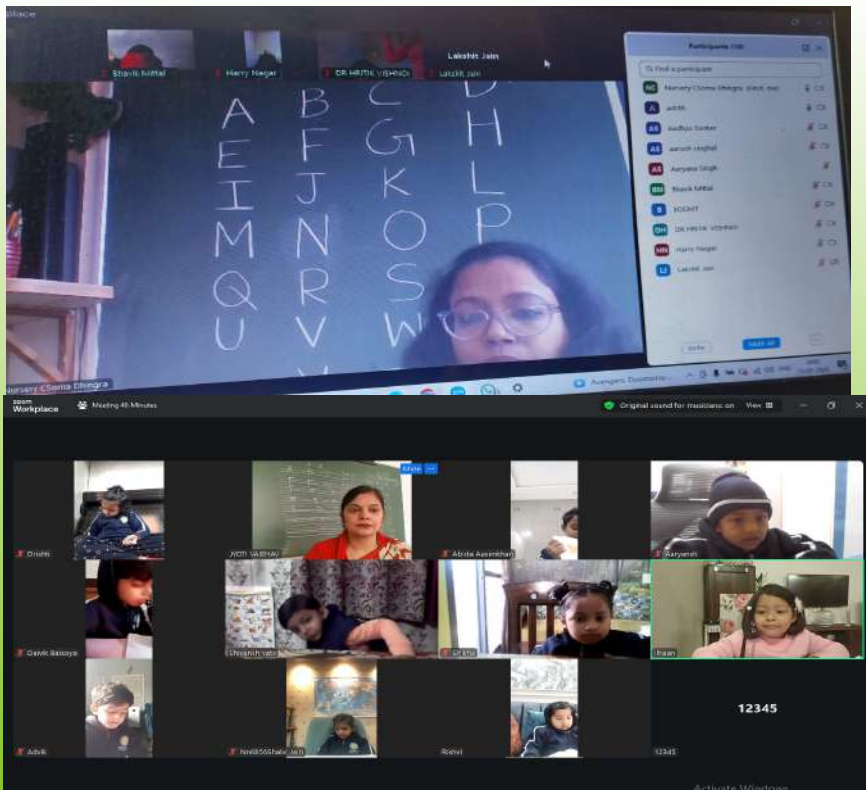


# NURSERY



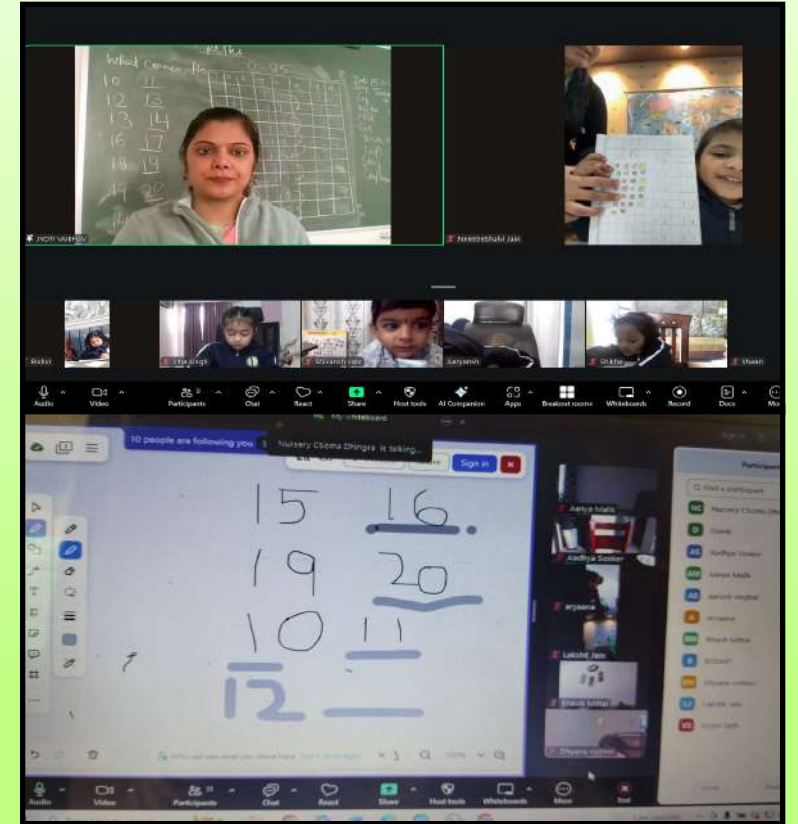
## ENGLISH

Students revised letters A to Z through various engaging practices. Learning was reinforced through dictation, phonics practice, air writing, writing practice from A to Z, and identifying words that begin with each letter, enhancing their overall learning experience. These activities promoted phonetic awareness, vocabulary building, and the development of strong language skills.



