NURSERY



ENGLISH

Students learned A to Z small and capital letters and revised their phonic sounds. They also explored words beginning with different letters to strengthen their vocabulary. Various activities were conducted to enhance their recognition and understanding of letters and sounds.

MATHS

Students learned and revised counting from 0 to 30 through oral practice and engaging activities. They practised writing numbers from 0 to 30 and strengthened their understanding through revision of before and after numbers. Various interactive activities helped reinforce number recognition and sequencing skills.



CRAFT

Students used different techniques to make various crafts to showcase on their Annual Day. They explored creative ideas and materials while making the crafts. The activities were done in groups, which made the experience enjoyable and encouraged teamwork. Students participated enthusiastically, making the learning process engaging and memorable.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Revision of previously learned concepts was carried out to strengthen the children's language skills. Regular practice of writing sentences, reading short paragraphs, and revising CVC words is being continued as an ongoing learning process to improve their reading and writing abilities.

MATHS

Recapitulation of all the previously learned concepts was done during the week. Children revised ascending and descending order, greater than and lesser than, as well as forward and backward counting. This revision helped strengthen their understanding and improve their numerical skills.



HINDI

Practice of two-letter words, three-letter words, and simple sentence writing was done during the week. Children were also engaged in regular reading practice to improve their vocabulary, pronunciation, and overall language skills.





ENGLISH

In English, the students revised positional words by actively participating in a hands-on activity. They placed different objects in various positions and confidently described the position of each object using the correct positional words. This activity helped strengthen their understanding of positional concepts while also improving their speaking skills, vocabulary, and confidence in expressing themselves clearly.



MATHS

Students revised addition and subtraction using number lines. Each student got an opportunity to solve the given sums with the help of the number line. This activity strengthened their understanding of addition and subtraction and improved their problem-solving skills, number sense, and confidence in solving sums independently.



GENERAL AWARENESS

The students revised the parts of a plant through an engaging board activity. The activity strengthened their understanding of plant parts and improved their observation skills, memory, and ability to identify and relate concepts correctly.



HINDI

In Hindi, the students revised picture composition. Each student came forward and spoke four to five lines about the given picture. This activity improved their speaking skills, sentence formation, vocabulary, and confidence in expressing their thoughts clearly in the language.





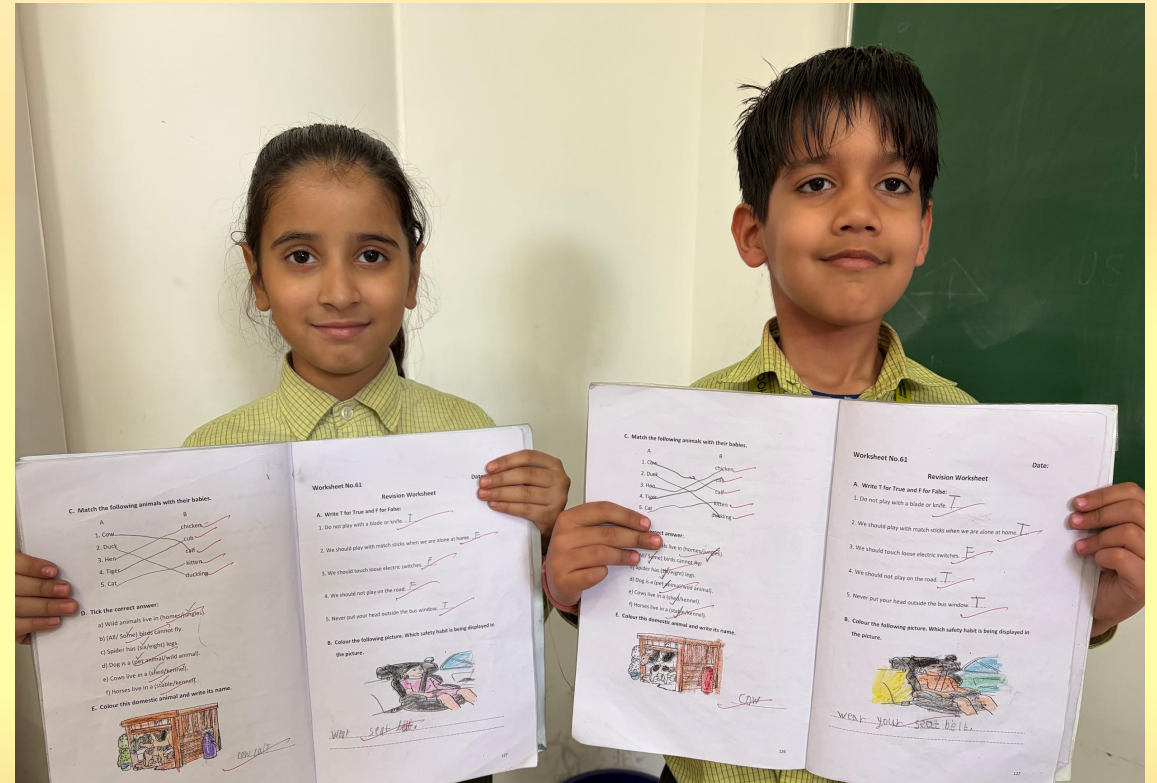
The week was filled with joyful learning and cheerful classroom moments. Students confidently recited the poem “I Like School” and shared the Words of the Month, enhancing their vocabulary. They completed an unseen passage on the Spring Season and practiced reading comprehension through a passage on Flowers. An oral revision of rhyming and joining words, along with an engaging story time, made the week vibrant and enriching for our young learners.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Children of Class 1 were given a revision worksheet based on the concepts taught in class such as Safety, Community Helpers, and Neighbourhood. The worksheet helped them recall and revise the topics learned in class. Children showed good participation while completing the worksheet.





