NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter G was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards. They did colouring of G related pictures in their Letter Book and tracing of the letter G in their workbook.

This week students were also introduced to the concept of After numbers, where they did worksheet related to the concept.



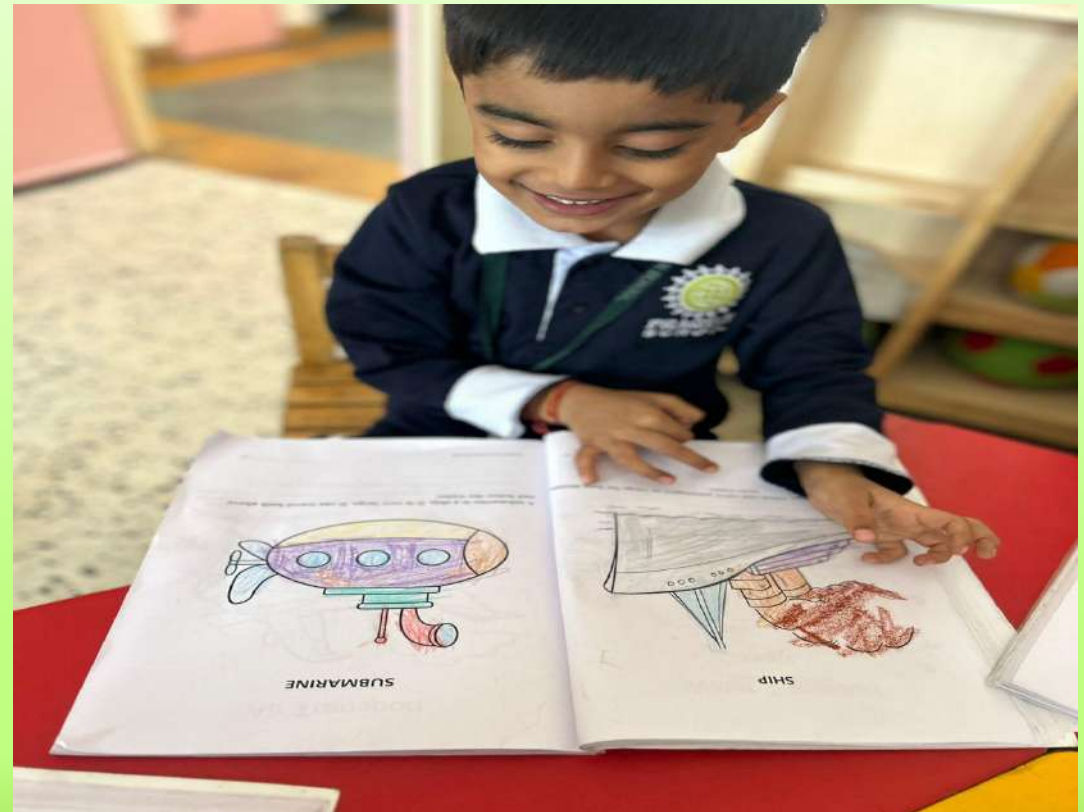
HINDI

GENERAL AWARENESS

EVS

KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

This week the children were introduced to 'am' and 'an' family words. They also did written work in their notebook and workbook. Three letter word reading was done in class from the reading book Dan and his Gran.

Under reading scheme, students also made an effort to make comic strip on the lesson 'The Bug'

MATHS

This week the children learnt sequence writing from 150-160. Revision of skip counting of 5's till 100 was done in the notebook.



HINDI

This week vyanjan श्र was introduced using pictures. Revision of two letter words through reading and written work was also done during the week.



GENERAL AWARENESS

Discussion and revision on transport was done in class through a story. Introduction of community helpers were done in the class through class discussions and asking a few questions related to the topic.



EVS

Some more water animals were introduced during EVS class. This week the children learnt about dolphins and their habitat. They enjoyed colouring worksheets related to it.



RESOURCE ACTIVITY

Learning through fun activities help in the retention and recapitulation. Students of Kindergarten enjoyed various activities in their resource period related to the topics that were covered in class, throughout the week.