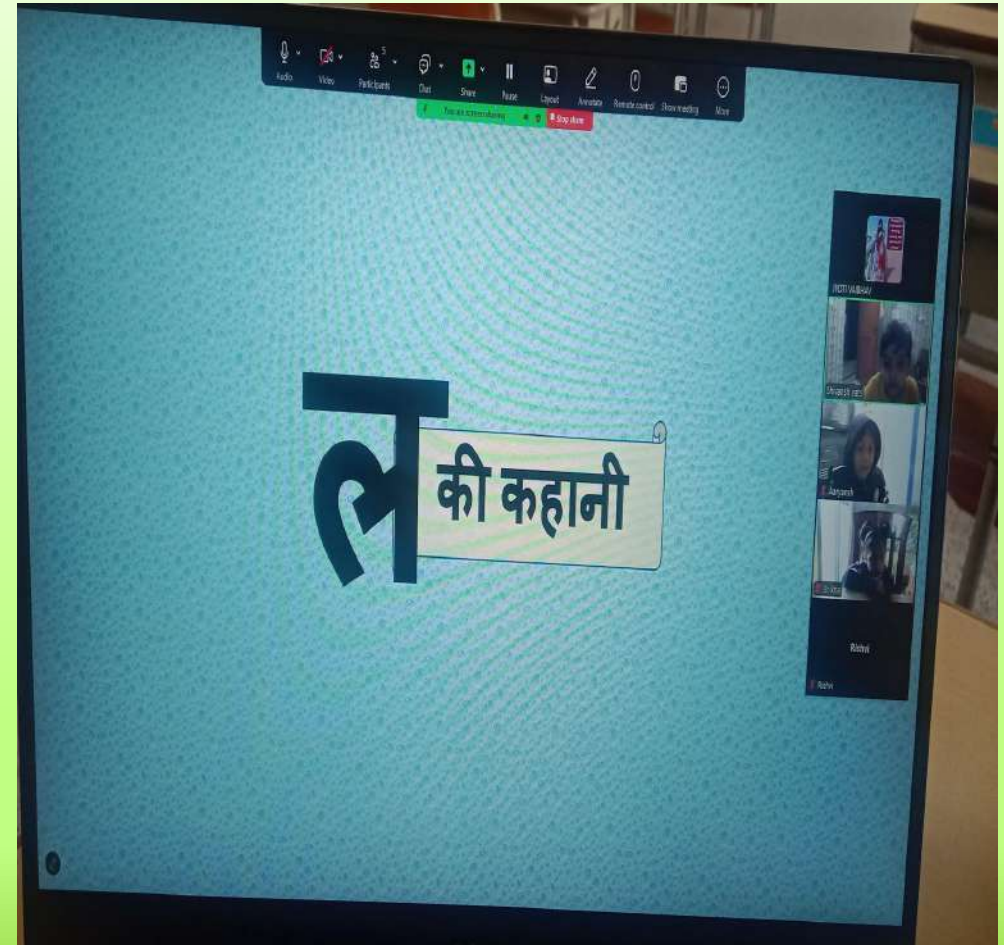
# MATHS

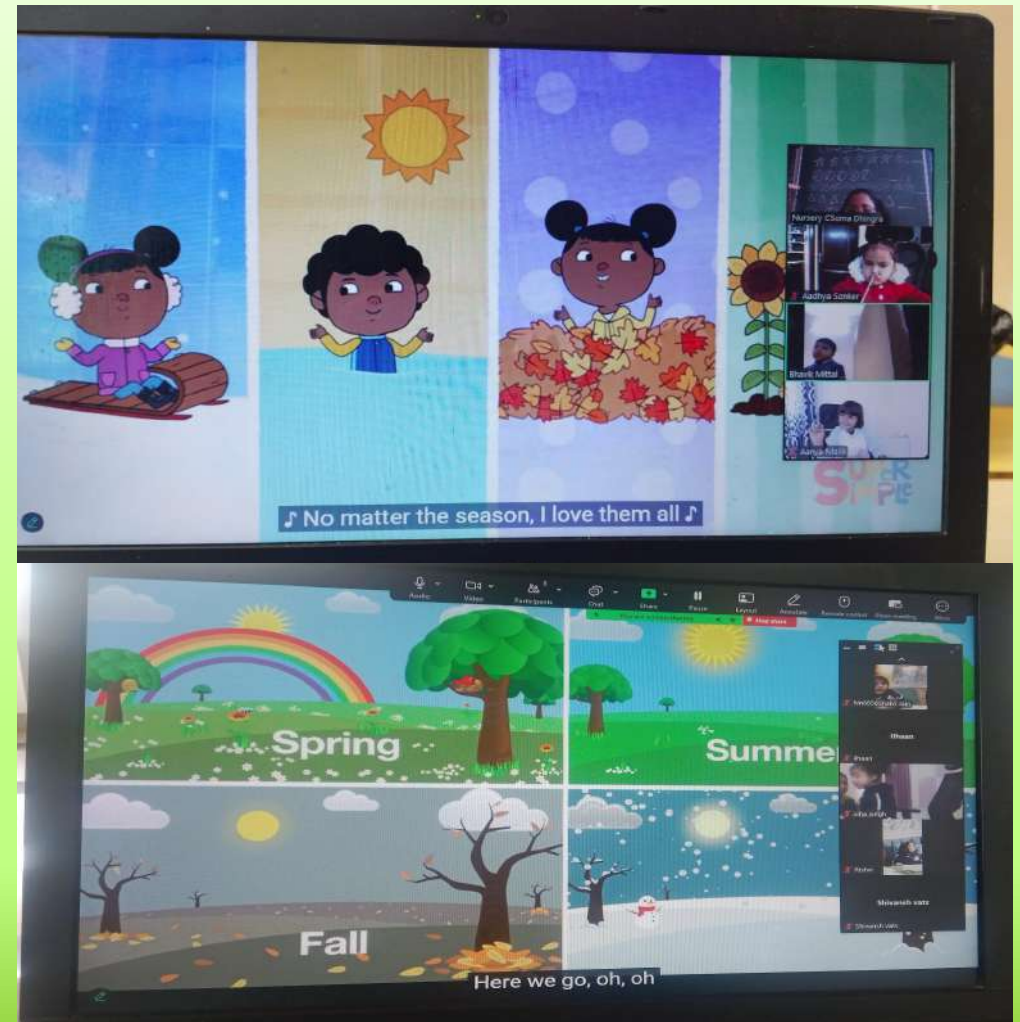
# HINDI

Students learned to recognize and pronounce each letter, explored related vocabulary, and coloured objects associated with them. The activities allowed them to discover new words and revise previously learned letters. Students participated enthusiastically, practiced correct pronunciation, and strengthened their understanding.



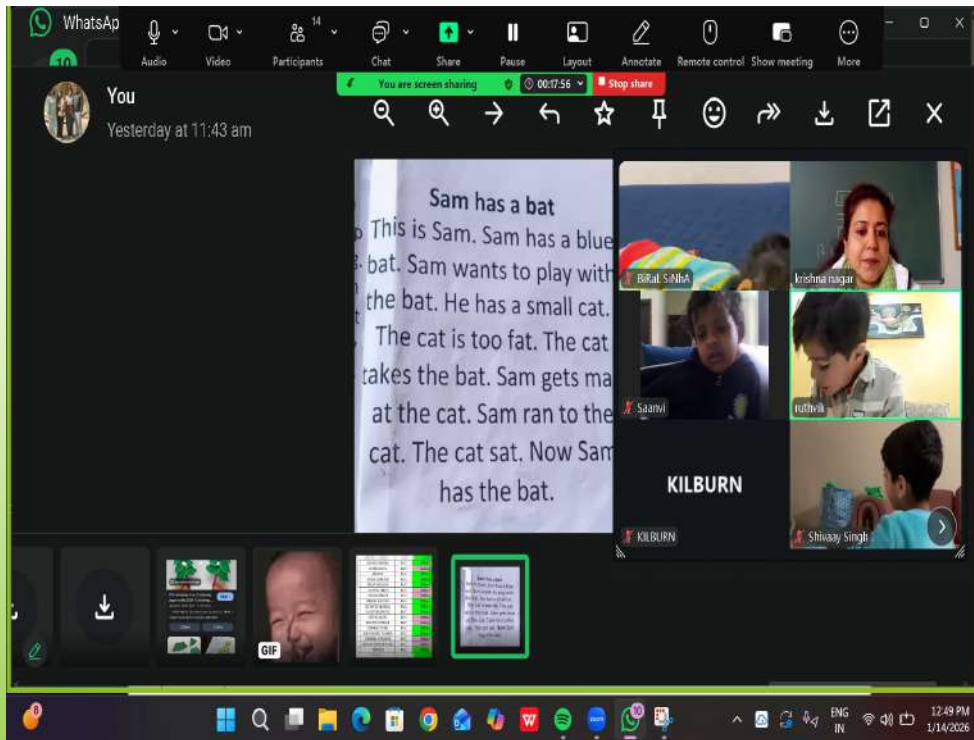
# GENERAL AWARENESS

As this month's theme was Seasons, nursery students were introduced to the four seasons of the year in a simple and engaging manner. They learned basic features of each season, shared their experiences, and discussed weather changes. A season-based poem was also introduced, helping students enjoy learning while improving listening skills, vocabulary, and expression.



# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



Children were introduced to ‘od’-family words. They actively practiced writing words like pod, rod, cod and also practiced speaking the words aloud during online classes, which helped build pronunciation skills. As part of reading scheme, children practiced reading the paragraph ‘Sam has a bat’ containing familiar words, supporting the development of reading fluency and comprehension.

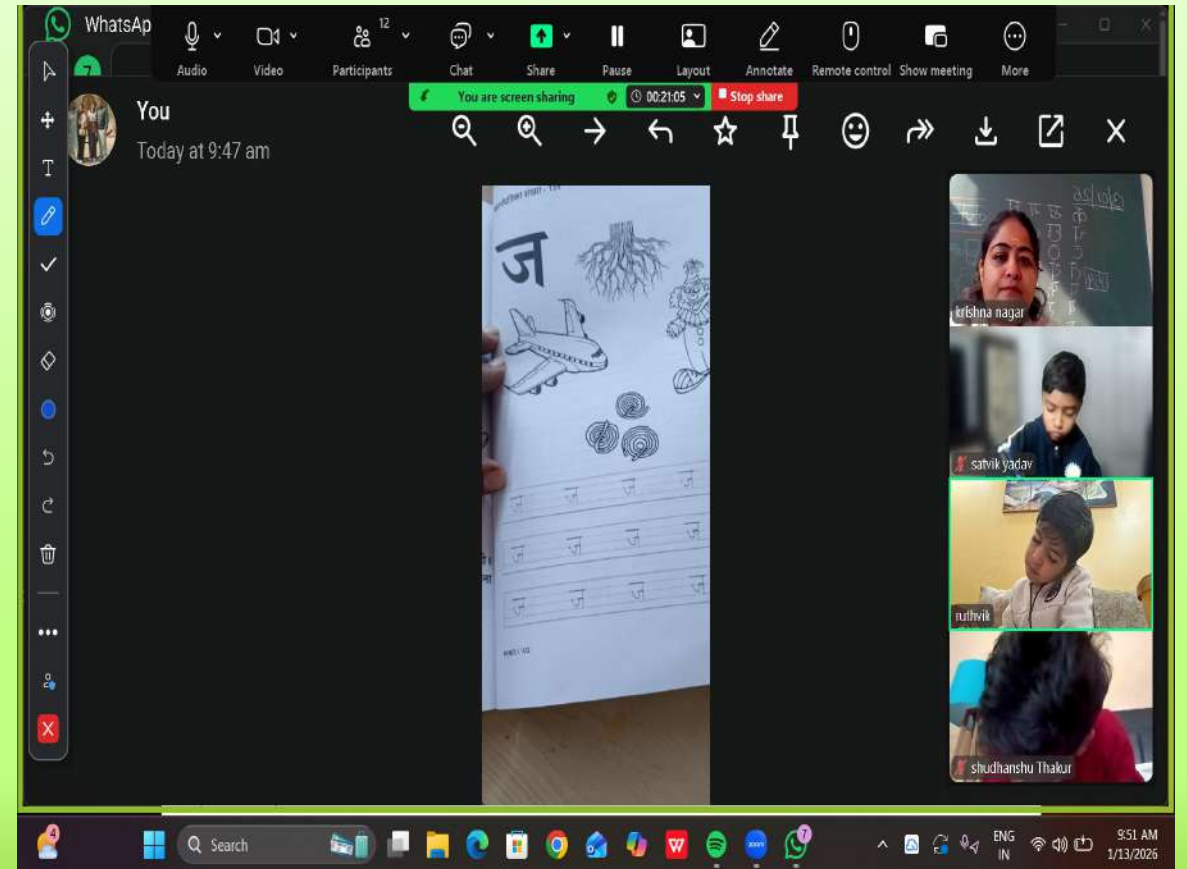
# MATHS

Children practiced addition and subtraction regularly, showing significant improvement in their mathematical skills. They are now able to solve sums with double-digit addition without carryover confidently and can solve single-digit subtraction problems with ease.

