Class activity - students enjoyed making Diwali craft in the class.



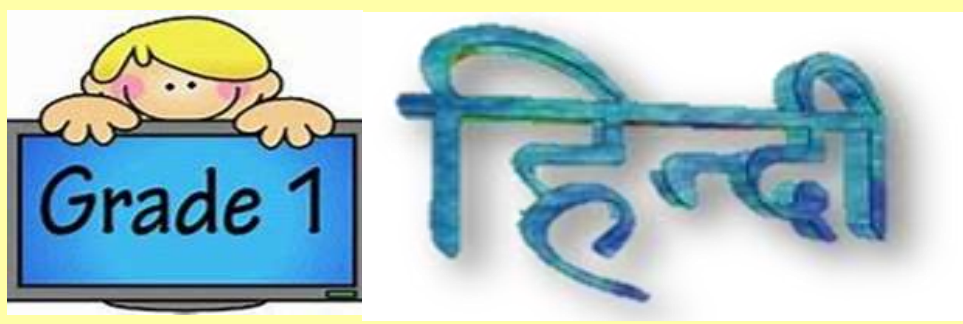

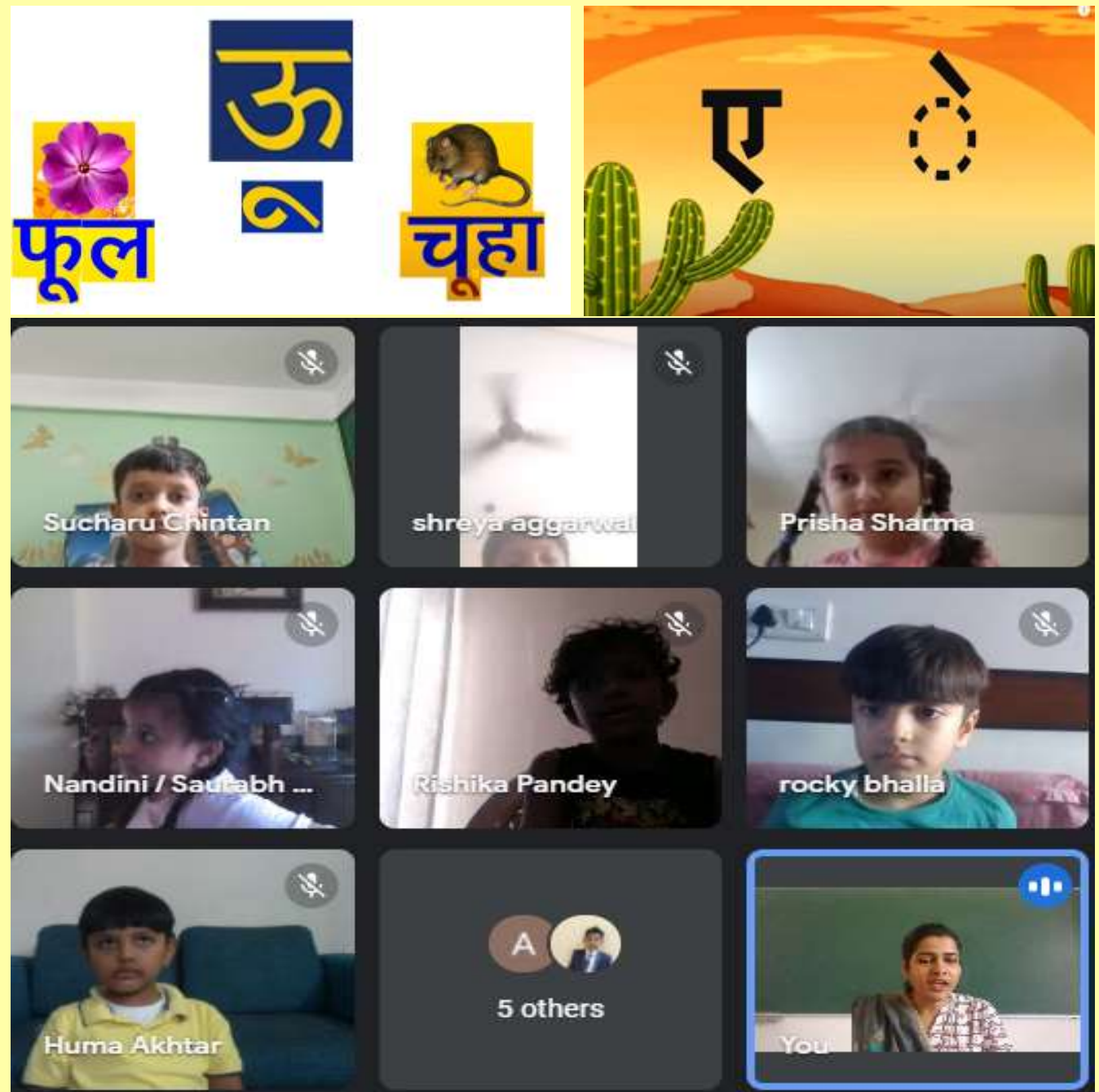

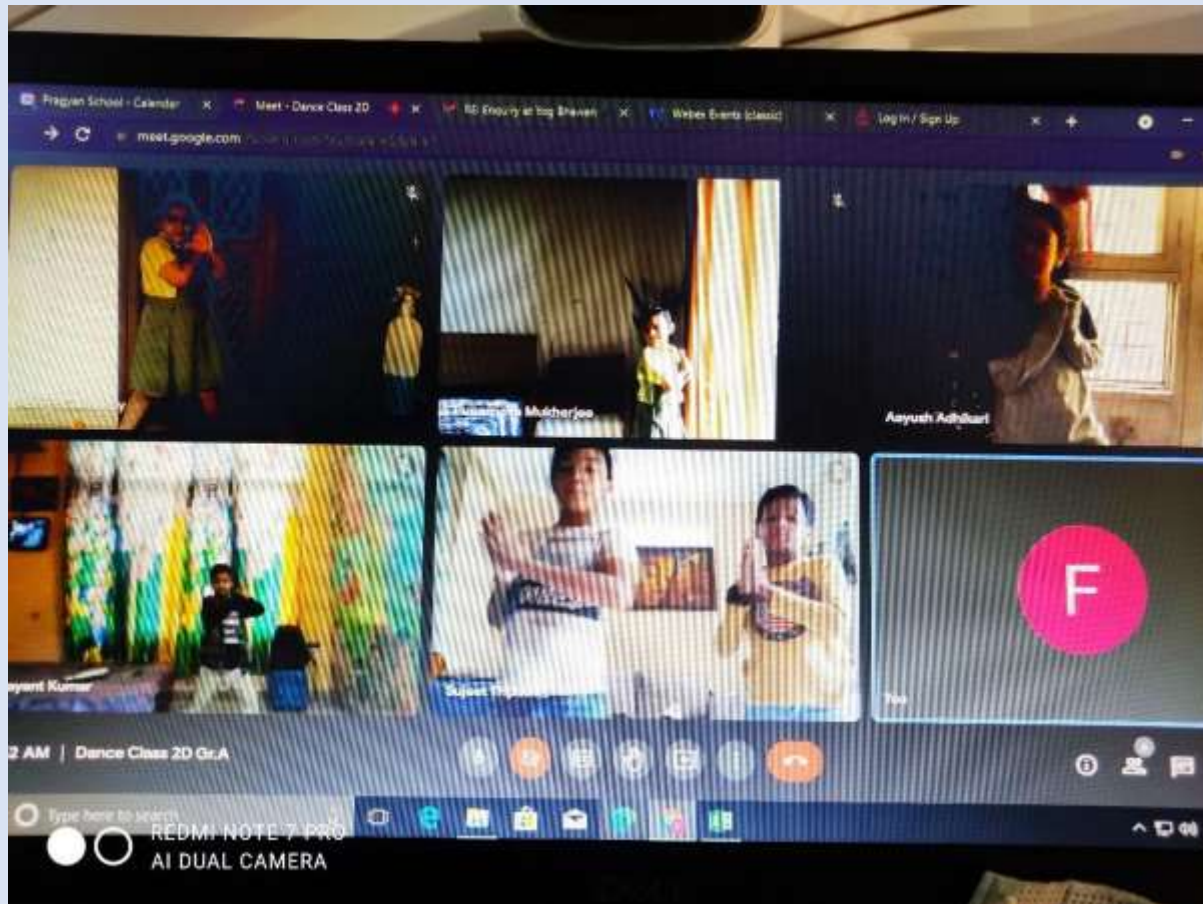

The ability to solve simple multiplication questions, and use multiplicative thinking, is helpful for children in everyday life. Public speaking is one of the most important and most dreaded forms of communication. As a part of Inter class weekly activity students of classes 1 & 2 participated in JAM (Just a Minute) on 27th October, 2021. The theme for the activity was 'Things seen in the garden' for class 1 and 'Seasons' for class 2. Students attending physical class were made to pick the chit related to the theme, whereas for online class topics were displayed on the screen, and children were supposed to speak on the spot in front of their classmates. Regular practice of the same was given to them by their teachers during their regular classes. Best entries will be awarded with e-certificates later.



