NURSERY



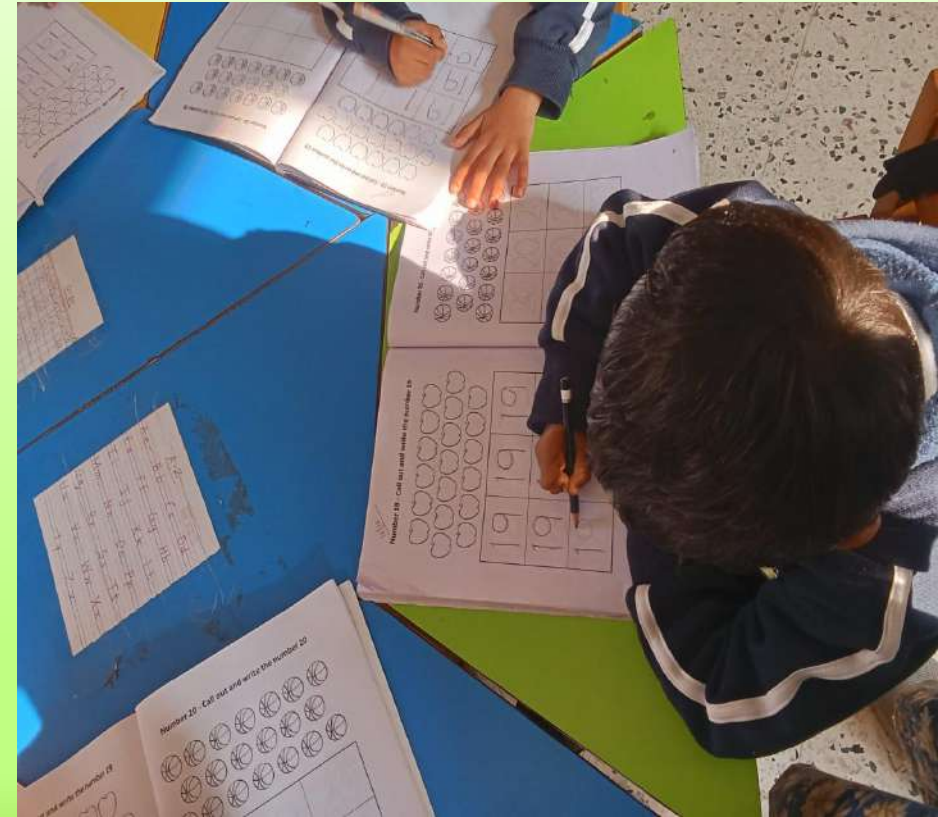
ENGLISH

Letter B was introduced to the students with the help of picture flashcards and they practiced the sound of letter B. Students coloured B related pictures in their Letter Book and traced the letter in their workbook.



MATHS

Number 19 was introduced to the students. They did counting of number 19 using blocks and also practiced writing the number in their workbook.

KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

Children of kindergarten were introduced to 'ip' and 'in' family words. Children wrote three letter words and sentences related to these family words. Introduction of blends, bl,cl,fl,gl,pl was done through a story. To enhance the reading skills, students were made to read from the book 'Mill and his Anthill'.

MATHS

Introduction of descending order was done through number cards and blocks. Students did worksheets based on descending order.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'ठ' was introduced to students with the help of pictures and stories. This week students also learnt to read and write four letter words.



GENERAL AWARENESS

This week the children were introduced to winter seasons. Discussion about the winter season was done in class, where students were informed about food items available in this season, clothes that we wear. Later they coloured the worksheets based on the theme.

Music plays an important role in our life. Students of Nursery and KG enjoyed learning the new song 'Joy to the world' and 'Jingle bell song' during their music class.



