NURSERY



ENGLISH

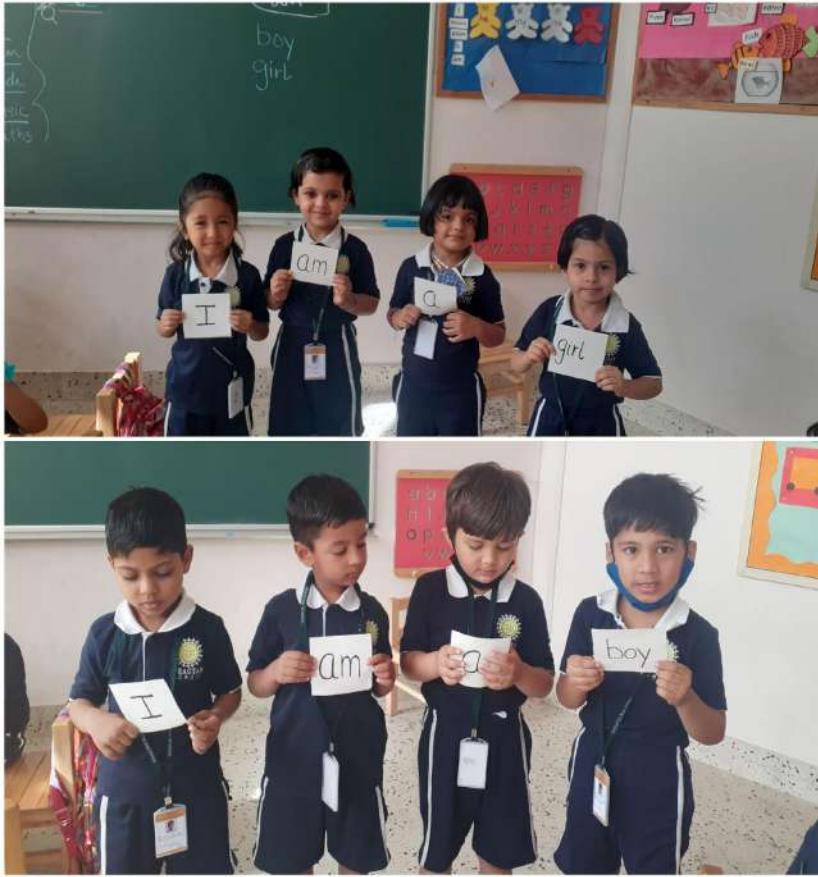
YOGA

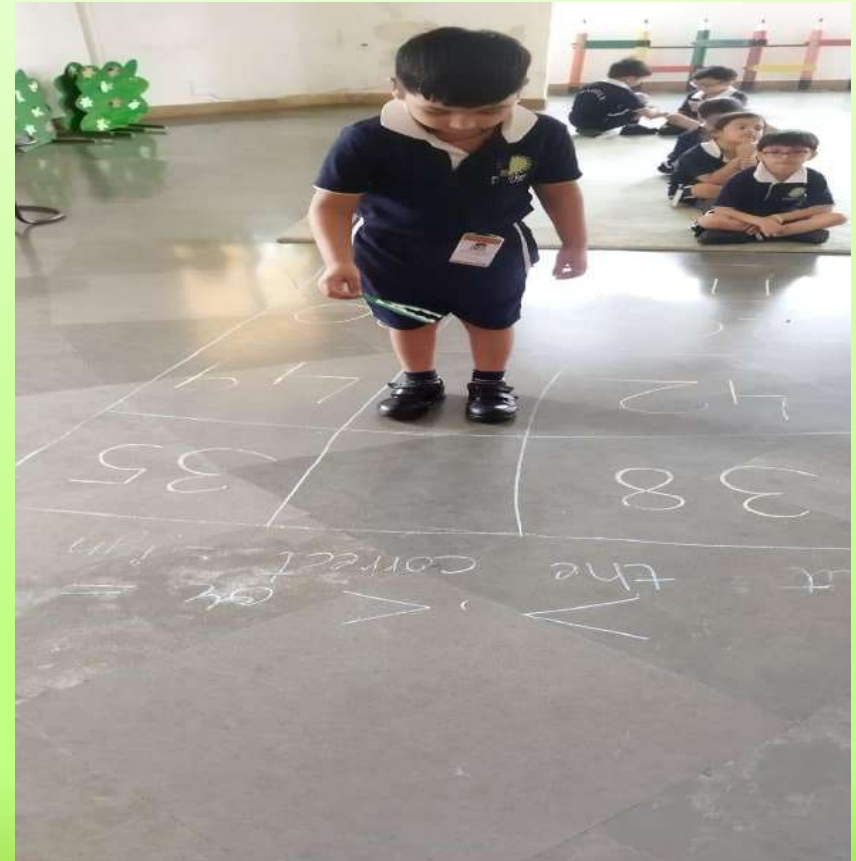
ENGLISH



Introduction of letter k was done through pictures, stories and flashcards. Students practiced singing the jolly phonic sound of the letters done with actions. Introduction of two letter words ib and ip was also done through flash cards.

MATHS

Introduction of numbers from 90-100 was done through flashcards. Children did various worksheets based on after/before and greater than, less than numbers. They practiced greater and lesser numbers with alligator mouth activity during resource period.



HINDI

Introduction of vyanjan ऋ was done with the help of pictures and stories. Students practiced writing ऋ in their workbook and notebook.

Discussion on food was done in class. Children were taught about dairy products and their benefits. They also enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.