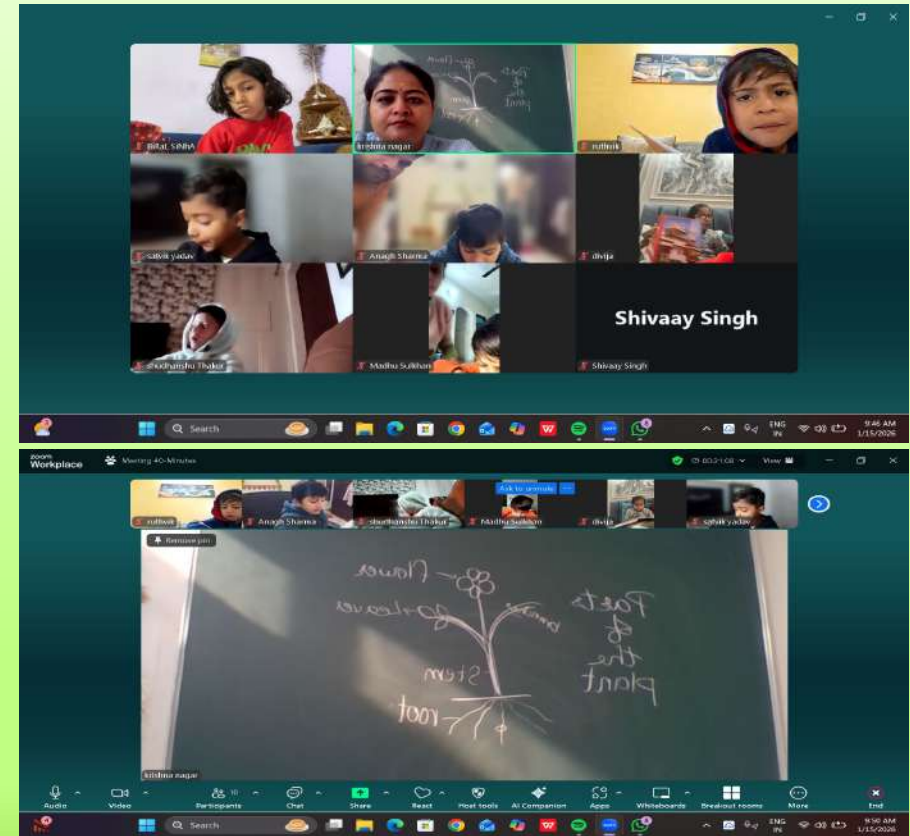
# HINDI

# EASP

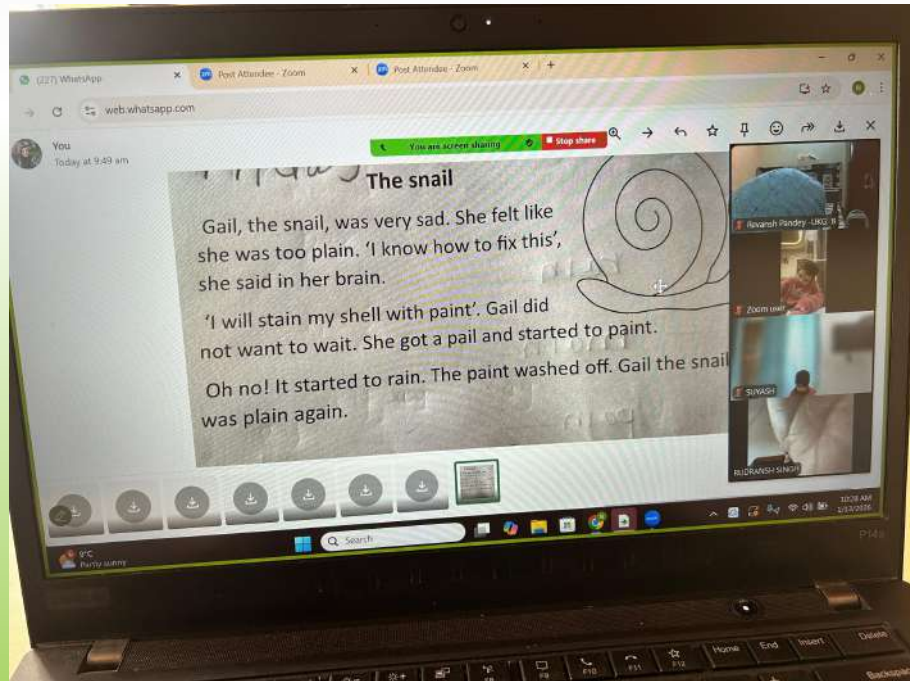


## ENGLISH

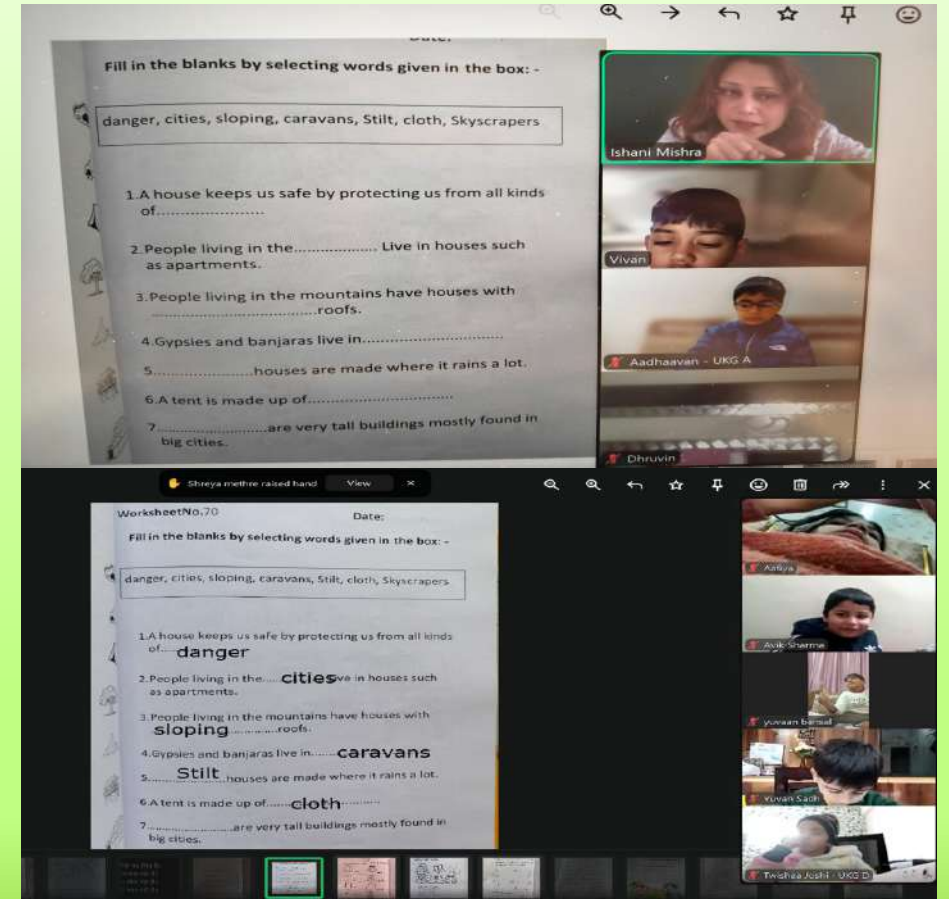

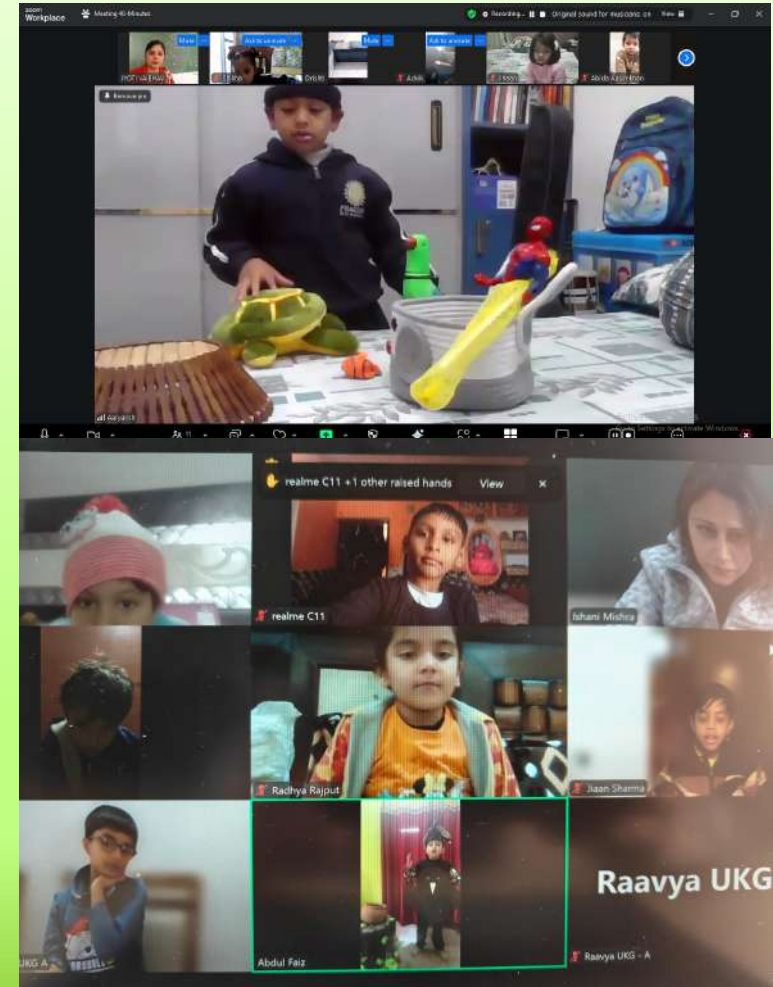
# GENERAL AWARENESS

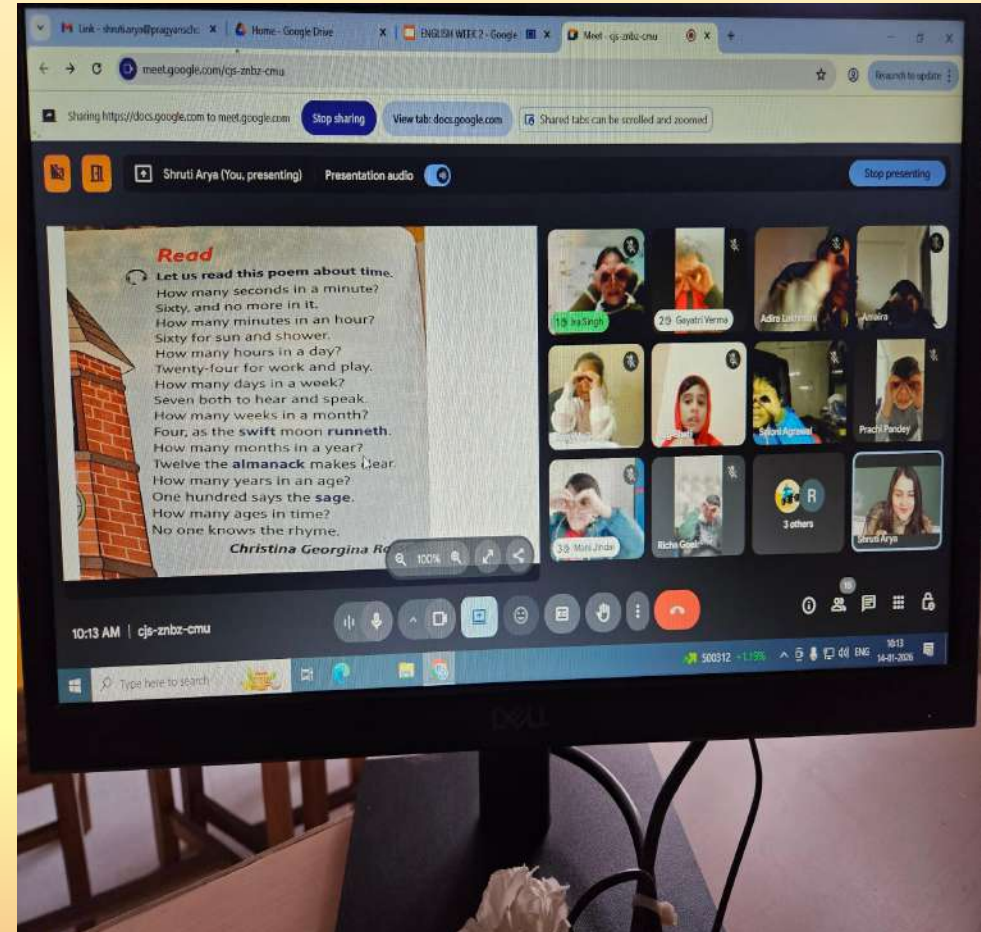
# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