WELLNESS SESSION : CLASS 1&2

During the wellness session of Yoga and Meditation, students of classes 1&2 learnt various stretching exercises and deep breathing to bring peace. 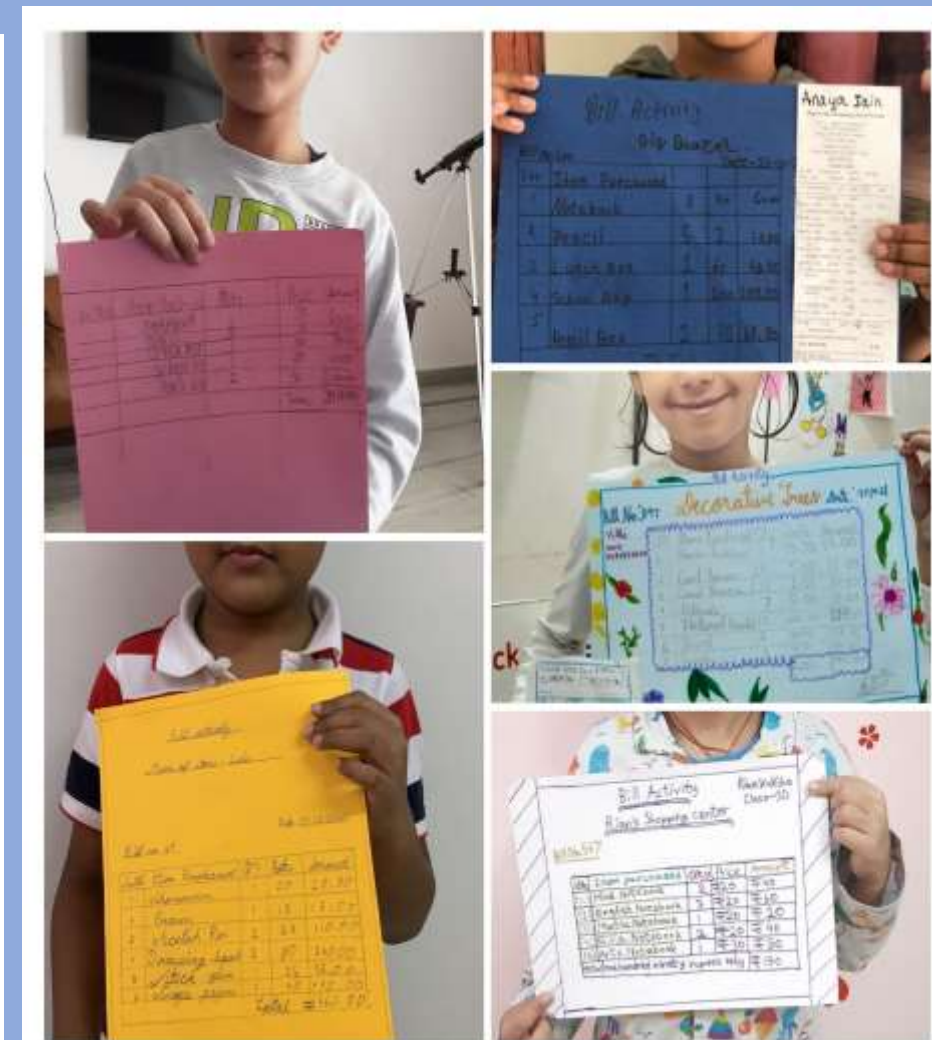