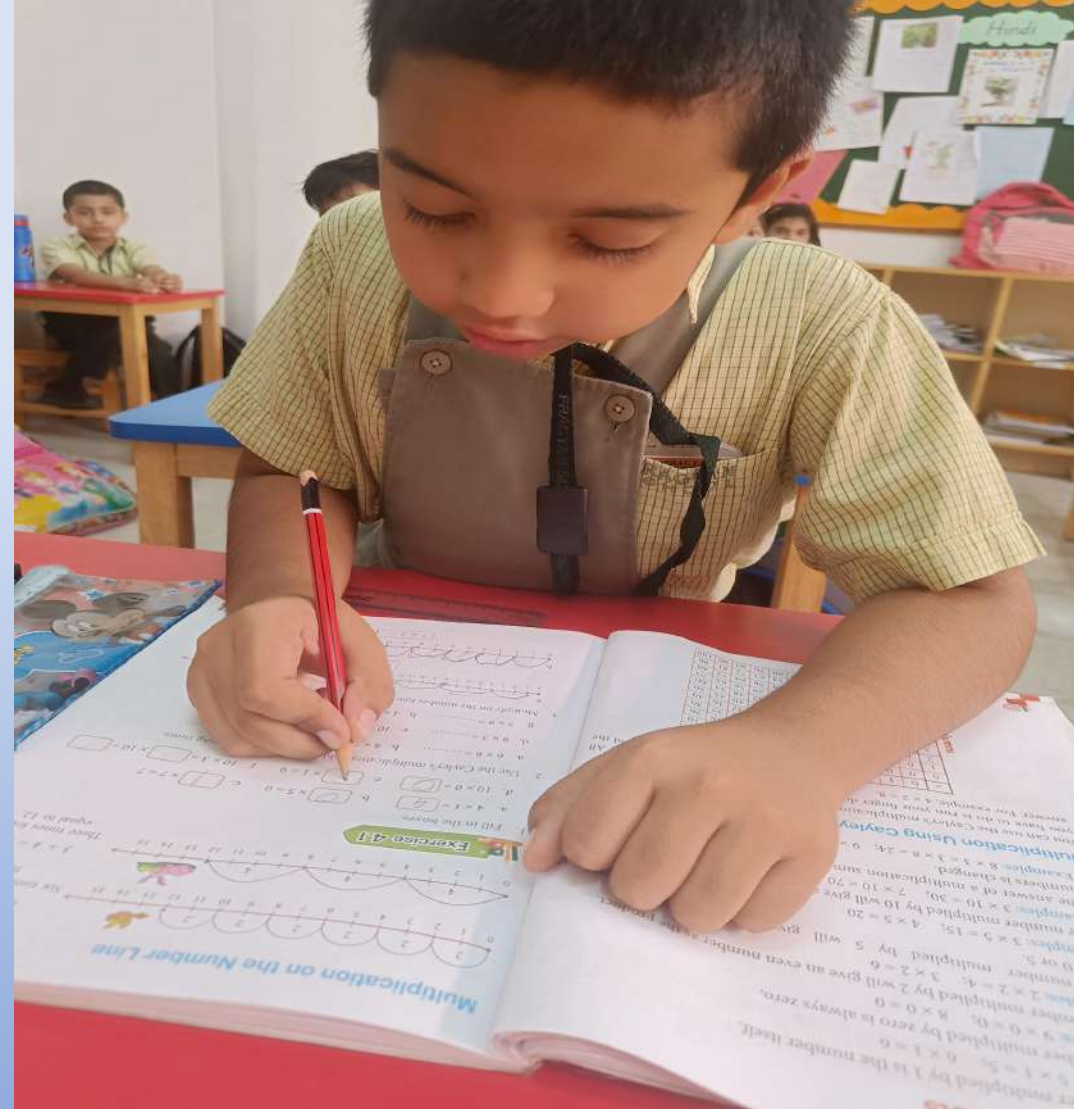




Math

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 3 continued with the chapter India-Physical. They were thrilled to know about the various landforms in India in detail such as the Northern Mountains, Northern Plains, Deserts, Deccan Plateau, Islands and Coastal Region. Oral evaluation of the topics taught was also done in the class to revise the concepts. Videos and ppt related to the topics taught were shown to the students in the class.





Students of class 4 were introduced to the poem of the month. They even learnt the new words of the month. Topic genders and antonyms were introduced. Worksheets based on the same topics were solved. Lesson Rainmaking was explained in class.





ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Grade 4 students continued to study the chapter- Human Body in which they studied the organ systems such as respiratory, excretory and the central nervous system. Interesting videos were shown to the students for the clear understanding of the concepts taught to them. The students also did the new words of the chapter in their notebook.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The interesting and captivating world of the nervous system was introduced to the students of grade 5 with the introduction of L-19: Nervous System. The various parts of the organ system-brain, spinal cord and nerves were discussed in detail along with its location, functions and significance. Videos on the various parts of the brain and the working of the nerves were shown to give a practical understanding of the concepts.





Students of class 5 did a few exercises based on Types of Adjectives in their course book and notebooks. They were introduced to articles this week and were given a list of synonyms too. They did a few worksheets based on them in their workbook.

Dance performances motivate the children and they get stage experience too. Students of class 5 prepared for their Independence Day. They also learnt some hand gestures.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (3-5)

Students of classes of 3-5 learnt basic skills of different games like layup shot and march practice. They have also learnt to play matches. General rules and regulations of basketball, match practice in football, backhand and forehand practice in table tennis, forehand and backhand lift shots in badminton and underhand skills of volleyball were also taught. They also participated enthusiastically in activities of physical fitness components development through different drills.