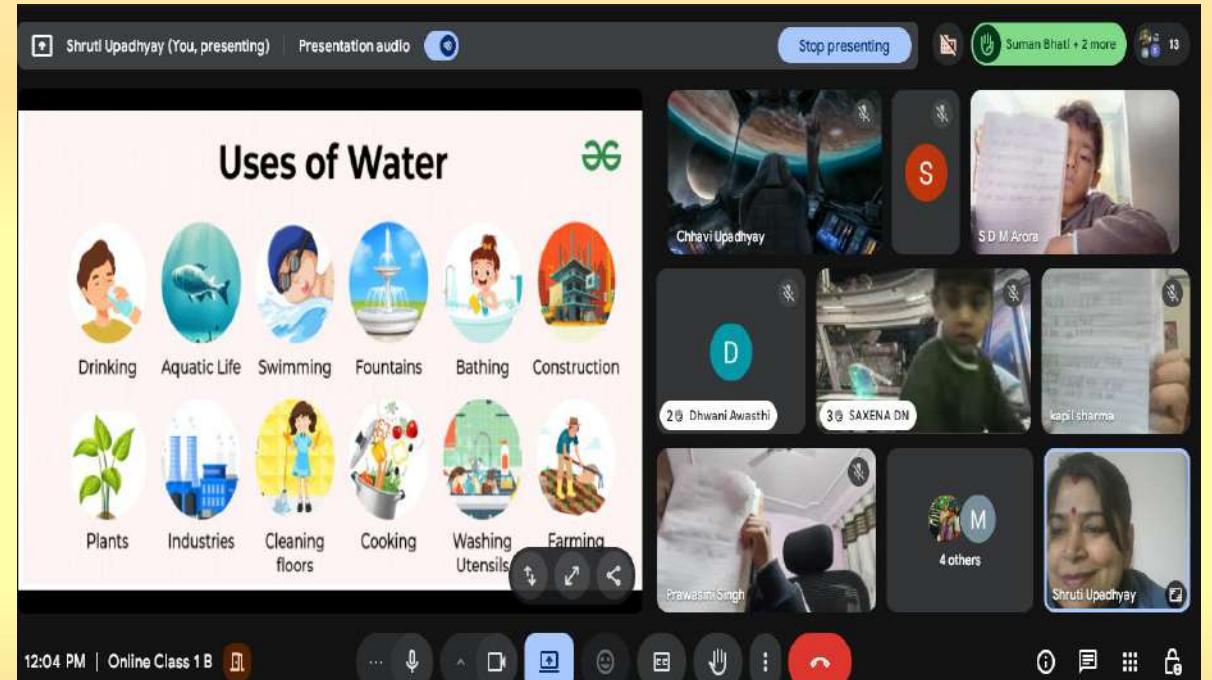

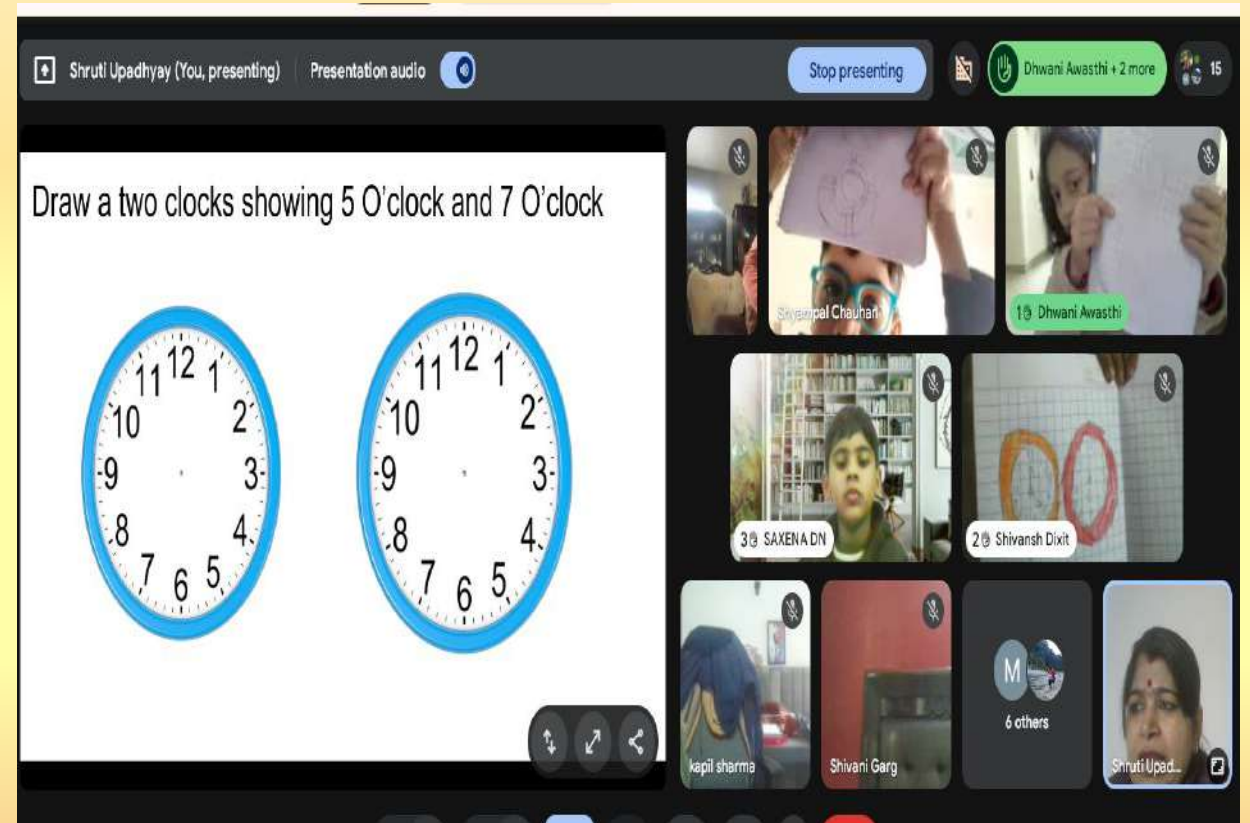
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

