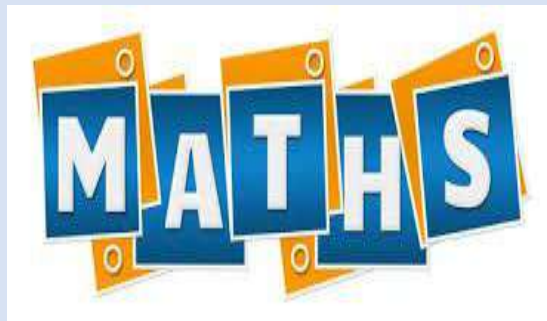




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Revision helps recall the details of the topic studied in class. Revising the topics helps students gain more confidence. This week students of class 2 revised chapters- Time to celebrate and Work & Play during their EVS class.





Learning shapes not only helps children identify and organize visual information, it helps them learn skills in other curriculum areas including reading, math and science. Students of class 2 were introduced to the Chapter: Shapes, where they could recognise a few 2D shapes. They practiced solving sums of subtraction and multiplication in their notebooks. They also revised facts of multiplication, subtraction along with the tables from 5 to 9.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Children of classes 1 and 2 were engaged in practicing the tune of the "Happy Birthday" song on the keyboard. This activity not only helped them strengthen their musical abilities, such as hand-eye coordination and rhythmic timing, but also contributed to their overall brain development by enhancing cognitive functions like memory and concentration.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Students of grade 2 were told about the famous artist S.H.Raza and they also tried to copy his drawings. This activity was conducted in pairs. Grade 1 students enjoyed drawing a scenery in their art file.

VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)



Children of classes 1 and 2 practiced singing and learning song - Aare badal kale badal. They enjoyed singing in groups and solo with relevant tunes of instruments.

DANCE (1&2)

Dance helps to explore feelings. Students of classes 1&2 are enthusiastically preparing for their upcoming events.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children of classes 1 and 2 learnt general and specific warm up with agility exercises like jumping, high knees, Tapping. They also learned the basics skills of badminton like forehand clear and in fun games they did passing with the ball to improve hand-eye coordination.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

Reading a book can be a fun and enjoyable way to spend leisure time. Students of classes 1 & 2 have spent their time in the library reading books and learning new things.

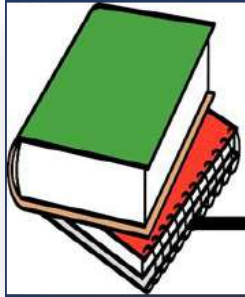




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

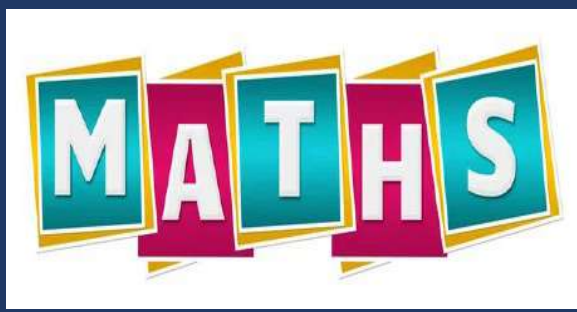




हिन्दी

Students of class 5 learnt to perform on the shloka, Vakratunda Mahakaya during this week in their Kathak Class.



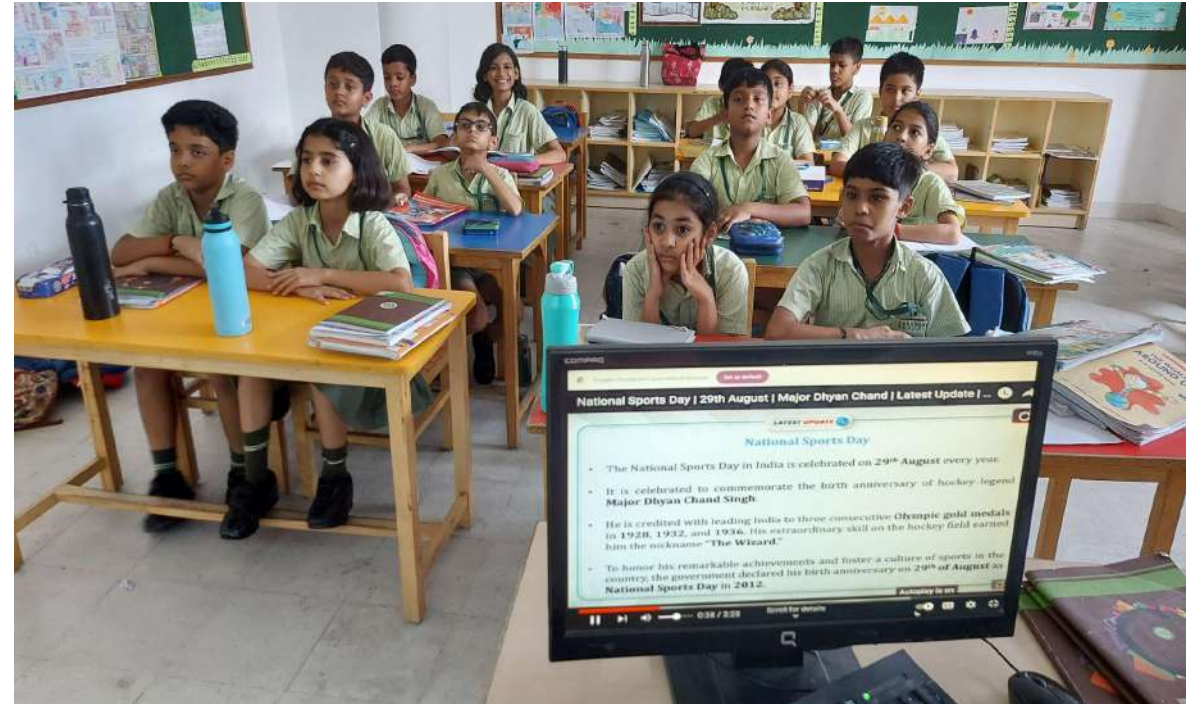
VOCAL MUSIC(3-5)
