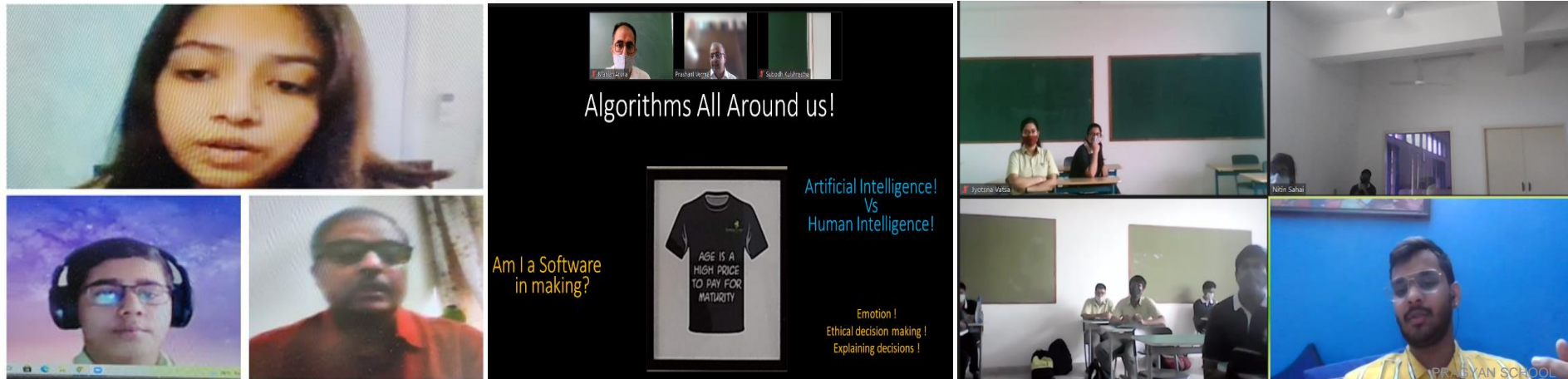
MORNING ASSEMBLY [IX-XII]

On Thursday, students participated in an activity "My NOT-TO-DO-LIST" where students answered the different questions to assess what not to do in their daily routine.

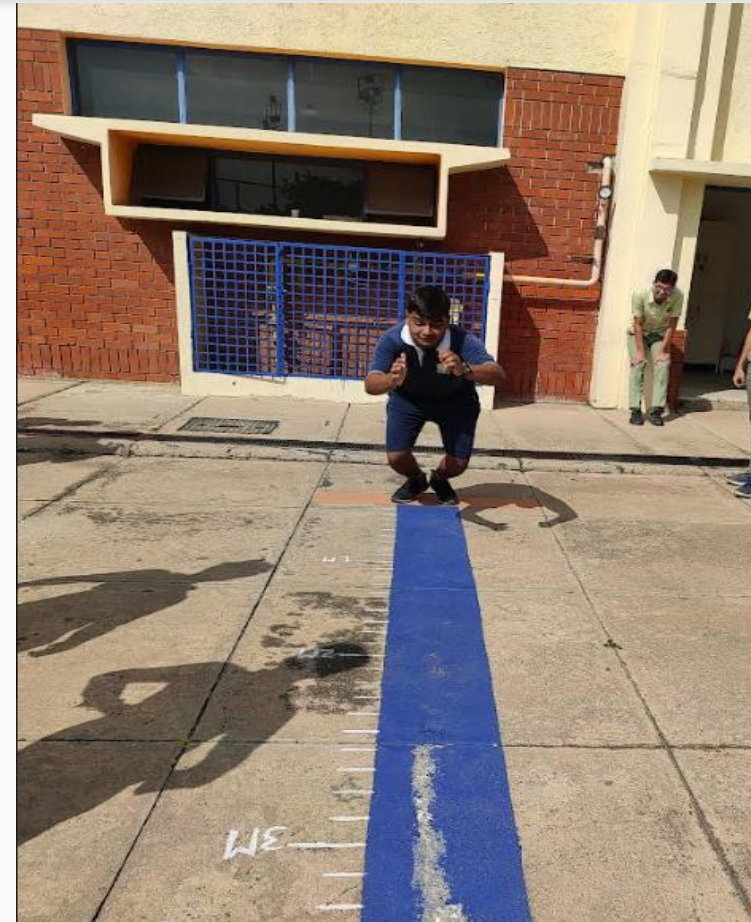
- Stuff that distracts me and wastes my time.

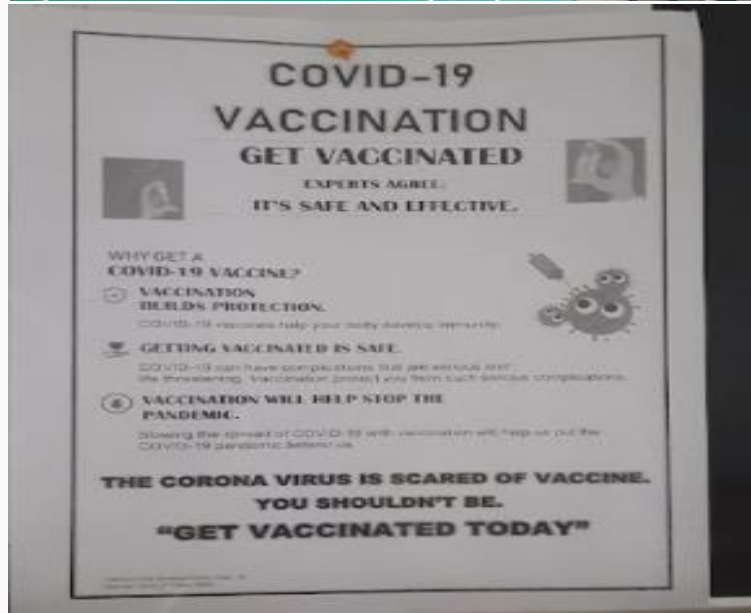
