ENGLISH

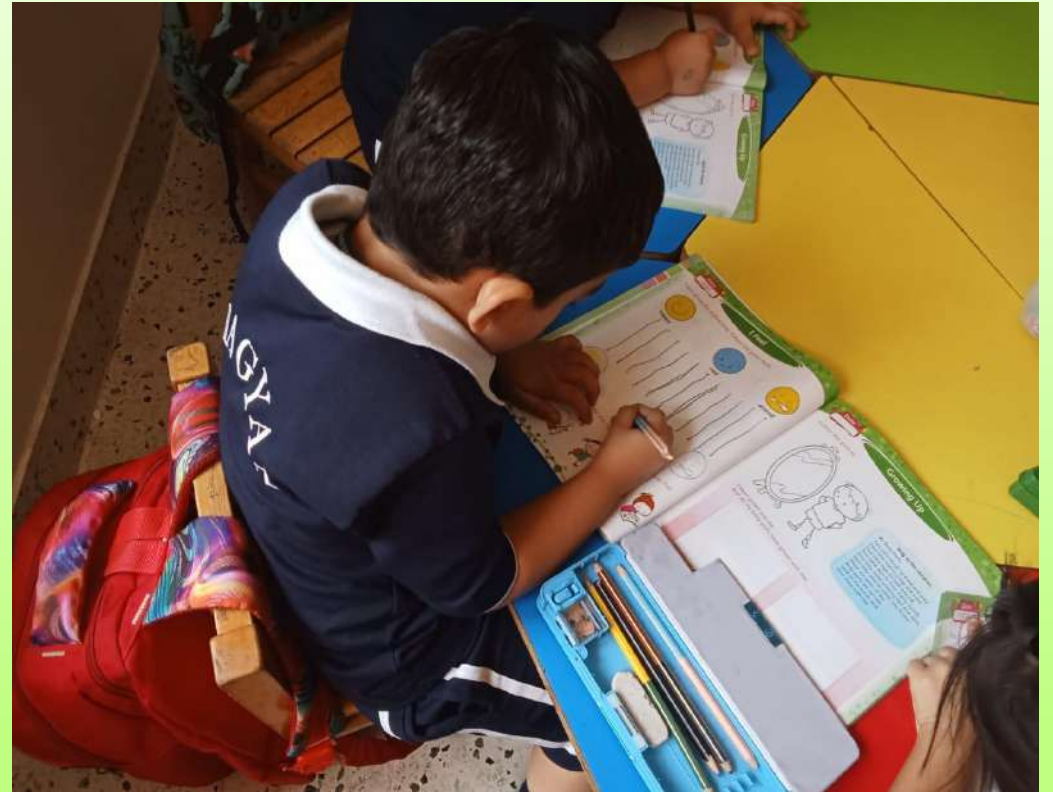
HINDI

KINDERGARTEN



HINDI

Recap of swar अ,आ,इ,ई,उ,ऊ, ए,ऐ was done with the help of flash cards and sandpaper tracing. Introduction of swar औ was done with the help of pictures and stories, students also practiced writing swar in their workbook and notebook.

GENERAL AWARENESS

During this week students learned about the nuclear family, they also did colouring in their workbook related to the topic.





ENGLISH

Learning about CVC words is an important tool in phonics as it can help children with reading, writing and rhyming three-phoneme words. Students recapitulated of cvc words and digraph 'ch' was introduced through an activity.

MATHS

Learning to count backwards can be a valuable skill for kids as it helps them to understand place value in math. Students did backward counting 100-1 and ascending order in the workbook and notebook.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week students practiced written work on the topic My family. They were able to recognize the family members and could write the names using the helpbox.



DANCE(NUR-UKG)

This week the students from Nur - UKG shined brightly. They learned new steps and danced with great enthusiasm.



VOCAL MUSIC (NUR-UKG)

This week in music class, Nur.- UKG students explored rhythm through clapping games and simple percussion instruments. They enjoyed singing familiar nursery rhymes, fostering their love for music and enhancing their coordination skills.