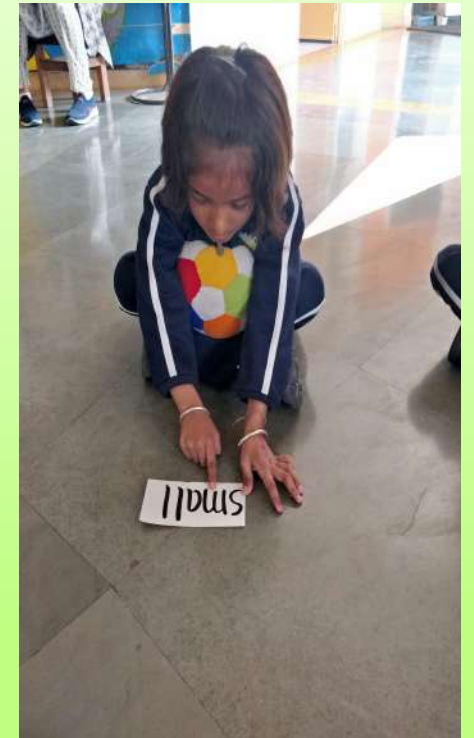
HEALTH AWARENESS CAMP

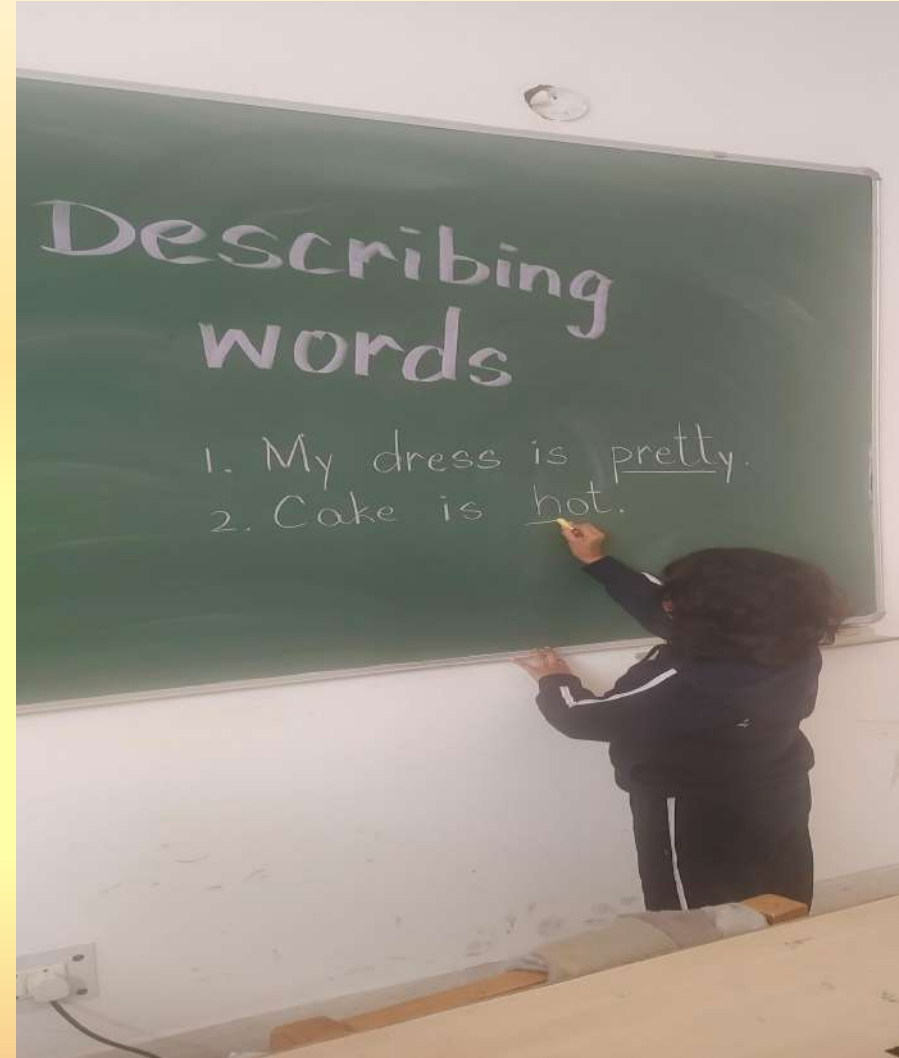
The event culminated with a vote of thanks by the principal Ms Ruchika Sharma and National Anthem

“To learn to read is to light a fire”

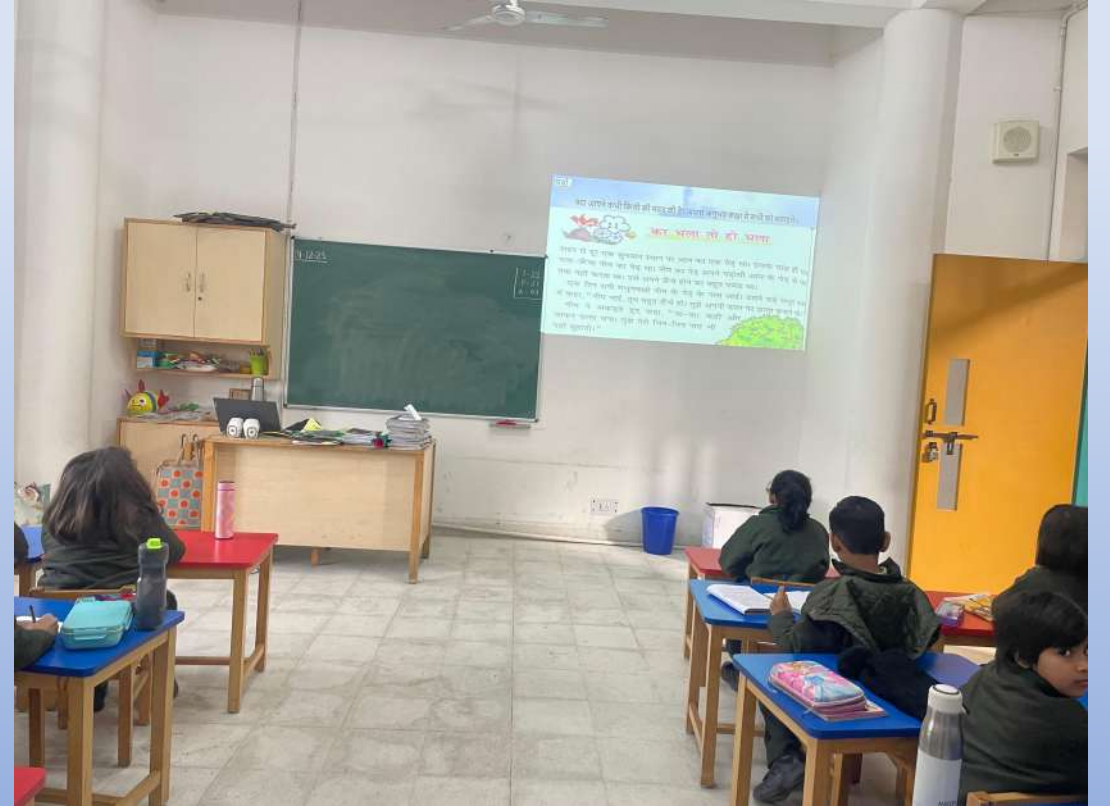

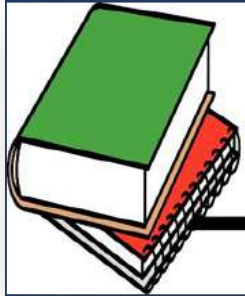
