# NURSERY

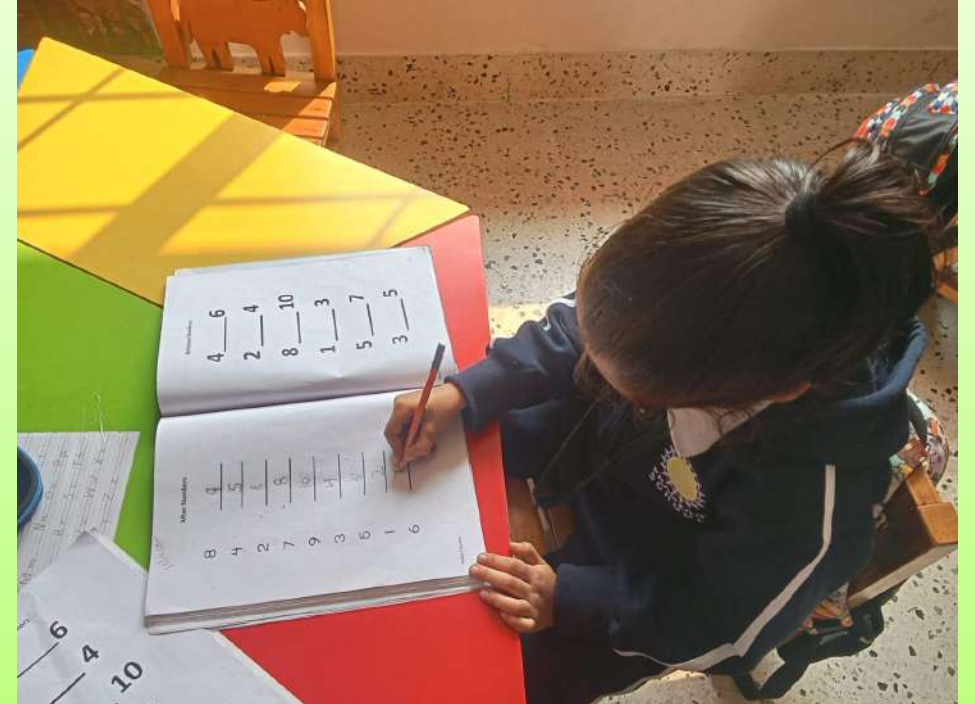


## ENGLISH

Students of class 2 recapitulated the chapter- Communication and Transport during their EVS class. They also did some notebook and workbook exercises related to the topic.