VALUE BASED EDUCATION: UKG

As part of a value based education, the students of UKG were introduced to the story 'All Together.' Stories help stimulate imagination, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills as children explore different scenarios and outcomes within the narrative.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

To have a better understanding of the subject material taught in their regular class, students of KG revised the swar taught in class and matched the objects with the correct swar. Students of UKG were engaged in various activities like introduction to positional words (in ,on ,under), creating 3 letter words in Hindi, and also learnt about different directions.



SPLASH POOL

During this week students typically enjoy splash pools by splashing around, giggling, and socializing while developing gross motor skills.

As part of sand pit activity, students built sandcastles, dug tunnels, created roads and simply ran their fingers through the sand. Sand play encourages creativity, problem-solving, and social interaction as they collaborate with peers to build structures.



SKILL BASED LEARNING (KG-UKG)

This week, students of Kindergarten & UKG were engaged in learning how to make lemonade. Learning simple recipes like lemonade not only introduces basic cooking skills but also fosters independence and creativity in the kitchen. This process encourages healthy eating habits and appreciation for homemade beverages over sugary store-bought alternatives. It was a fun and memorable experience that sparked the curiosity in students about different foods and flavours.





Students of class 1 enjoyed learning use of these/those in a sentence through exercises. They were acquainted with the words near, far, singular, plural and were told how these words are related while framing sentences using this,that,these & those. They were also presented with a relevant video to deepen their understanding.

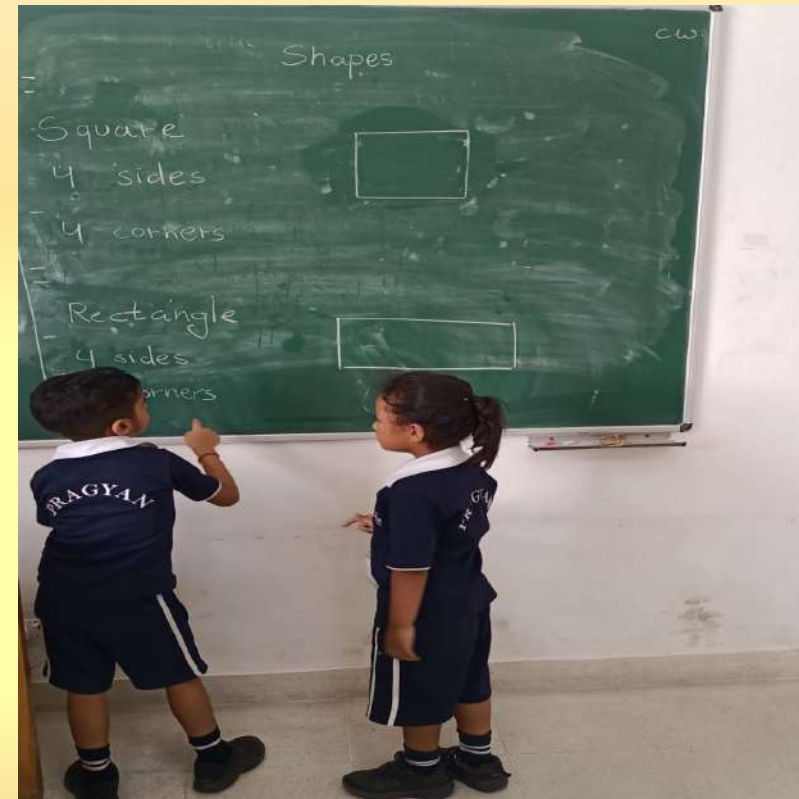




Math

Understanding shape is foundational to cognitive development, as infants mostly use shape to learn names of objects. Additionally, shape is important because it has applications in everyday life. Children of class 1 enjoyed learning and doing activities related to basic shapes.

Revision of नाम शब्द was done through oral questions, where they had to think of all the different kinds of names in नाम शब्द which help them to extend their thinking.