SCIENCE DEMO

Experiments help children to begin observing the world around them. Their observations lead to critical thinking and questioning why things work the way they do. The children were demonstrated about the concept of Day and Night by using a Globe and a torch.



VALUE EDUCATION

Value-based education aims at training the student to face the outer world with the right attitude and values. Students of kindergarten learnt the value of being responsible and helping each other through the story of Little Red Hen.





Class 1 students revised 'rhyming words'. They understood the topic well with PPTs and reference videos. They did worksheet and notebook work for the same and an oral game for rhyming words was also conducted in the English class.

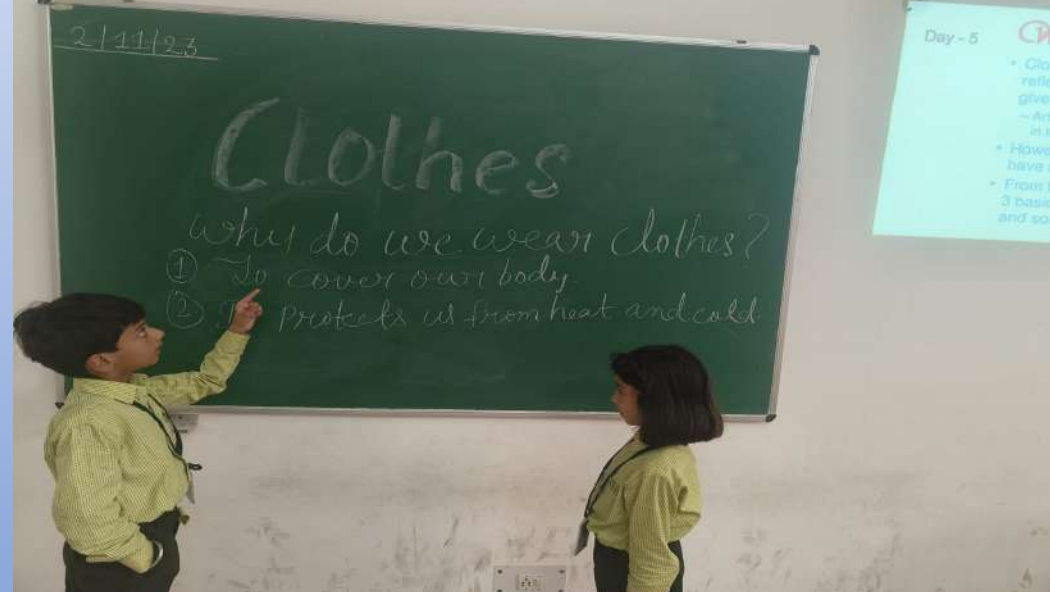

This practical application helps them to see the real-world relevance of what they've learned in the classroom. Students of class 2 participated in class activity based on chapter "The Rainbow". Where students drew a scenery with a rainbow and spoke a few sentences on their picture.





Clothes are one of the basic needs of human being. Clothing brings confidence and reflects personality. This week students of class 1 were introduced to chapter Clothes. They had a discussion on the importance of clothes and how clothes change according to season.





Learning time is very important for the kids. They learn to manage their time well and it can allow one to focus on their priorities and help to accomplish the tasks. Students of class 2 were introduced to the Chapter: Time, where they were being taught how different hands of the clock work. They practiced a few questions based on the same. They also revised Subtraction and Division word problems along with the tables.