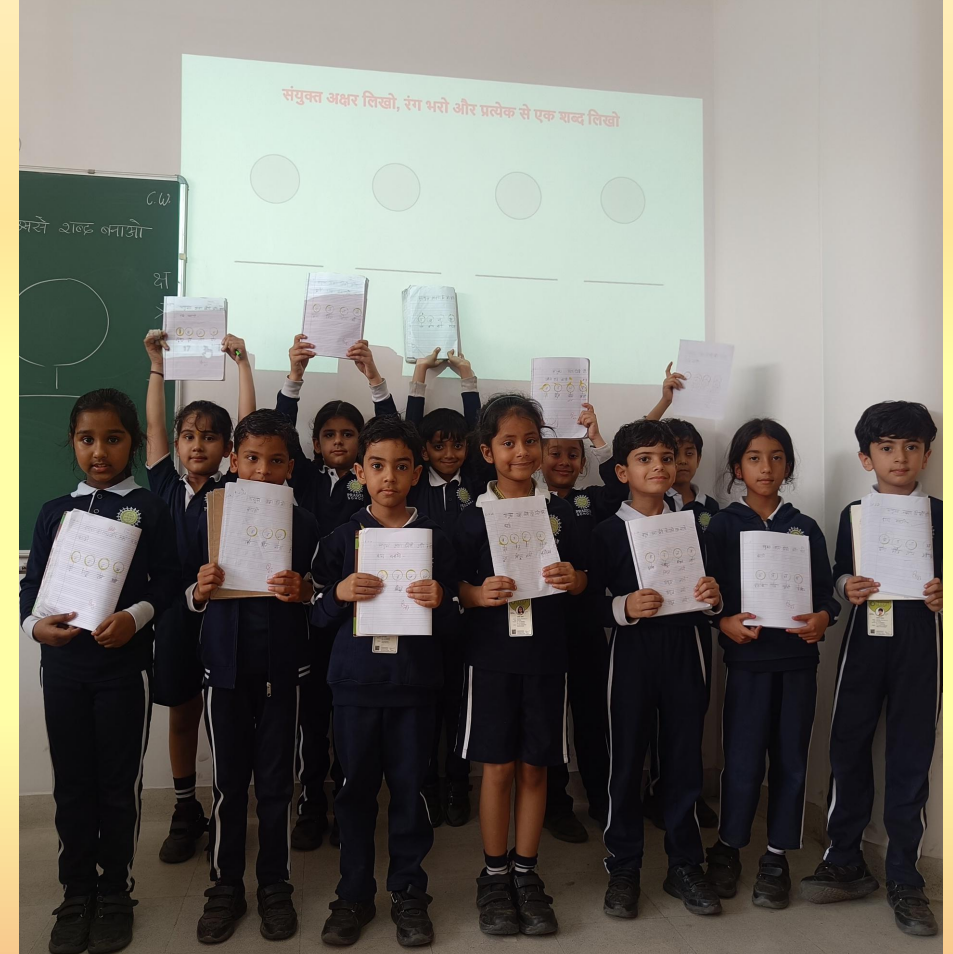
Children of Class 1 enjoyed learning and revising the concept of patterns in class. They practiced identifying and completing different patterns through notebook work and classroom activities. The children showed great interest while recognizing number and shape patterns. This helped them strengthen their understanding of the topic.





