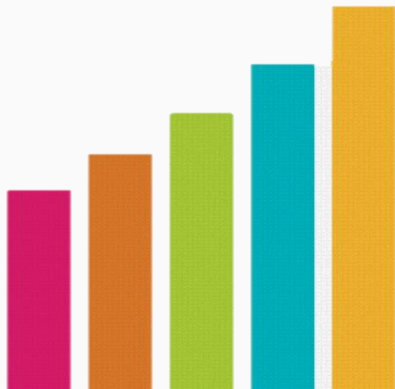

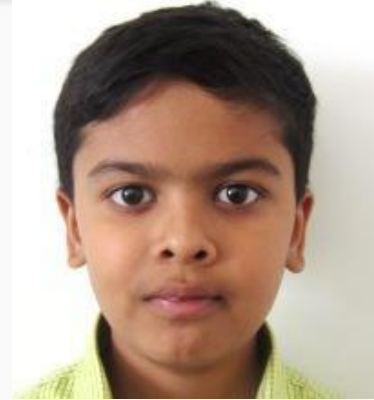


INTER SCHOOL COMPETITION

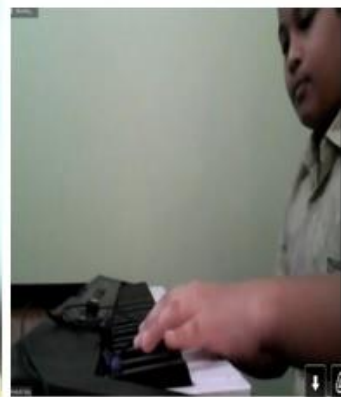