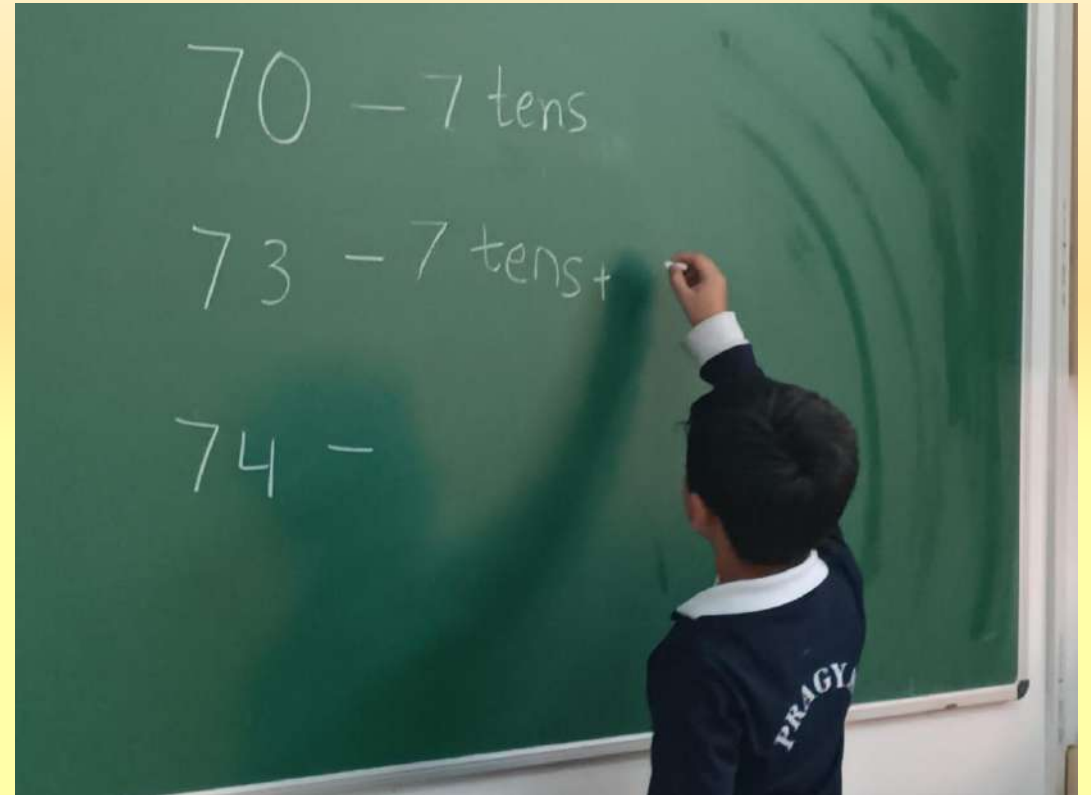




# Math

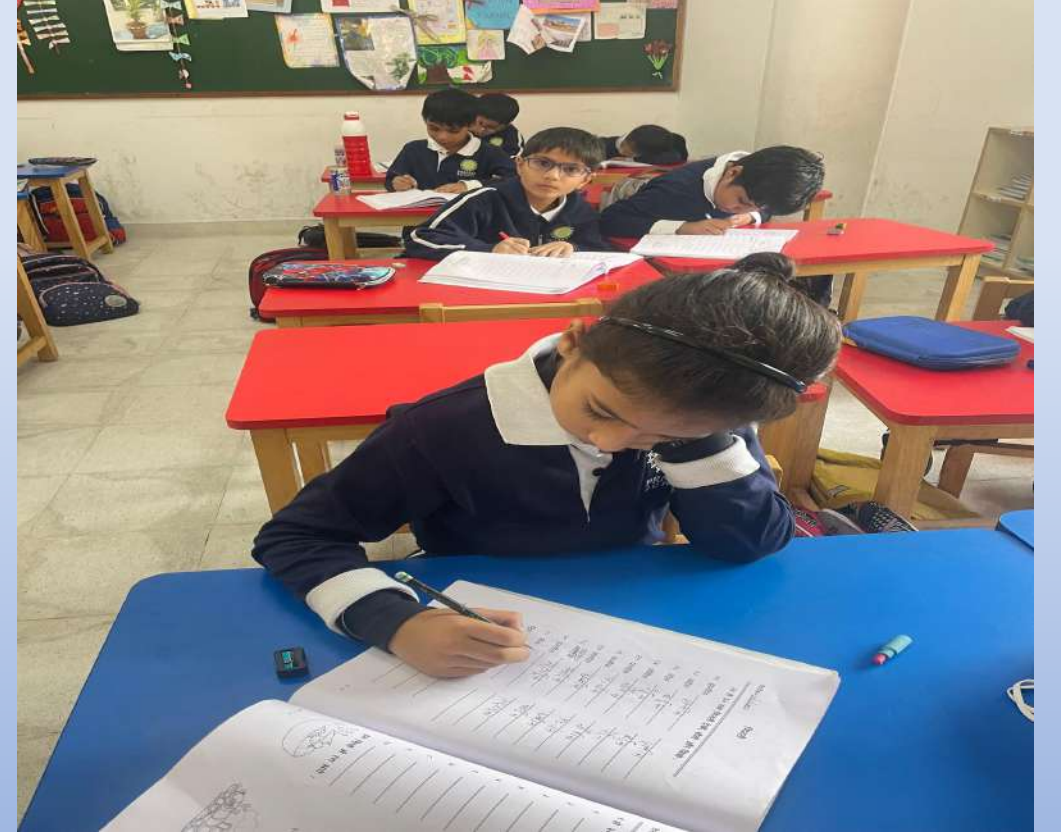
Students of class 1 revised the hindi poem during the week. They revised the **ो की मात्रा** through a few writing work. The reading of the chapter **मोर** during their class.