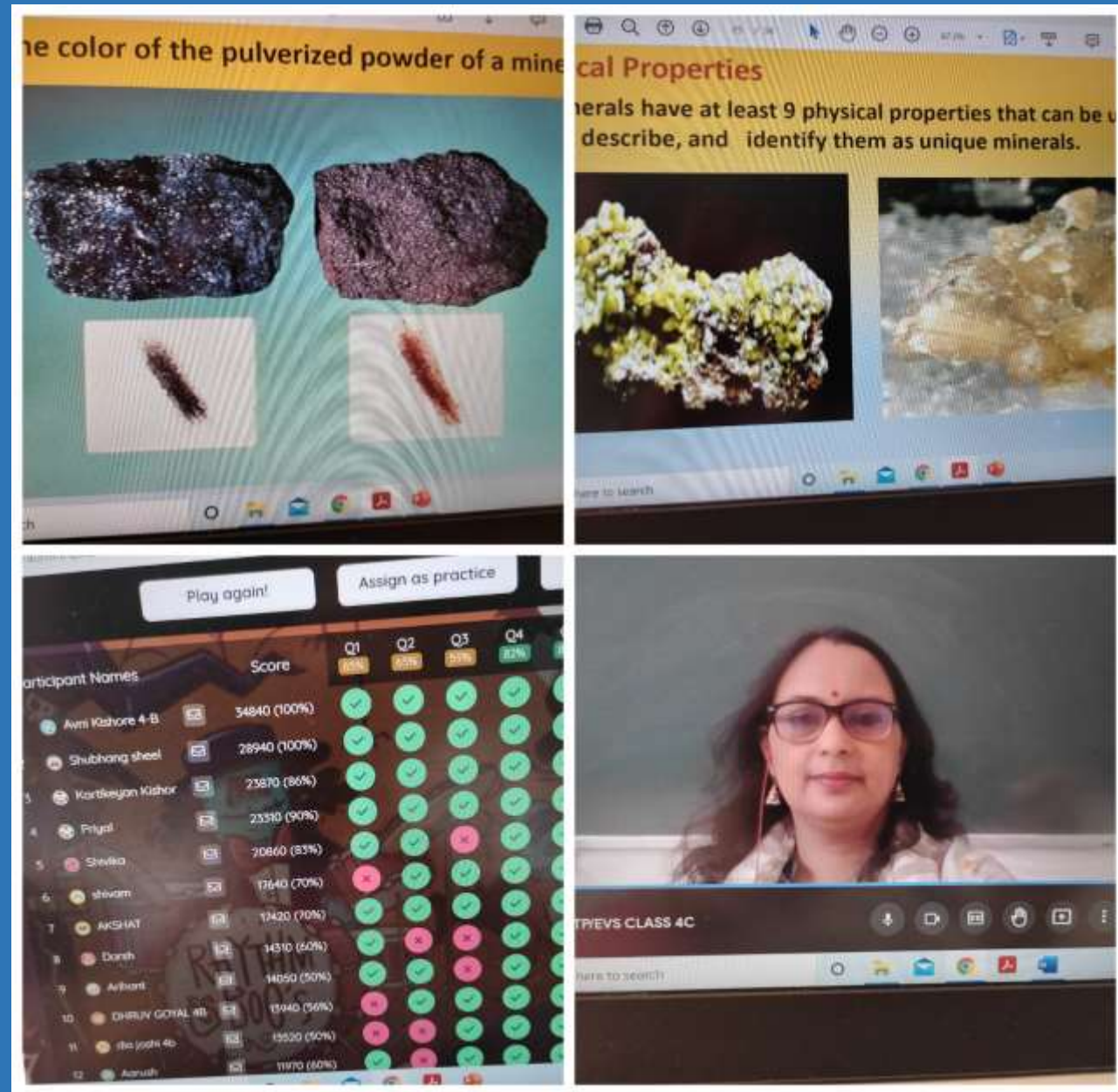

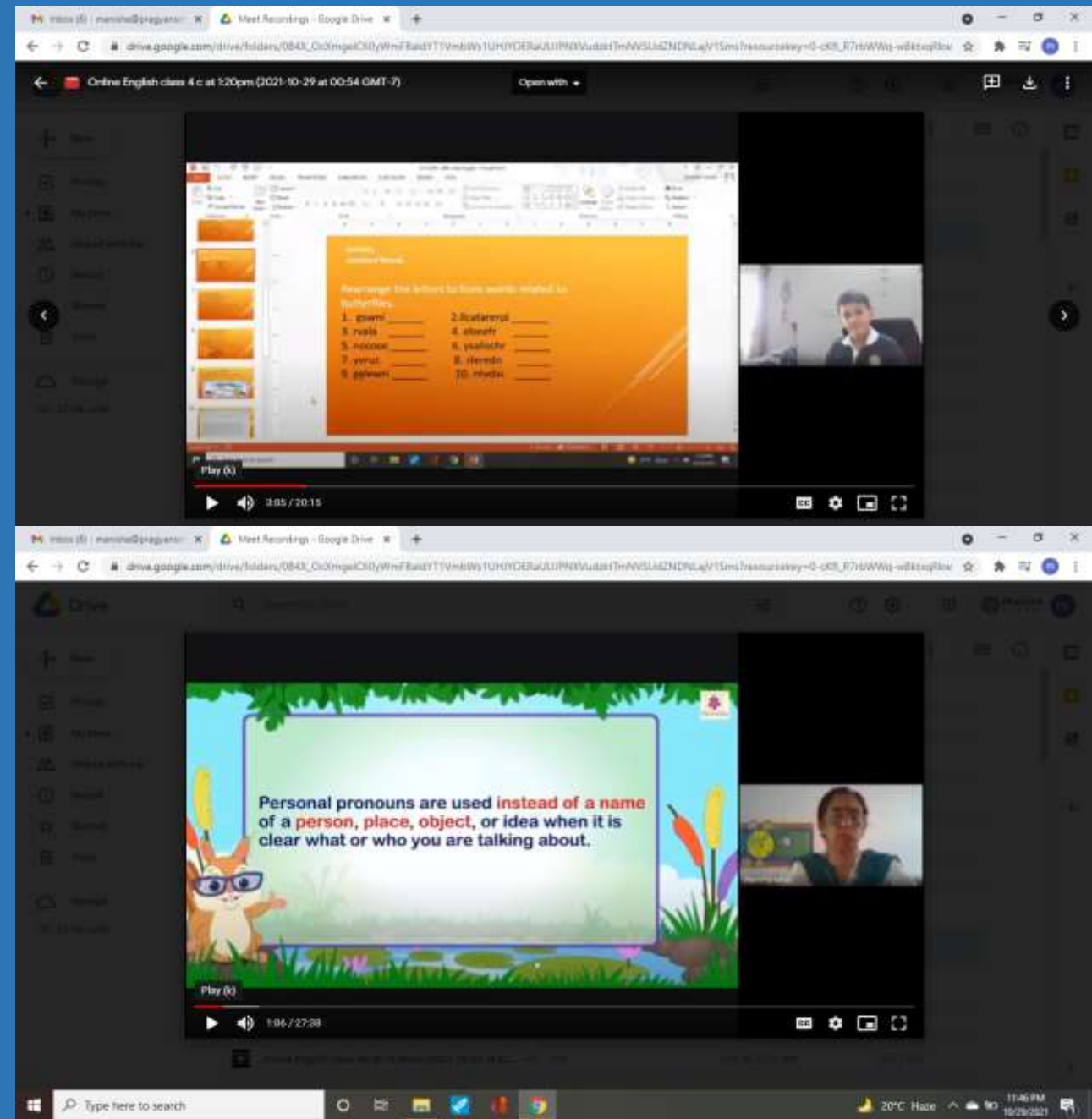
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