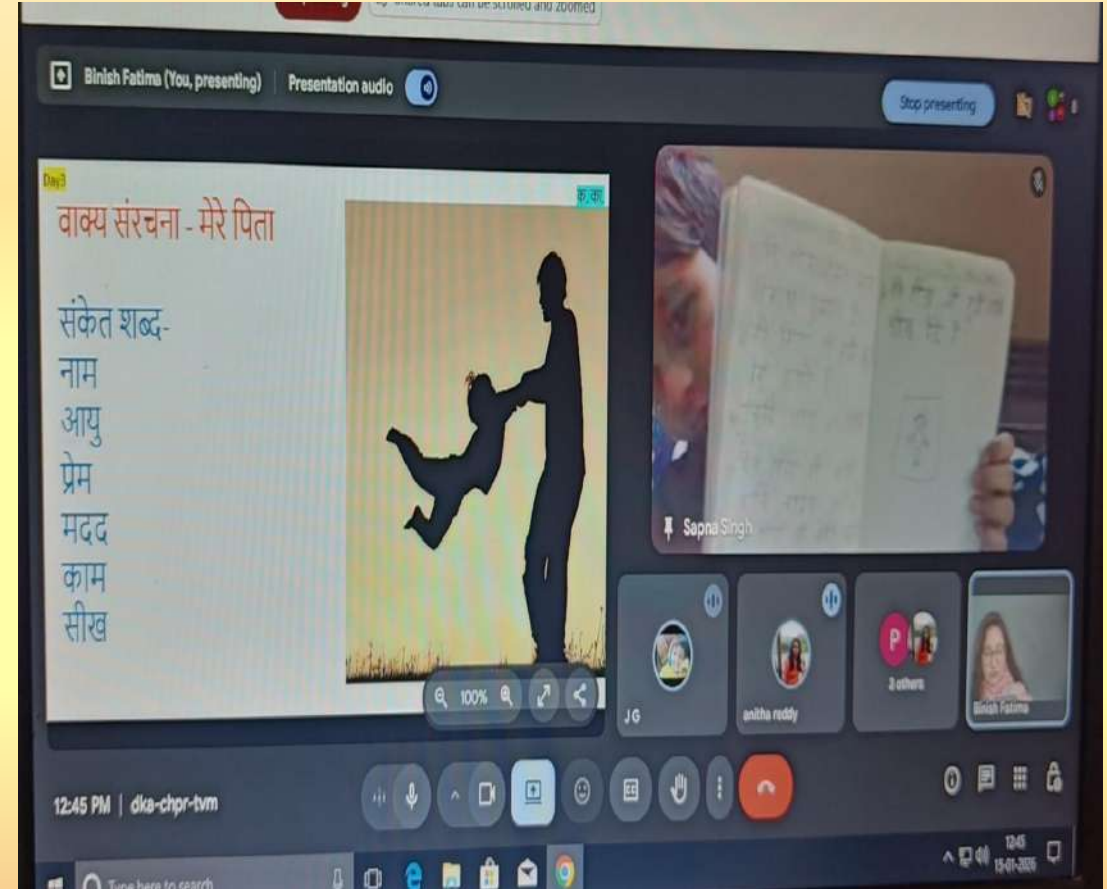

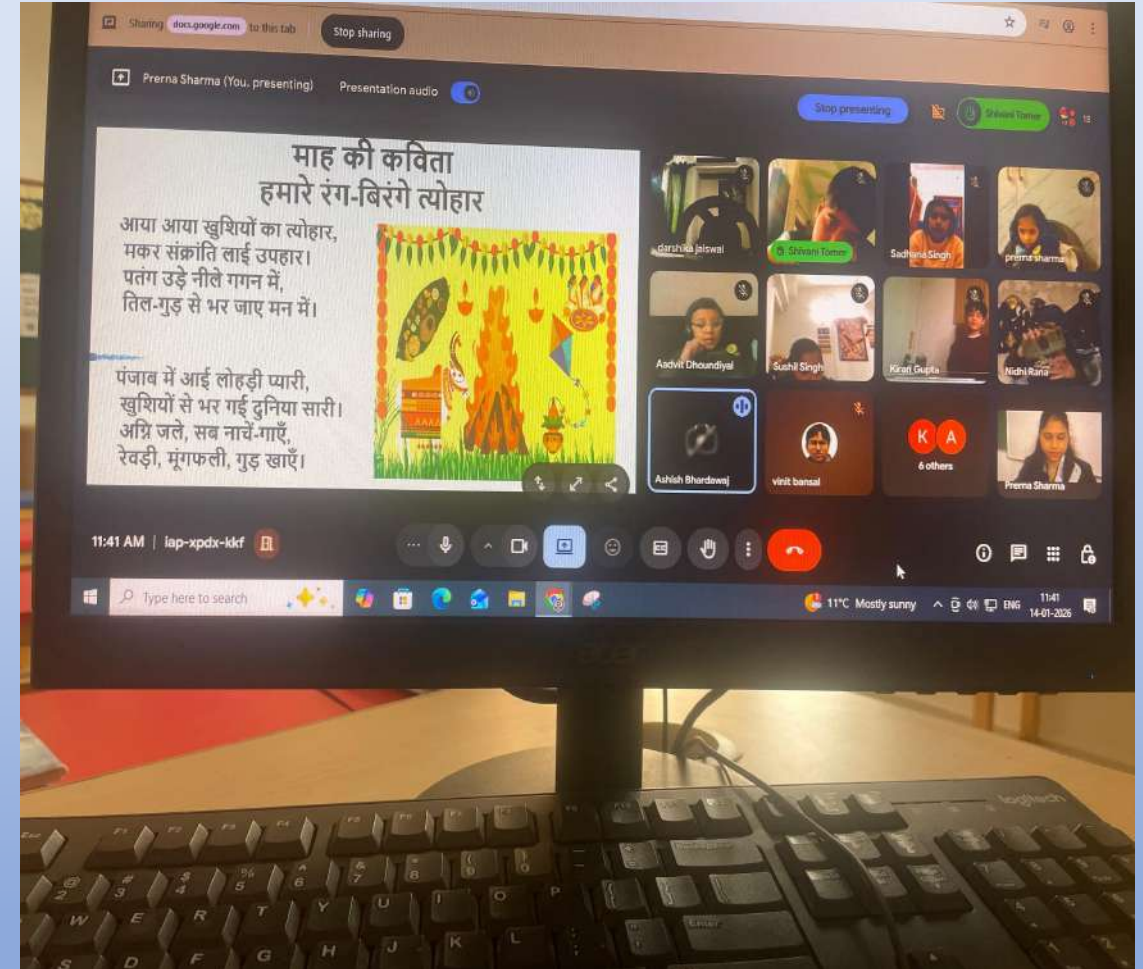

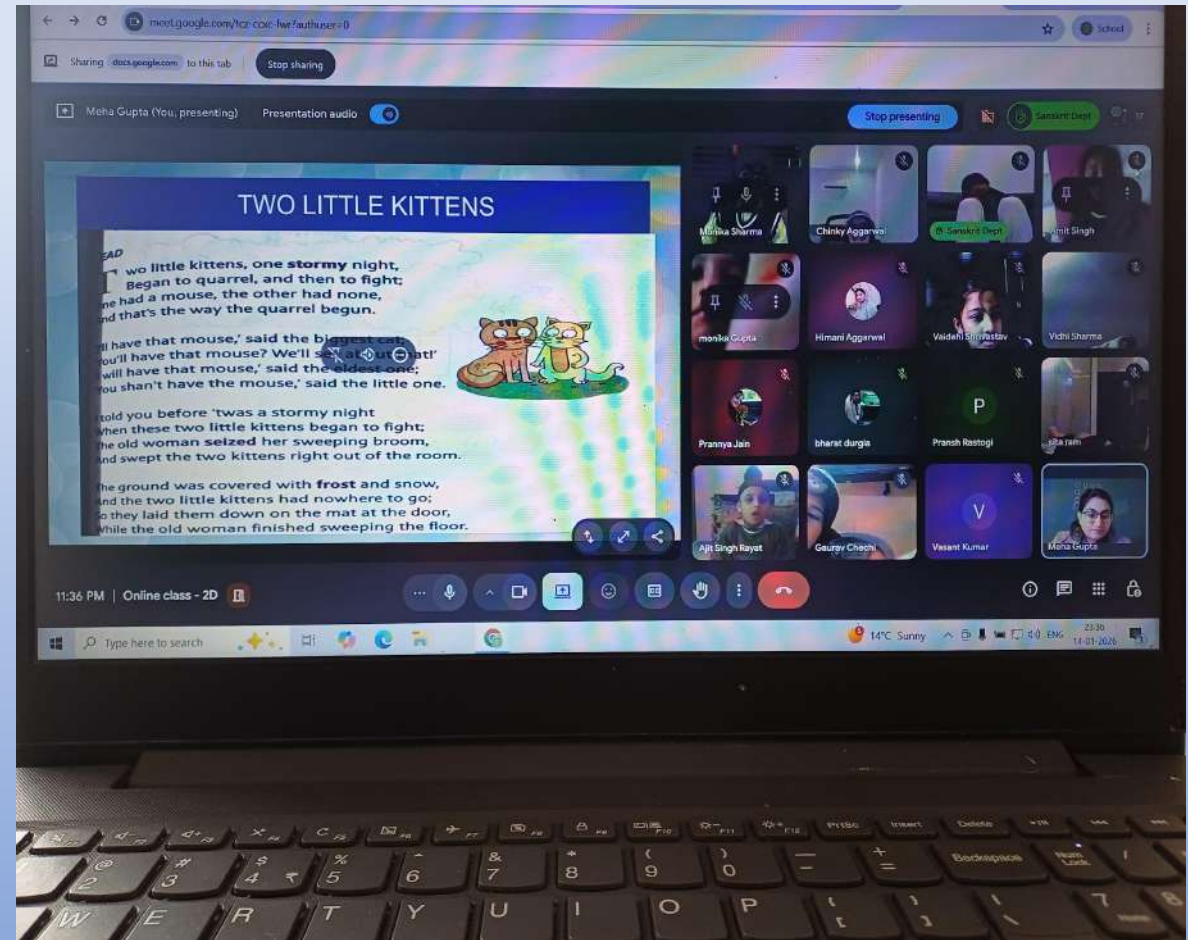