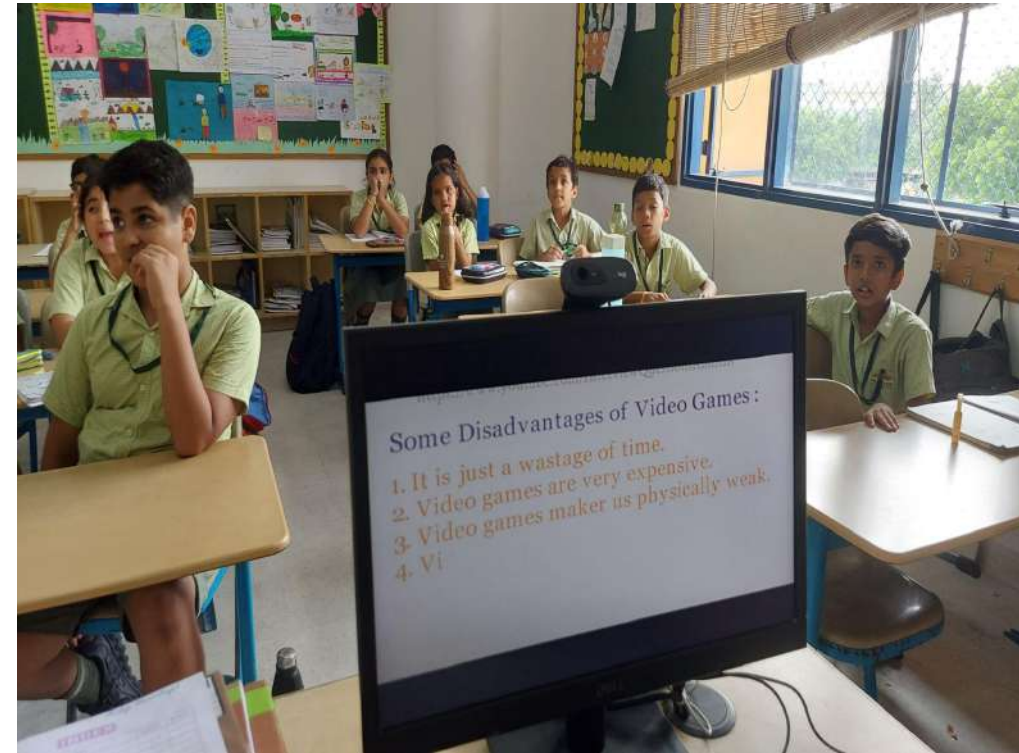
LIBRARY (3-5)

Libraries provide the students with a healthy environment for learning and encourages the process of learning and grasping knowledge. Students of classes 3,4 and 5 read different types of books in the library and also issued them. A student of class 4C also presented a summary of the book - A Tiny Bit Lucky by Tom Gates. Tom Gates is a boy who is more focused on doodling and biscuits than his schoolwork. A Little Bit Lucky is a book about Tom and a few things going on in his life over the week.



CLASS TEACHER PERIOD

Classes 3 to 5 have theme based Class Teacher's period from Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. Monday's Circle Time class was based on the topic 'Video Games...a boon or bane.' The pros and cons of playing video games were discussed in the class along with related slides. The students enthusiastically participated in the class discussion posing their views. Tuesday's Value Education session was on Quotes of Freedom Fighters. The quotes of famous freedom fighters were shared. Post session, the students wrote on a paper 'The Pledge I Want To Take.' Thursday's General Awareness session was on Top Indian Companies Ruling The World.

On August 7th and 8th 2023, students of class 3 B conducted the morning assembly on the topic Friends and Family. Students commenced the assembly with the morning exercise and further presented inspirational thoughts, talk, news and poems in English and Hindi. Students enjoyed participating and spoke confidently.

BULLY TO BUDDY WORKSHOP

Pragyan School conducted a workshop for the students of classes 3-5 on Bully to Buddy, an anti-bullying campaign for schools. The workshop was conducted on 8th August, 2023. The spokesperson was Ms. Anusha Tyagi, a CID-UNESCO certified Expressive Arts based therapist, currently working in the Department of Mental Health and Behavioral Science at Fortis Healthcare, Noida.

She emphasized that bullying violates the human rights of a child to participate freely in his/ her environment. Each child is unique from each other irrespective of physical abilities, memory and creativity.

The workshop was meant to empower the students with the ability to identify and recognise such incidents, and be aware of the steps involved in dealing with the same. The module aims to help the school establish mechanisms to prevent bullying in schools by establishing an anti-bullying squad.

The one hour booster session was an eye-opener for both the students and the teachers to learn and reflect on bullying behavior, its causes, consequences