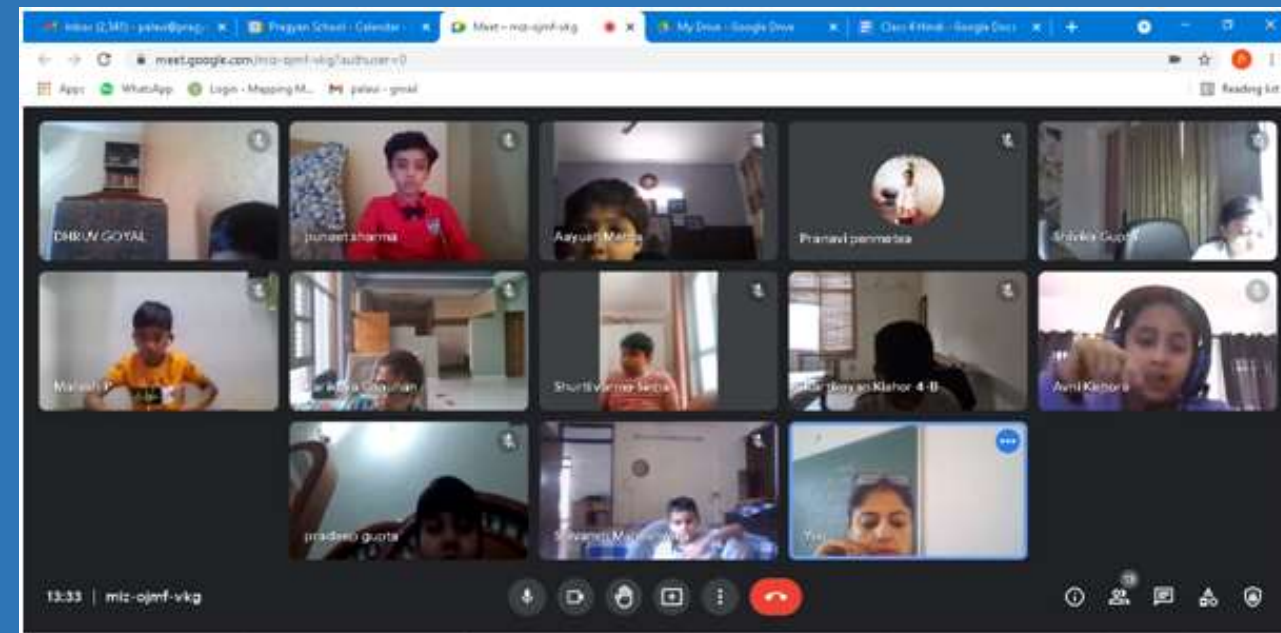

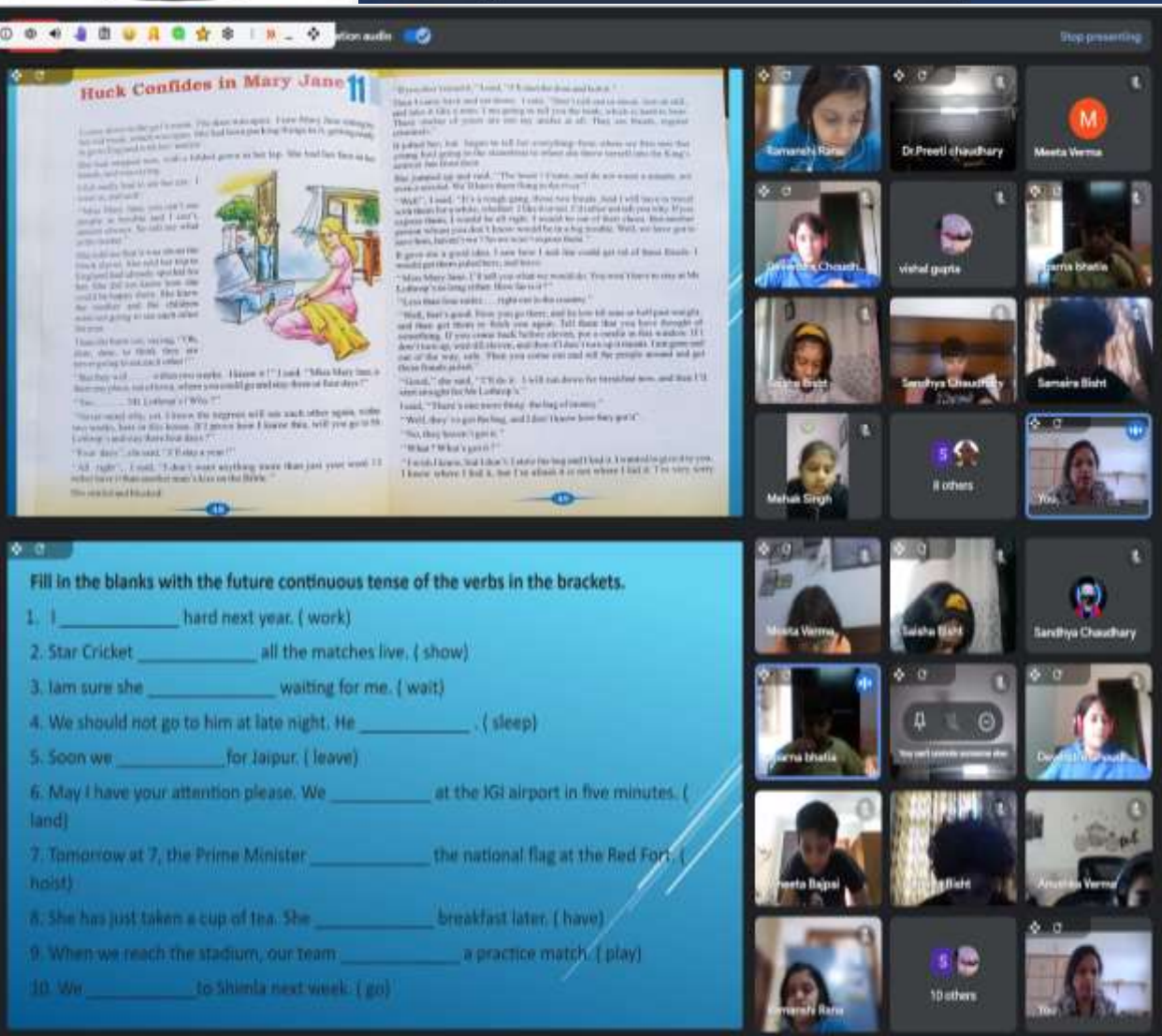

Congratulations to Students of classes 3-5 who participated in Inter- Class yoga competition 'Posture Folks'.