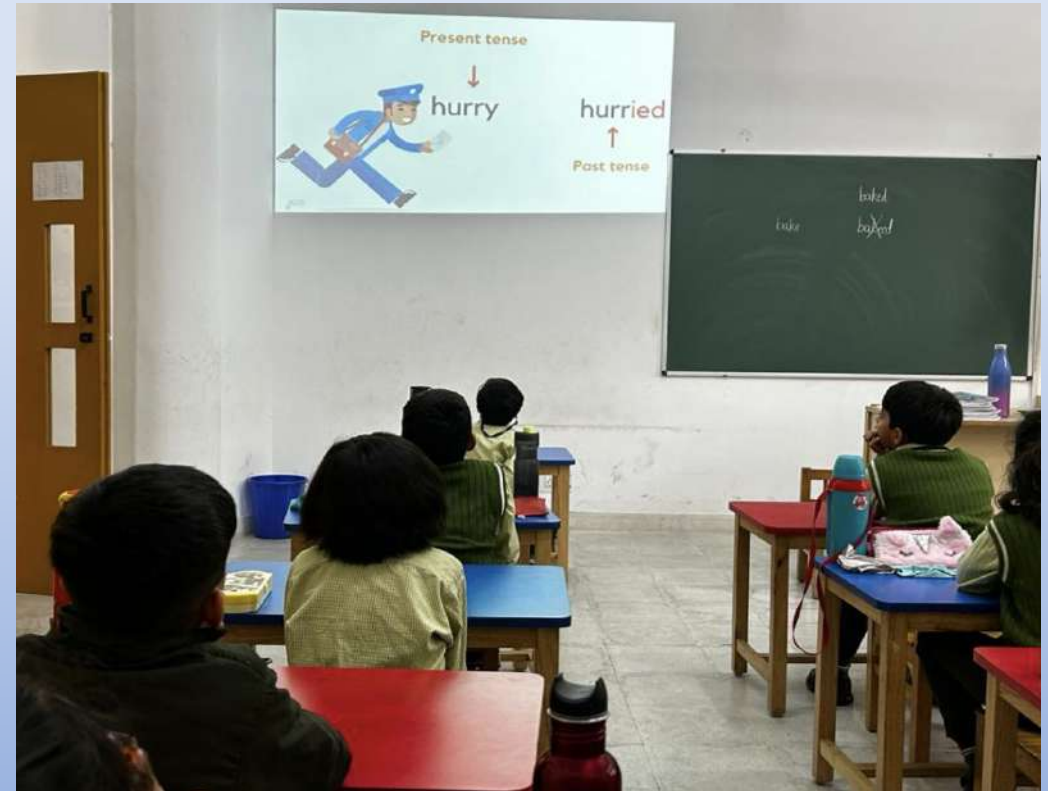
# हिन्दी

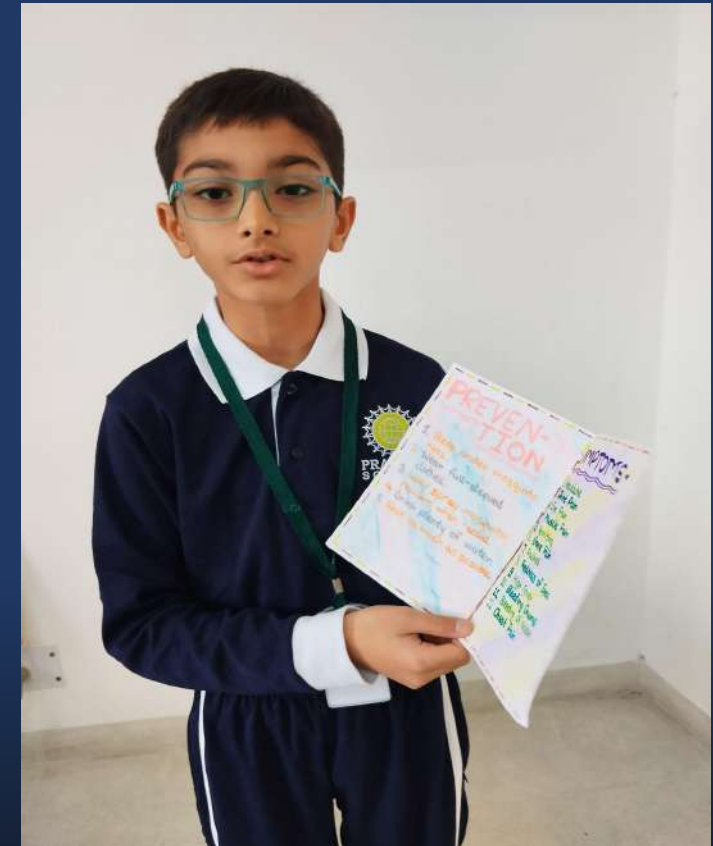
# हिन्दी