हिंदी भाषा में कविता वाचन का विशेष महत्व है। कविता बच्चों में शुद्ध उच्चारण, हाव-भाव का प्रस्तुतीकरण और मनोरंजन ढंग से गायन जैसे गुण विकसित करती है। मई माह के तीसरे सप्ताह में बच्चों ने उत्साह के साथ तितली कविता का सामूहिक गायन किया। लिखित कार्य के अंतर्गत बच्चों को तितली कविता से संबंधित शब्दार्थ कराया गया। विद्यार्थियों ने व्याकरण में संज्ञा आधारित पुनरावृत्ति कार्य किया। क्रियात्मक कार्य के अंतर्गत बच्चों ने बहुत उत्साह और कलात्मकता से पेपर क्राफ्ट द्वारा रंग-बिरंगी तितली बनाना सीखा। थिंकिंग रूटीन के अन्तर्गत सूझबूझ पर आधारित प्रश्नों द्वारा उनकी कल्पना शक्ति और विचार शक्ति को सुदृढ़ किया गया।





Second-grade students engaged in reading the lesson "The Two Sculptures" and acquired new vocabulary. Through an integrated approach to learning (AIL), they fused art with literature by sketching out the story's characters, which not only honed their artistic skills but also deepened their understanding of the narrative. Furthermore, they engaged in thought-provoking discussions about the moral implications of the story. This comprehensive approach resulted in a rich and meaningful learning experience for the children, fostering both their academic growth and their appreciation for storytelling and creativity.





A house provides a sense of security and wellbeing. Students of class 2 read chapter- My Home and did a few chapter related exercises in their workbook during their EVS class. They also revised new words of the month. Students enjoyed drawing illustrations and discussed the uses of different tools used to keep the house clean.





Rounding numbers makes calculations easier and understandable while also keeping the number close to its original value. Students of class 2 learnt how to round off numbers to the nearest tens and hundreds. They answered multiple oral questions of the same, watched some videos and did assignments. Following rounding off, the students also learnt to estimate the sum and solve word problems. Ice breaking activities like number bond activity with watermelon seeds and arranging numbers in ascending and descending order with flash cards were performed. Students understood these simple mathematical concepts easily with the help of fun activities. Revision of before and after, addition sums was also done.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Musical instruments play a vital role in facilitating the exploration of music, providing children with both entertainment and educational avenues. In their instrumental music sessions, first-grade students are currently mastering the keyboard, and are being taught the fundamentals of playing notes as sa re ga ma pa, as well as understanding the concepts of aaroh and avroha.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)

Students of class 1 learned to mix colours and create secondary colours whereas students of class 2 did tree shading using very easy steps of pencil shading. They were introduced to three tones of shading pattern light, medium and dark.



VOCAL MUSIC (CLASS 1)



Music can raise someone's mood, get them excited, or make them calm and relaxed. Children of class 1 practiced the prayer song 'Sadbhawna ki rah par' and 'Hey gyanroopi bhagwan' during their vocal music class.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Jumping helps to develop leg strength and balance. It requires coordination of upper and lower extremity movements which is used during childhood games. It also plays an important role in sports such as basketball and volleyball. Students of classes 1 & 2 were given training through various long jumps and long distance races to strengthen their body balance.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

"A library is a storehouse of knowledge." The importance of books in human life is quite insightful. Books indeed hold a special place in our lives and offer various benefits that contribute to personal and intellectual growth. Students of classes 1 & 2 came to the school library to read books of their choice.



CIRCLE TIME/ VALUE EDUCATION

“Honesty is truth telling, truth speaking, truth living, and truth loving.”

Students of grade 1 and 2 had a class discussion on the topic - Honesty is the best policy. They understood the meaning and importance of honesty and different ways by which one can become truthful. They were also shown a story video to understand the value of honesty better.

Students of Class 1 & 2 participated in circle time activity related to Mother's day. They spoke confidently on the topic “माँ के लिए खास क्या किया”.....

The virtual tour provided students with an immersive experience to enhance their cultural understanding. The week focused on enlightening students of classes 1 & 2 with our neighbouring countries China, Bangladesh & Japan through interactive sessions.