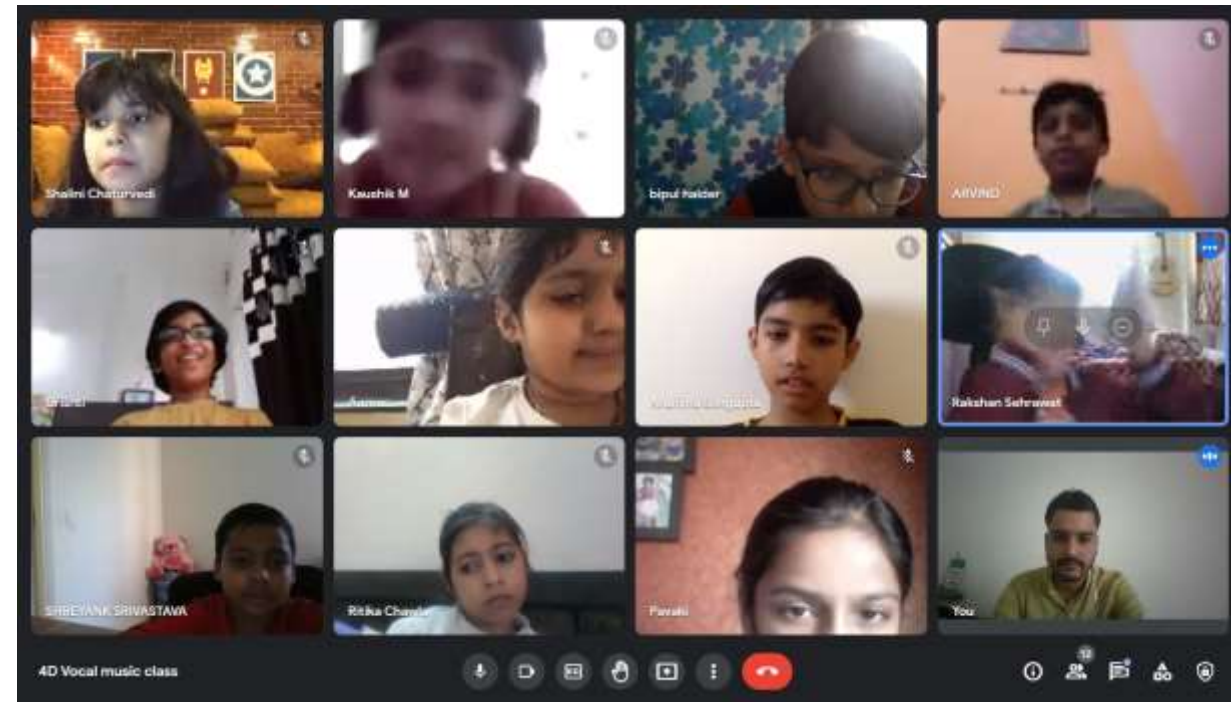

Students of online classes learnt yoga asanas and ways to develop physical fitness components.



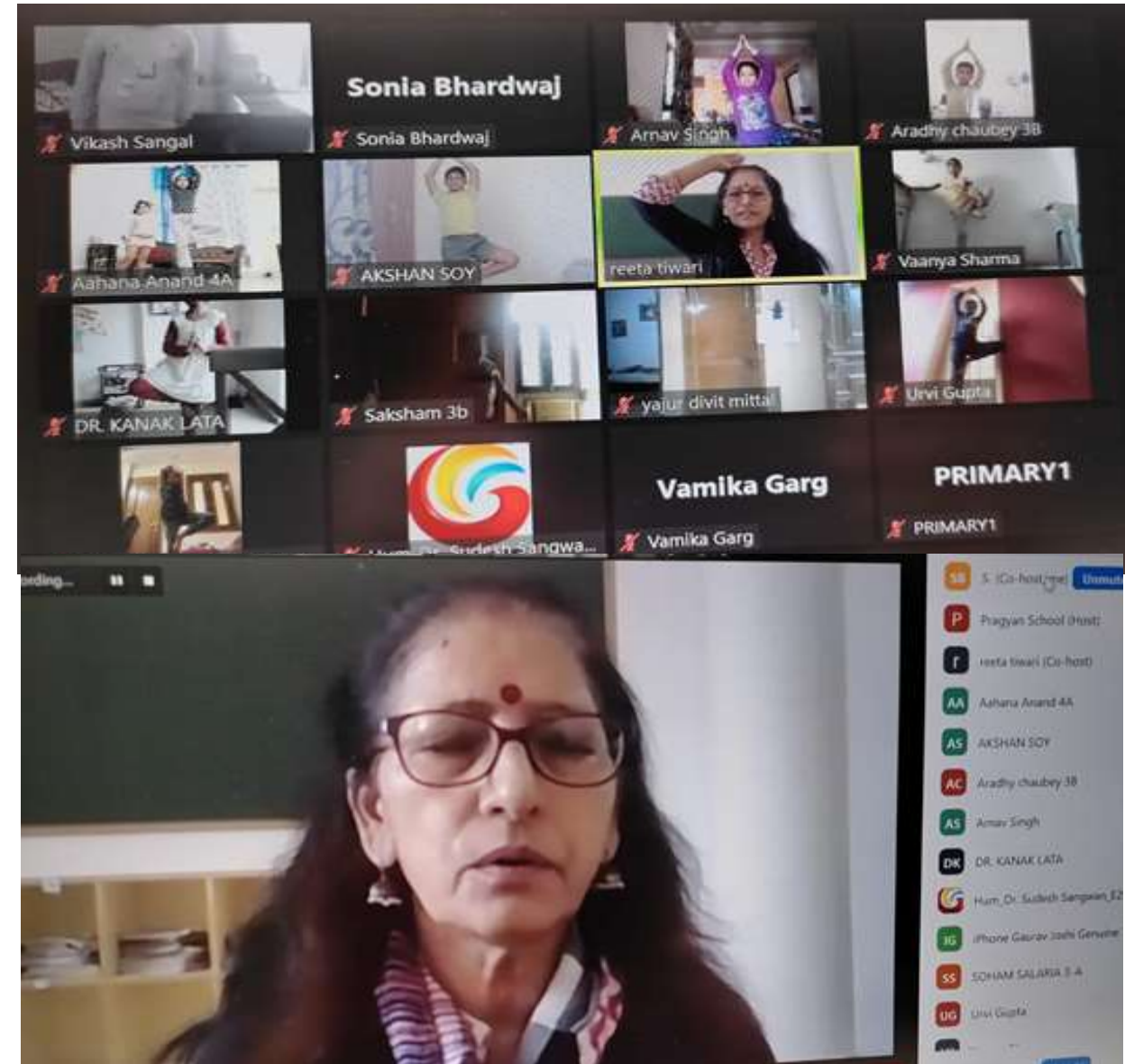
VOCAL MUSIC (3 - 5)

