# NURSERY

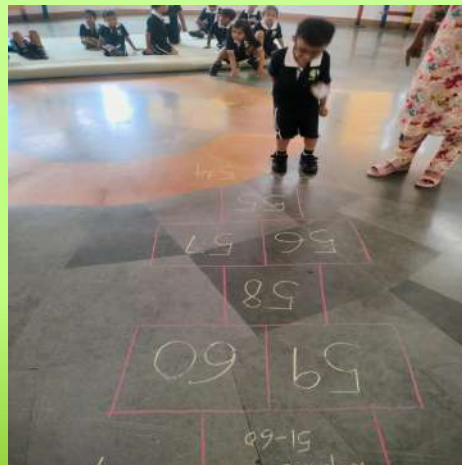
# EVS

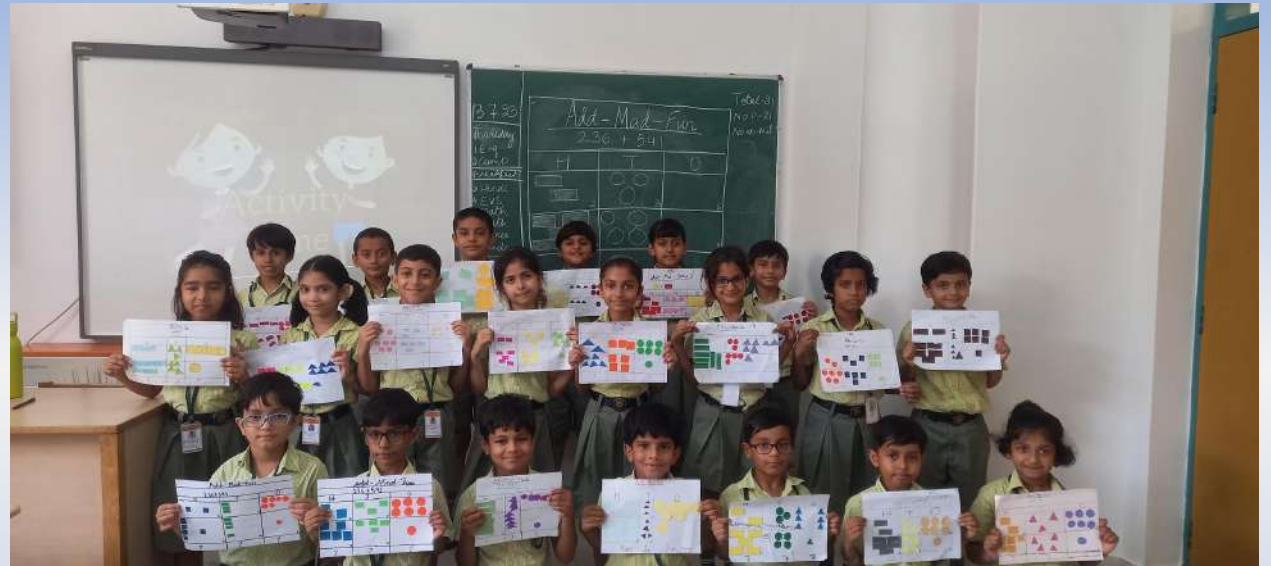

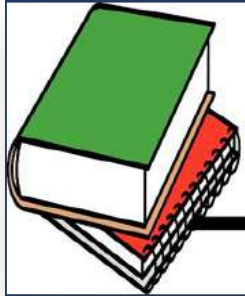




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

# English



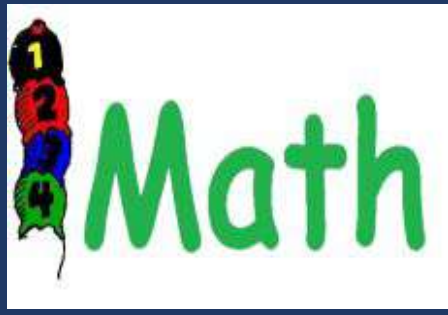

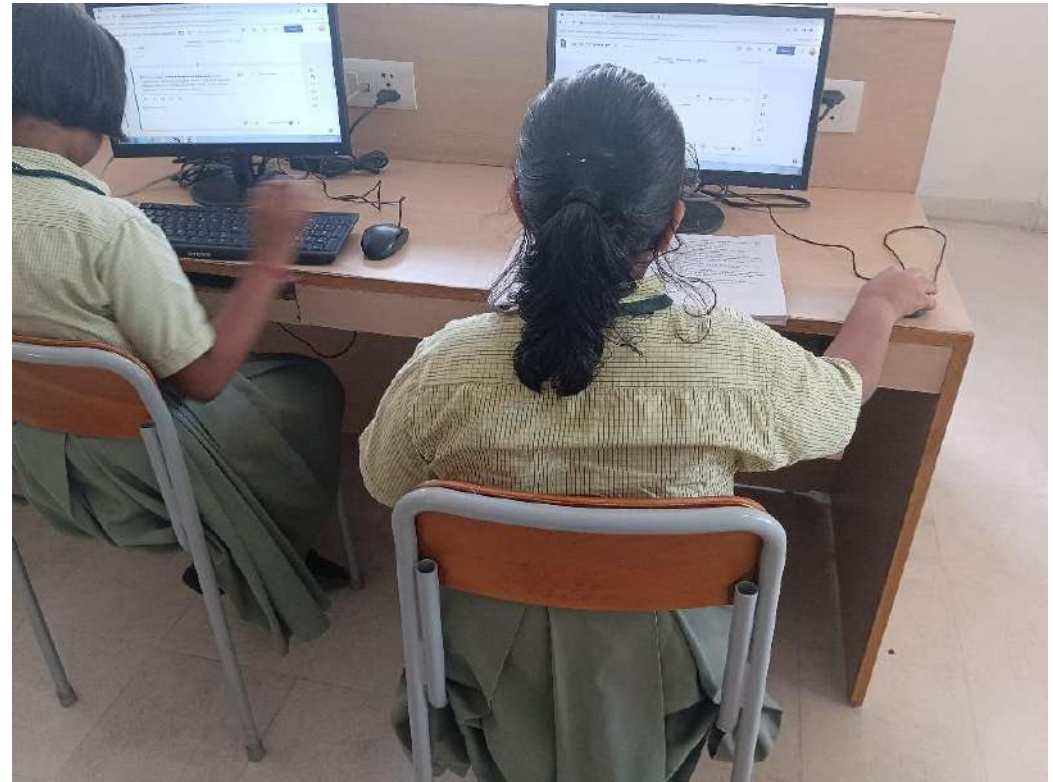


# COMPUTER (3-5)