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह कक्षा 1 के विद्यार्थियों ने हिंदी विषय में विभिन्न रोचक और शिक्षाप्रद गतिविधियों के माध्यम से अपने भाषा कौशल का अभ्यास किया। विद्यार्थियों ने उत्साह के साथ कविता वाचन किया और सही उच्चारण व भाव के साथ प्रस्तुति देने का प्रयास किया। इसके साथ-साथ वाक्य बनाओ गतिविधि के माध्यम से उन्होंने नए शब्दों का प्रयोग करते हुए सरल व अर्थपूर्ण वाक्य बनाने का अभ्यास किया। विद्यार्थियों के पठन कौशल को विकसित करने के लिए पाठ का पठन कराया गया तथा उस पर आधारित अभ्यास भी करवाए गए। साथ ही संयुक्त अक्षरों की पुनरावृत्ति कराई गई, जिससे बच्चों को उन्हें पहचानने और सही ढंग से लिखने में सहायता मिली। सप्ताह के अंत में एक रोचक गतिविधि कराई गई जिसमें विद्यार्थियों ने संयुक्त अक्षरों को लिखकर उन्हें रंगों से सजाया और प्रत्येक से एक-एक शब्द लिखने का अभ्यास किया। इस गतिविधि के माध्यम से बच्चों की रचनात्मकता, लेखन कौशल और शब्द भंडार को बढ़ावा मिला। सभी विद्यार्थियों ने पूरे उत्साह और लगन के साथ भाग लिया।





हिन्दी

इस सप्ताह छात्रों ने अपठित गद्यांश का अभ्यास किया। उन्होंने कार्यपुस्तिका में दिए गए अपठित गद्यांश से संबंधित प्रश्नों के उत्तर लिखे। इस अभ्यास के माध्यम से छात्रों ने गद्यांश को समझने तथा उसके आधार पर उत्तर देने का प्रयास किया। छात्रों ने ध्यानपूर्वक पाठ पढ़कर सही जानकारी खोजने का अभ्यास किया। इससे उनकी पठन-समझ क्षमता में वृद्धि हुई। साथ ही, माह की कविता का सस्वर वाचन भी कराया गया। छात्रों ने कविता का स्पष्ट और सही उच्चारण के साथ पाठ किया। इस गतिविधि से उनके आत्मविश्वास और भाषा कौशल का भी विकास हुआ।