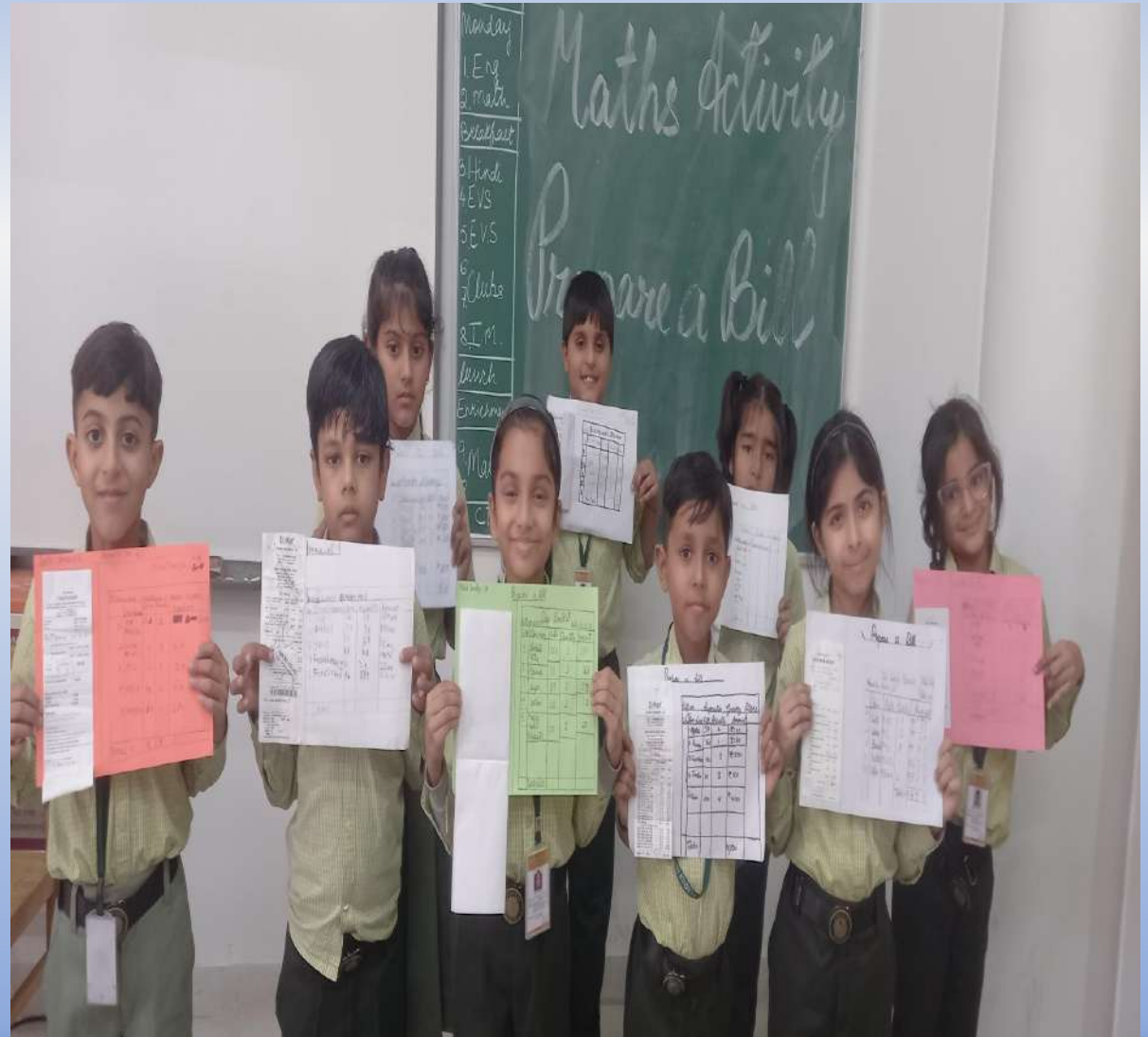

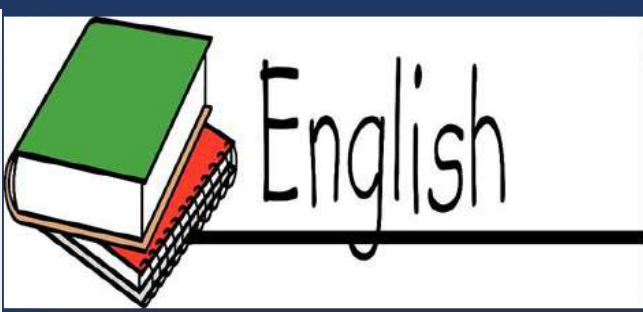




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