# हिन्दी

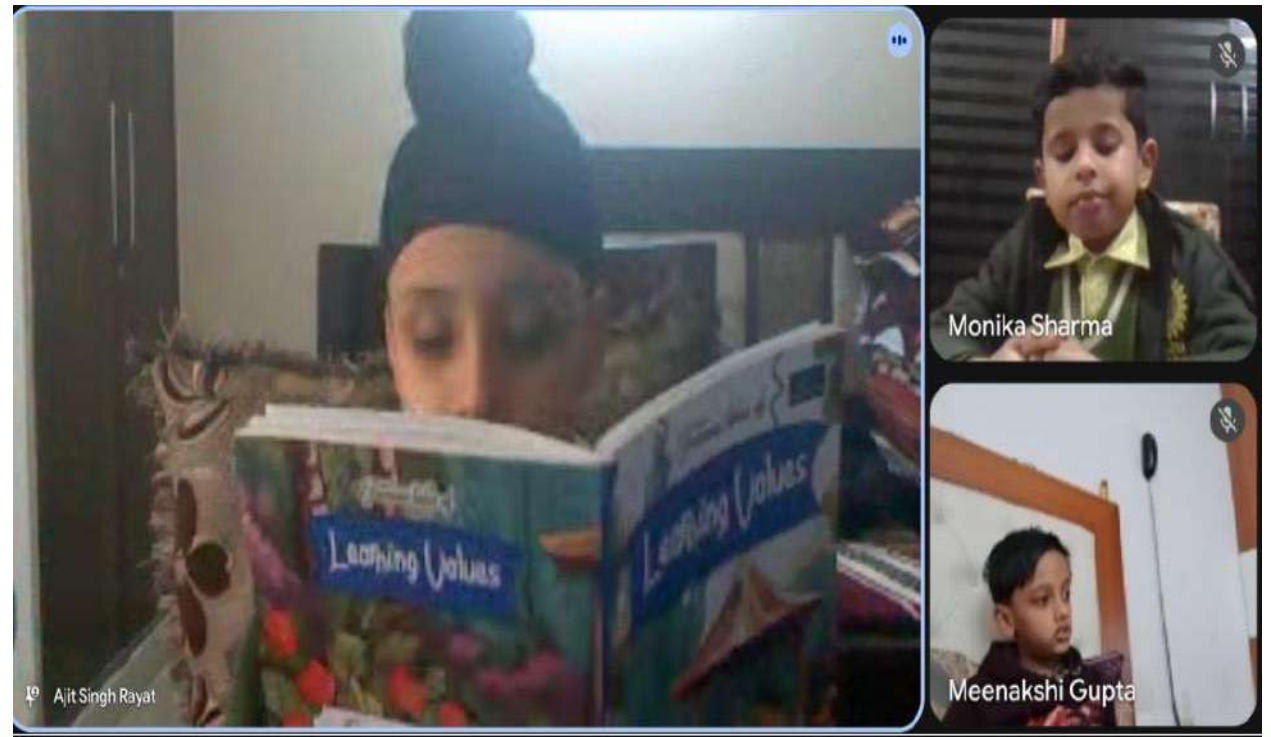
# VOCAL MUSIC

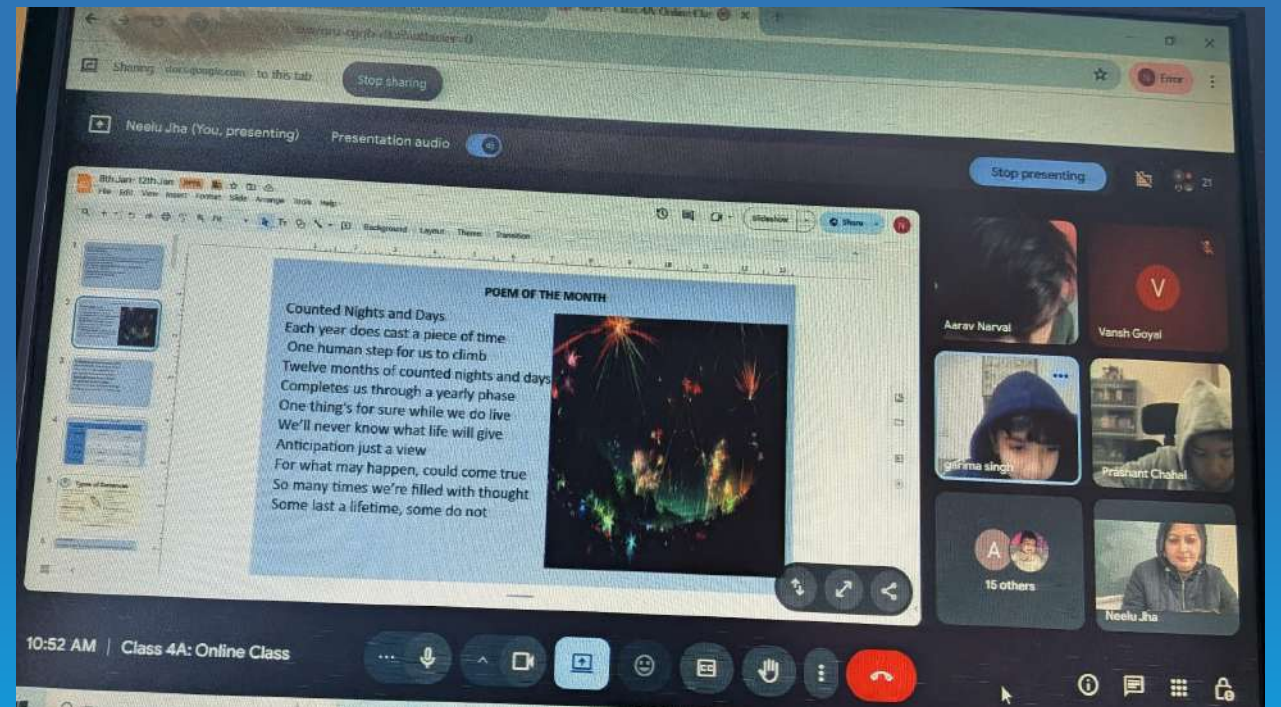
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