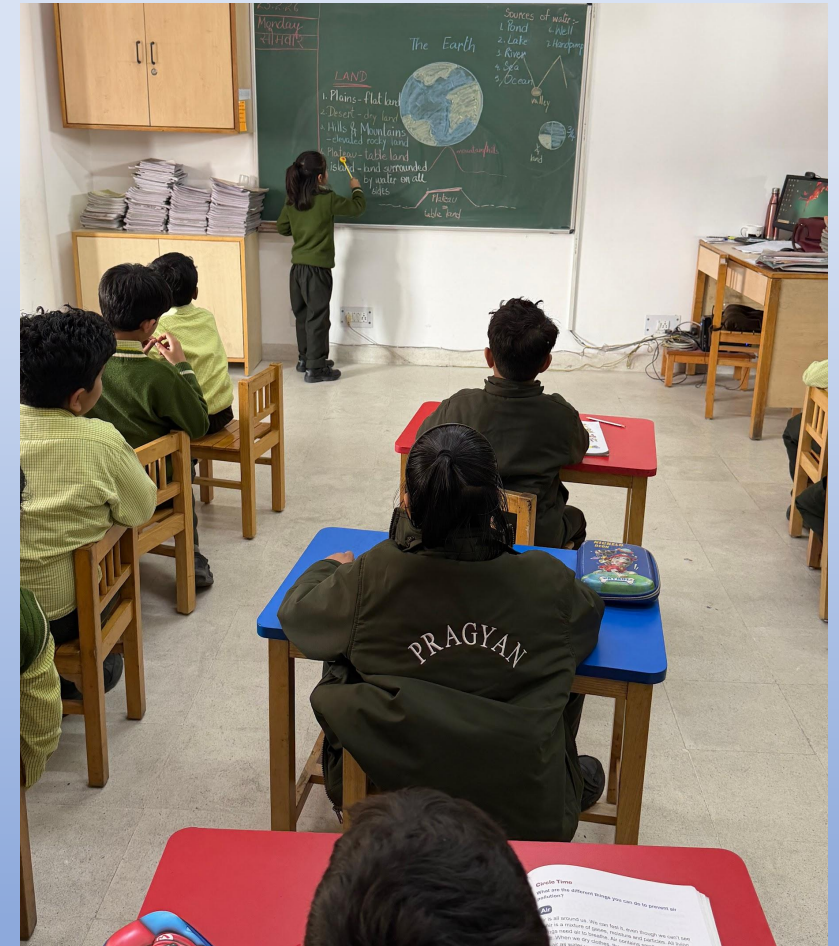
Students of Class 2 practiced recitation of the poem during the week and participated in comprehension and picture composition activities. These activities helped students improve their reading, writing, and understanding skills. Through regular practice, they also learned to express their ideas better and gained confidence in using language.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of Class II were introduced to the new EVS chapter, “The Earth.” Through this lesson, they learned about our planet and explored various landforms such as mountains, plains, and deserts. They were also introduced to different sources of water, including rivers, lakes, and oceans, and discussed the importance of conserving water through simple practices. In addition, students developed basic awareness about air pollution and ways to keep the environment clean and healthy. The topic was reinforced through interactive discussions, reference videos, and classroom activities, helping students deepen their understanding and encouraging them to care for the Earth and its resources.





This week, Class 2 students revised the topics of Addition, Subtraction, Time, and Data Handling. The revision included two-digit and three-digit addition and subtraction along with related word problems. Students also practised reading time (hour and half-hour), days of the week, months of the year, and calendar-based questions. In Data Handling, they worked on reading and interpreting pictographs and answering questions based on simple tables.



ART & CRAFT (1&2)

Grade 1 and Grade 2 students joyfully explored abstract art scenery this week. Through this activity, they experimented with a variety of colours, shapes, and patterns, allowing their creativity and imagination to flow freely. It was delightful to see the young artists confidently expressing their ideas through vibrant artwork and developing an appreciation for artistic expression. The activity encouraged creativity, confidence, and a love for art among the students.



VOCAL MUSIC

This week in the Vocal Music class, students learned the prayer “Mann Usi Ki Karo Prarthana.” The teacher guided them through the tune and meaning, helping them sing it correctly and confidently. The children participated enthusiastically and enjoyed singing together in a joyful and cheerful environment.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The children of Class 2 actively participated in balancing exercises and also enjoyed playing table tennis as a recreational activity during their games period. These activities helped them improve their coordination and balance. The children of Class 1 performed their regular exercises and enthusiastically took part in the fitness test. All students showed great energy and participation.



YOGA

This week, students enthusiastically participated in a refreshing Yoga session. They practiced simple yoga exercises such as standing stretches, side bends, toe touches, twisting movements, and heel raises. The session helped them relax their minds, stretch their bodies, and understand the importance of staying active and maintaining a healthy lifestyle. It was wonderful to see the students smiling and enjoying the calm yet energetic atmosphere.

Students of Class 3 revised the grammatical concept of Question Words, followed by written practice exercises. They also wrote a paragraph on the topic A Visit to the Hill Station.