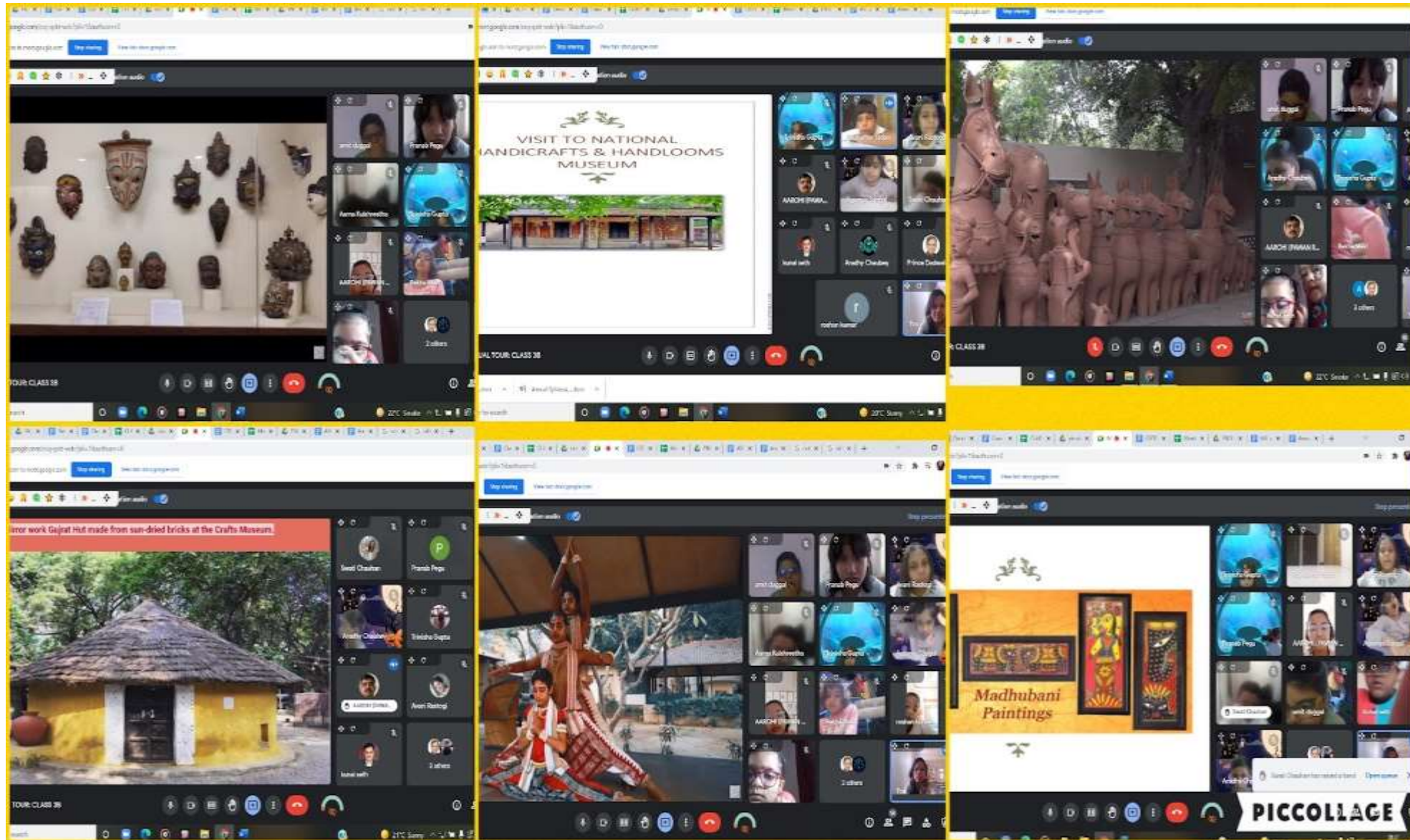
CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3-5)



COLLABORATIVE SESSION: 3 - 5