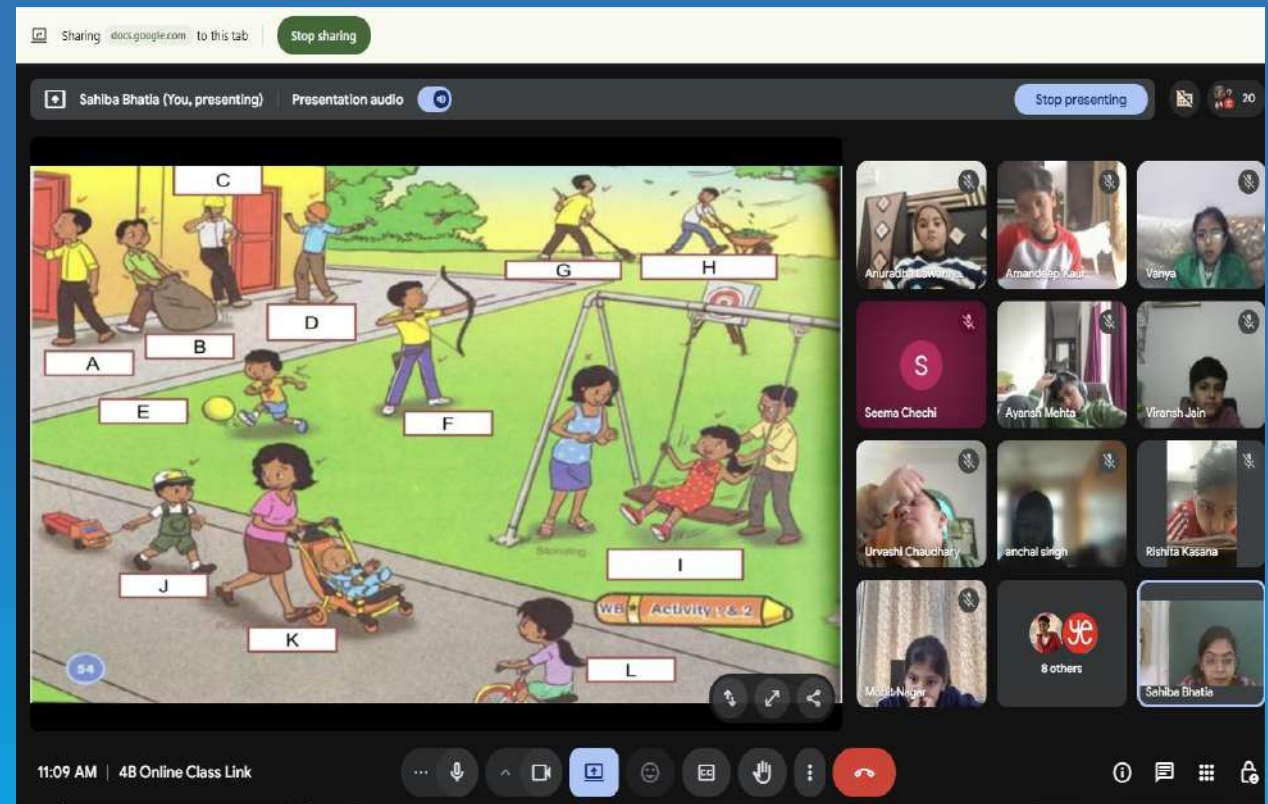

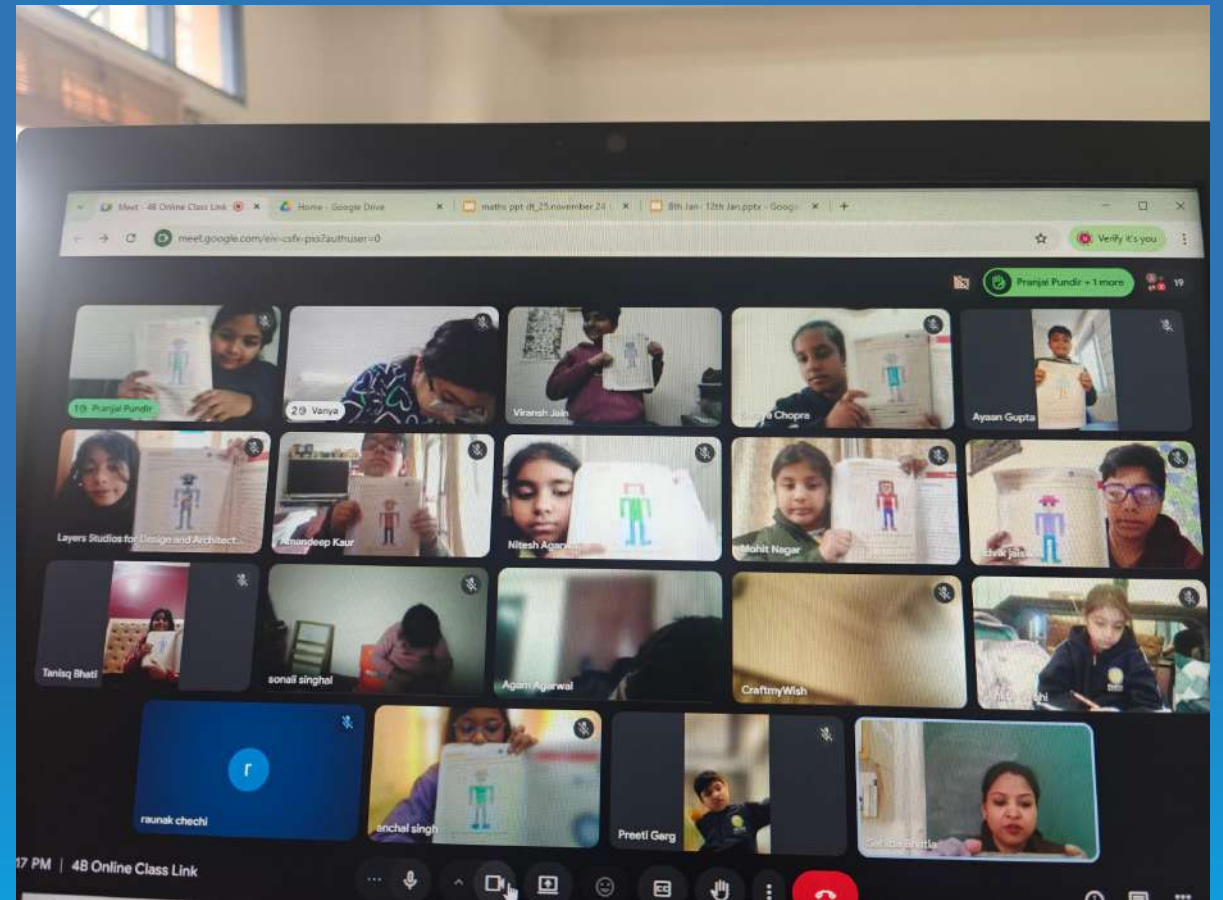
# हिन्दी

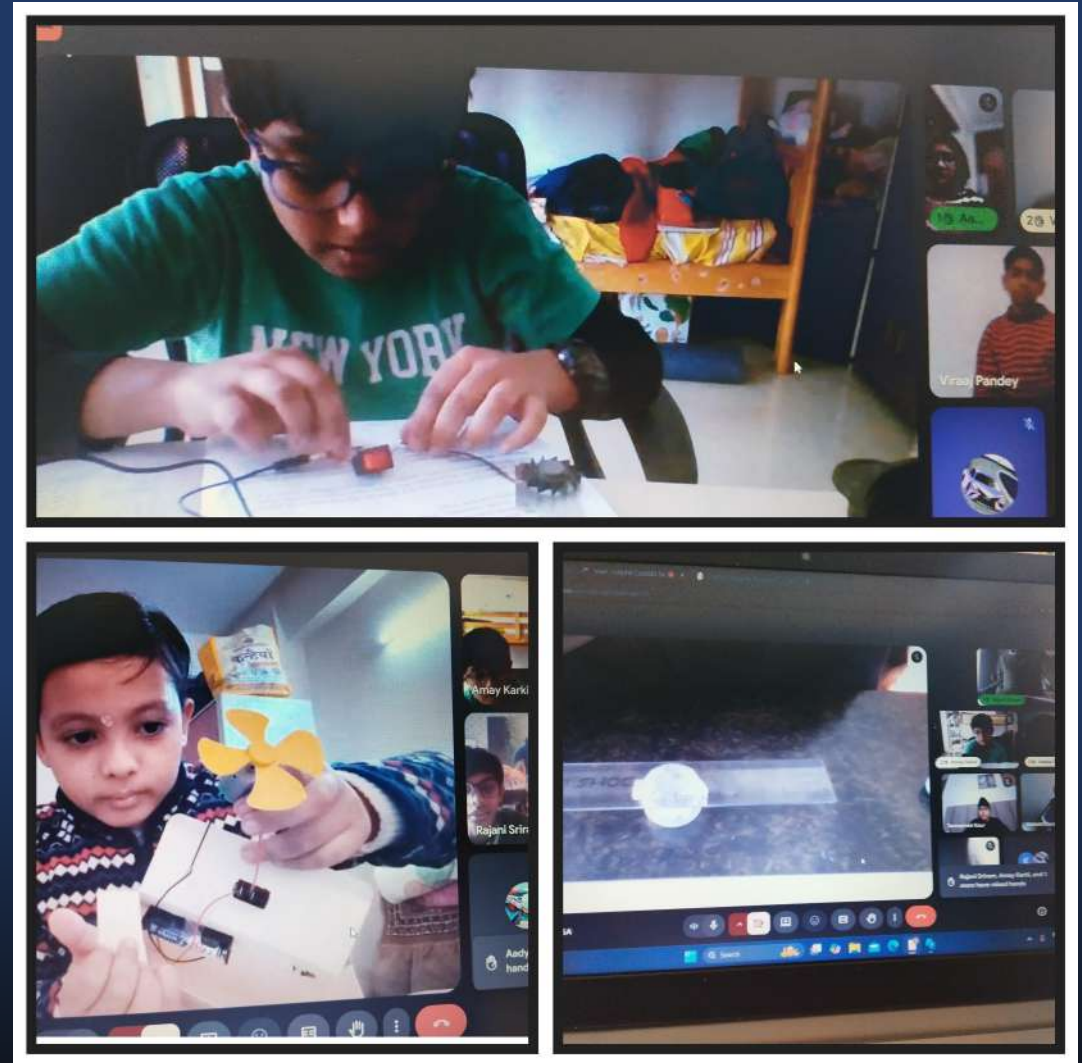