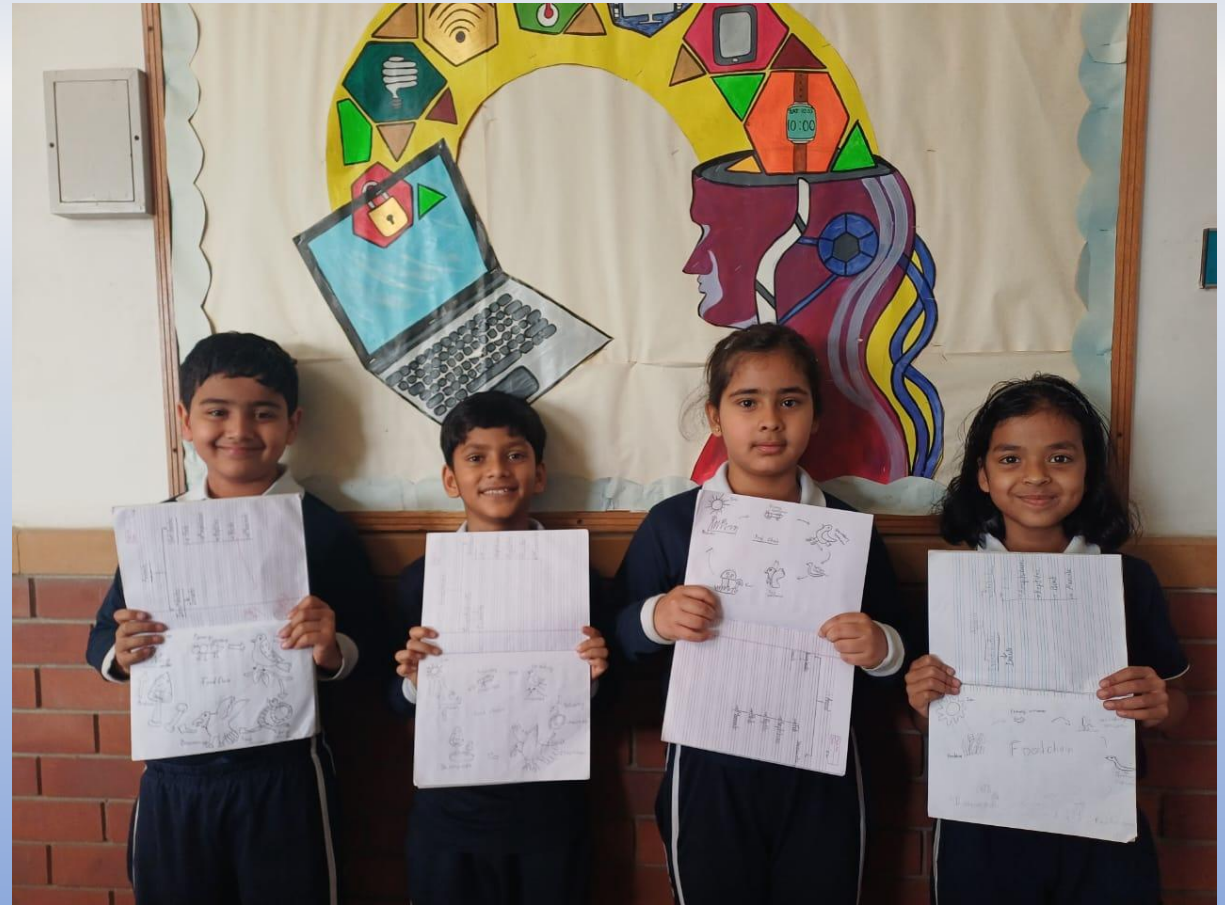
Students of grade 3 revised and practiced the concept of division. They revised the long division method by recalling the multiplication tables and dodging. They practiced the related questions in the notebook.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

In Class 3, a mind map related to the lesson “Animals” was drawn by the students in their notebooks. Through this activity, the children differentiated between herbivores, carnivores, omnivores, and frugivores, along with suitable examples of each. A video related to the topic was also shown in the class to enhance the students' understanding of the concepts.





Students of Grade 4 revised different grammatical concepts such as nouns, pronouns, adjectives, and prepositions. They also completed exercises related to these topics in their workbooks to reinforce their understanding.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Class 4 completed the chapter “Know Your Government.” To make the concept more engaging and practical, a mock election was conducted in the class to select the class monitor. This activity helped students understand the process of voting and the importance of choosing representatives in a democratic system. 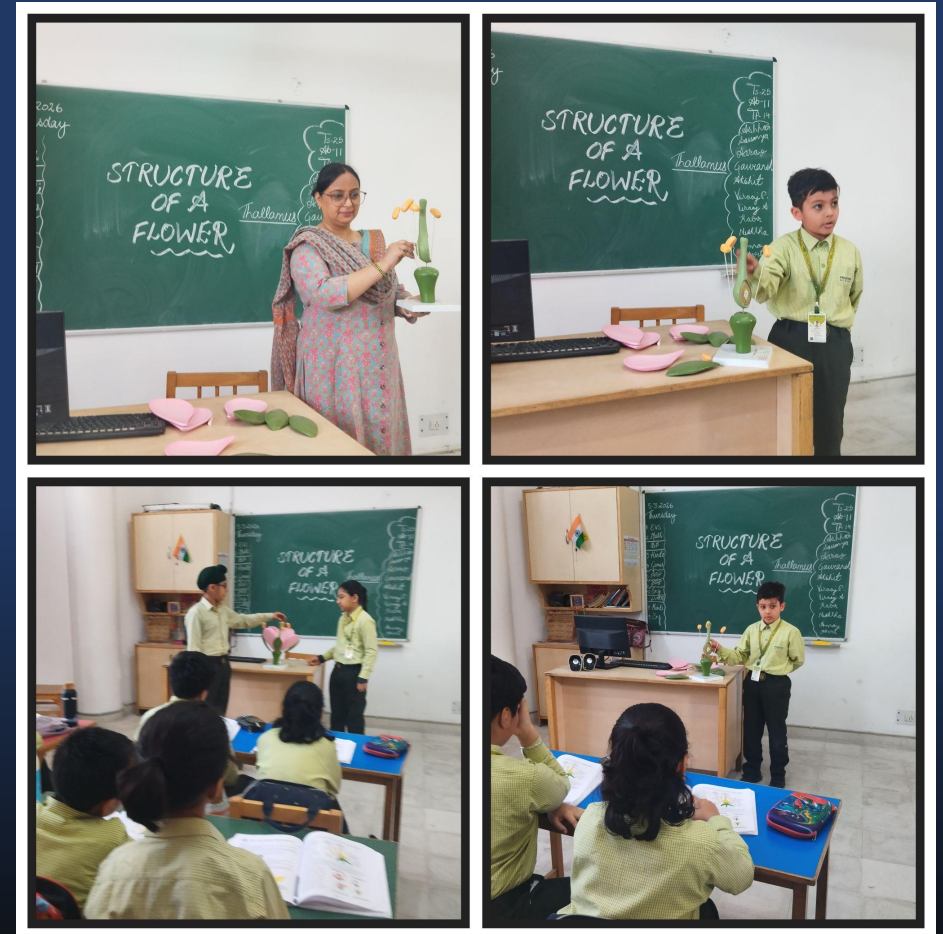

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Grade 5 students revised some important concepts that they had previously learned in Class 5, including Fundamental Rights and Fundamental Duties. This revision helped them recall and strengthen their understanding of the basic rights and responsibilities of citizens. In addition to this, students were introduced to the structure of a flower. They carefully observed a model of a flower in the classroom and learned about its different parts, such as petals, sepals, stamens, and pistils. They were also explained the functions of each part, helping them understand how flowers play an important role in plant reproduction.





Grade 5 students revised some important grammar topics such as Conjunctions, Active-Passive and narration that they had already learned in Class 5. They also practised for their Role Play on the chapter Pepper the Phantom Pet. They started working on their projects.

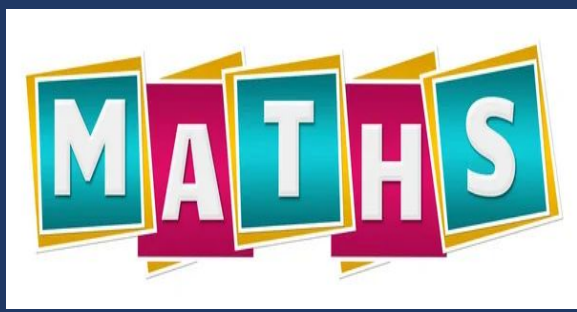




हिन्दी