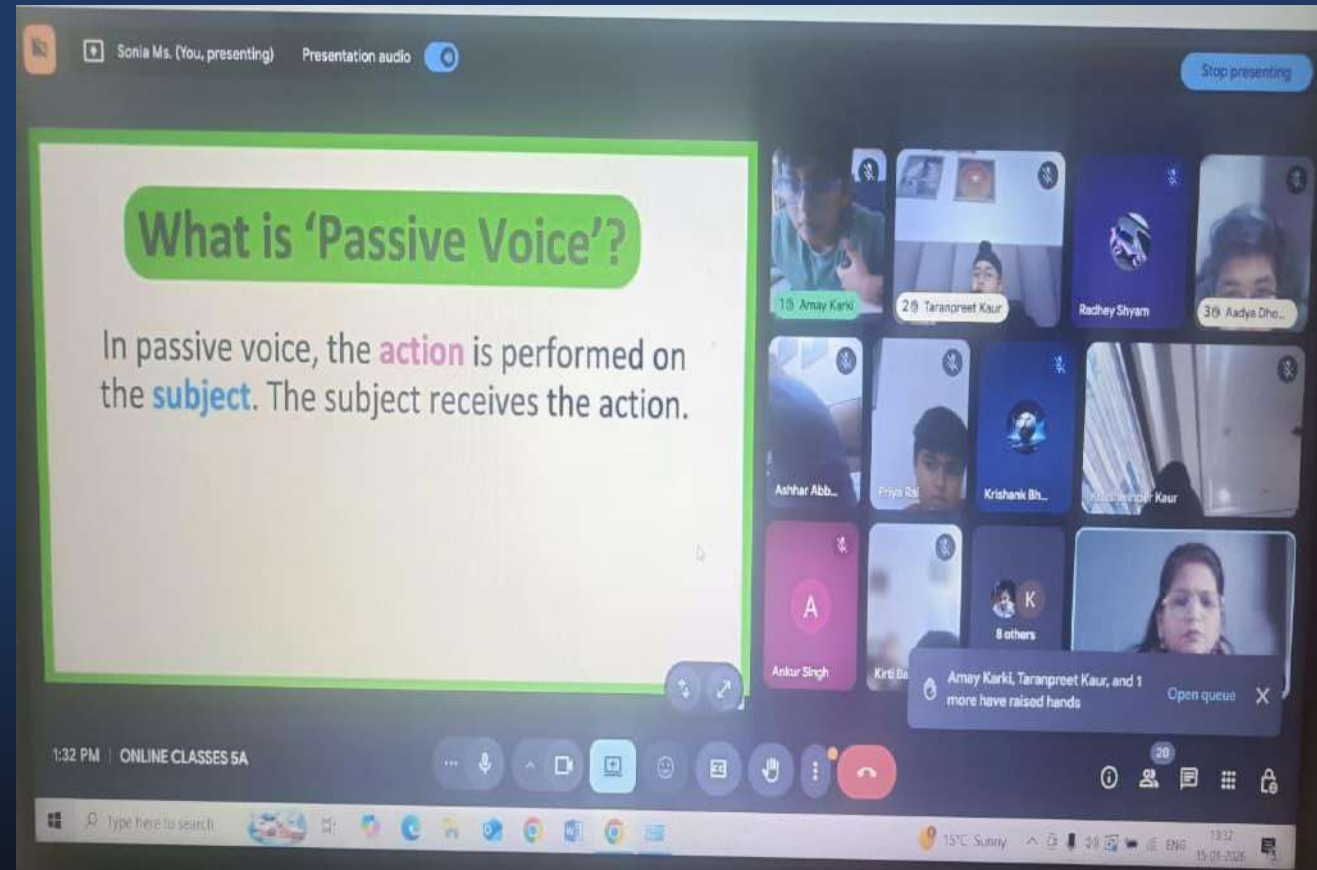
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
